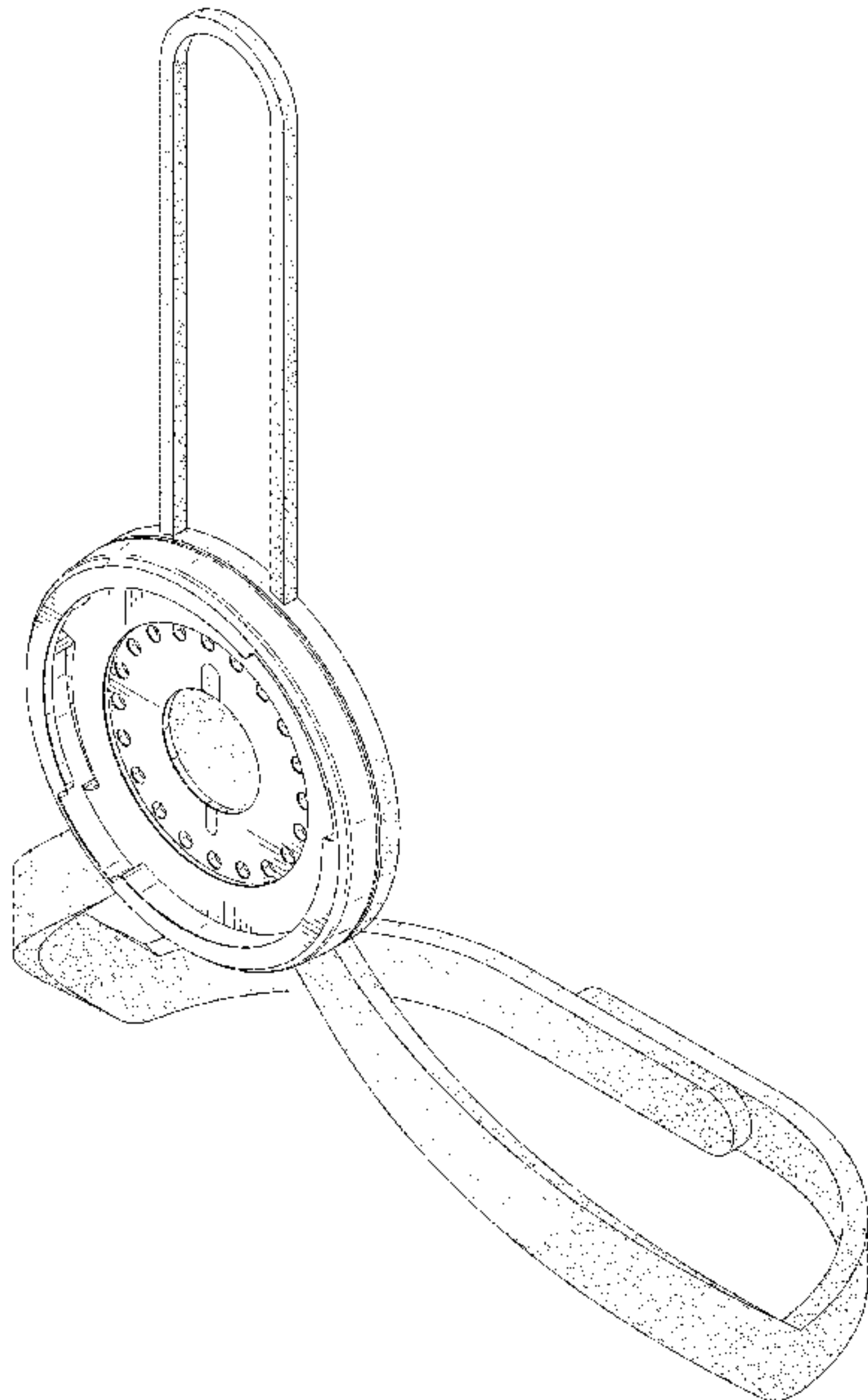
(57) CLAIM

