DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a left side view of the kayak of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is an enlarged view, taken form FIG. 7, of the transom of the kayak of FIG. 1.

FIG. 9 is a right side view of the kayak of FIG. 1.

FIG. 10 is a front view of the kayak of FIG. 1.

FIG. 11 is a back view of the kayak of FIG. 1.

FIG. 12 is an enlarged view, taken from FIG. 11, of the transom of the kayak of FIG. 1.

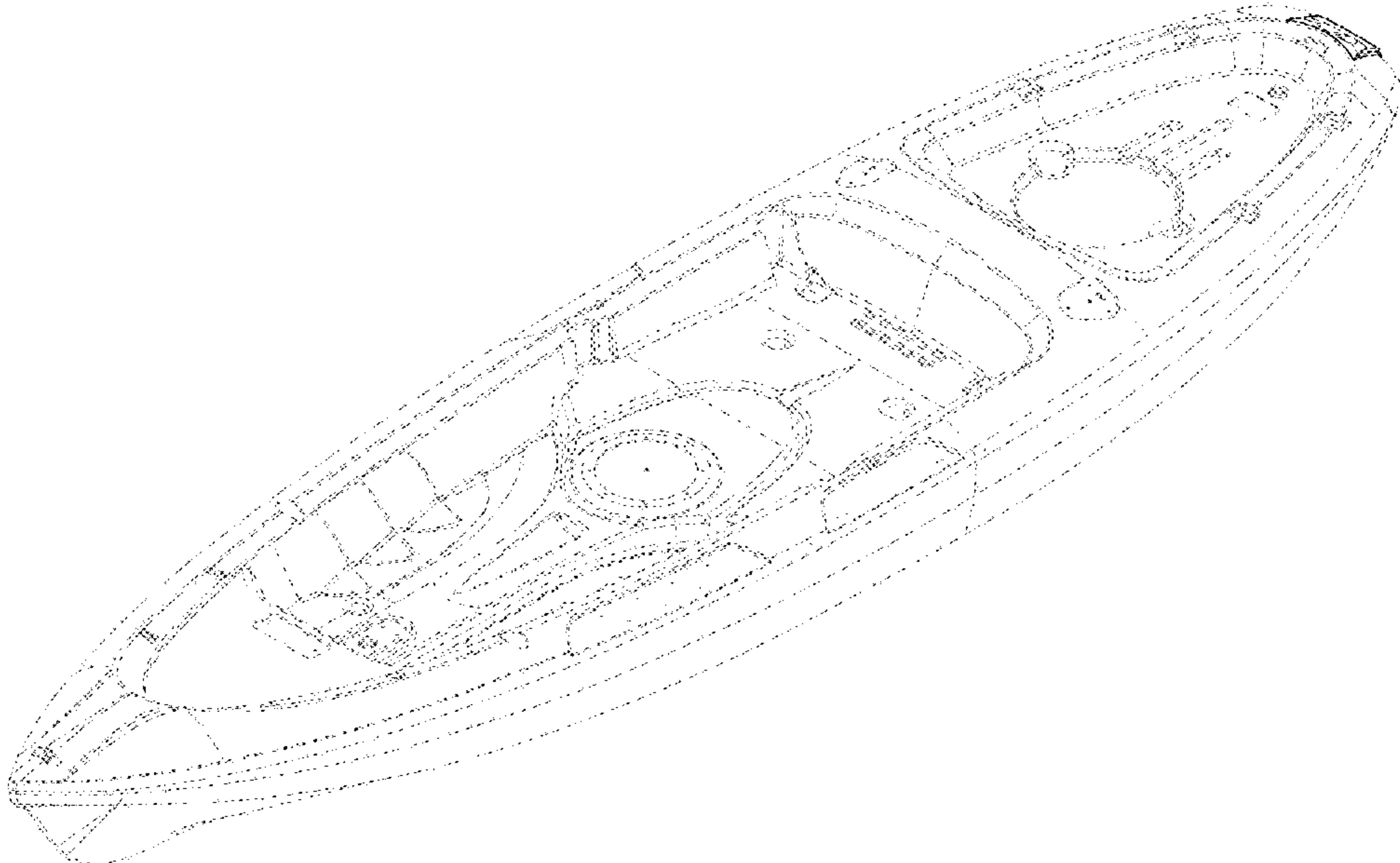
FIG. 13 is a right side partial perspective view of the back of the kayak of FIG. 1; and,

