DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof;

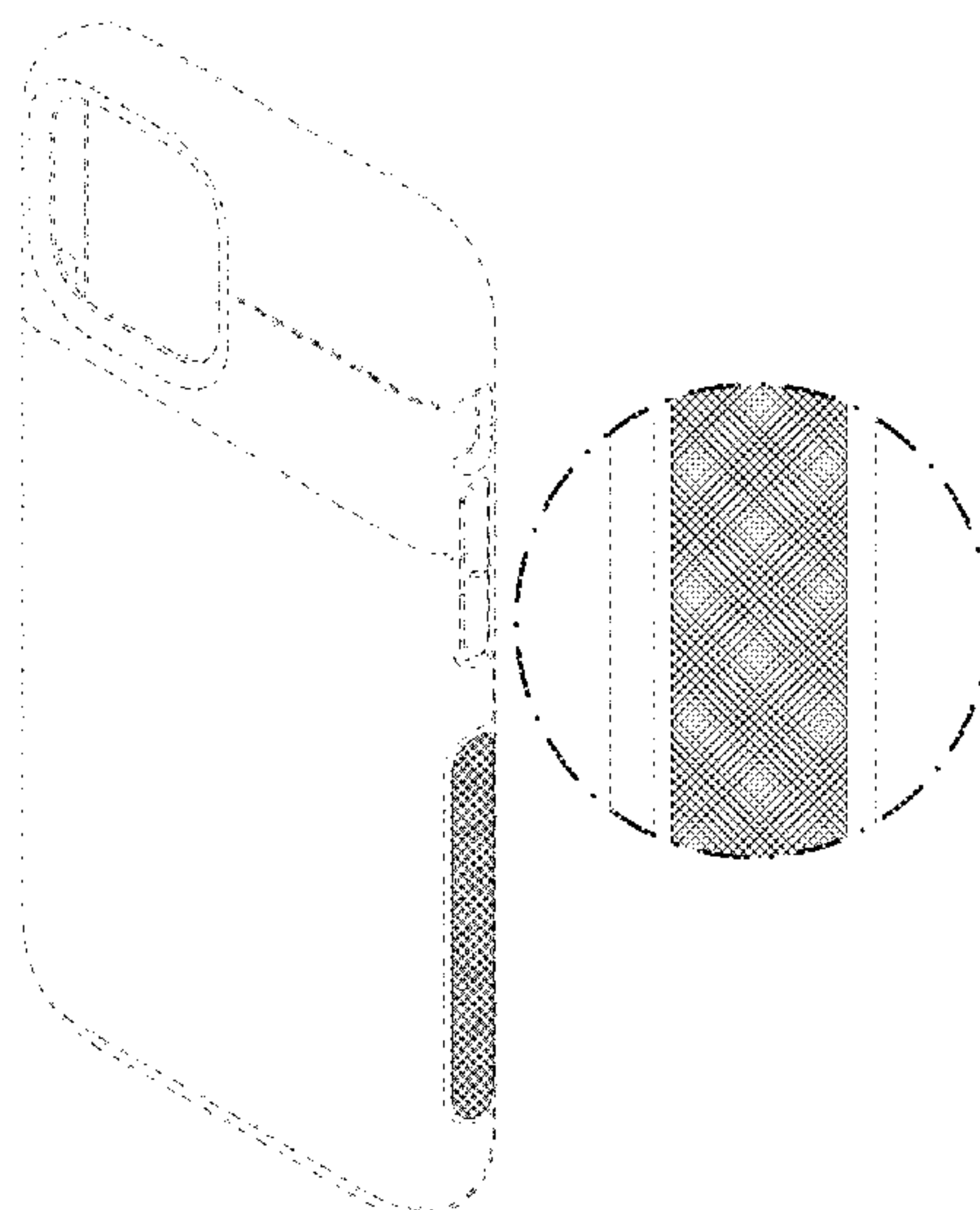
