(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of an ornamental design for a shoe, shown with an unclaimed portion of an upper layer of the shoe removed along the dash-dot-dash lines;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the shoe of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a right front perspective view of the shoe of FIG. 1 shown with the upper layer, the upper layer and portions visible through the upper layer being unclaimed.
The dash-dash-dash broken lines are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the shoe that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot-dash lines are included to illustrate where an unclaimed portion of the upper layer of the shoe was removed and form no part of the claimed design.

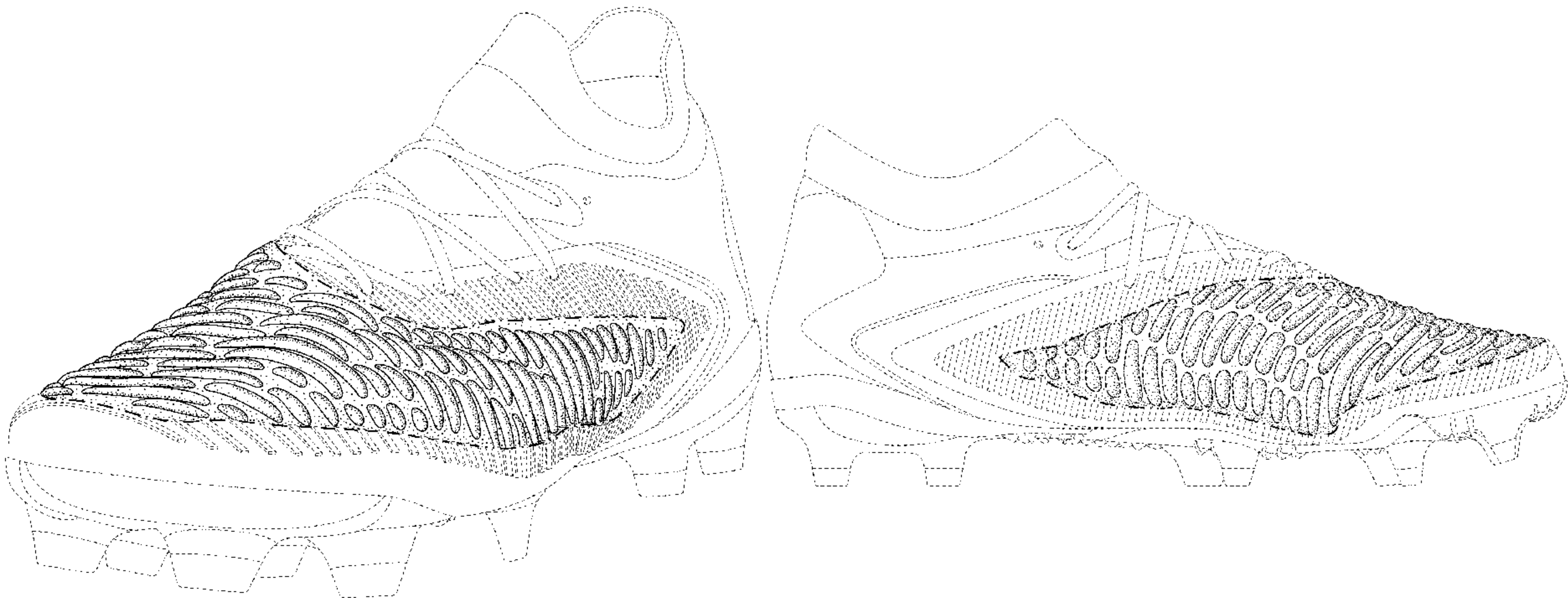

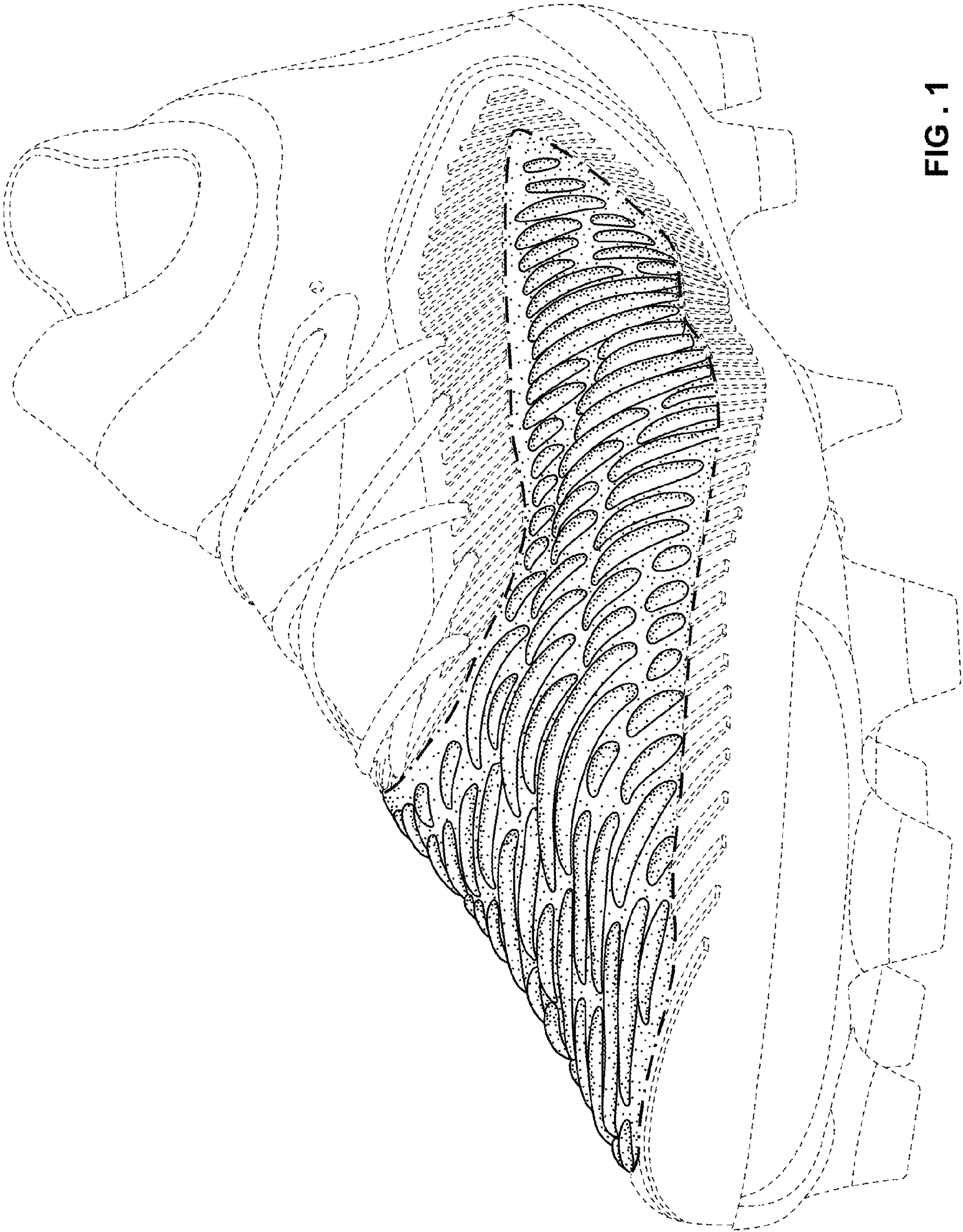