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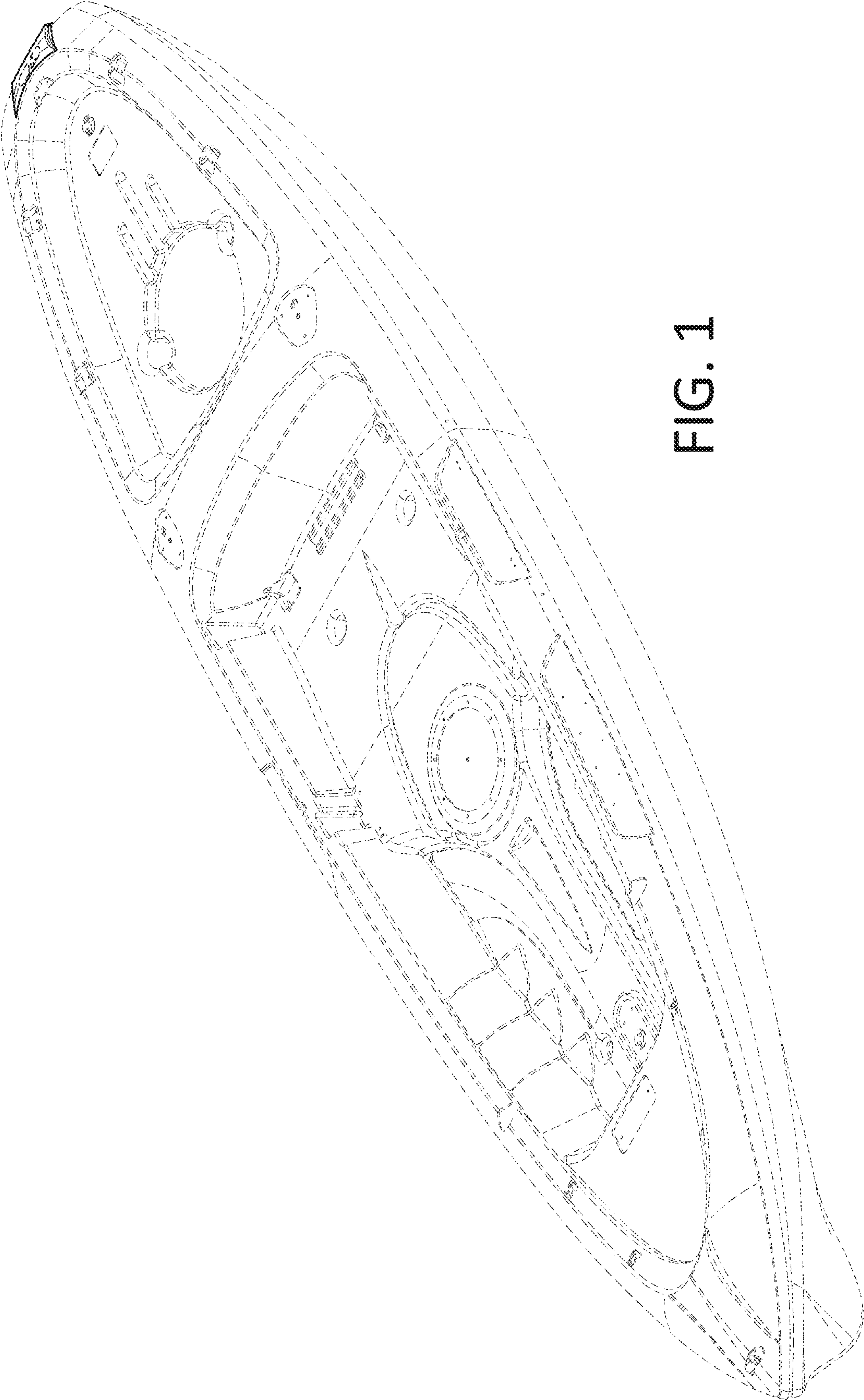