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

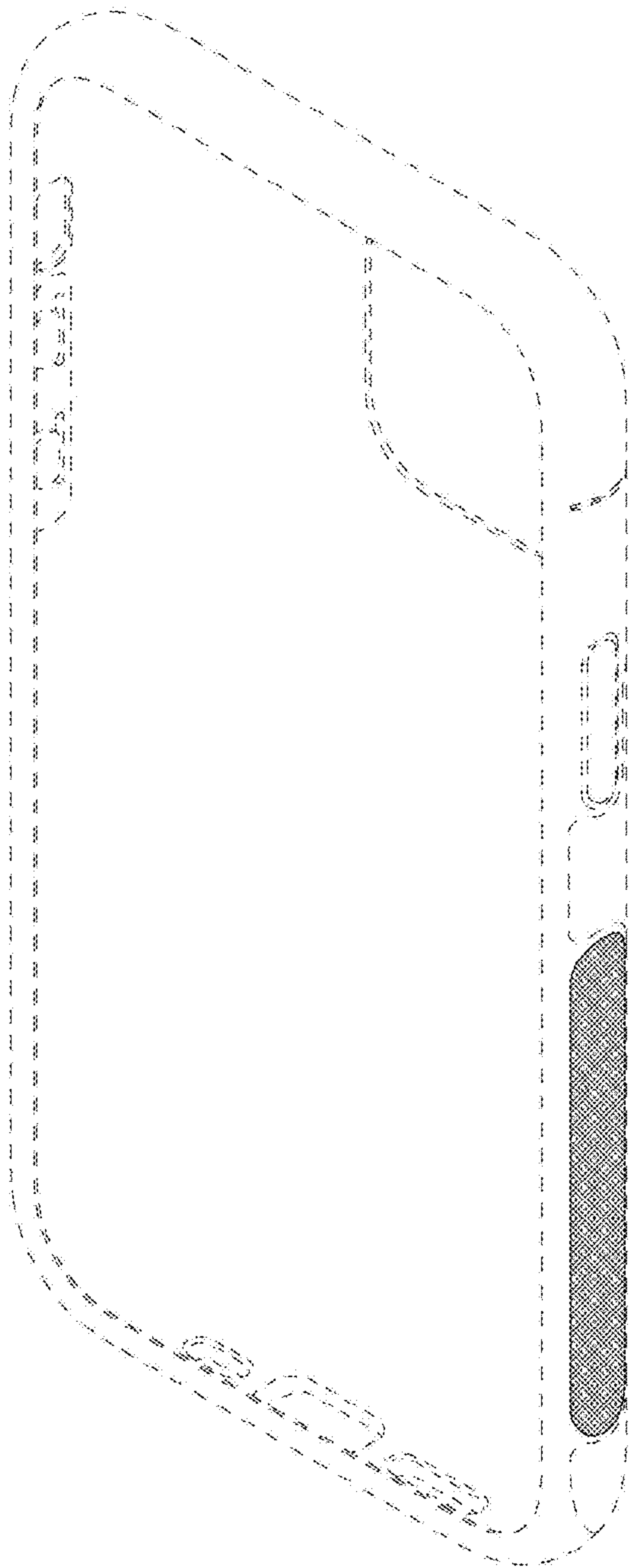

