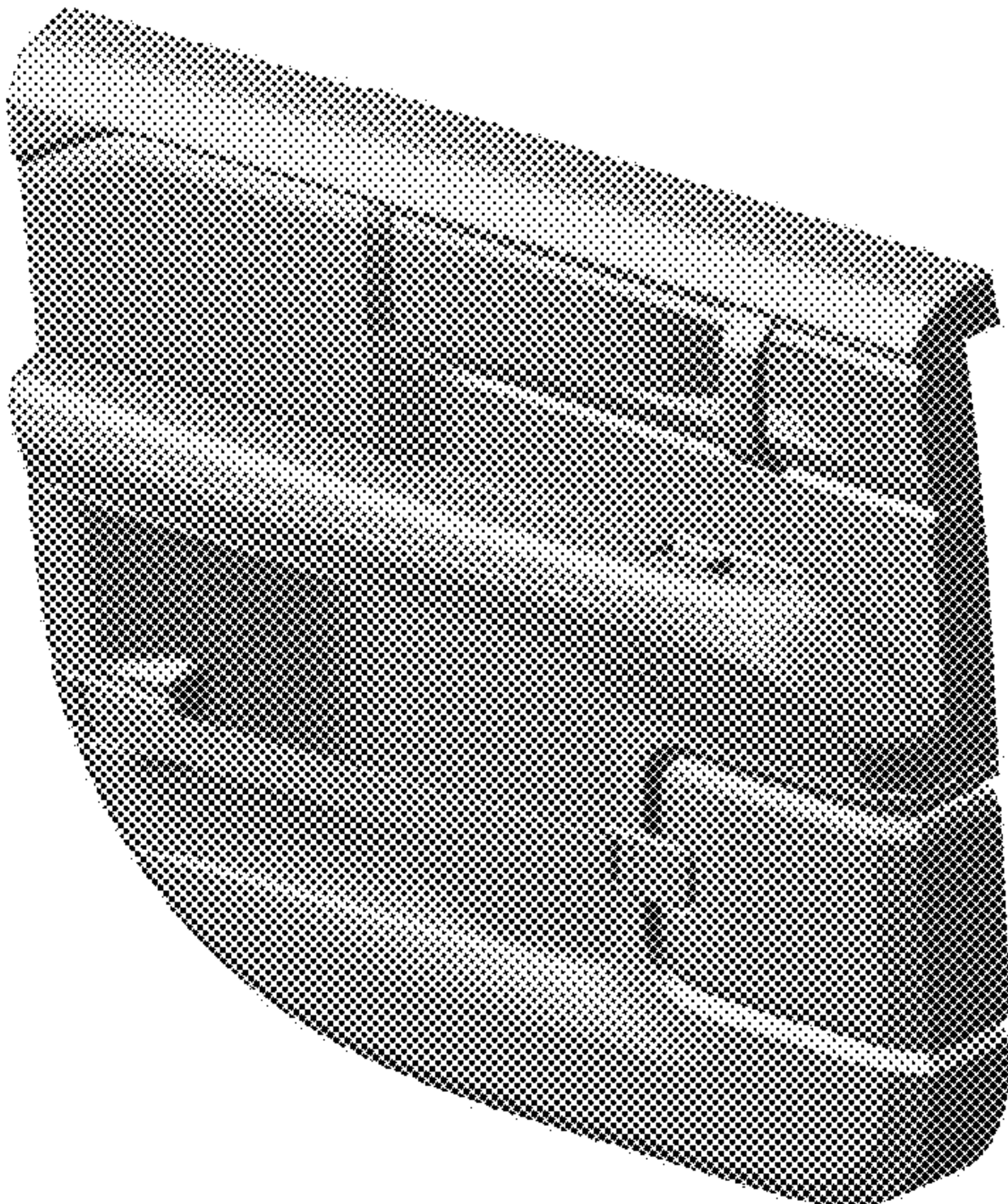
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vehicle door trim panel as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front top right perspective view of a vehicle door trim panel according to the new design.