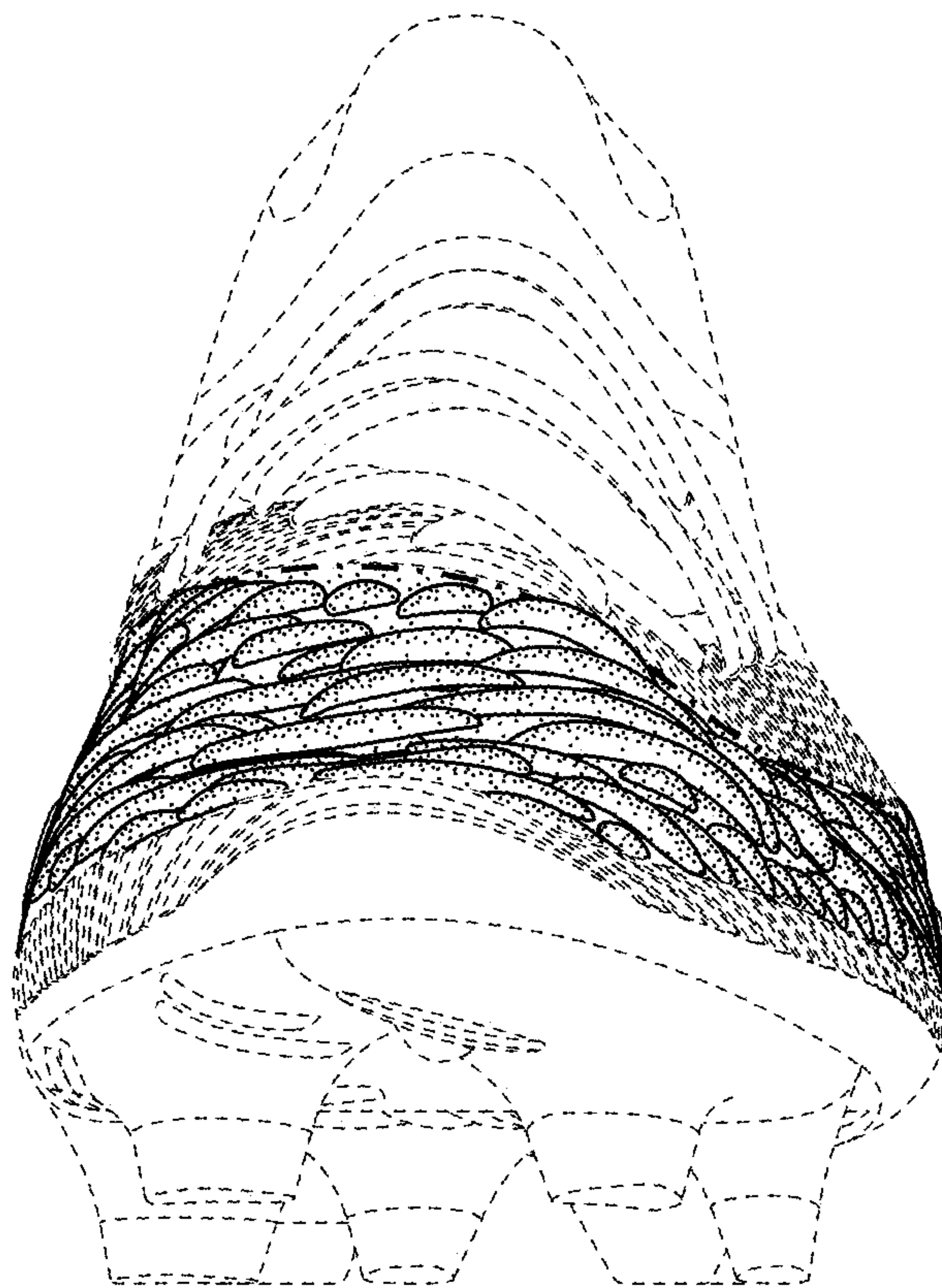

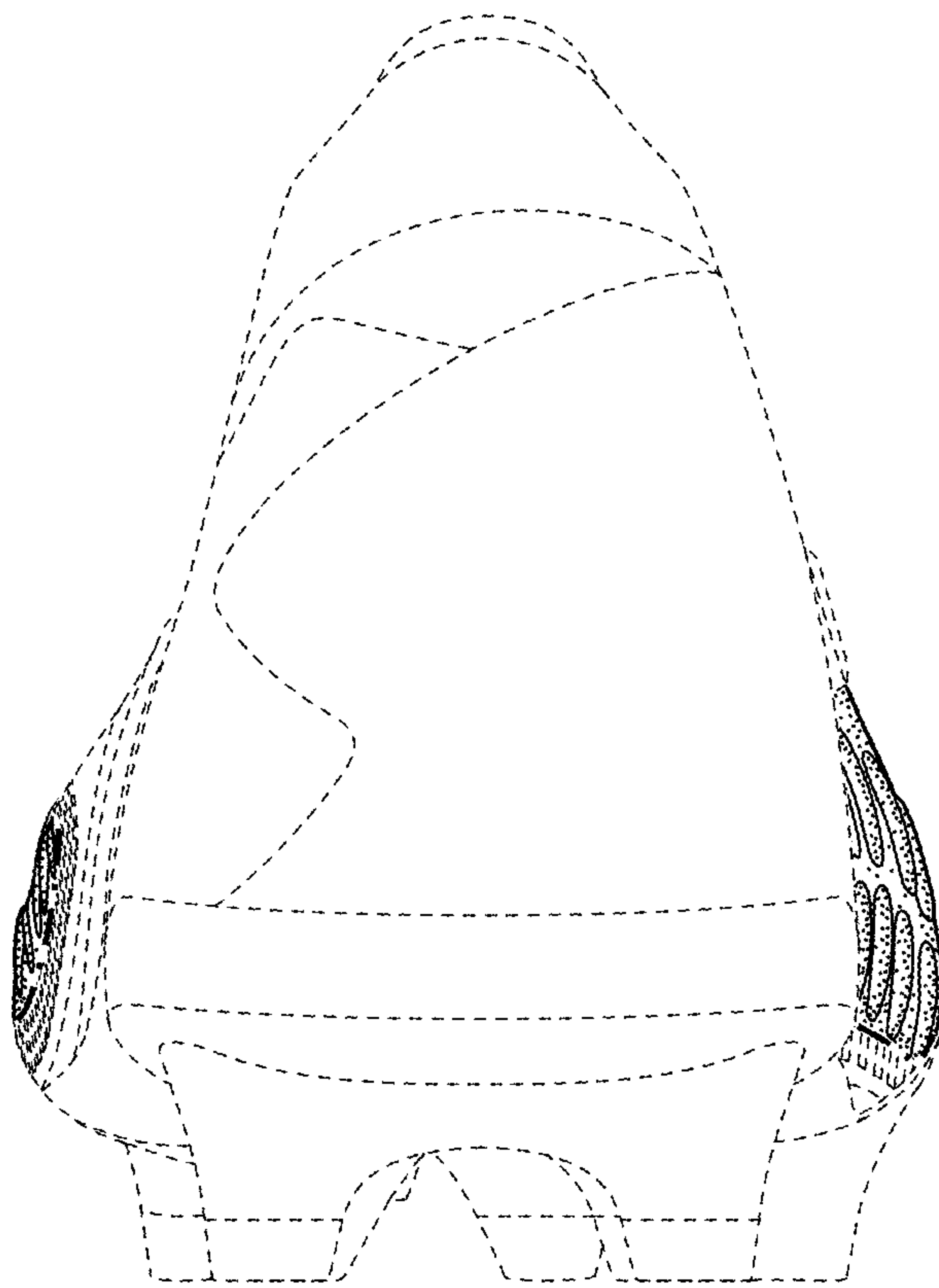

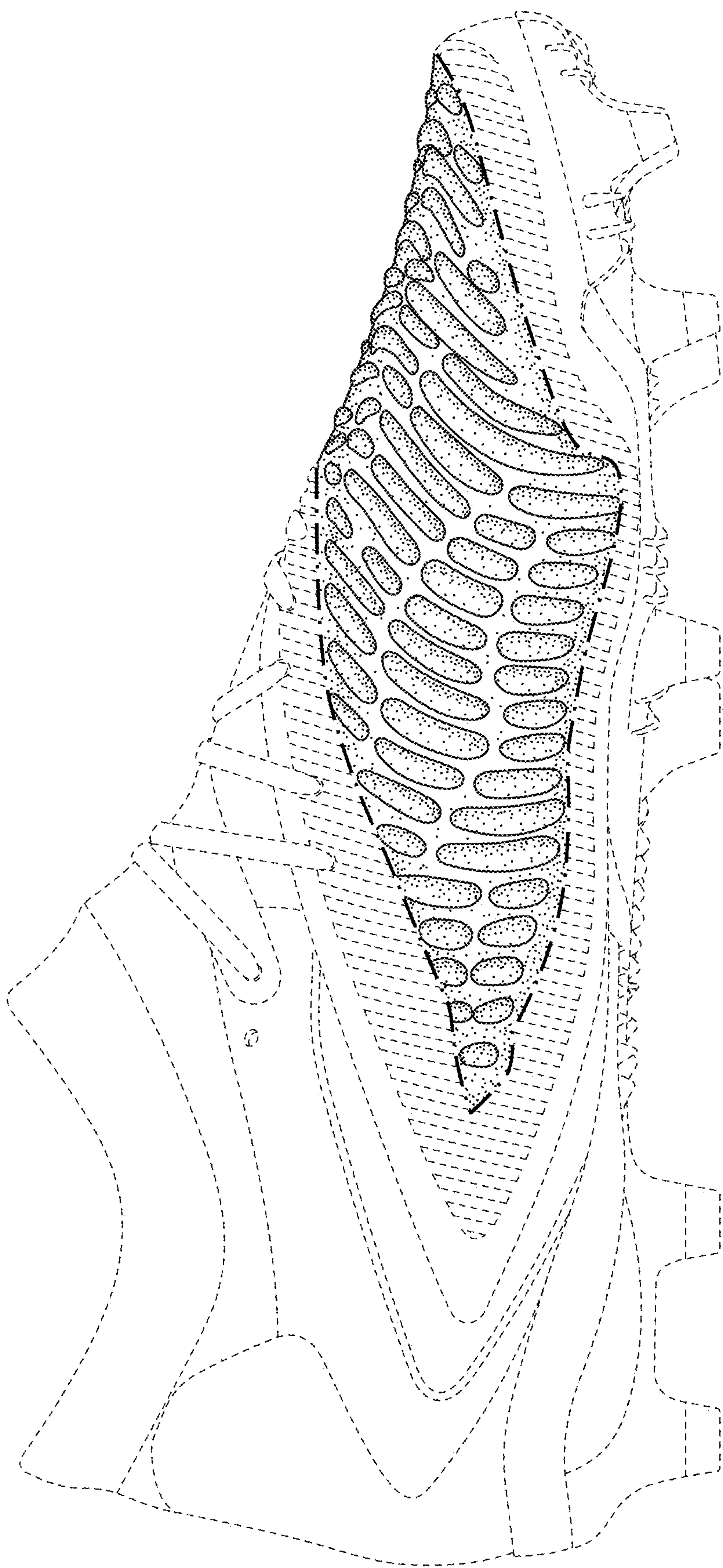

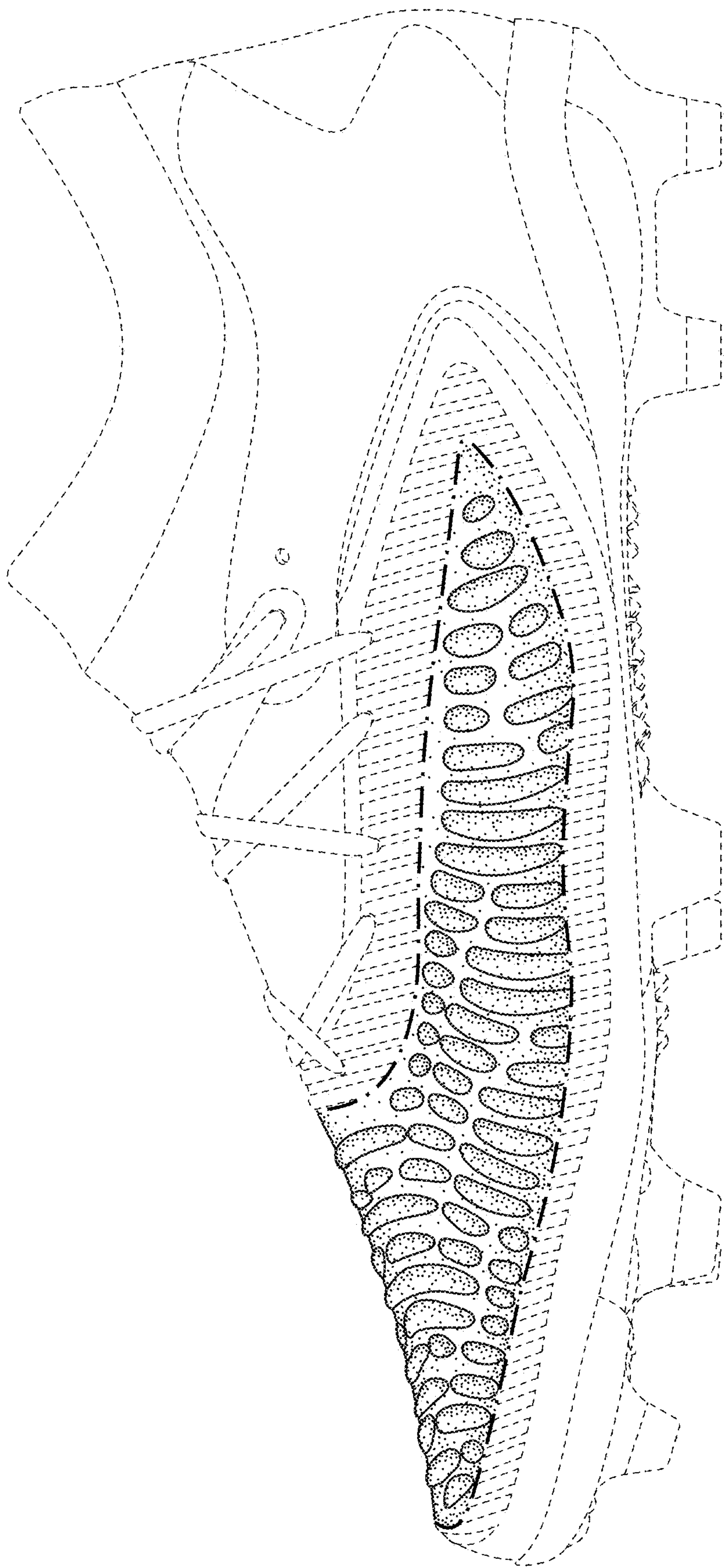

