FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the kayak of FIG. 9.

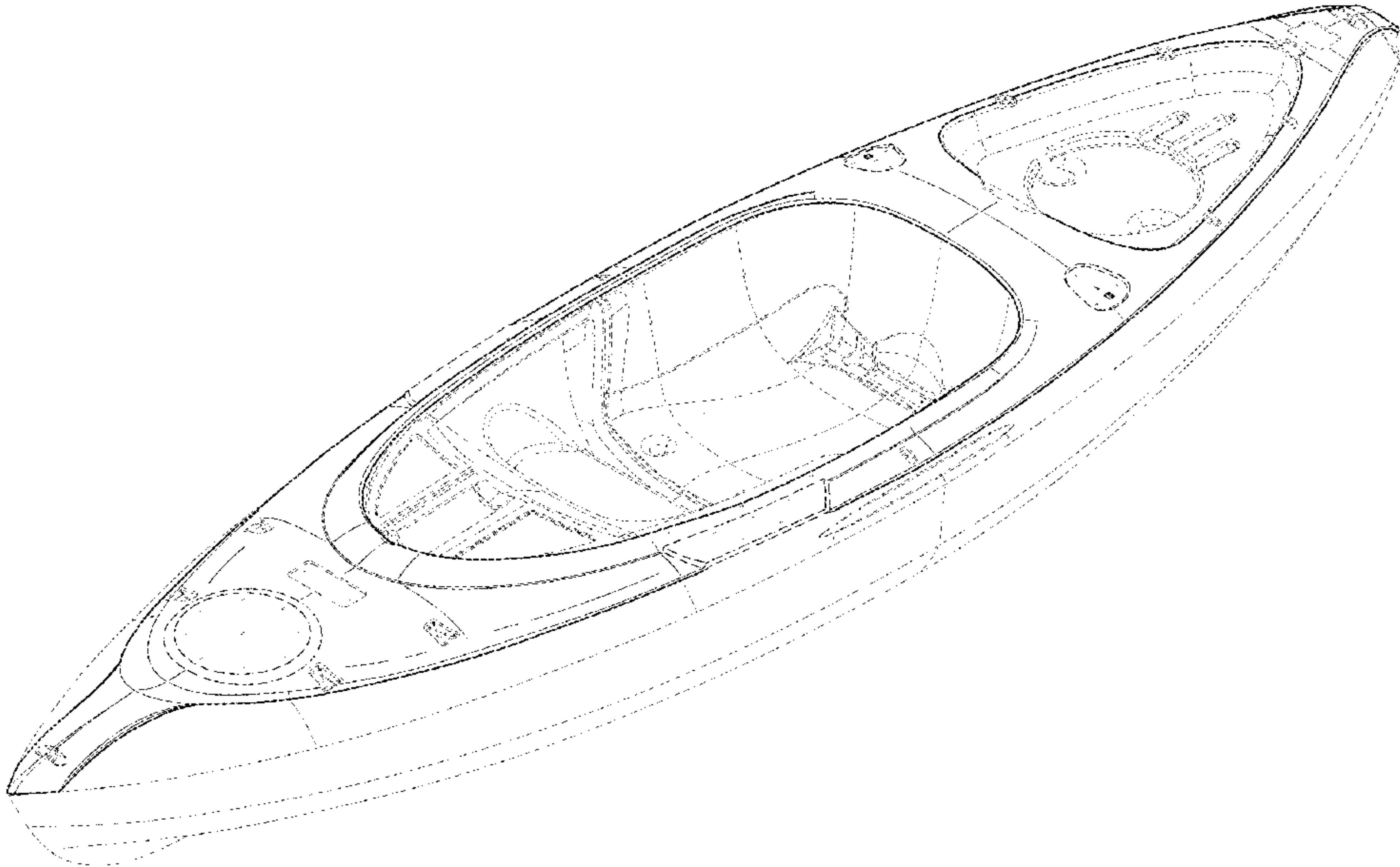
FIG. 13 is a left side view of the kayak of FIG. 9.