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a right-side view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a left-side view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
FIG. 7 is a front top left perspective view thereof.
FIG. 8 is a front view thereof showing the vehicle door trim panel in an installed configuration.
FIG. 9 is a front top left perspective view thereof showing the vehicle door trim panel in an installed configuration; and, FIG. 10 is a front top right perspective view thereof showing the vehicle door trim panel in an installed configuration.
The mirror image of the vehicle door trim panel is claimed but not shown.
The portions of the vehicle door trim panel rendered in darker gray tones are claimed. The portions of the vehicle door trim panel rendered in light gray are for illustrative purposes and form no part of the claimed design.

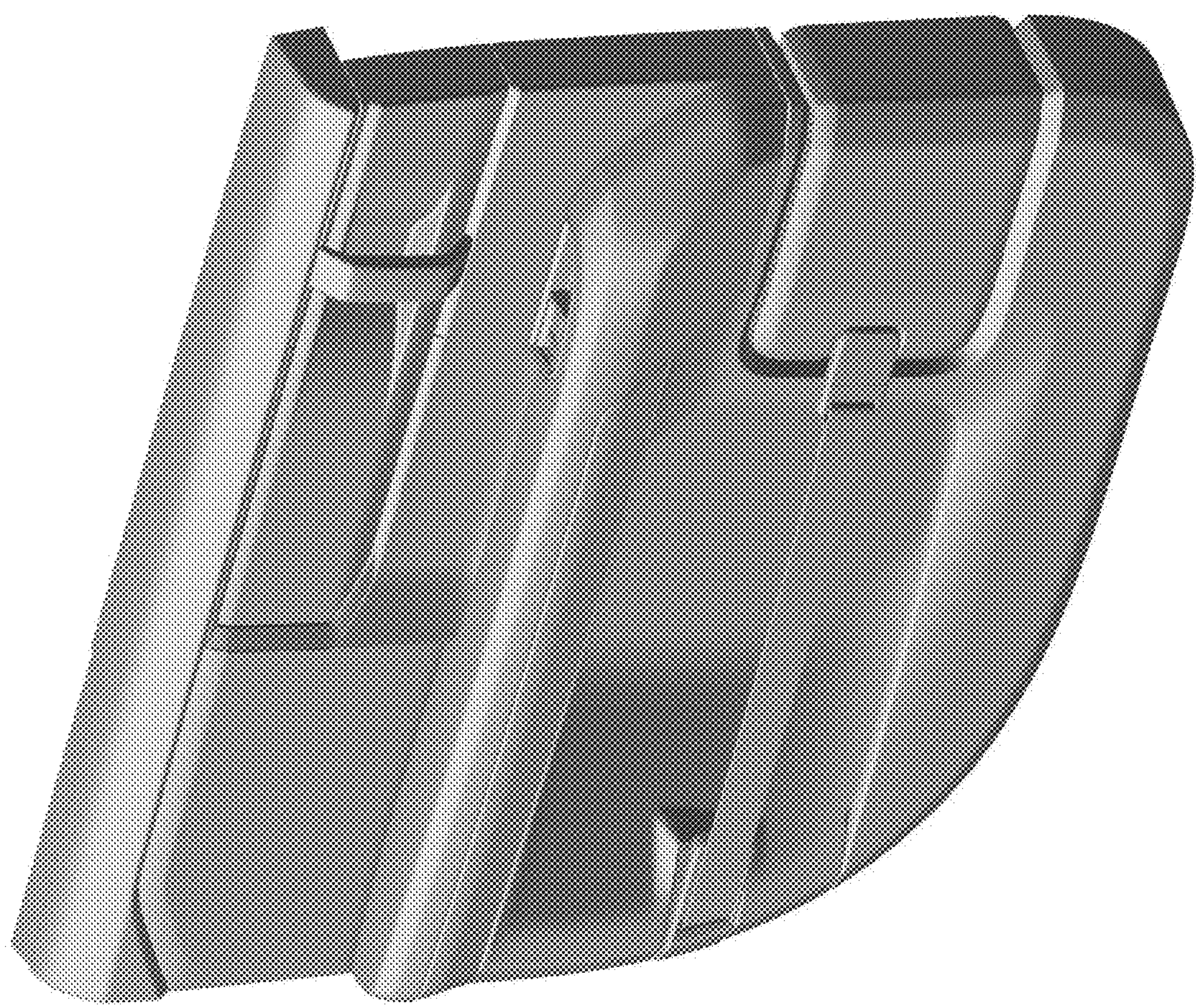