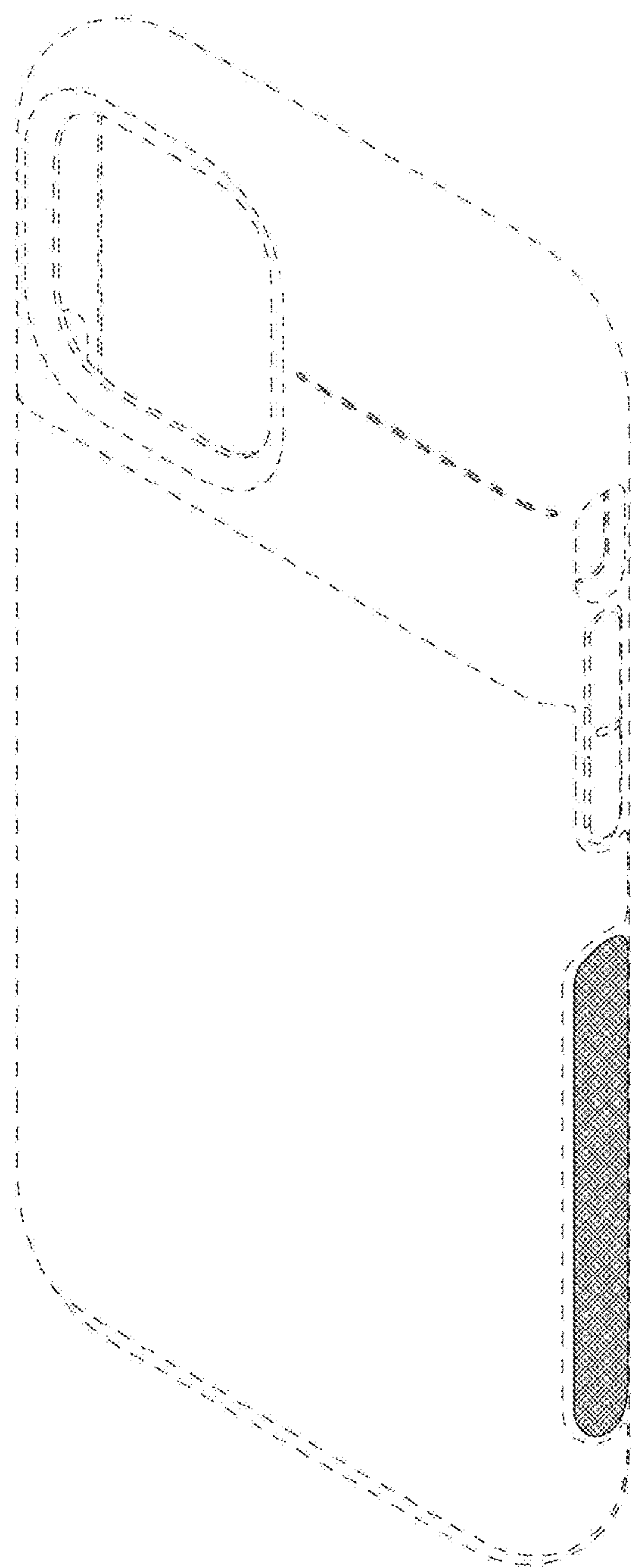

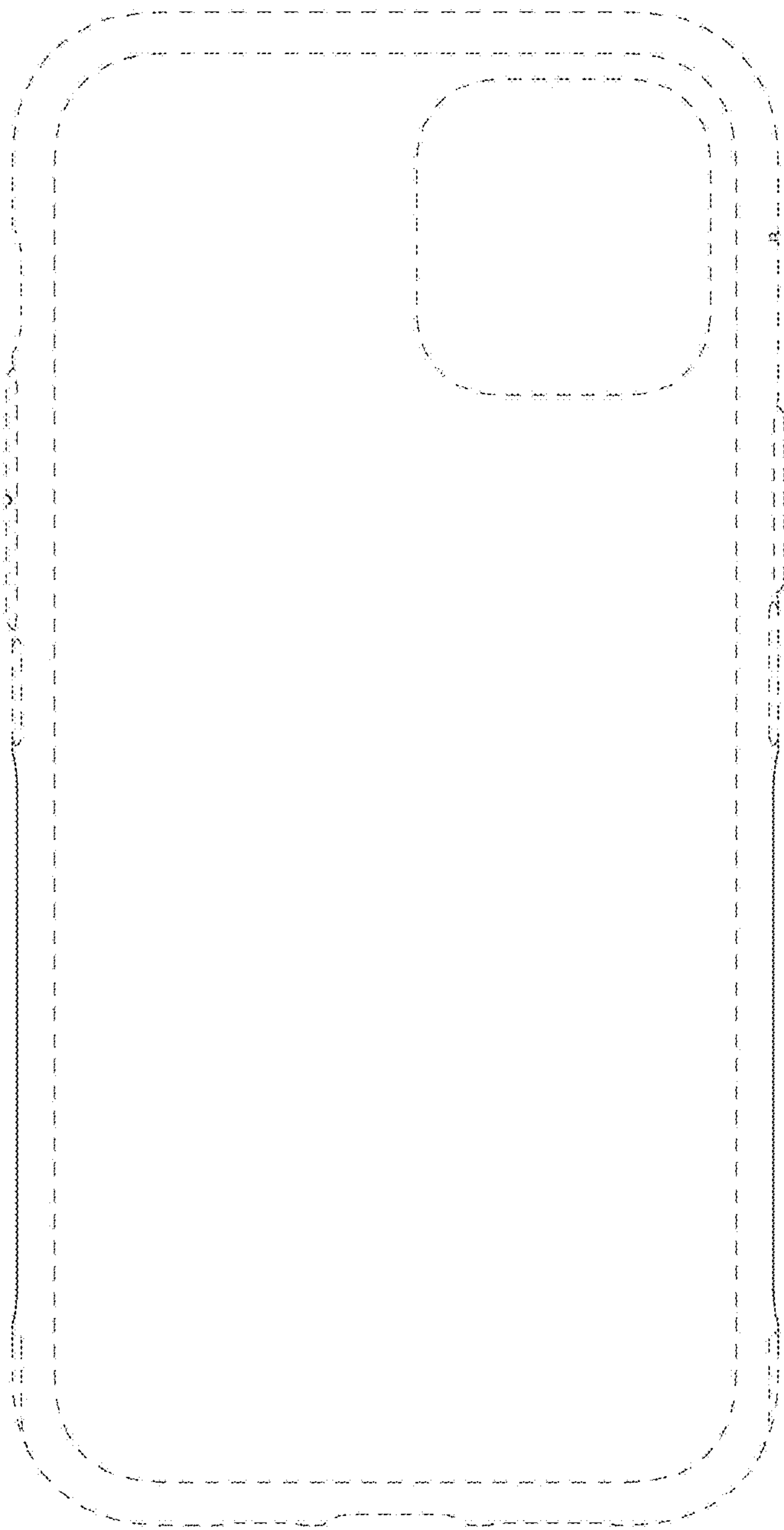