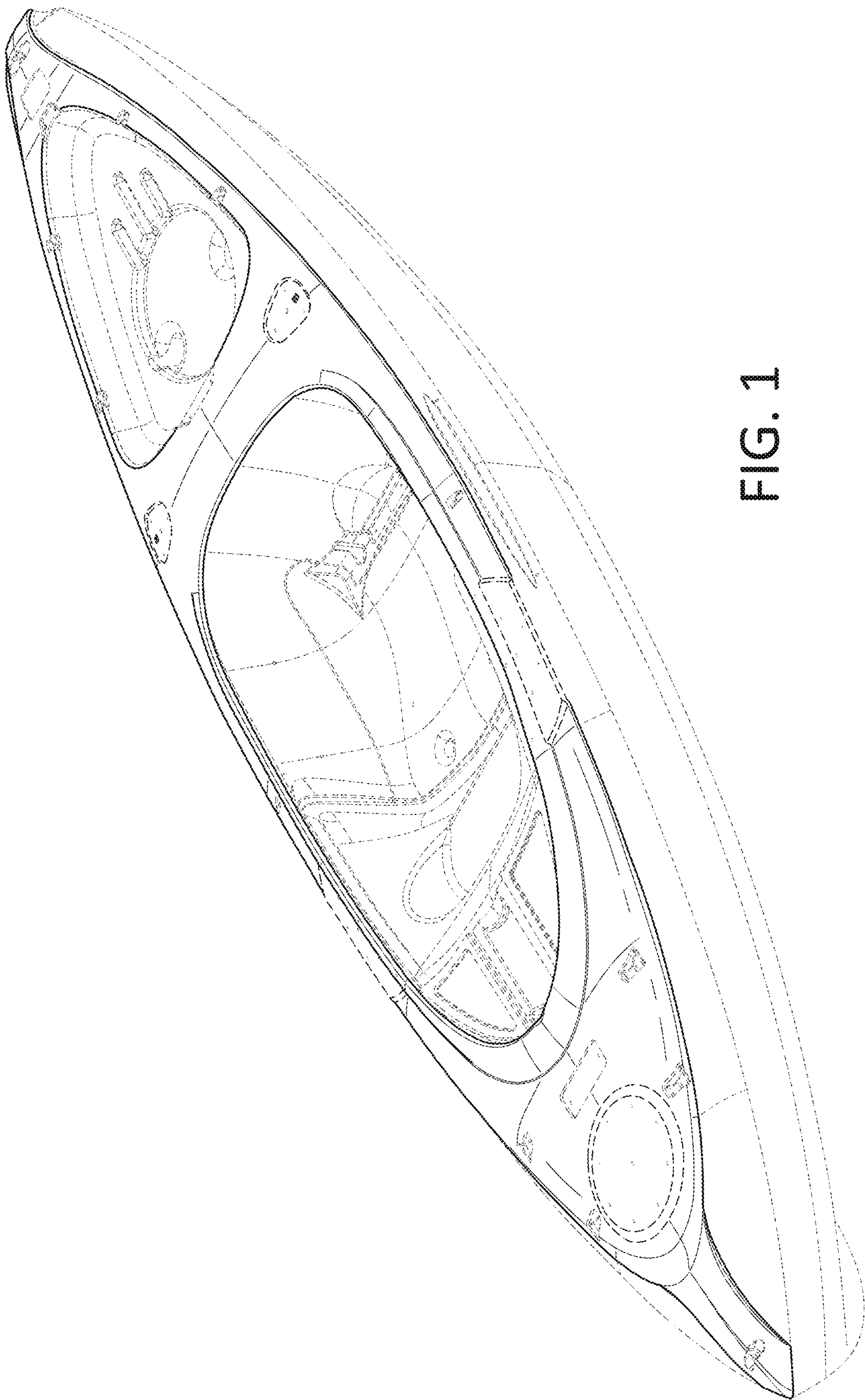

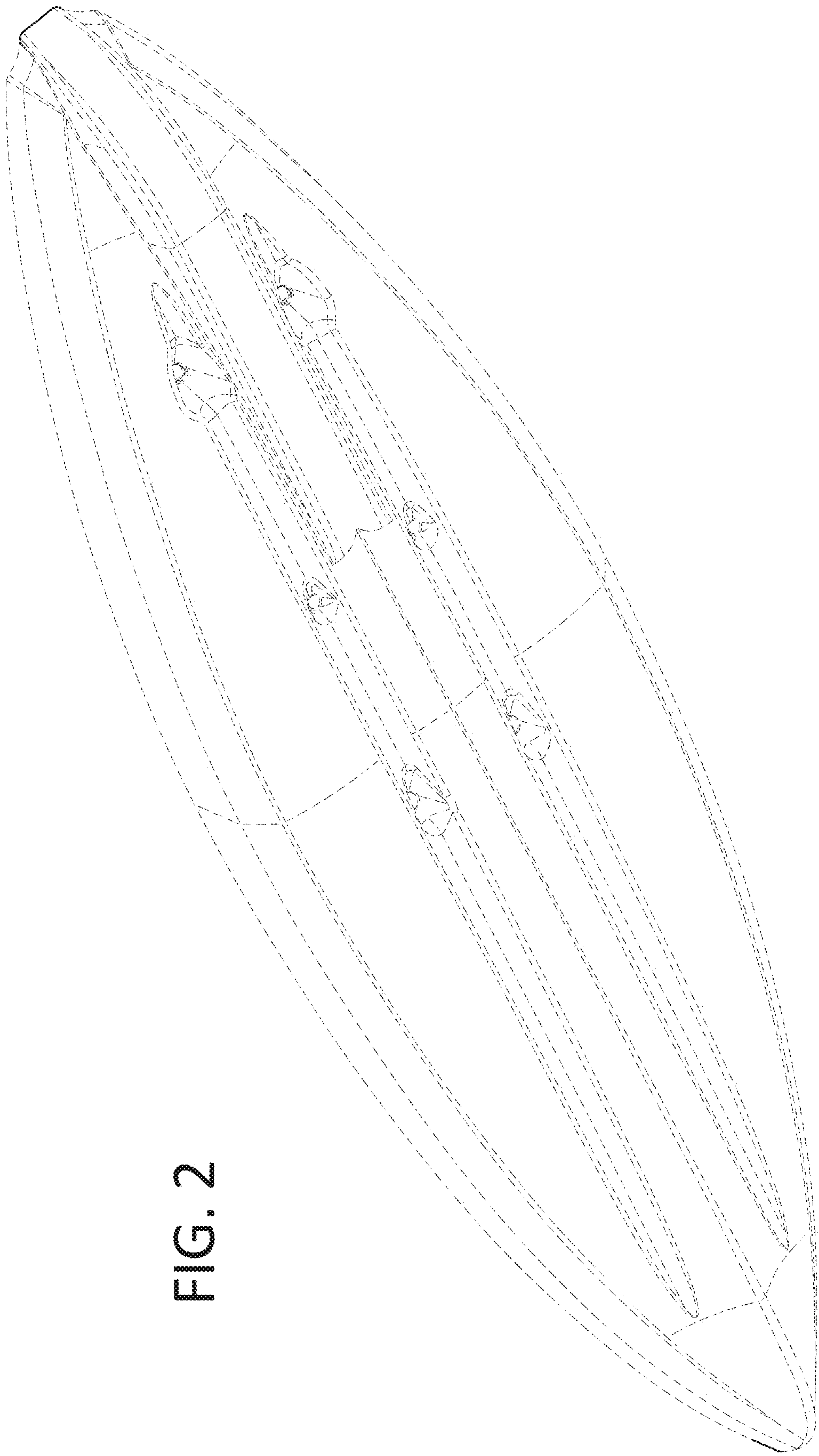