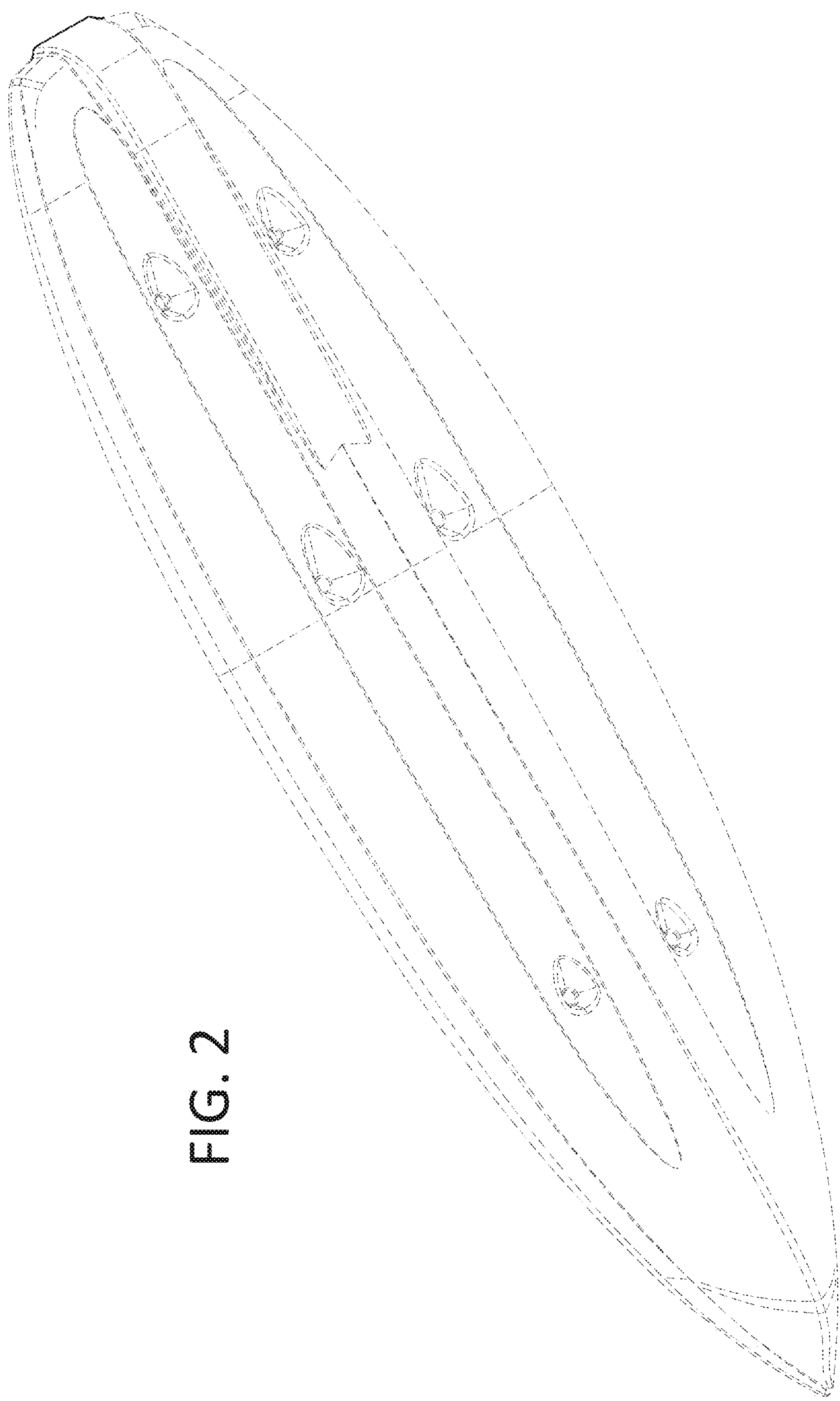

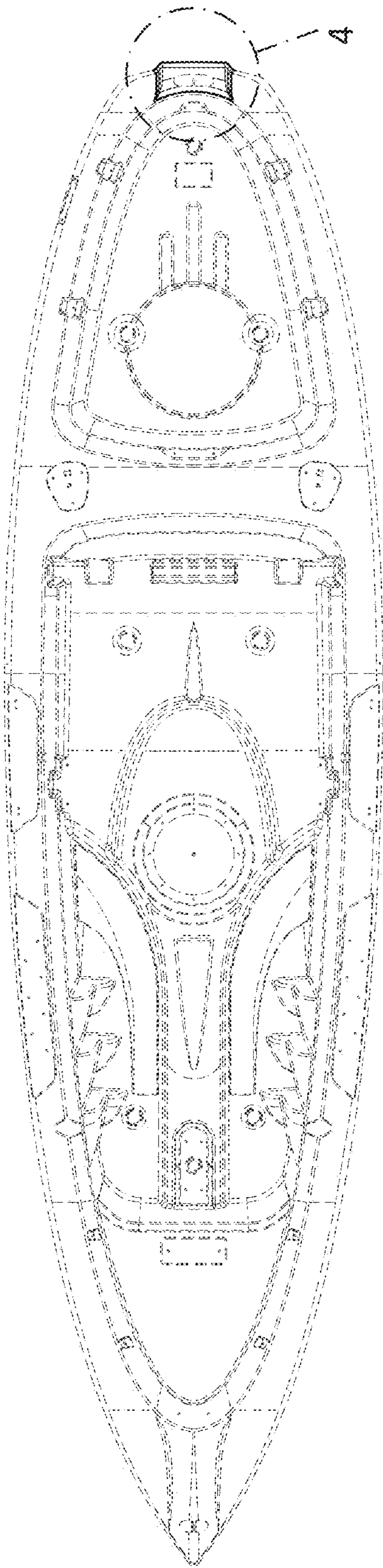