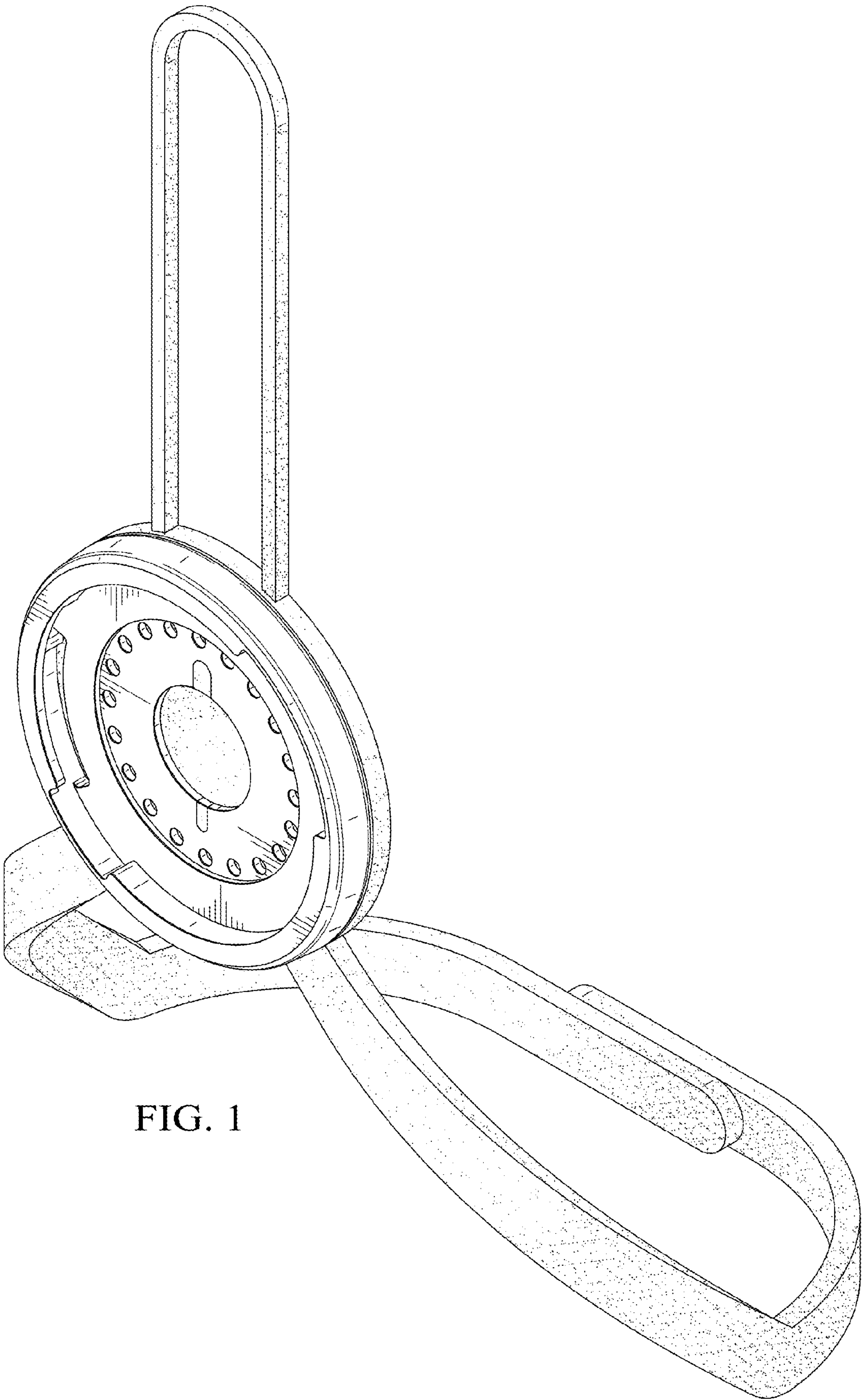