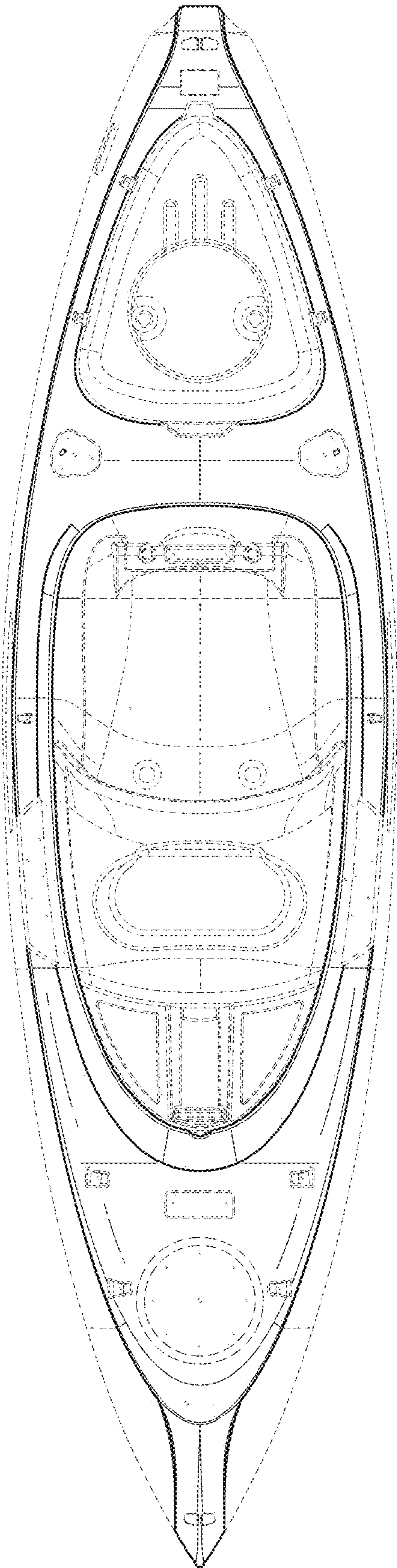

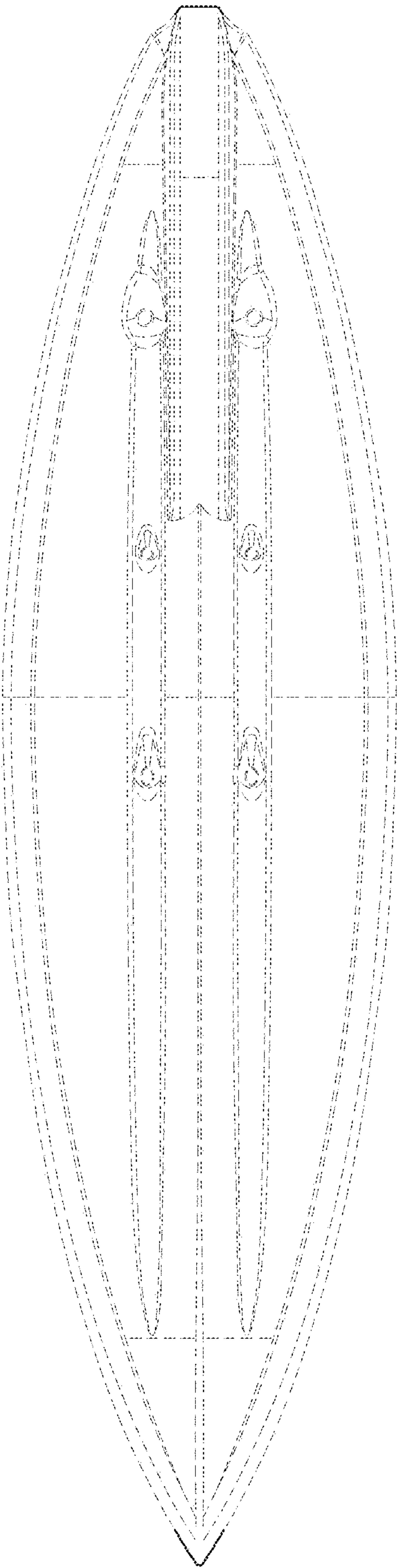

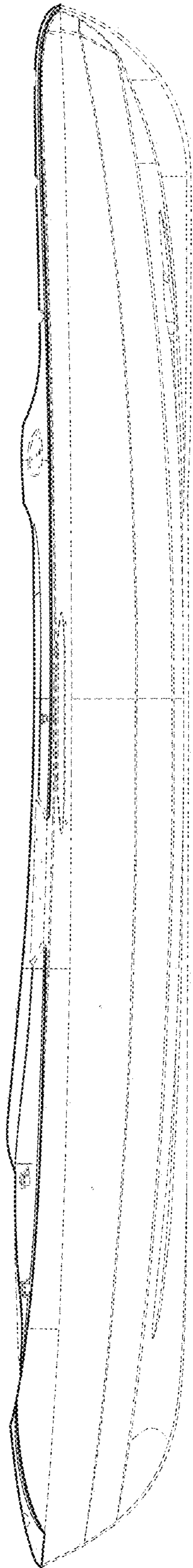