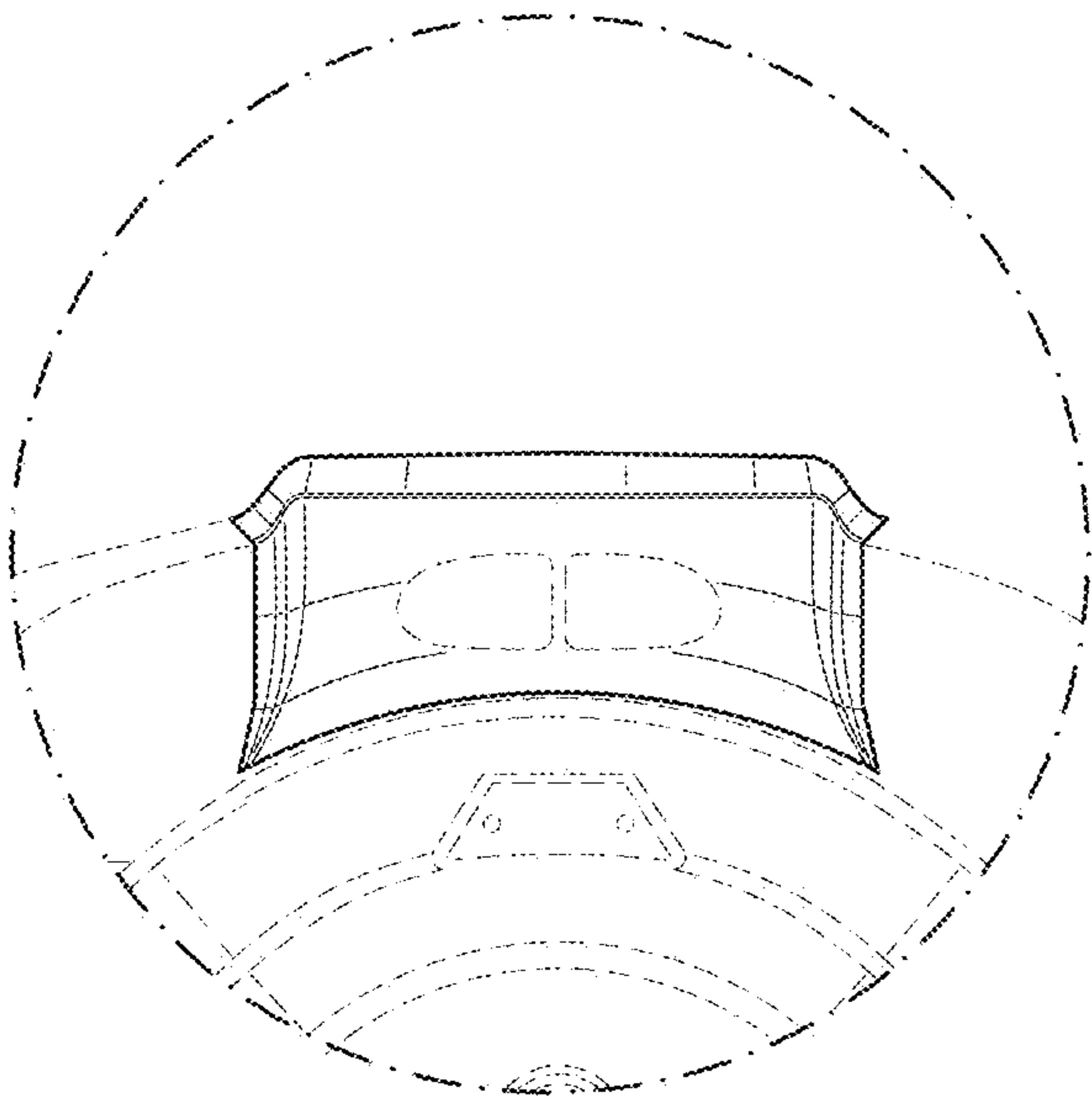

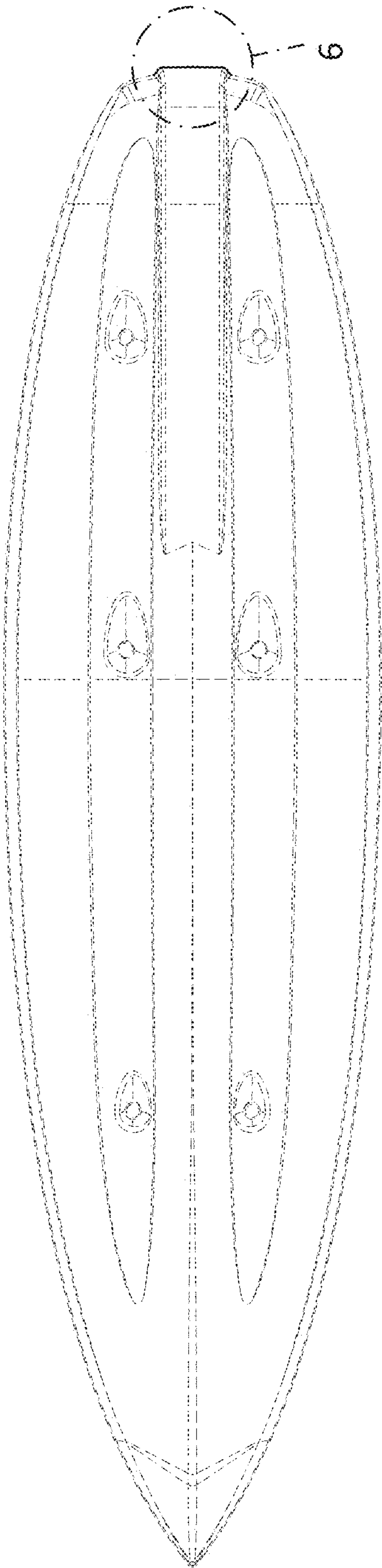

