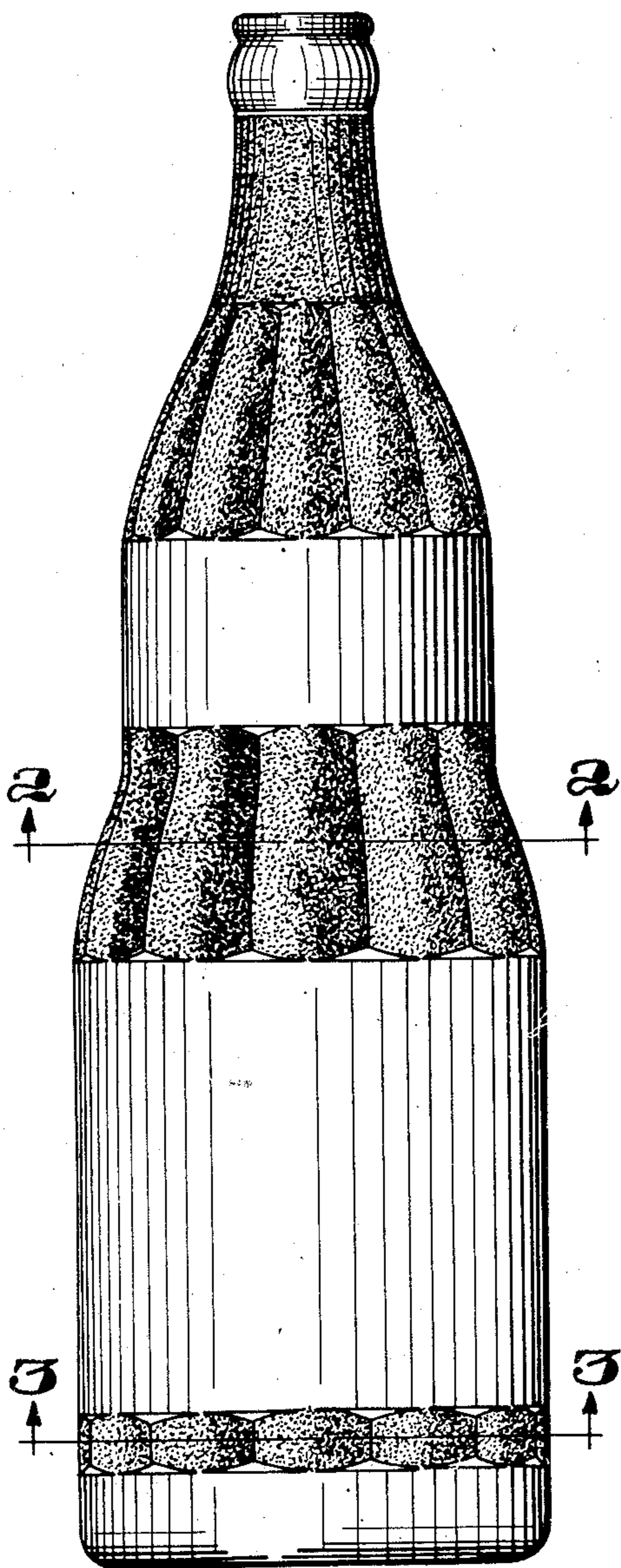

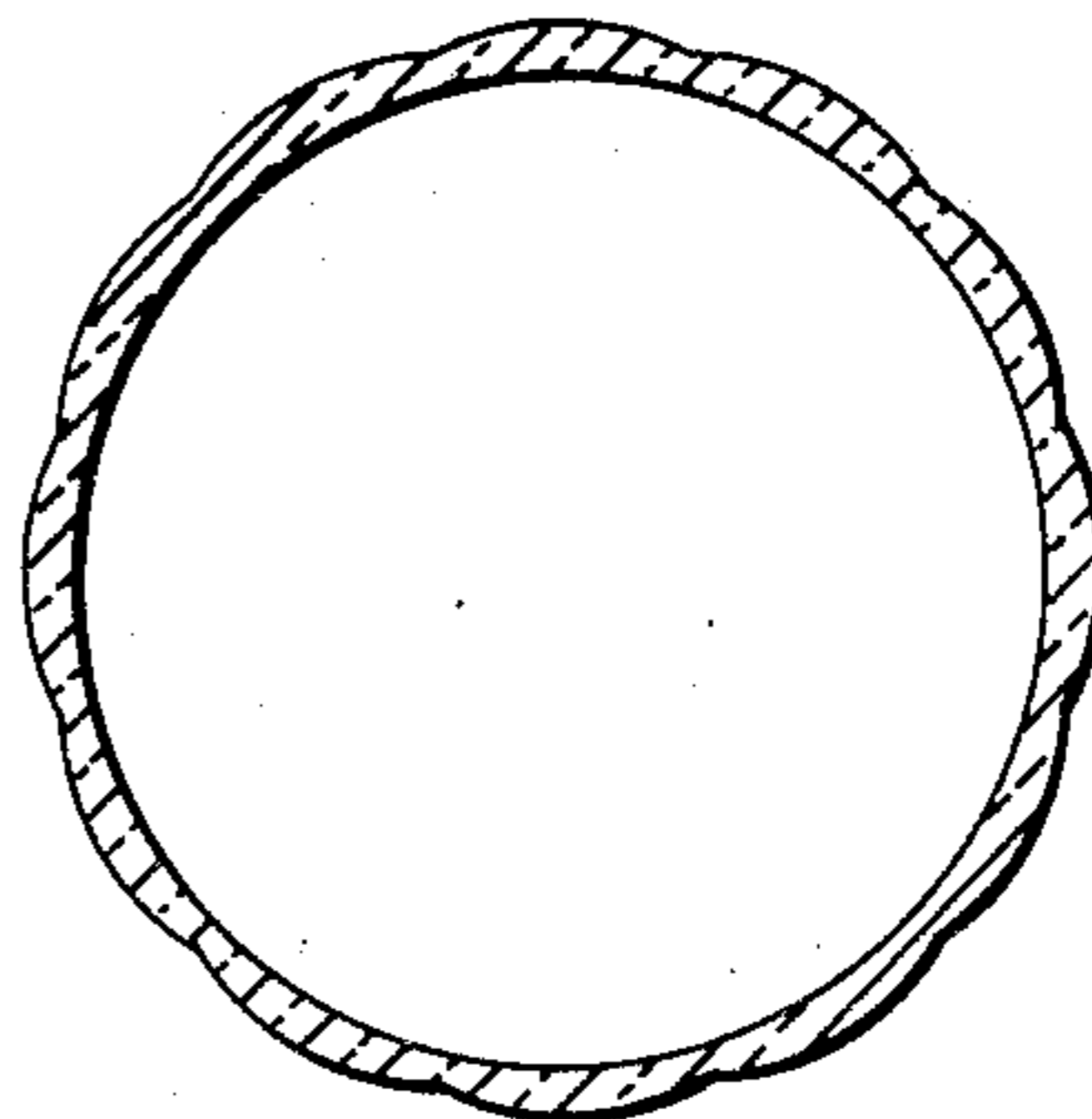
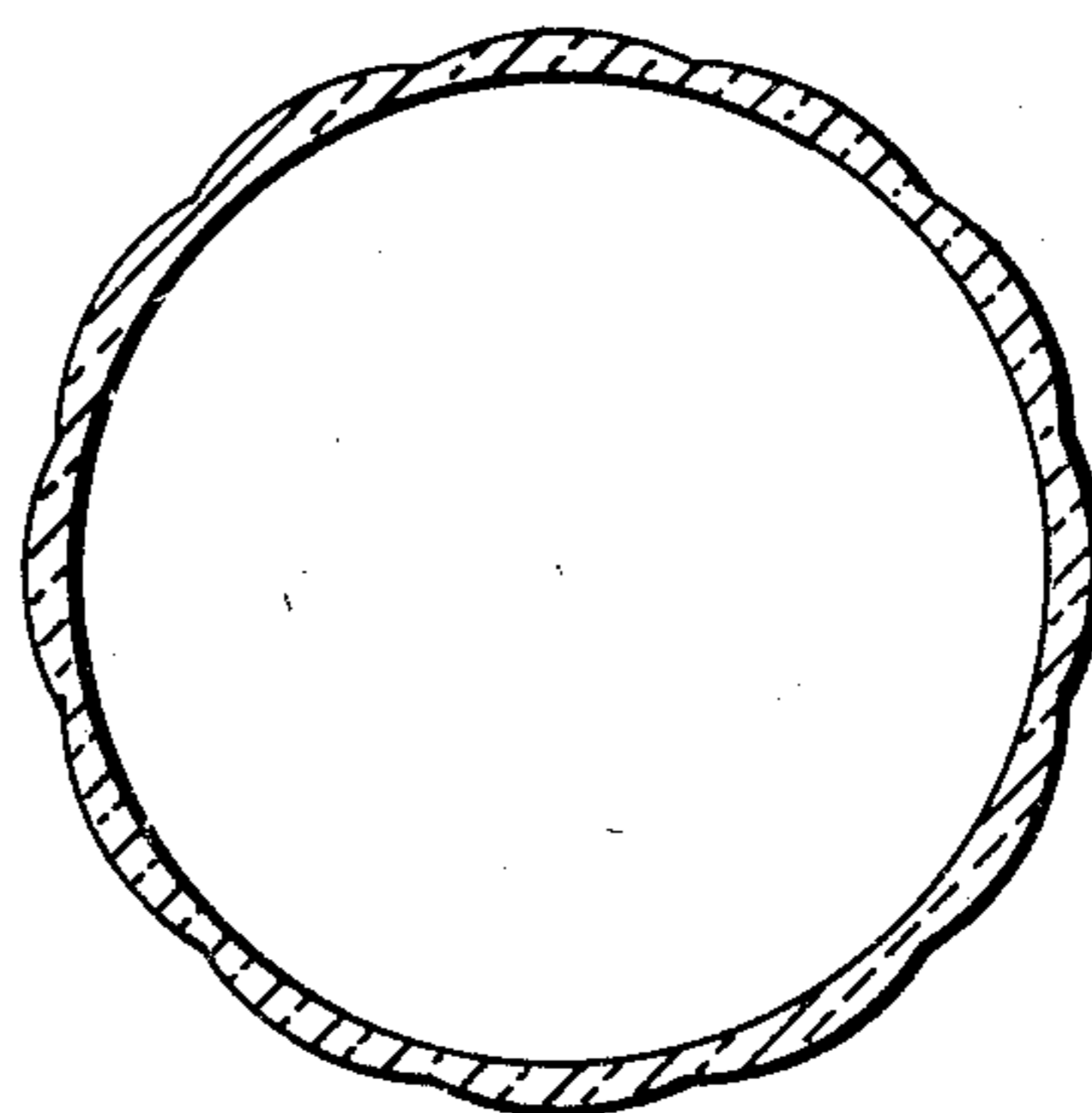

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward Rachins, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brookline, in the county of Norfolk and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a sectional view on line 2—2 of Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a sectional view on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.