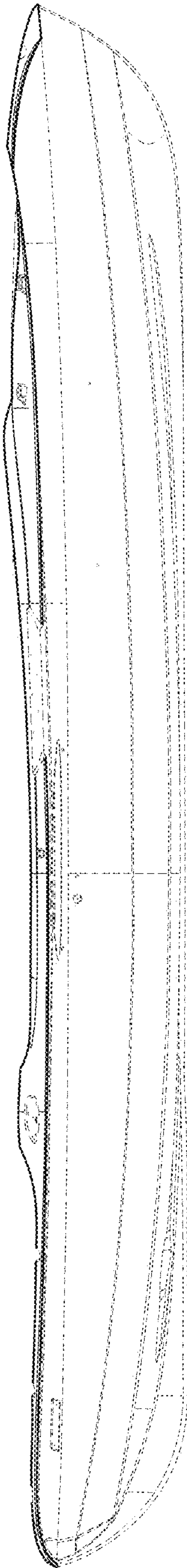

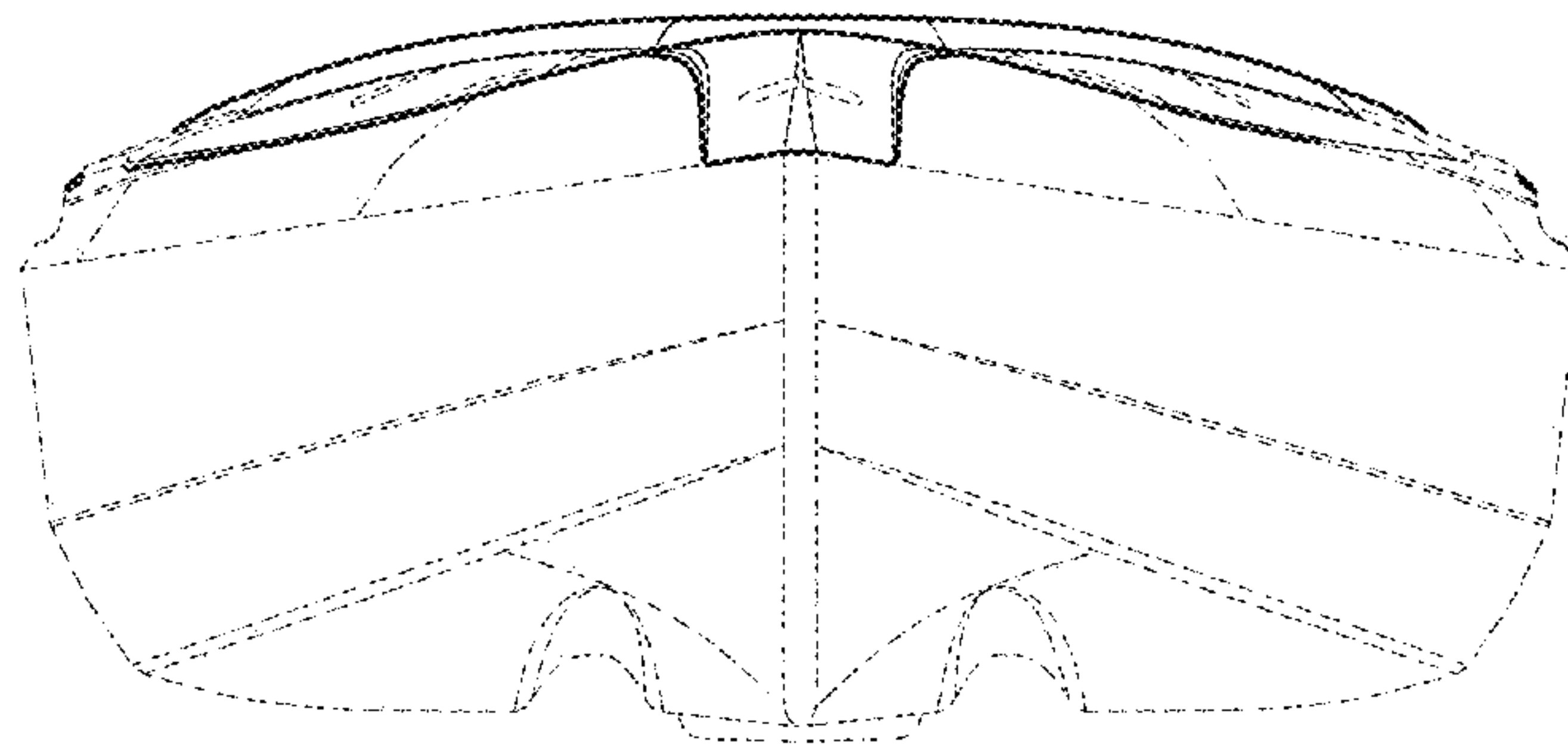