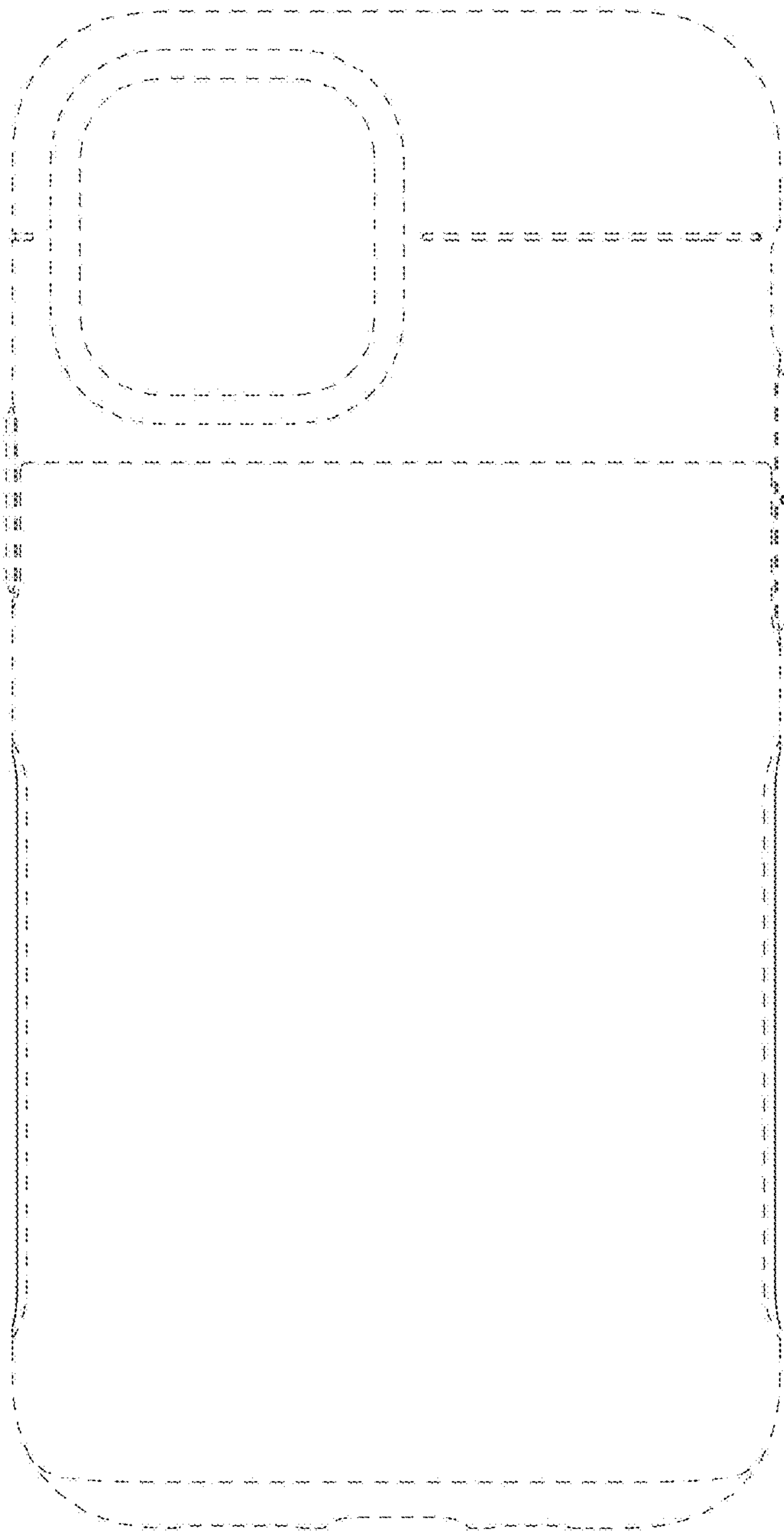

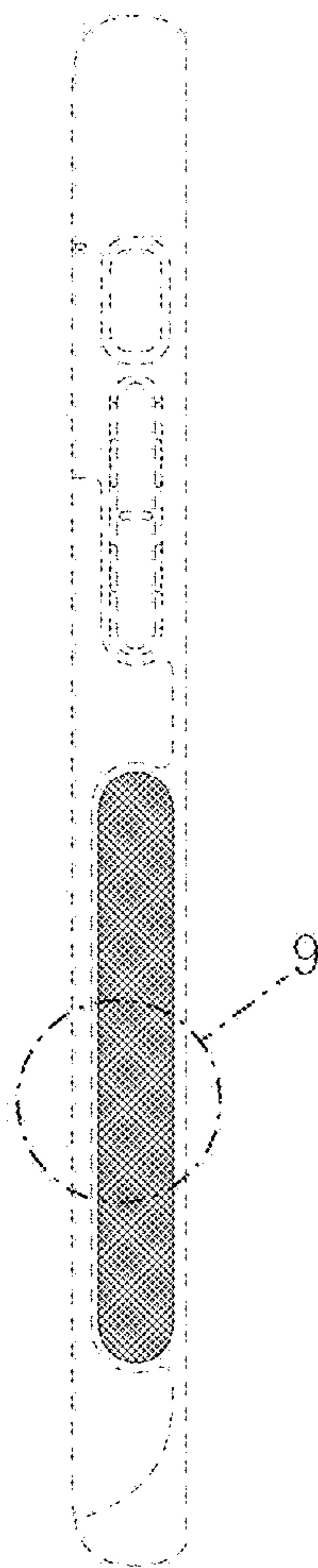

