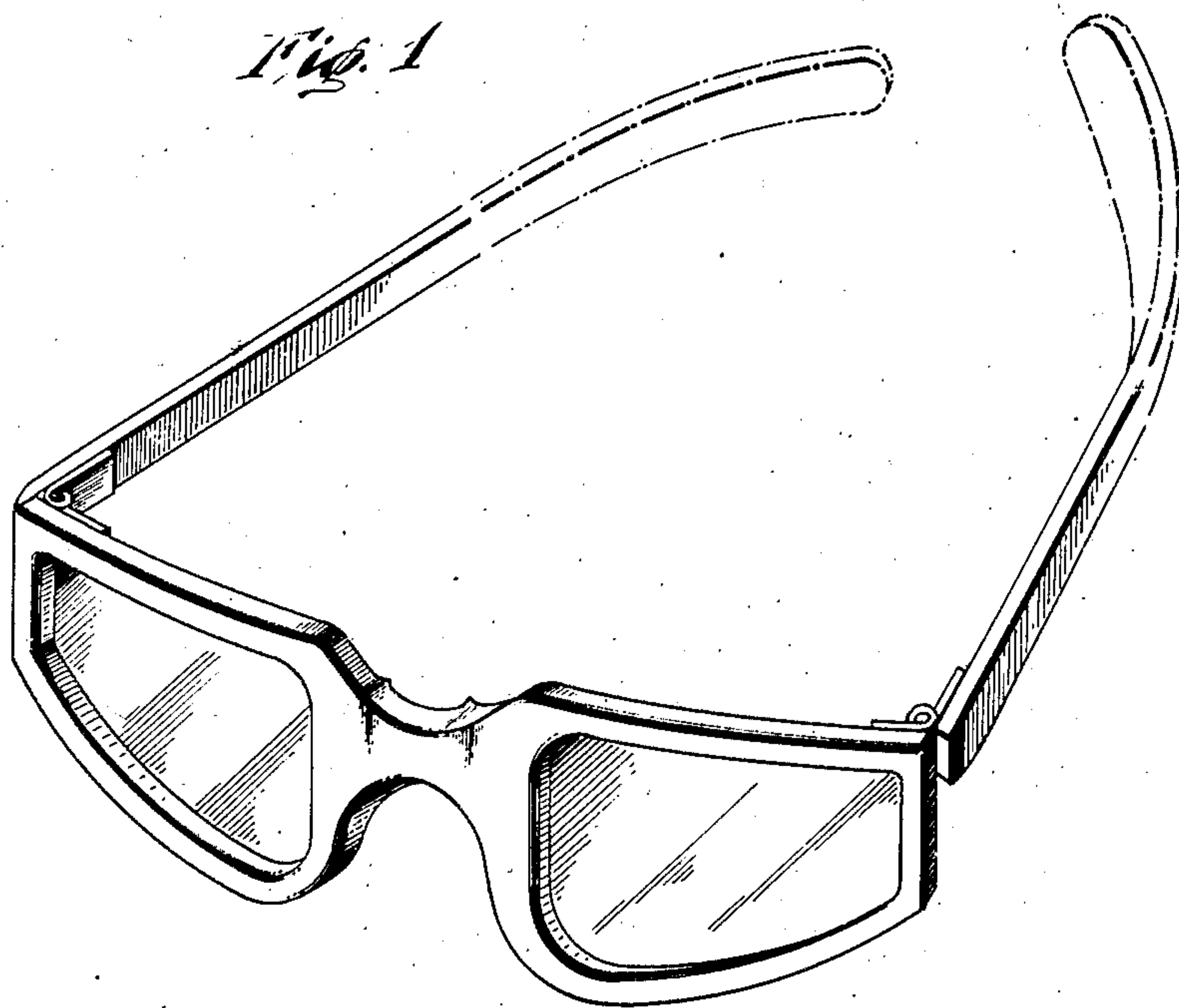

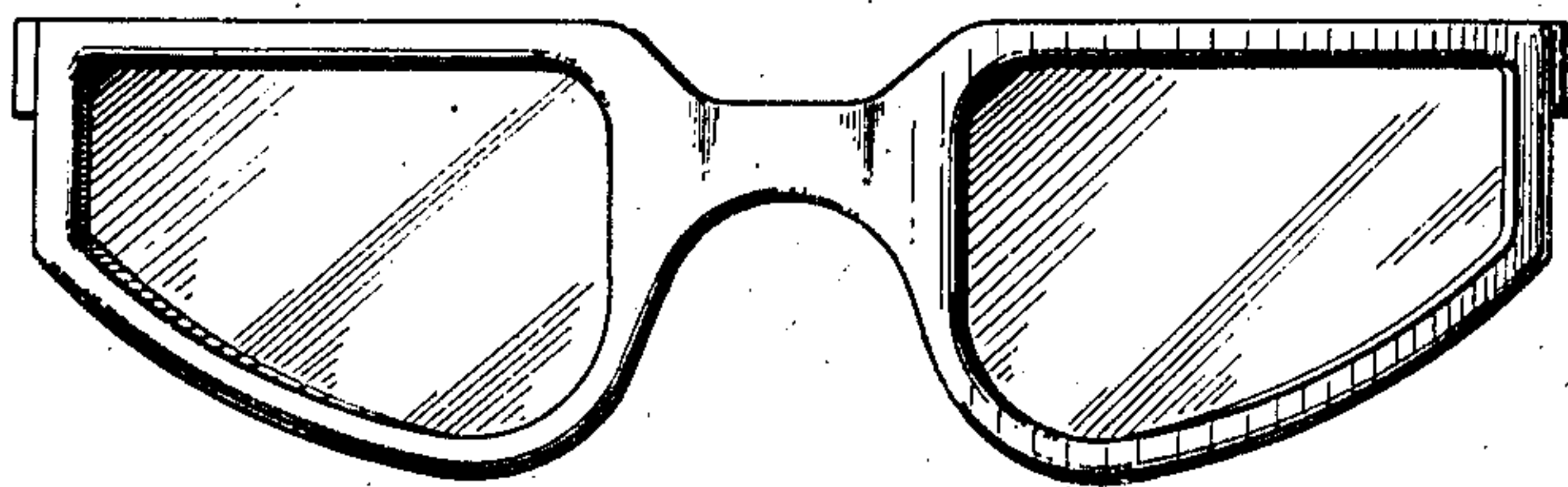
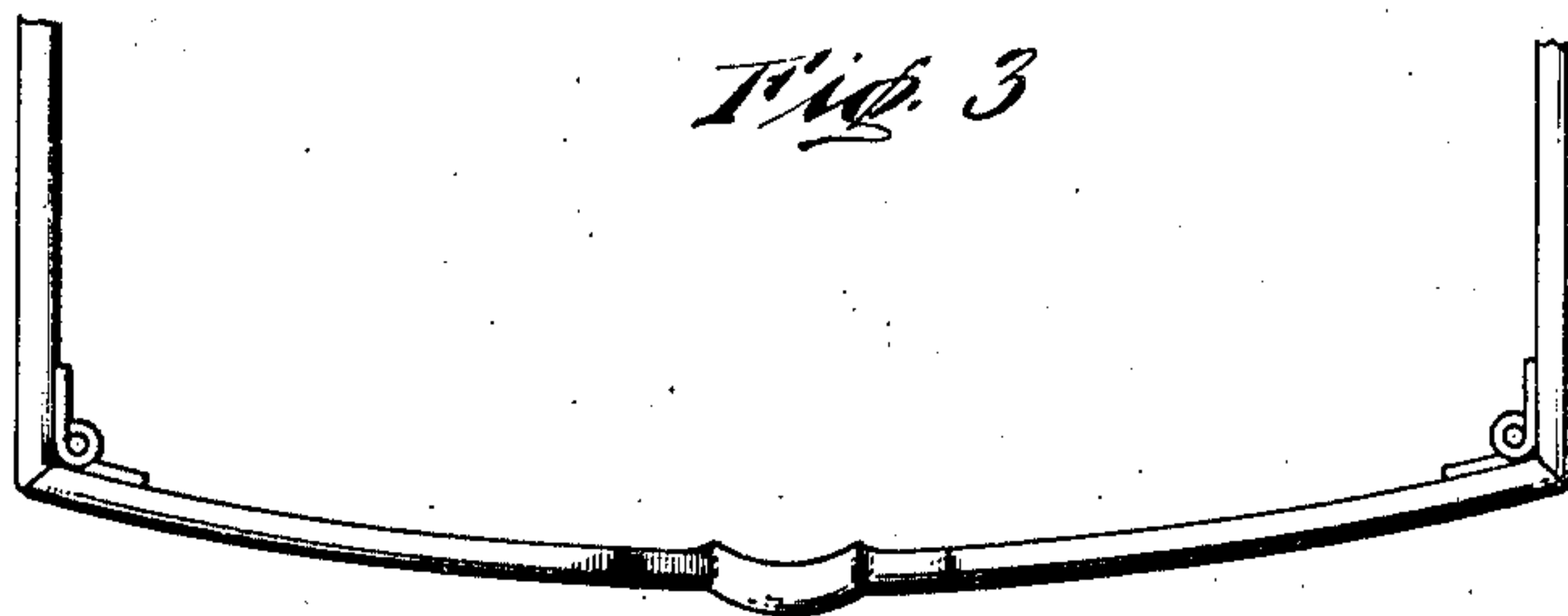

DESIGN FOR A PAIR OF SPECTACLES

Altina Sanders, New York, N. Y.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Altina Sanders, a citizen of the United States and resident of New York, in the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pair of Spectacles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing,

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a pair of spectacles showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front view of my spectacles; and

Fig. 3 is a plan view of the same, the temples being shown in a fragmentary condition for convenience of illustration.

The essential features of my design for a pair of spectacles are shown in full lines and the same is characterized by the upper right angular formation of the rims in combination with the upward, outward curvature of the lower portions.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pair of spectacles, substantially as shown and described.