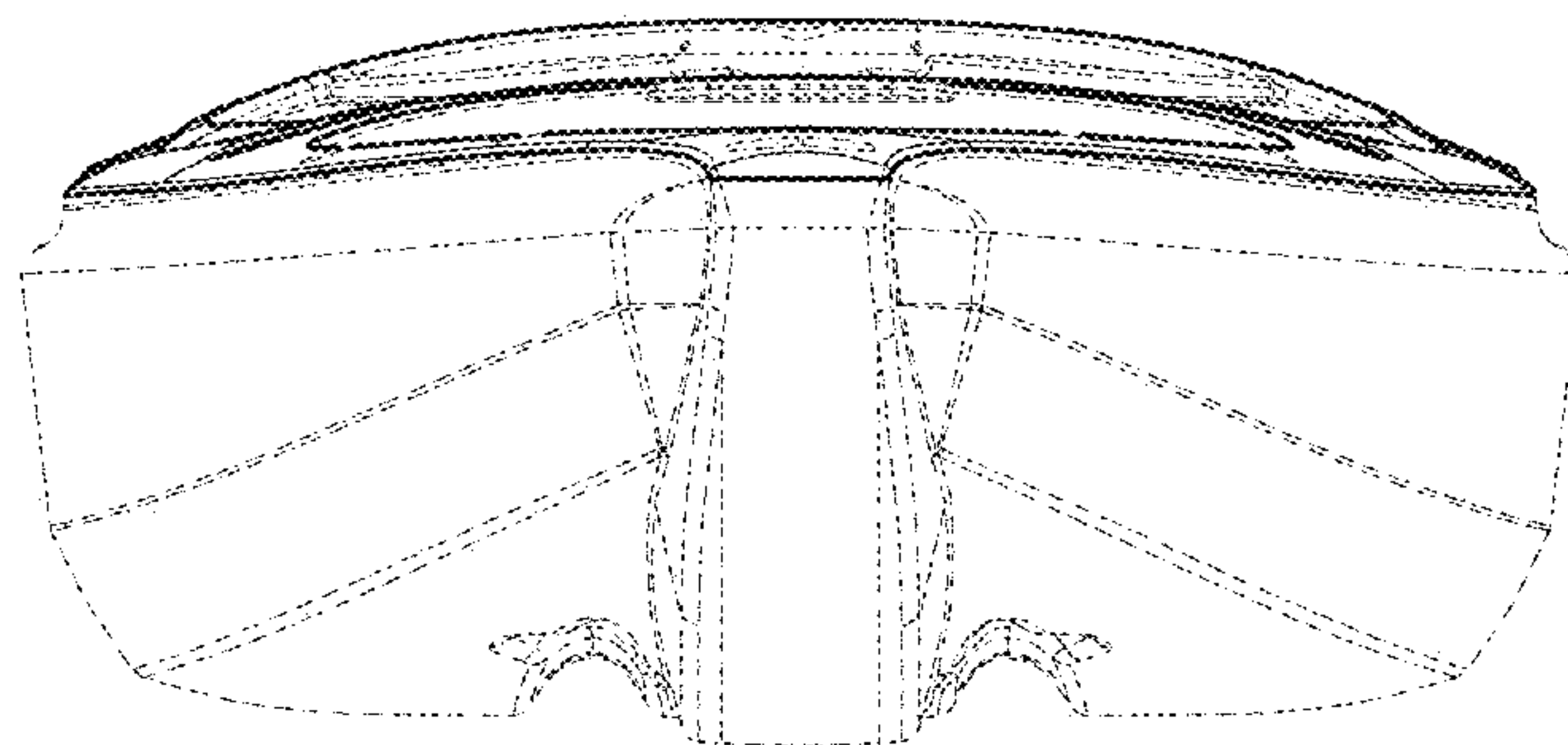

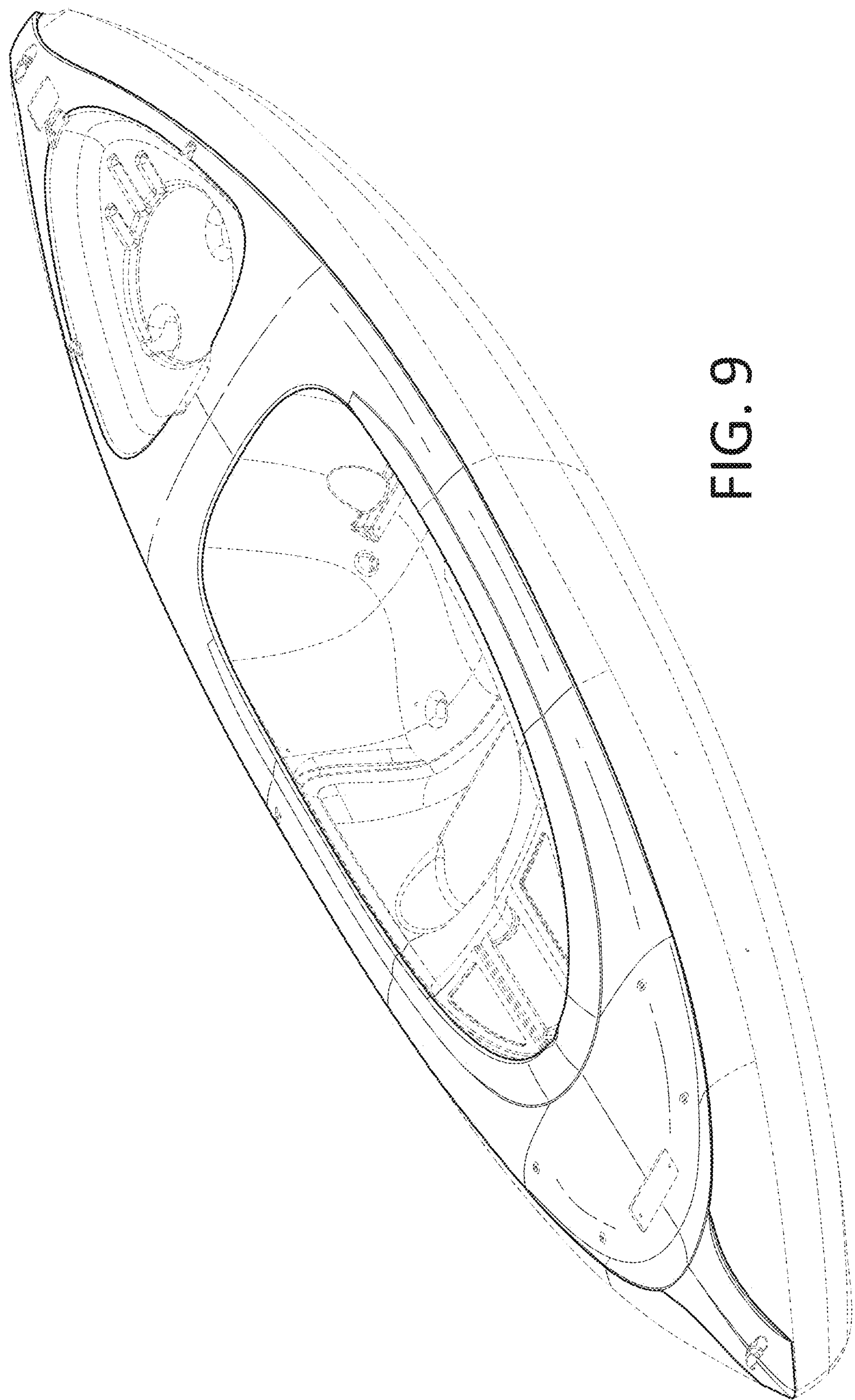