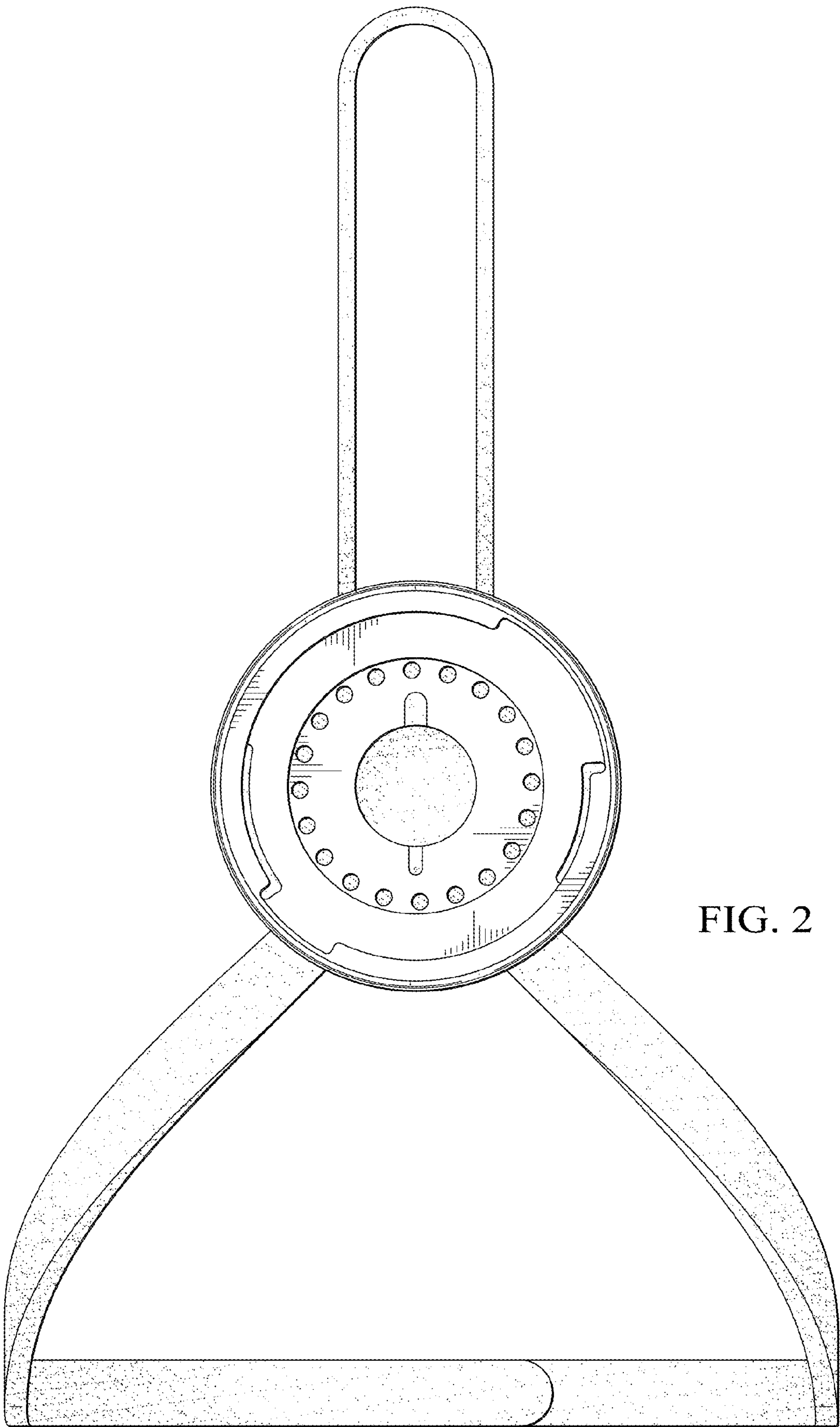

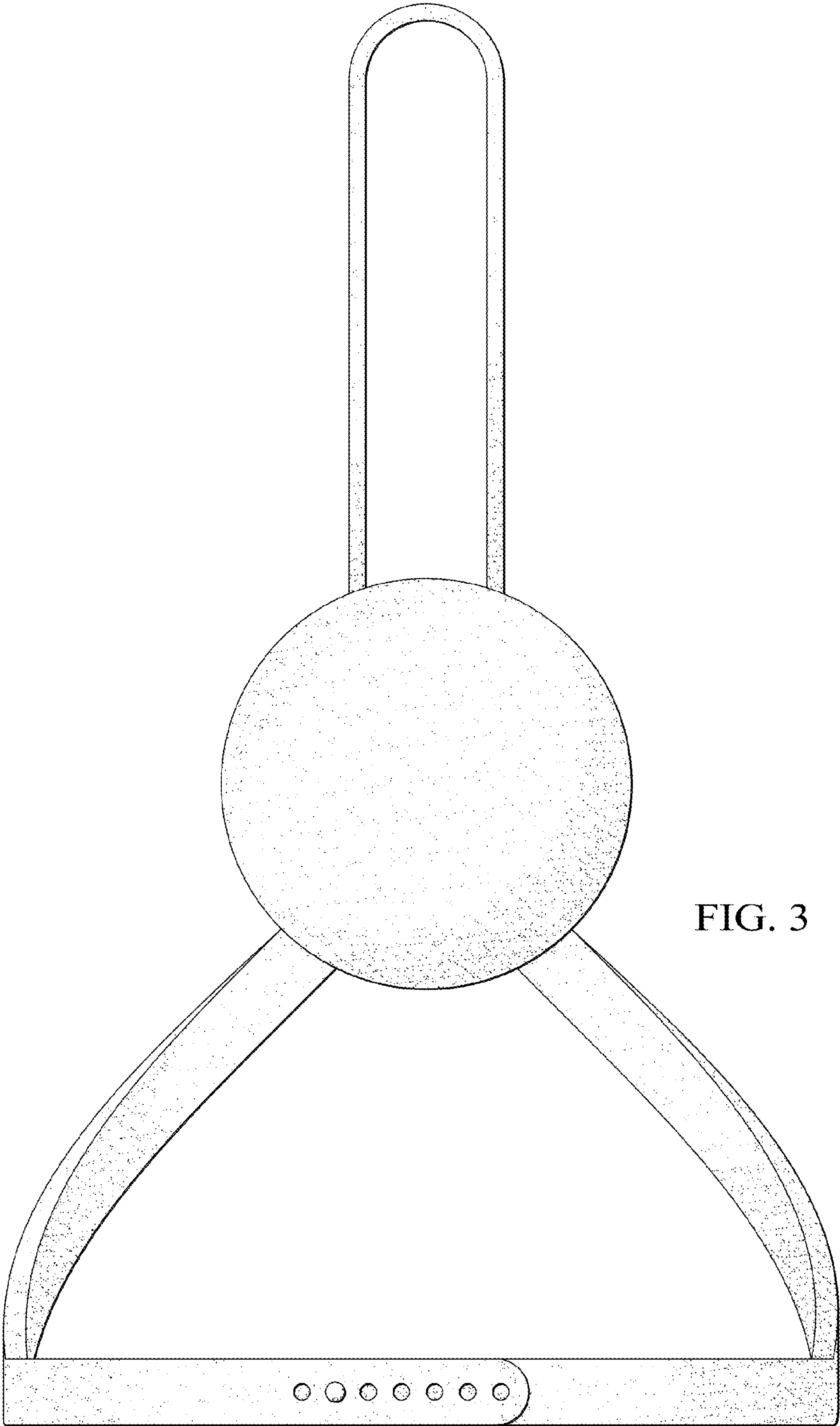