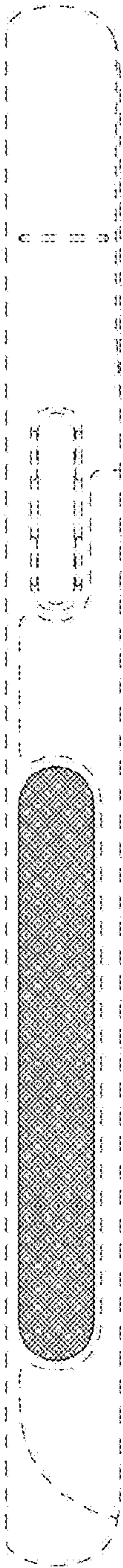

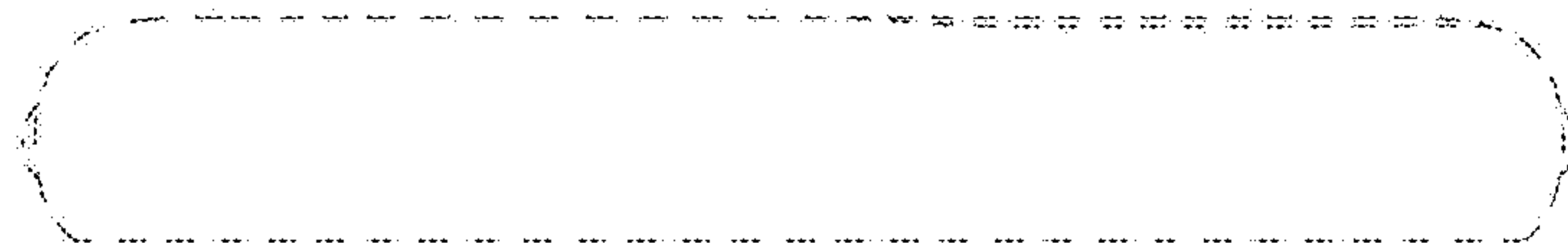