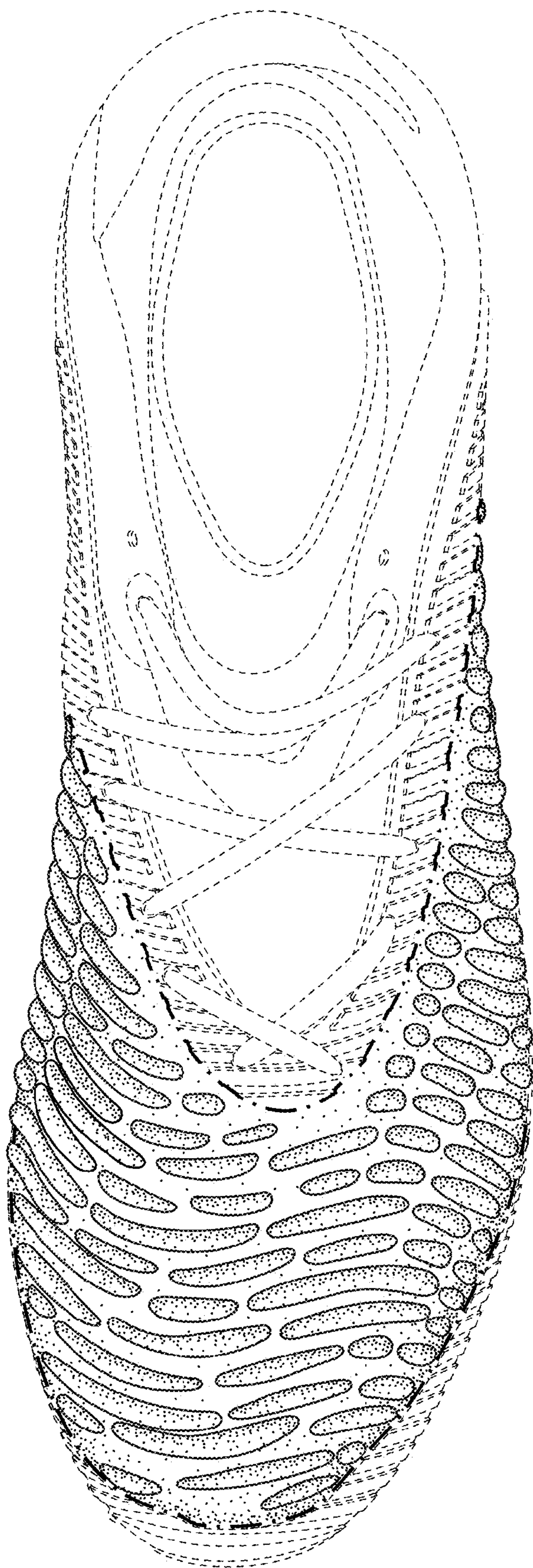

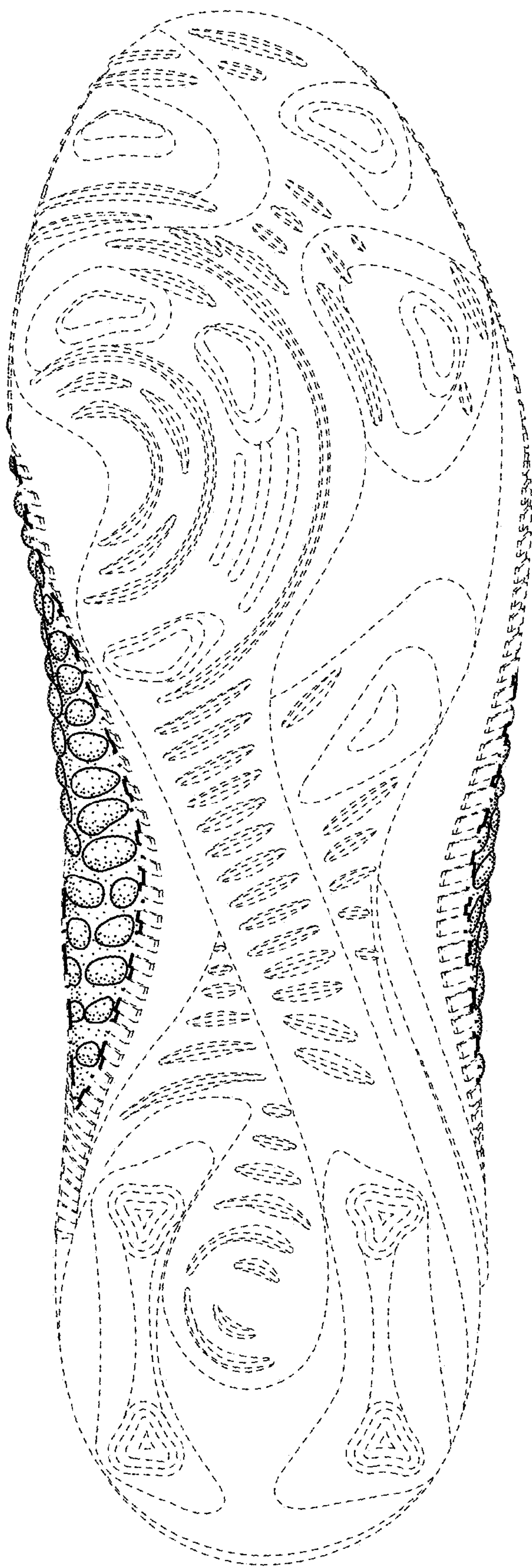

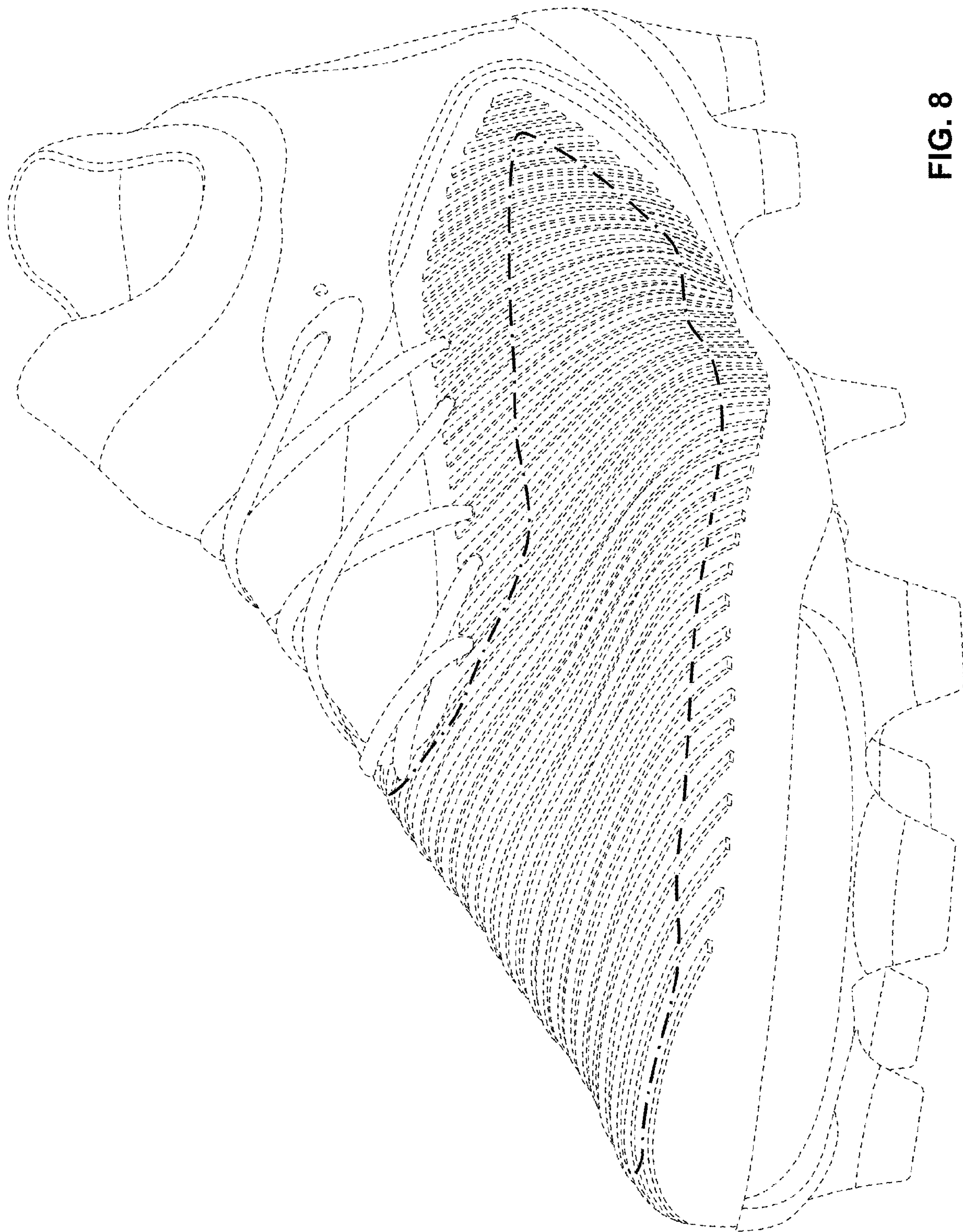