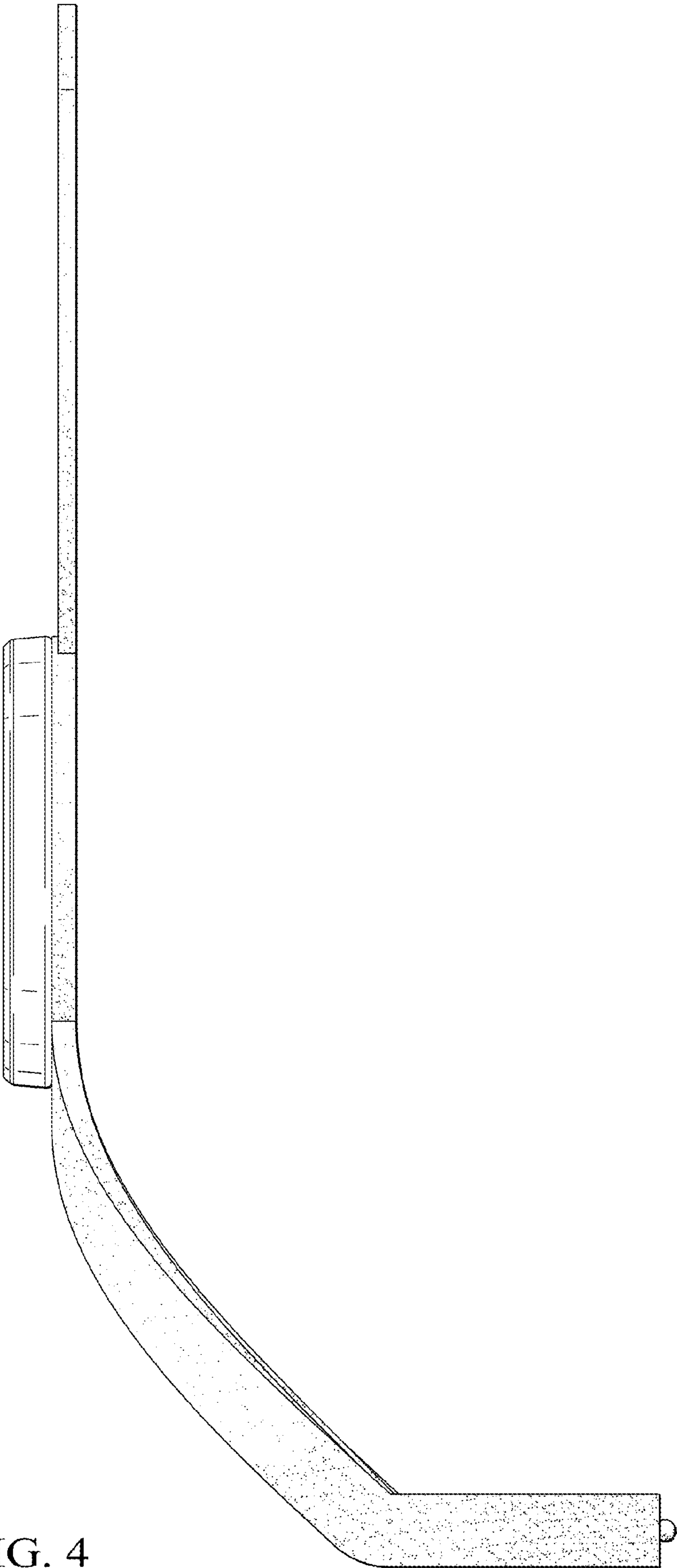

