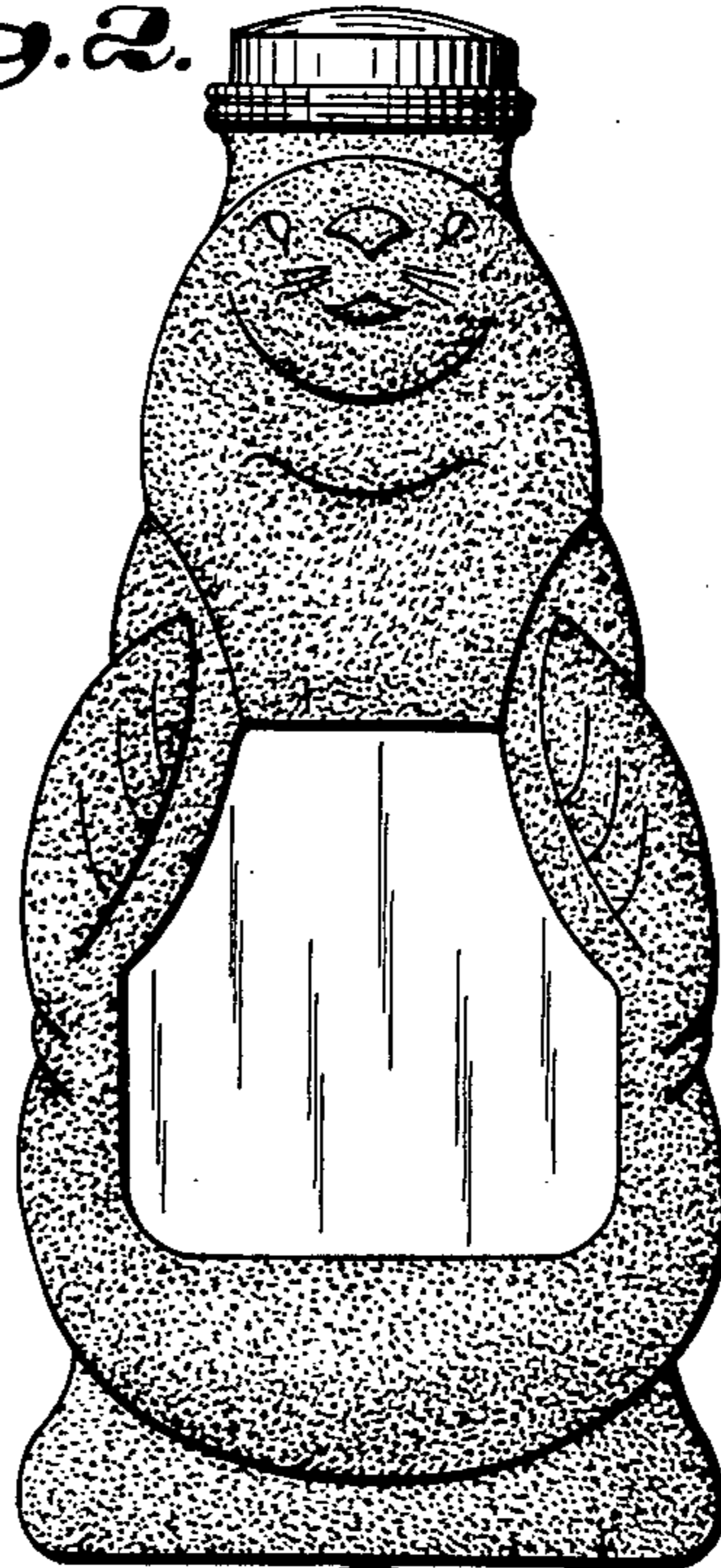