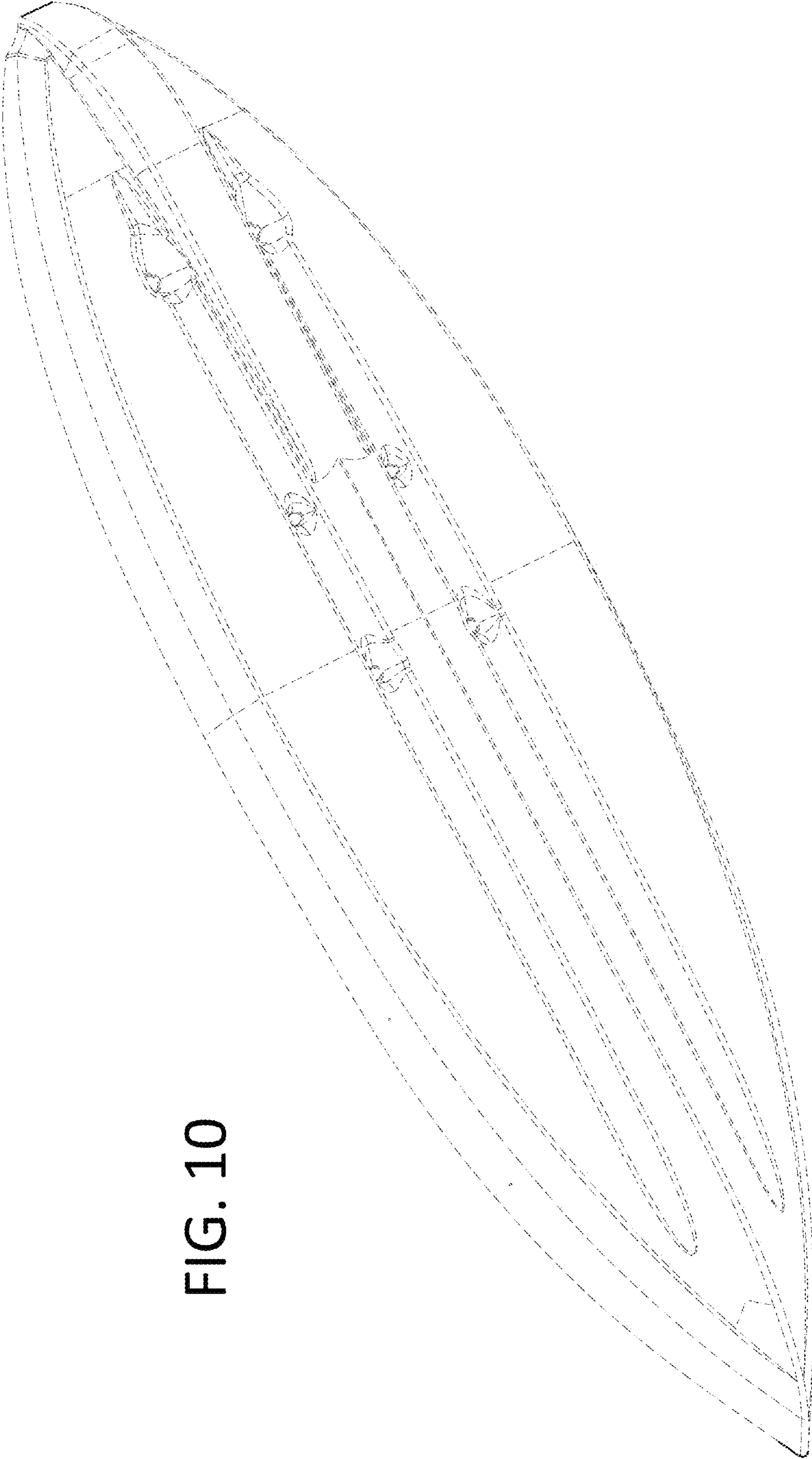

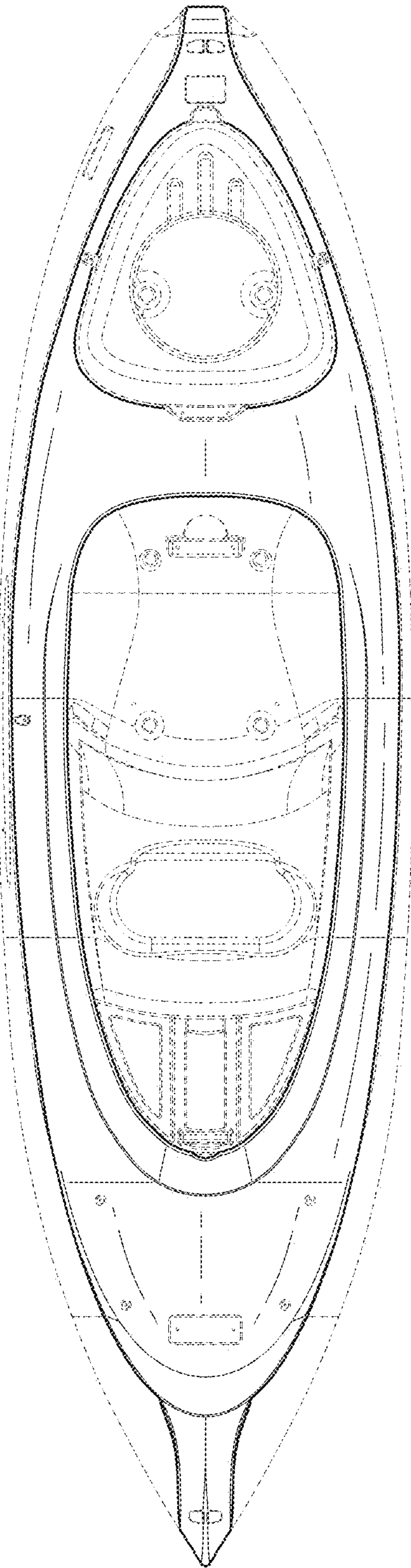