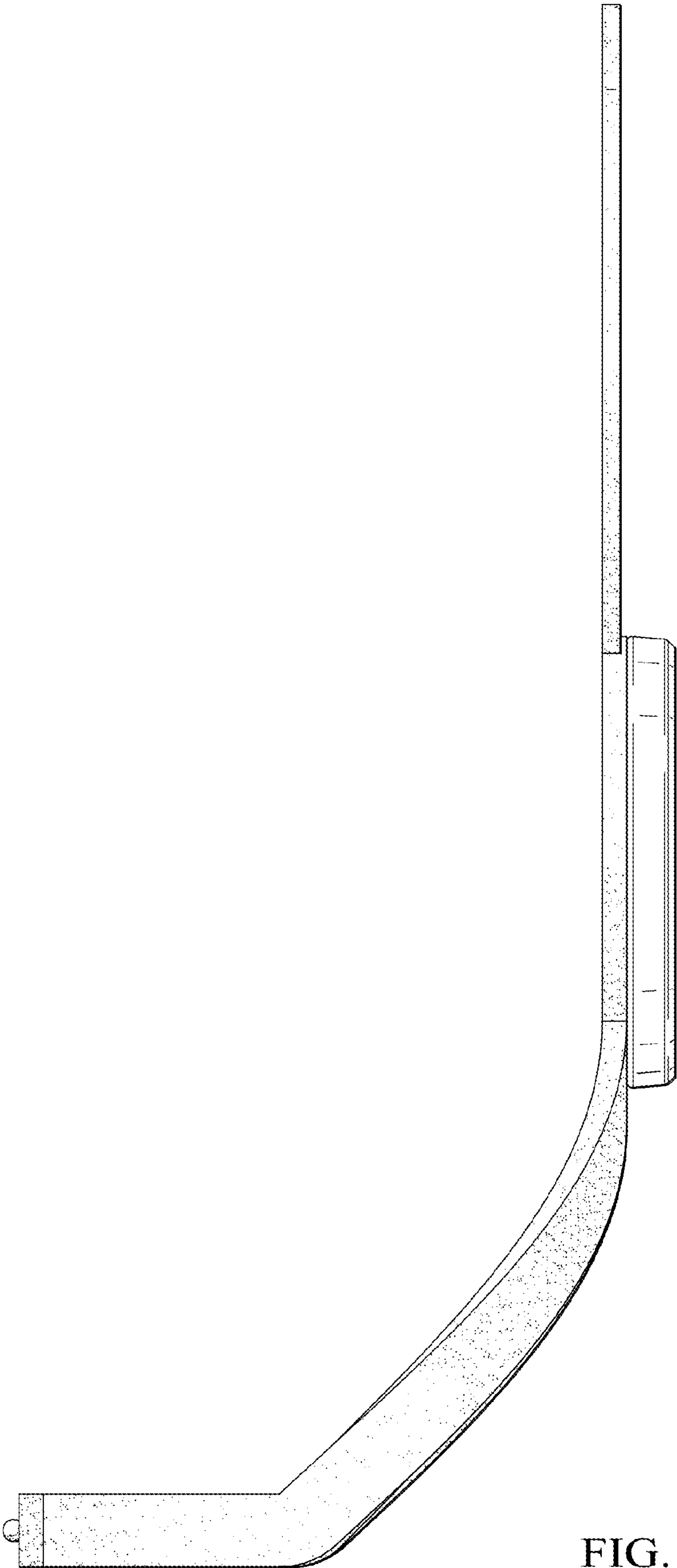