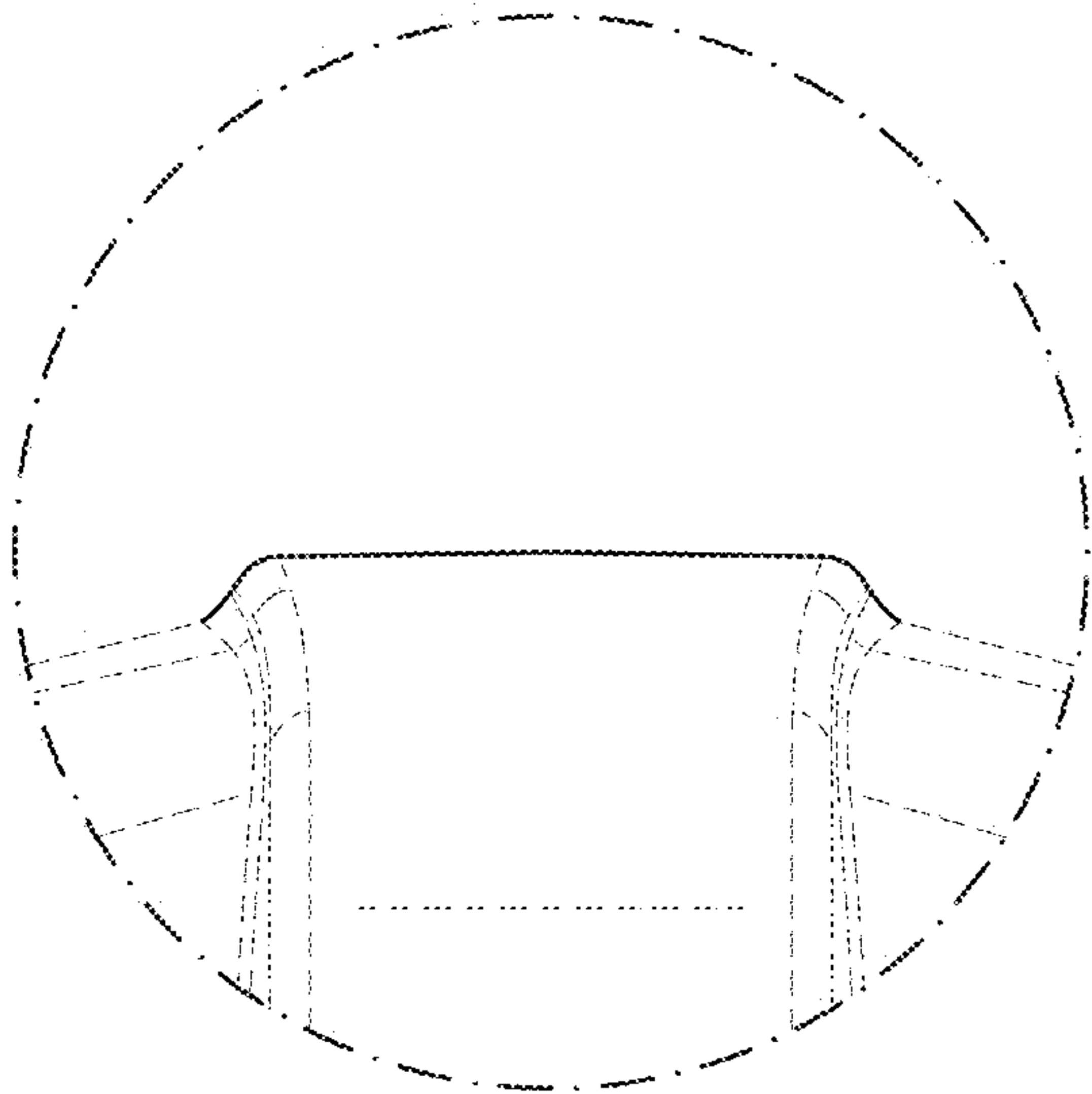

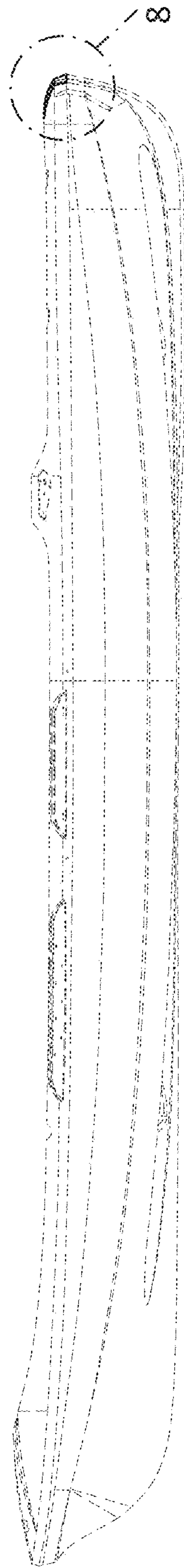

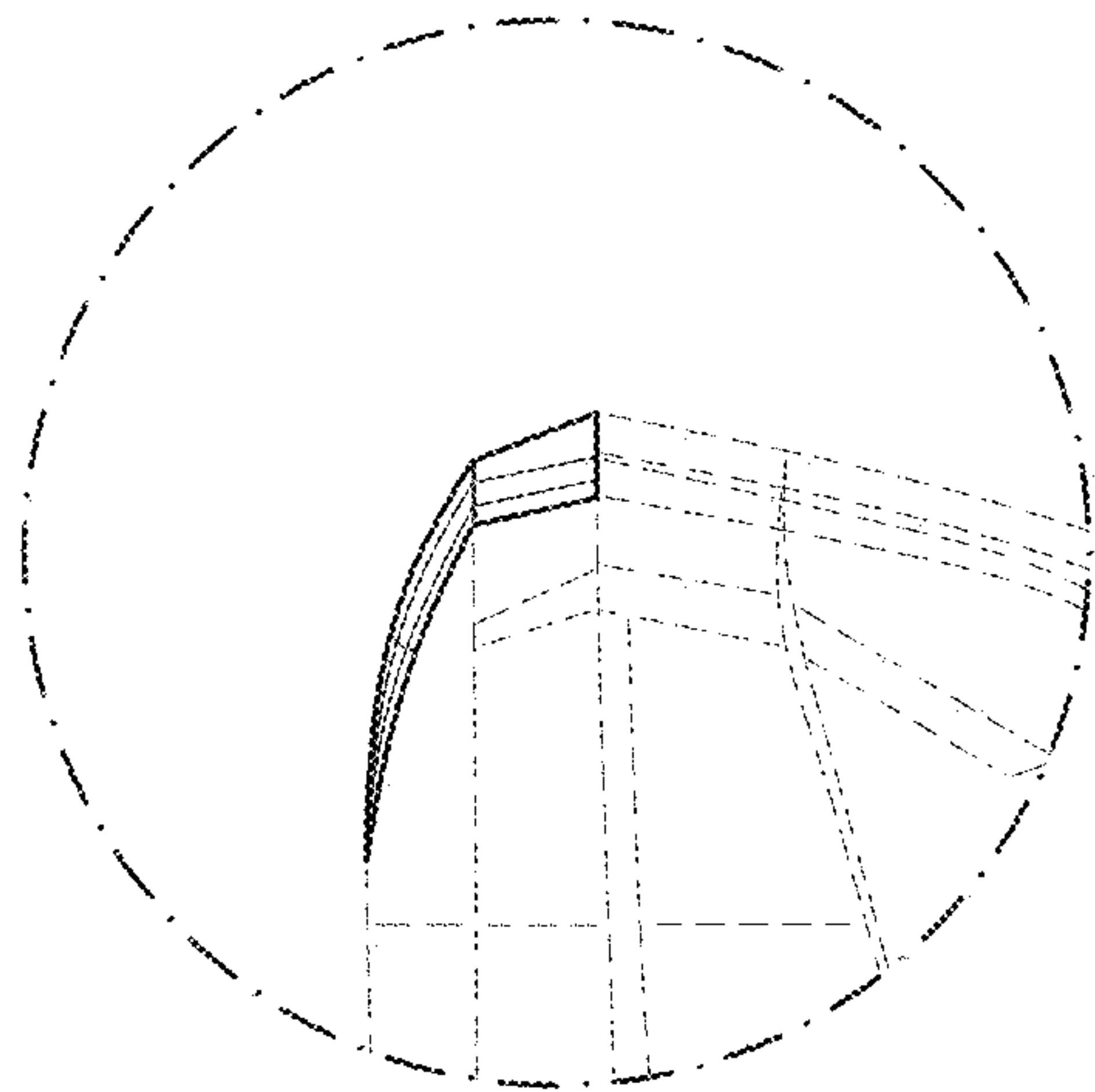