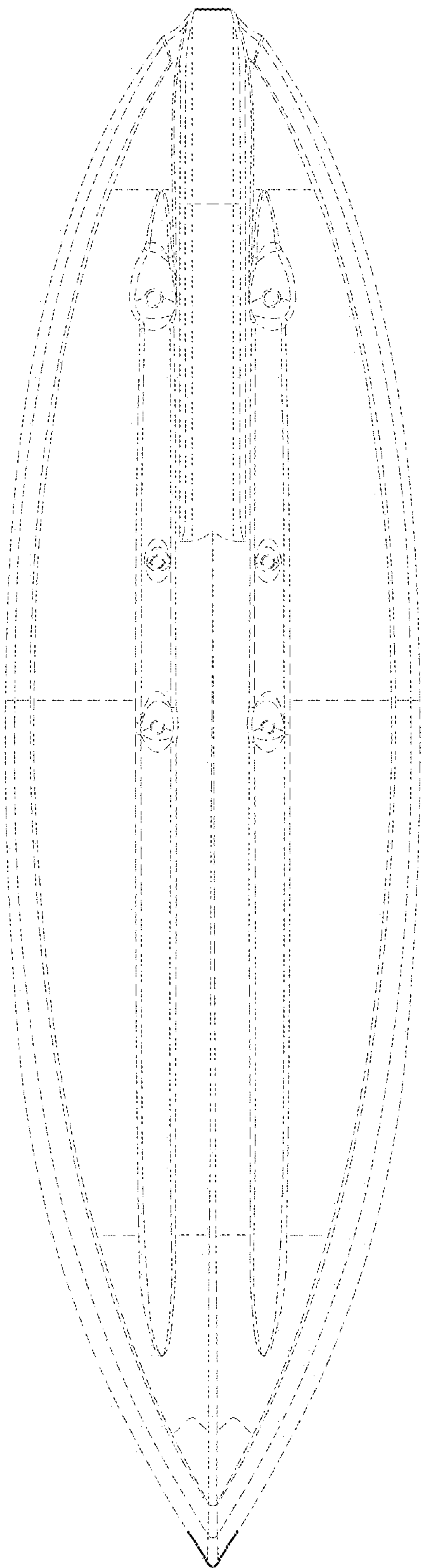

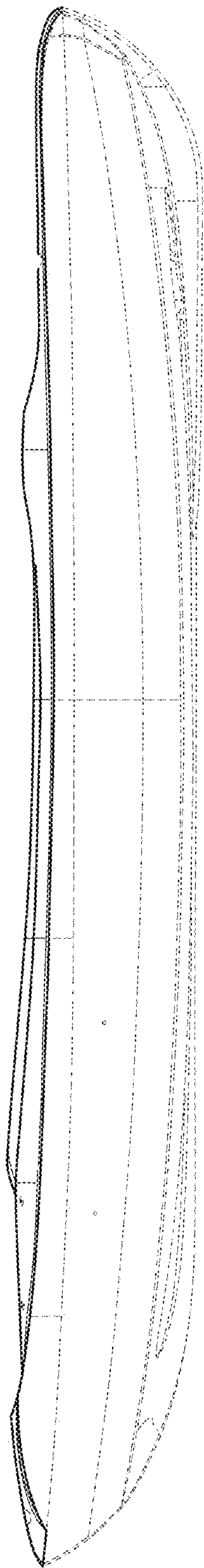

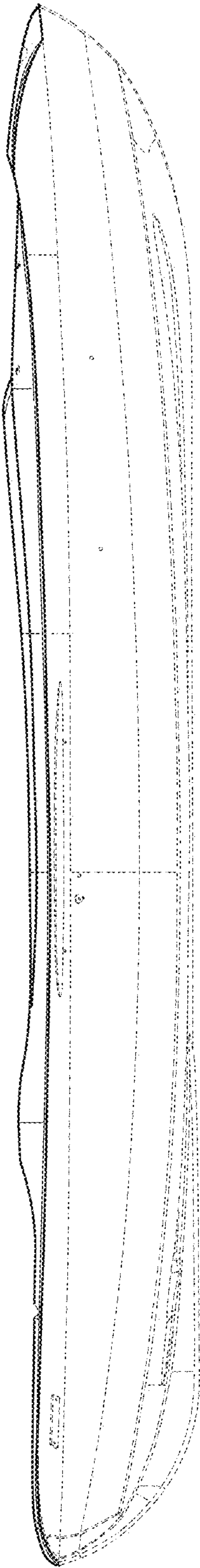