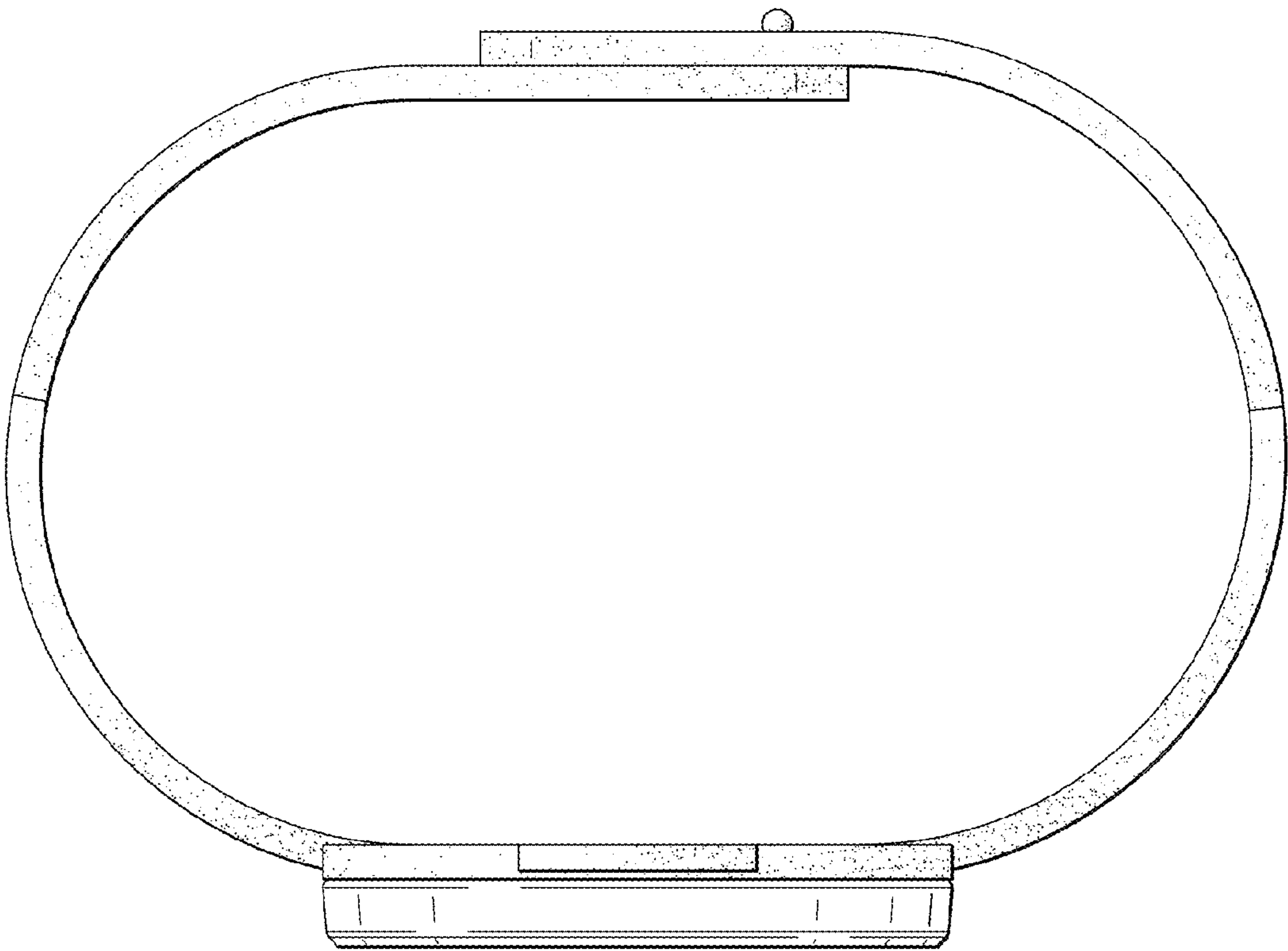