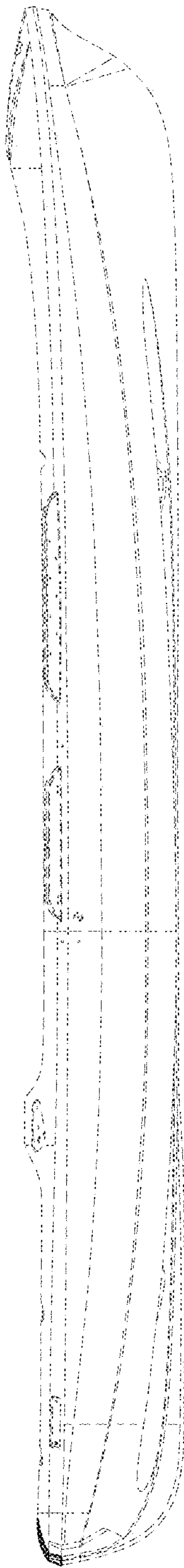

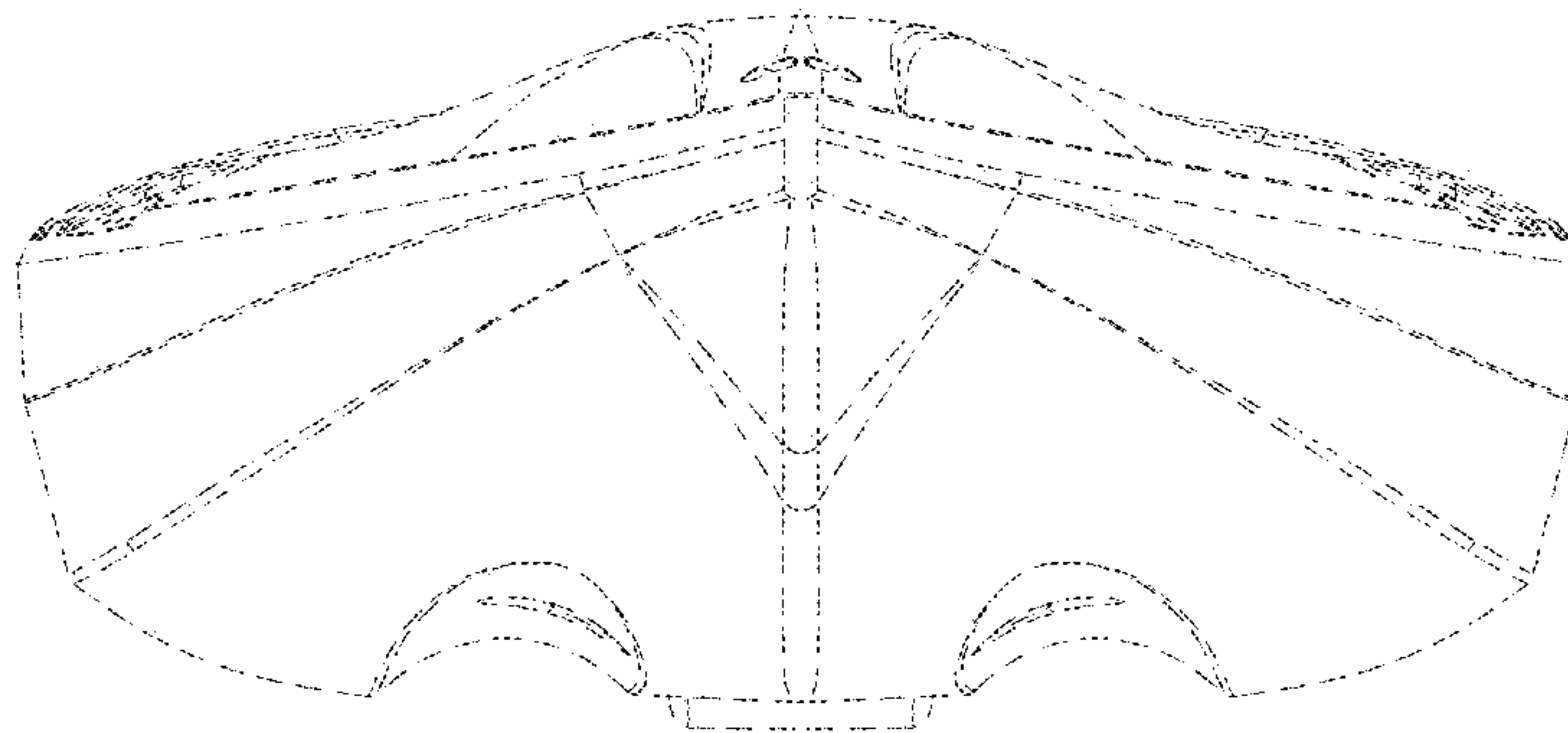