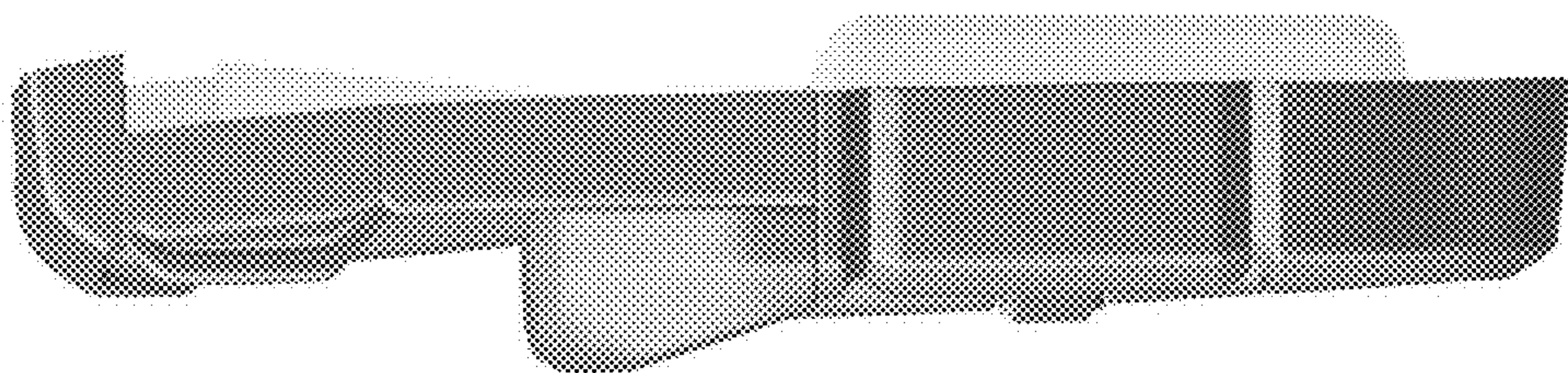

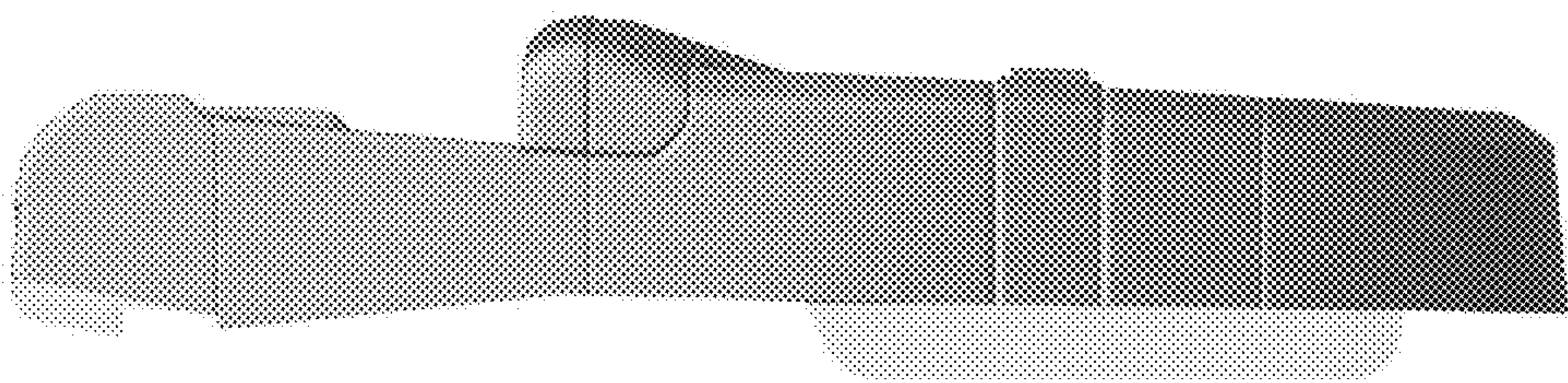

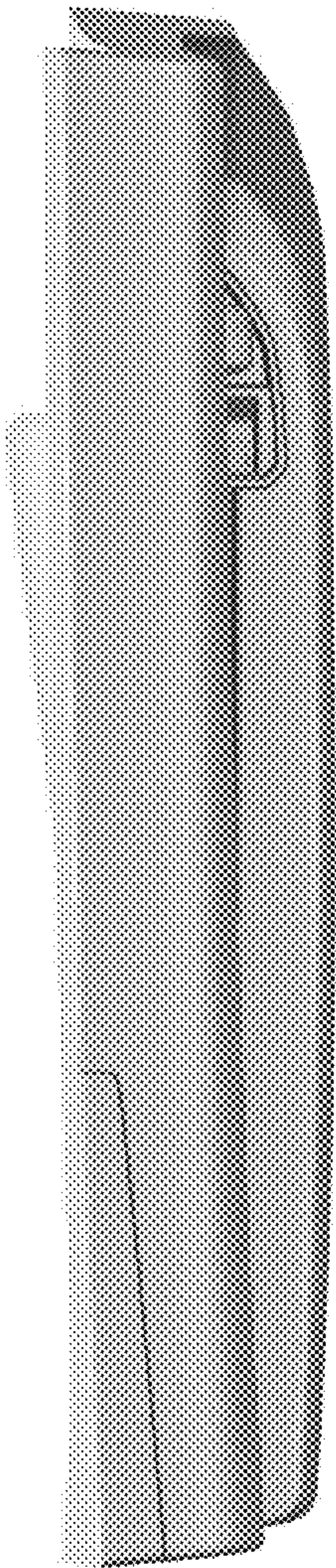

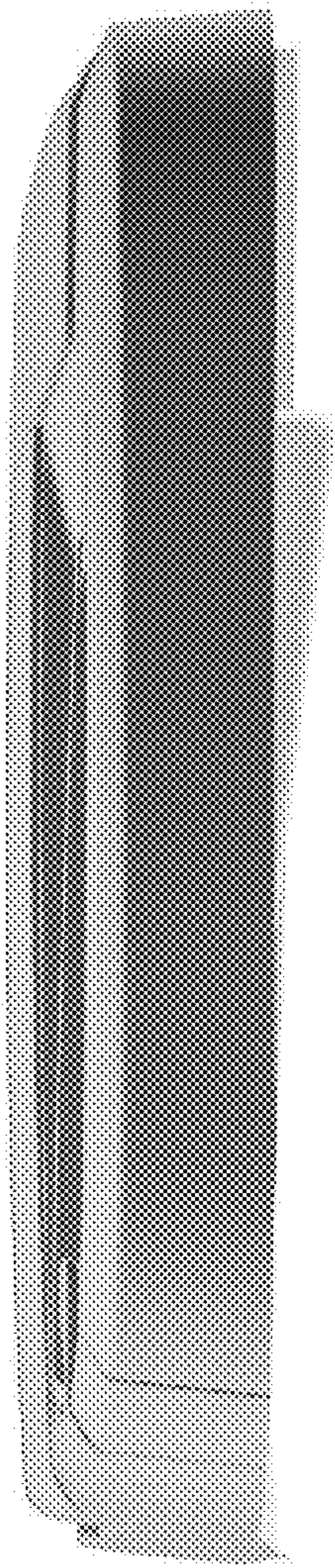

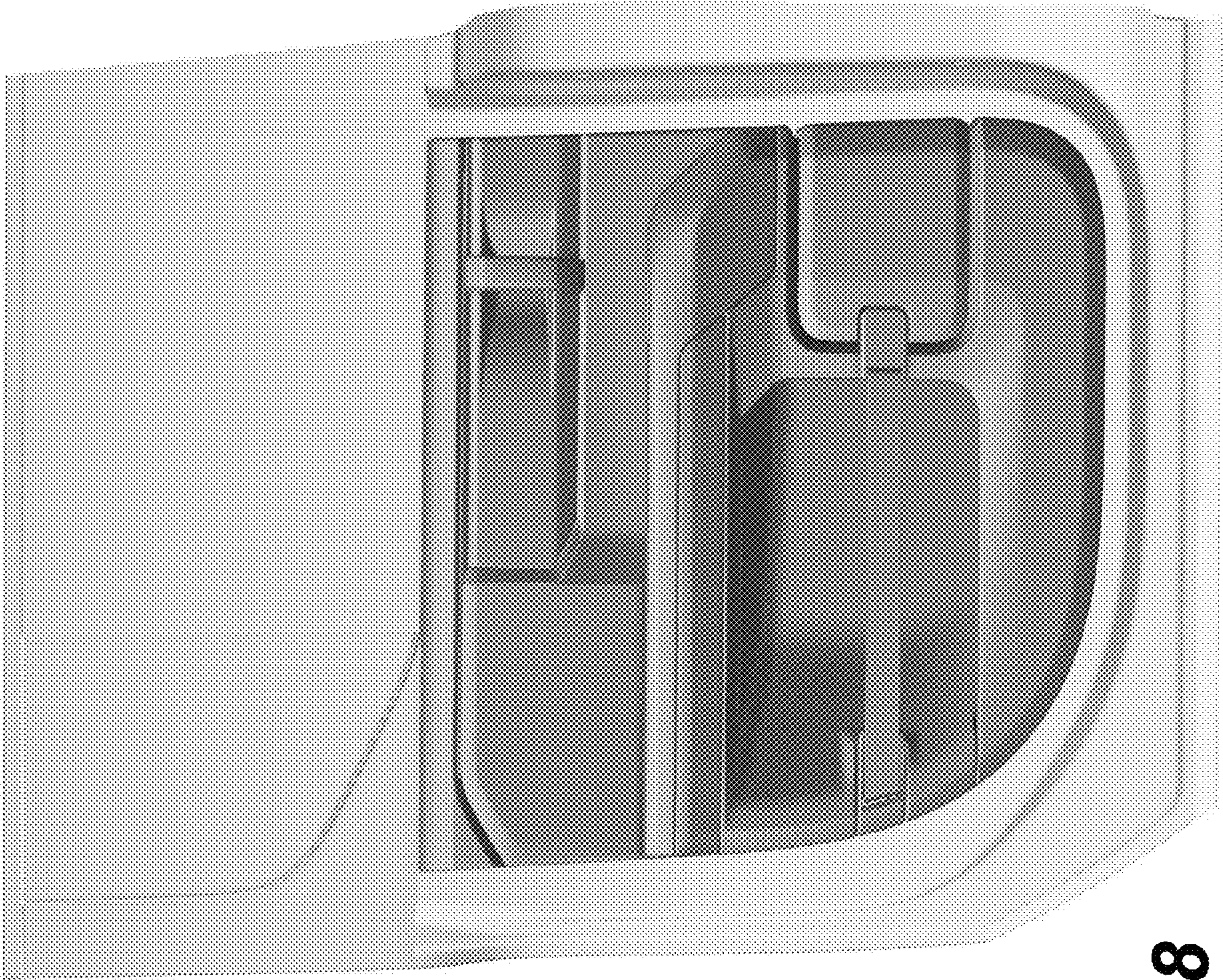

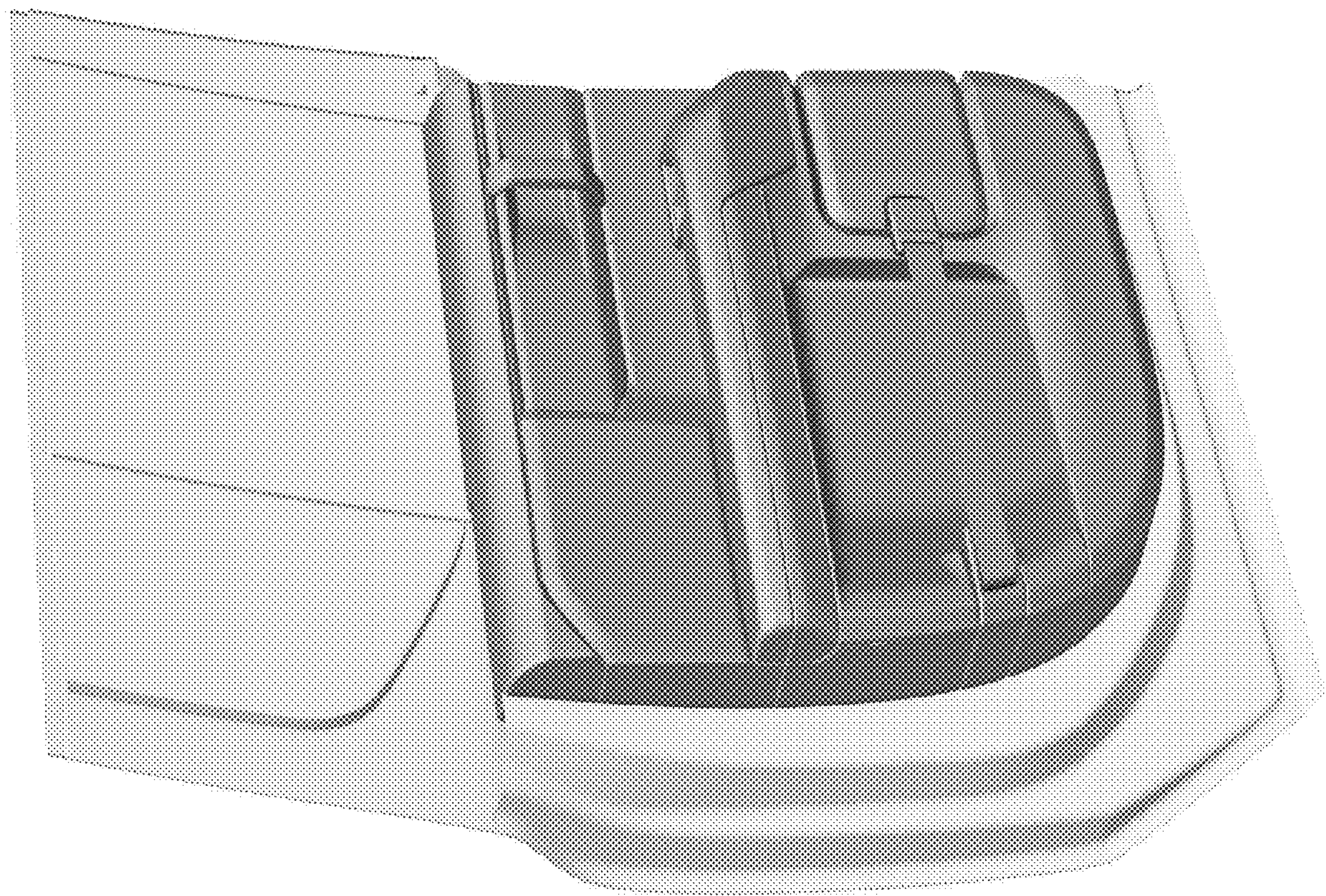