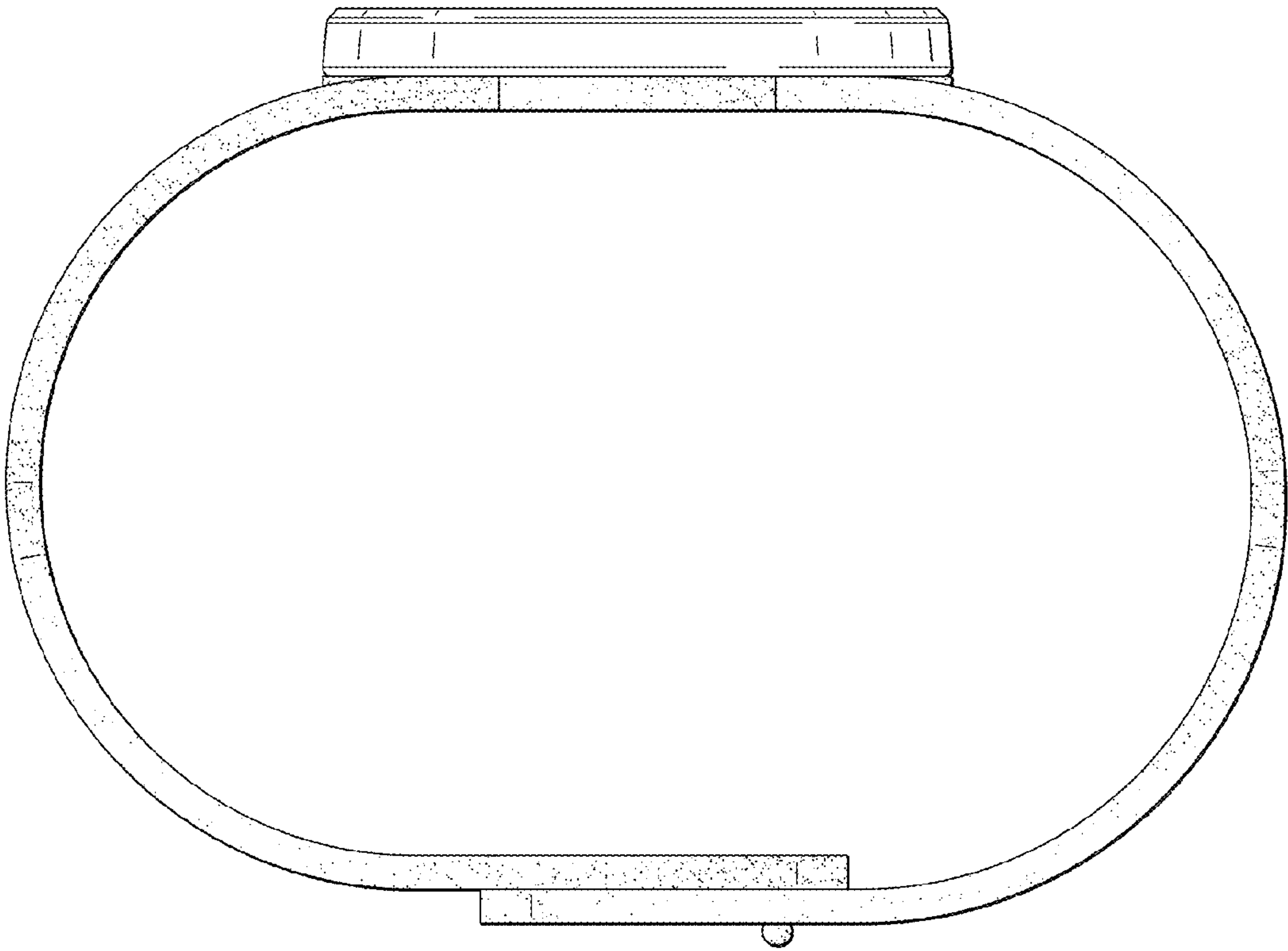

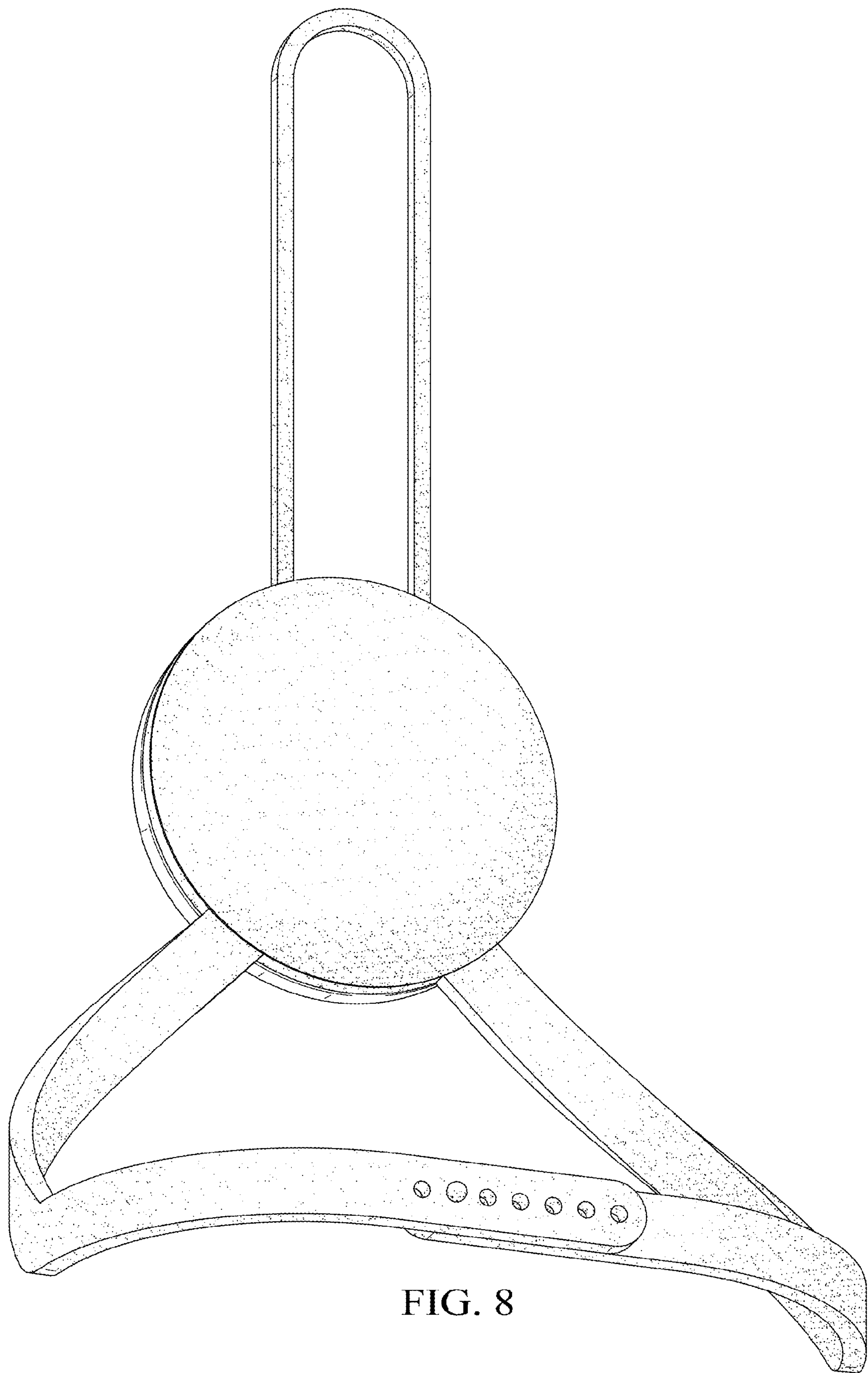