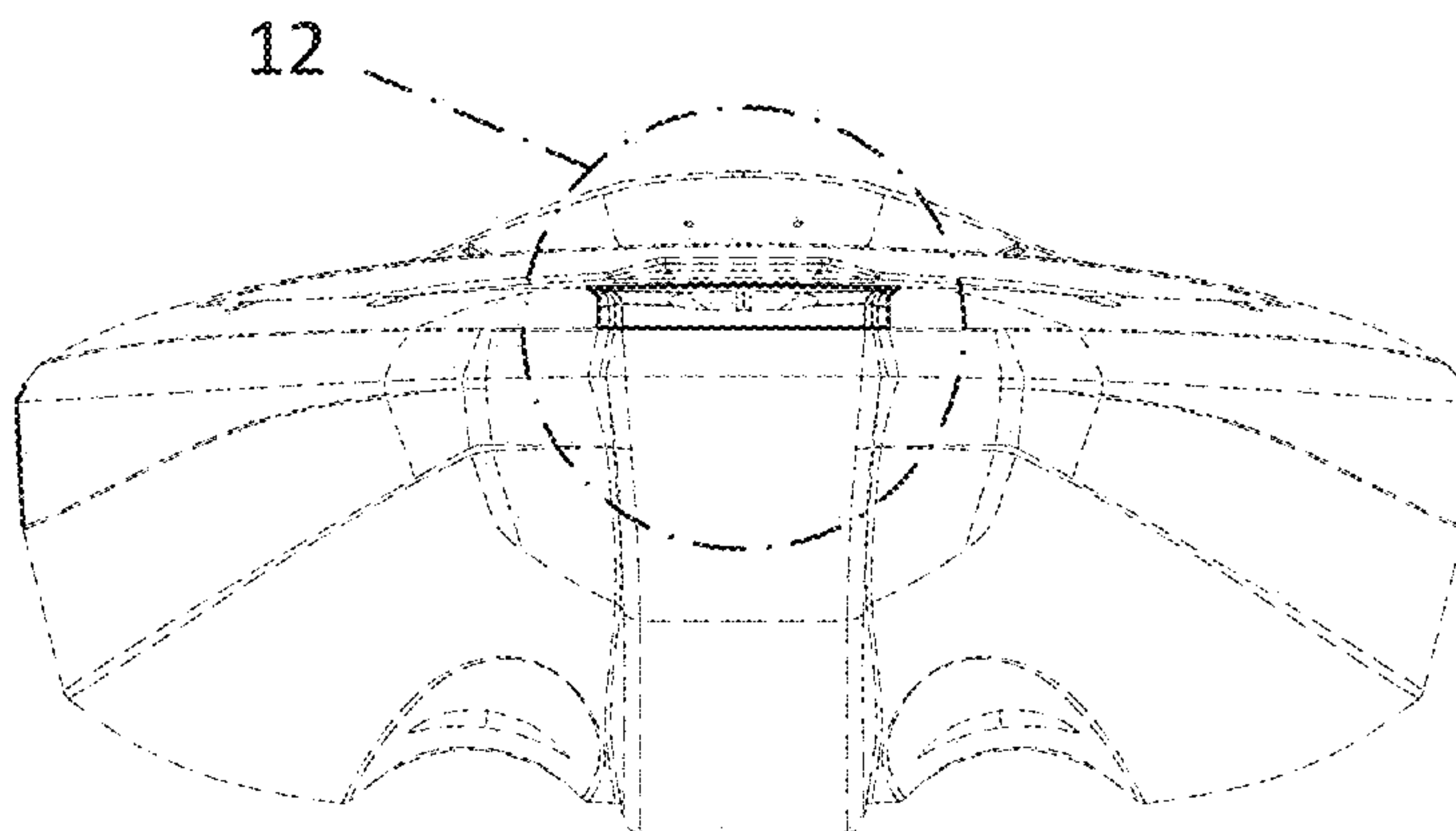
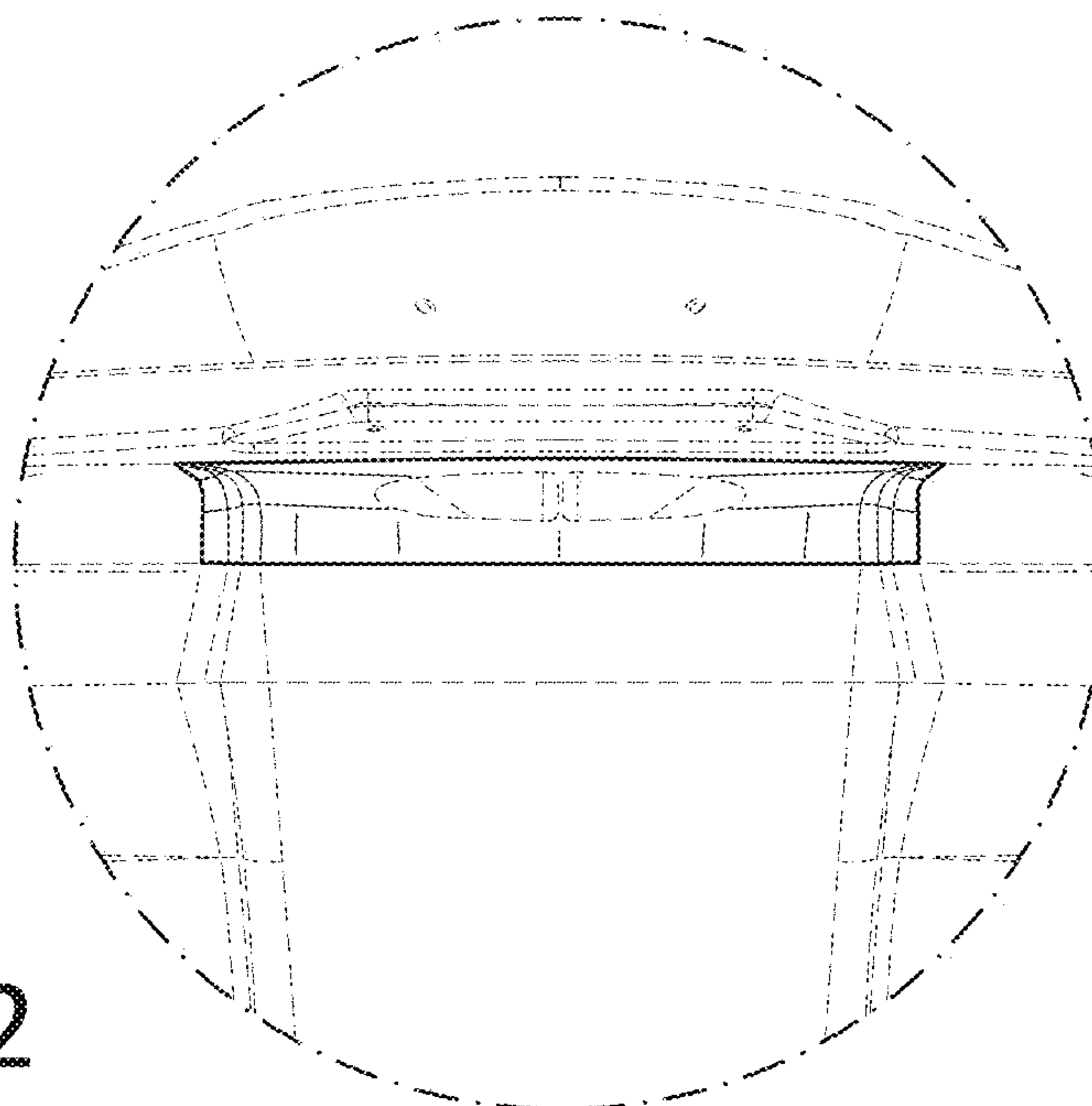