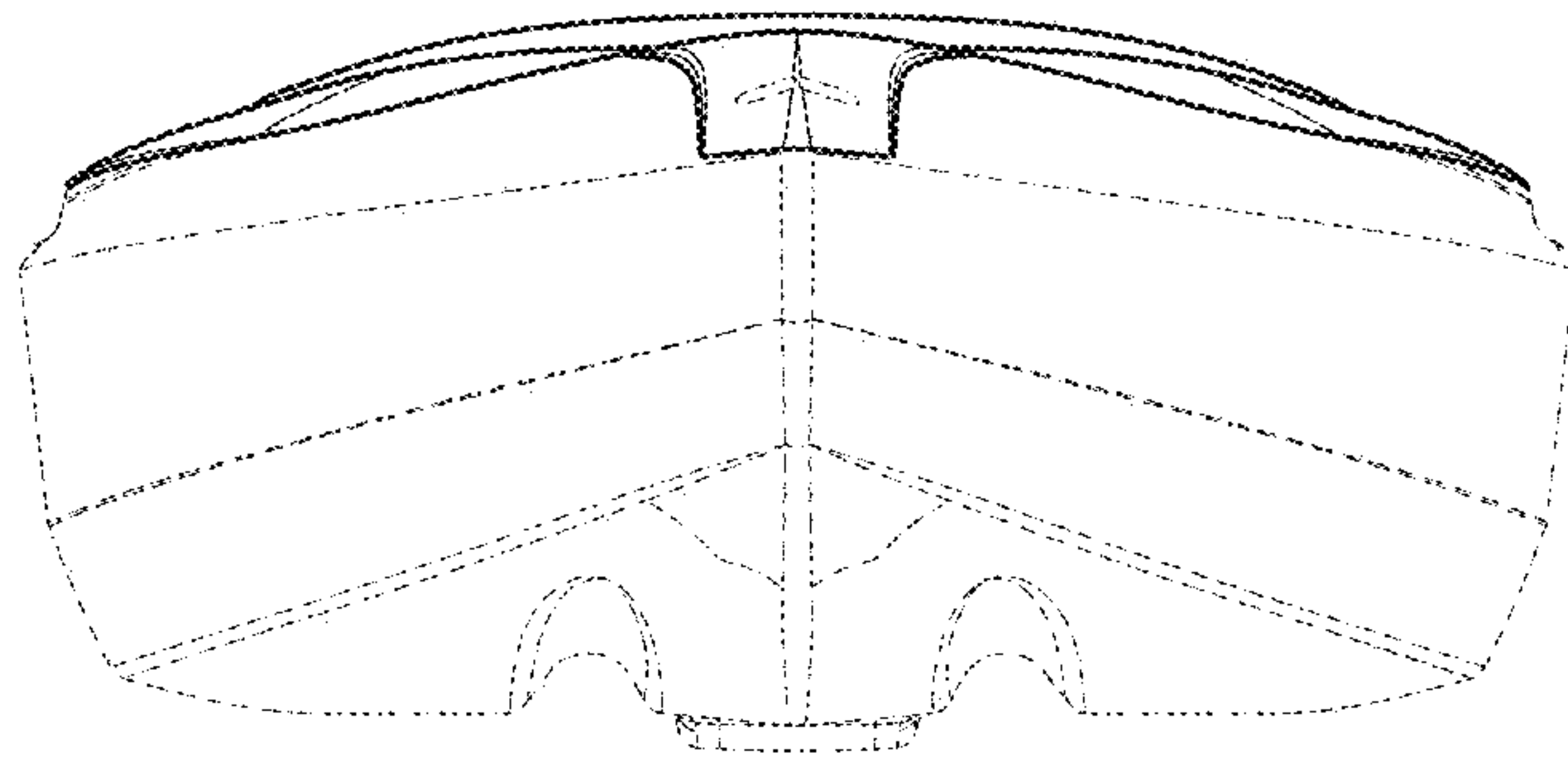

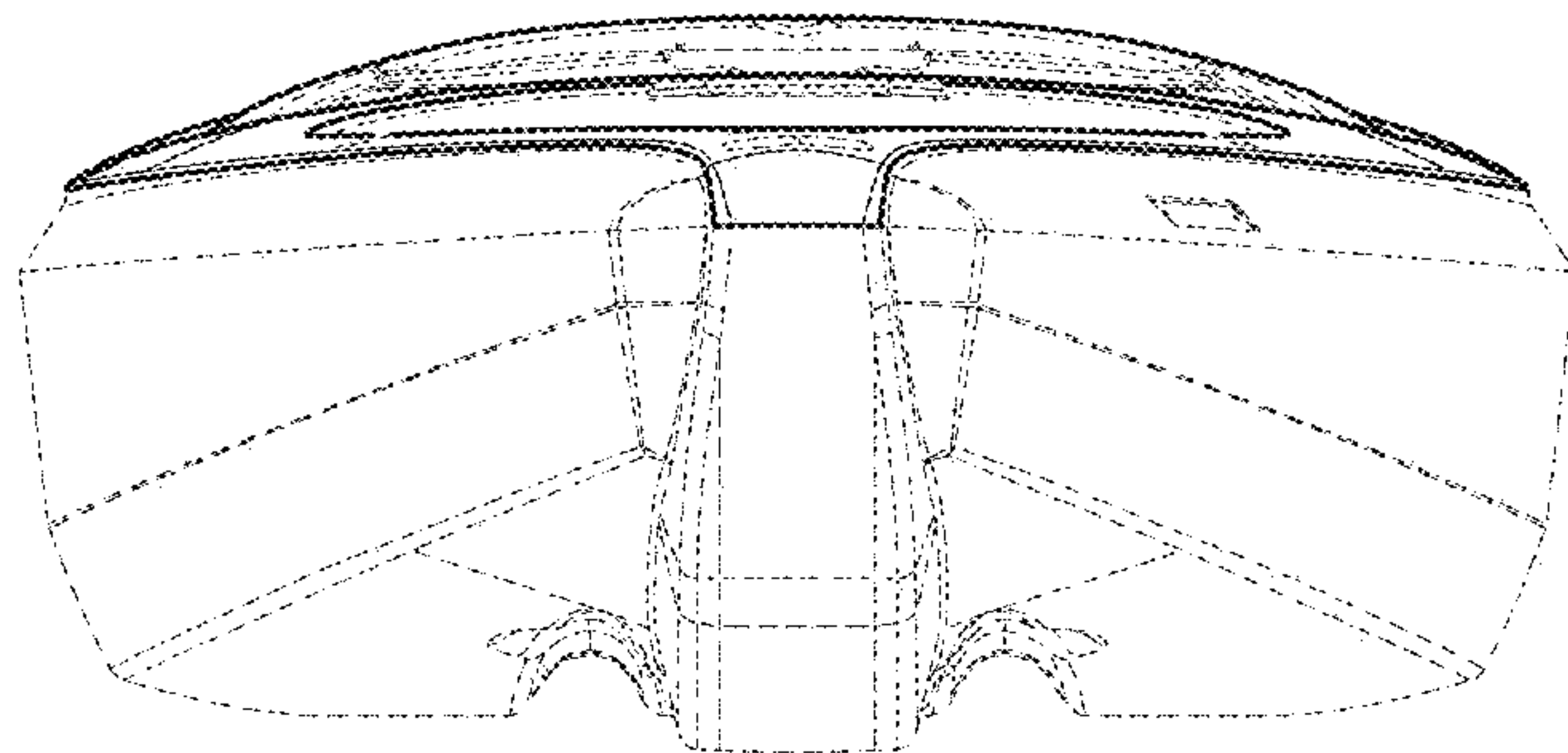