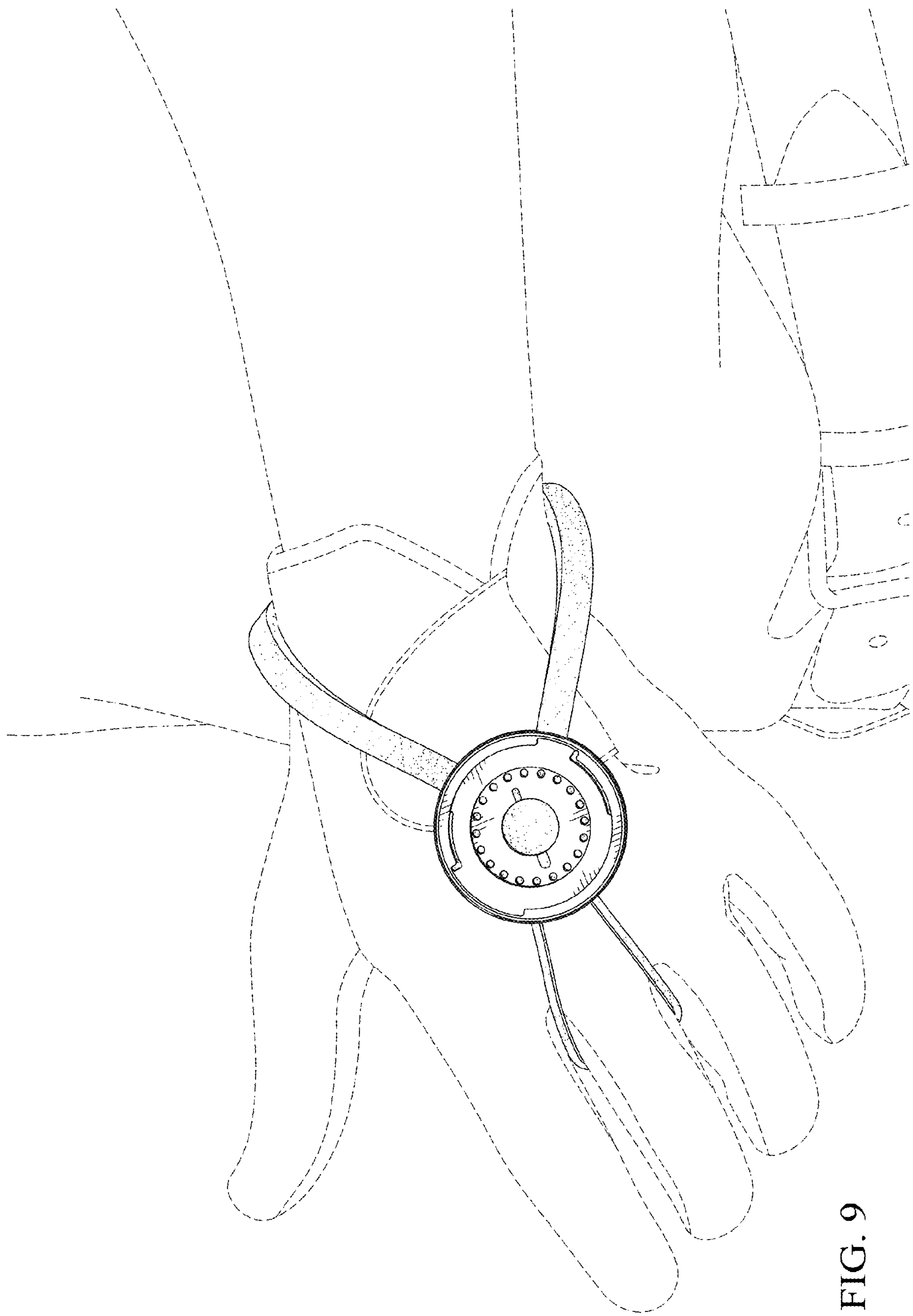