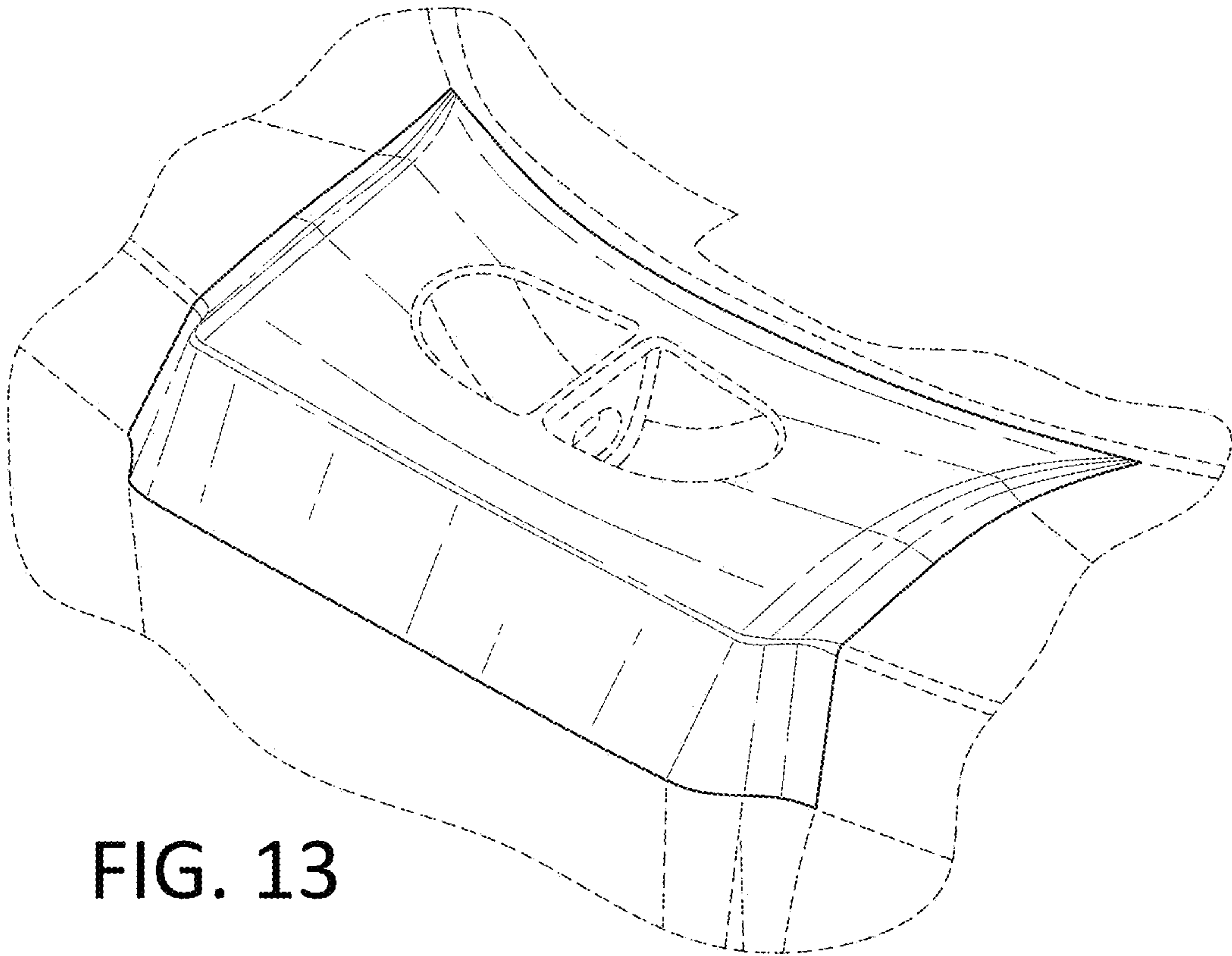

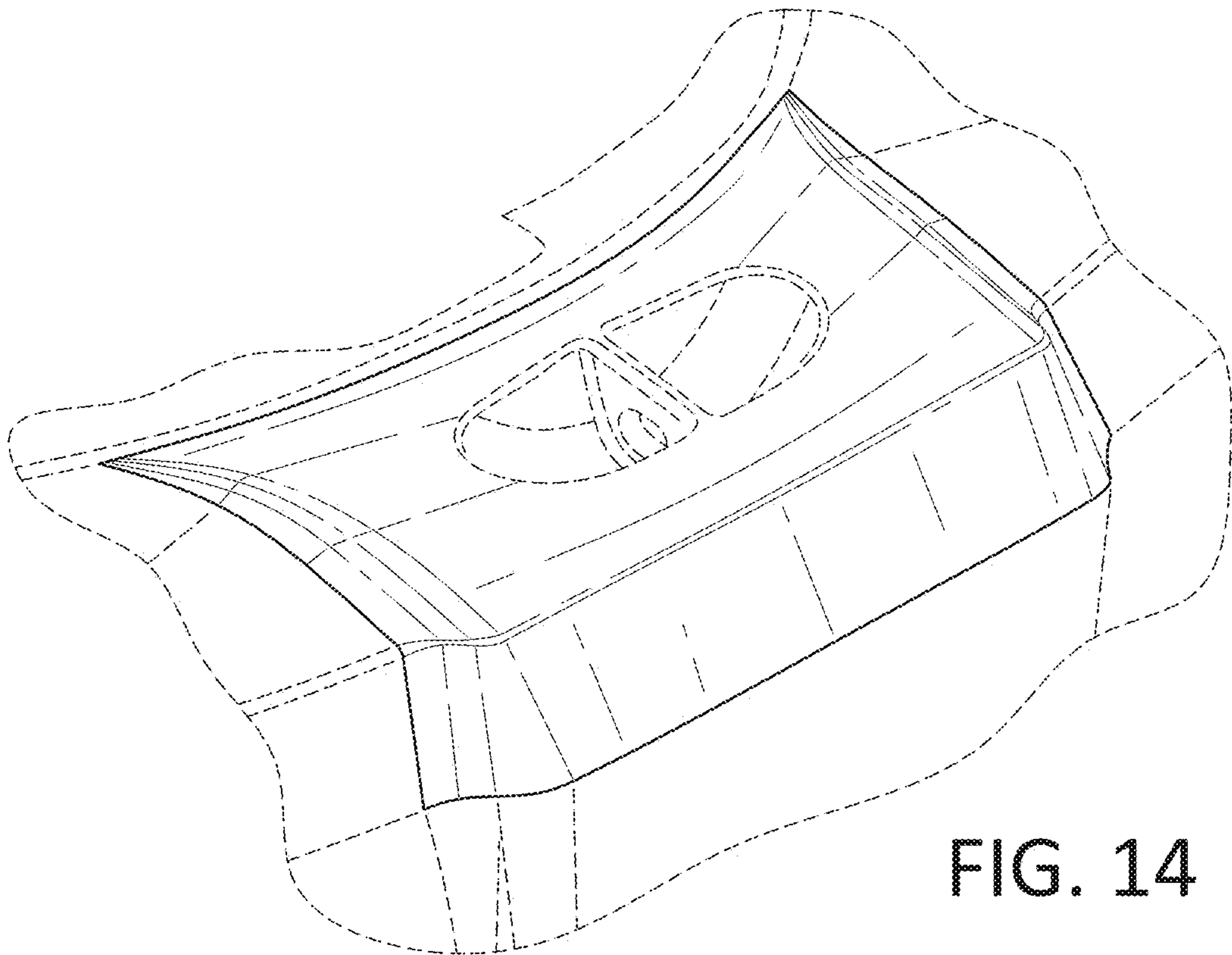
