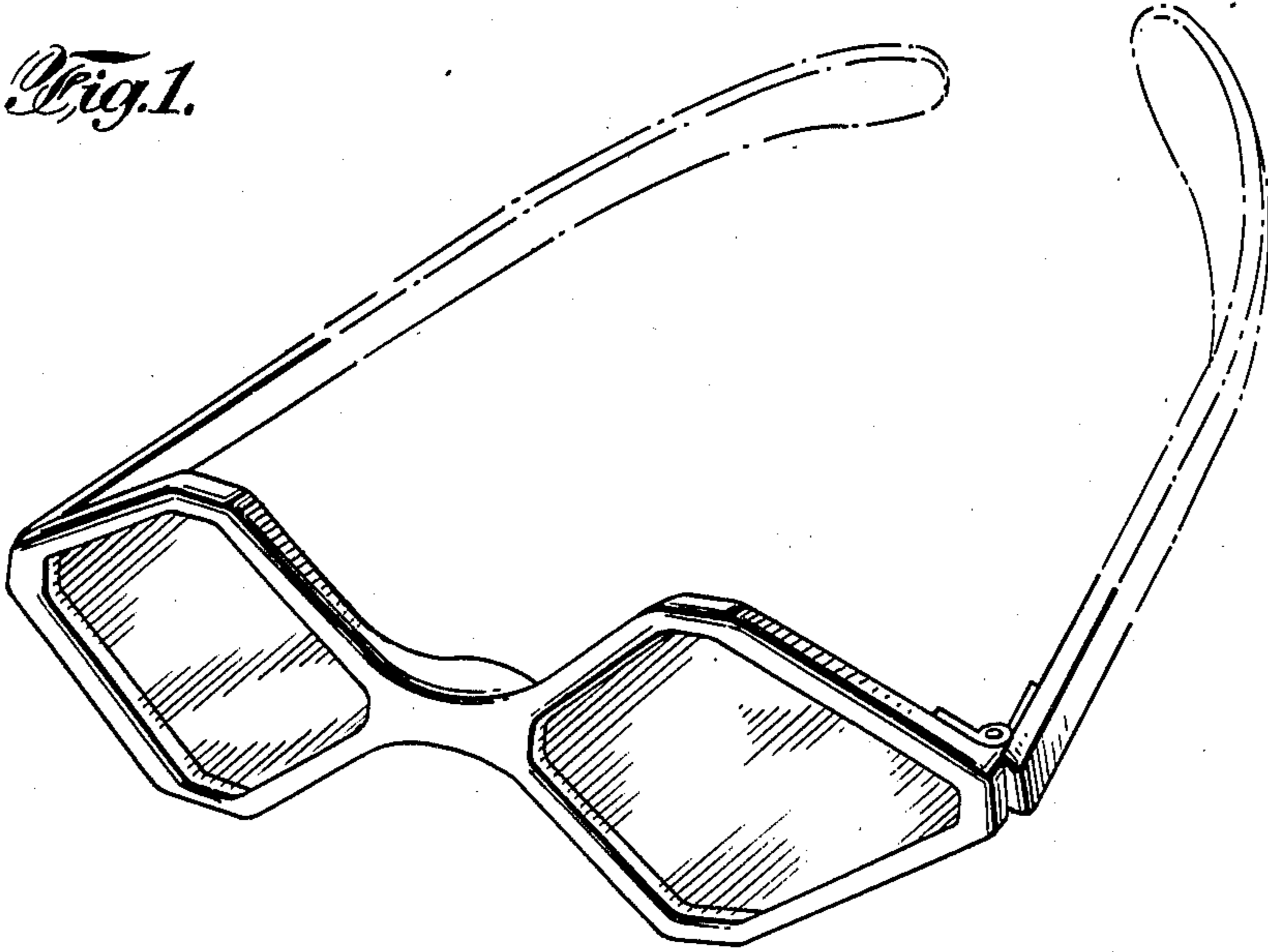

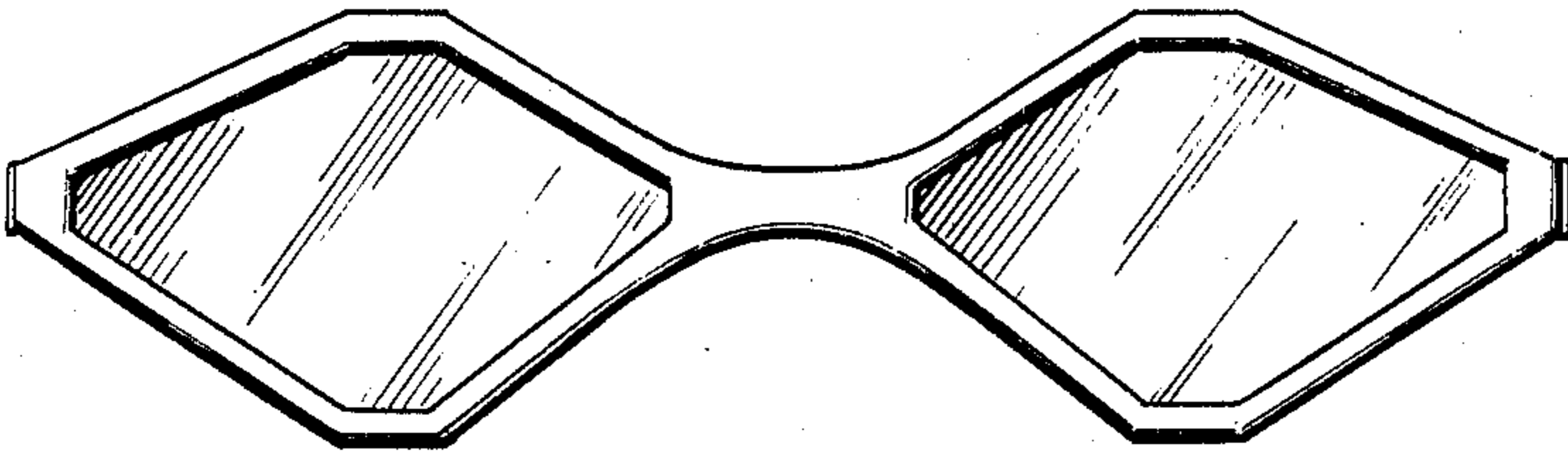
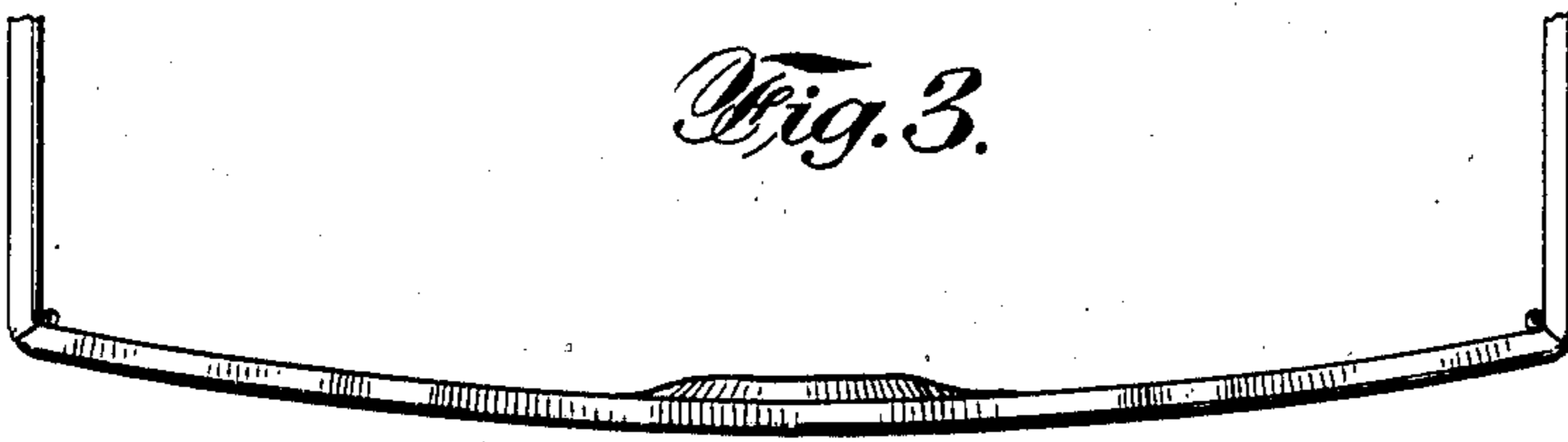

DESIGN FOR A PAIR OF SPECTACLES

Altina Sanders, New York, N. Y.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Altina Sanders, a citizen of the United States and resident of New York, in the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pair of Spectacles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing,

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a pair of spectacles showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front view of my spectacles; and

Fig. 3 is a plan view of the same, the temples being shown in a fragmentary condition for convenience of illustration.

The essential features of my design for a pair of spectacles are shown in full lines and the same is characterized by the elongated hexagonal lens rims having sides of the relative proportions to each other as illustrated.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pair of spectacles, substantially as shown and described.