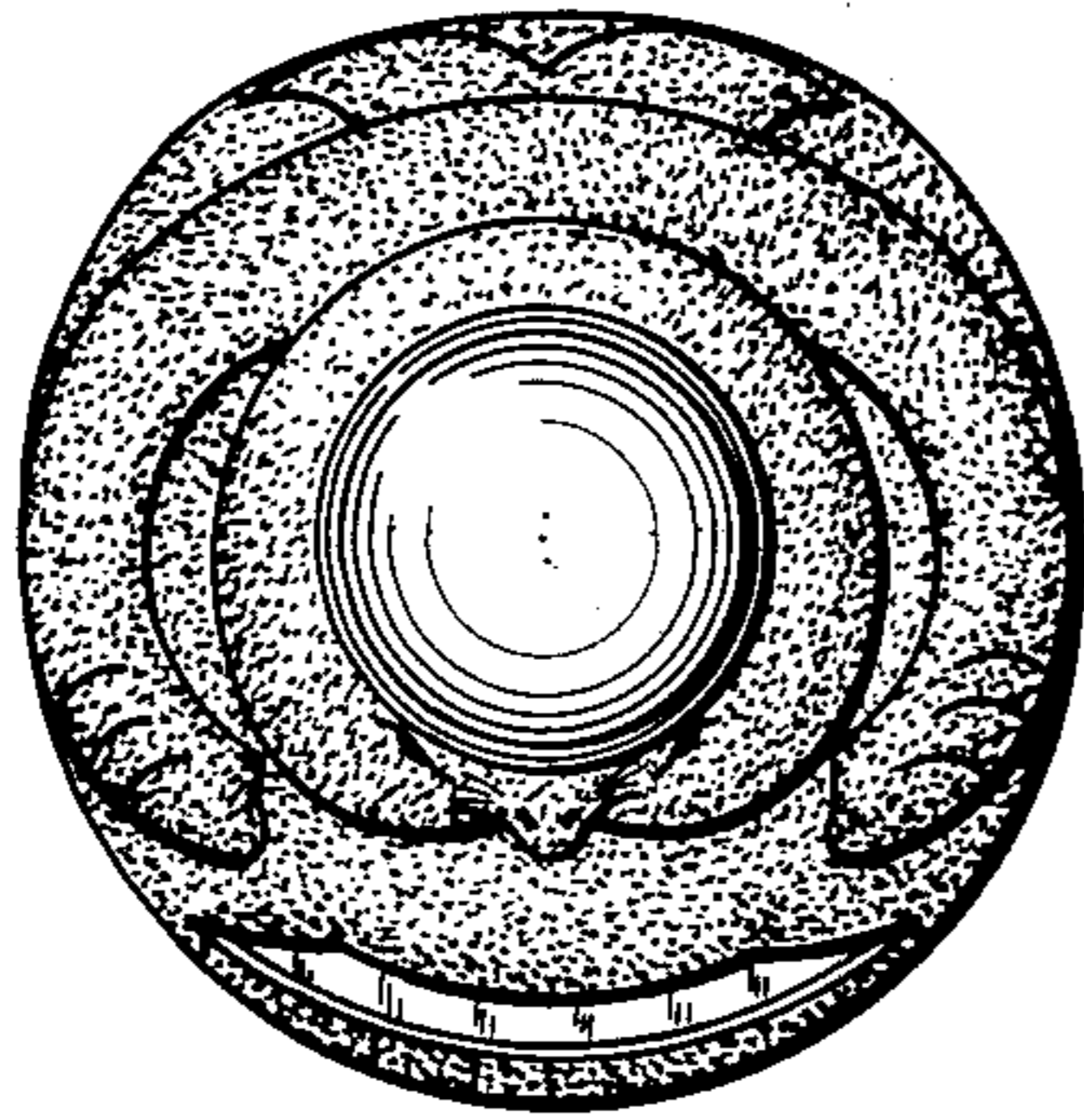

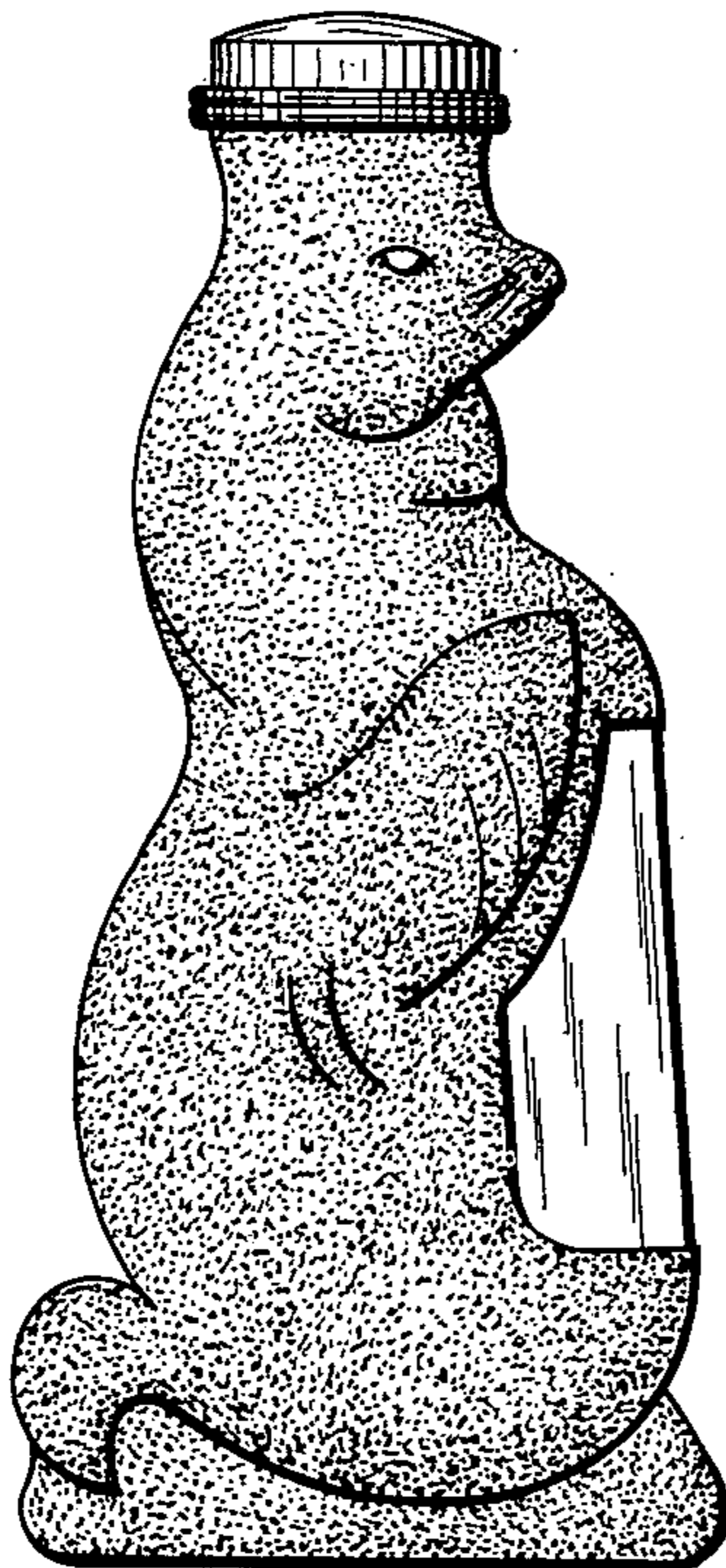
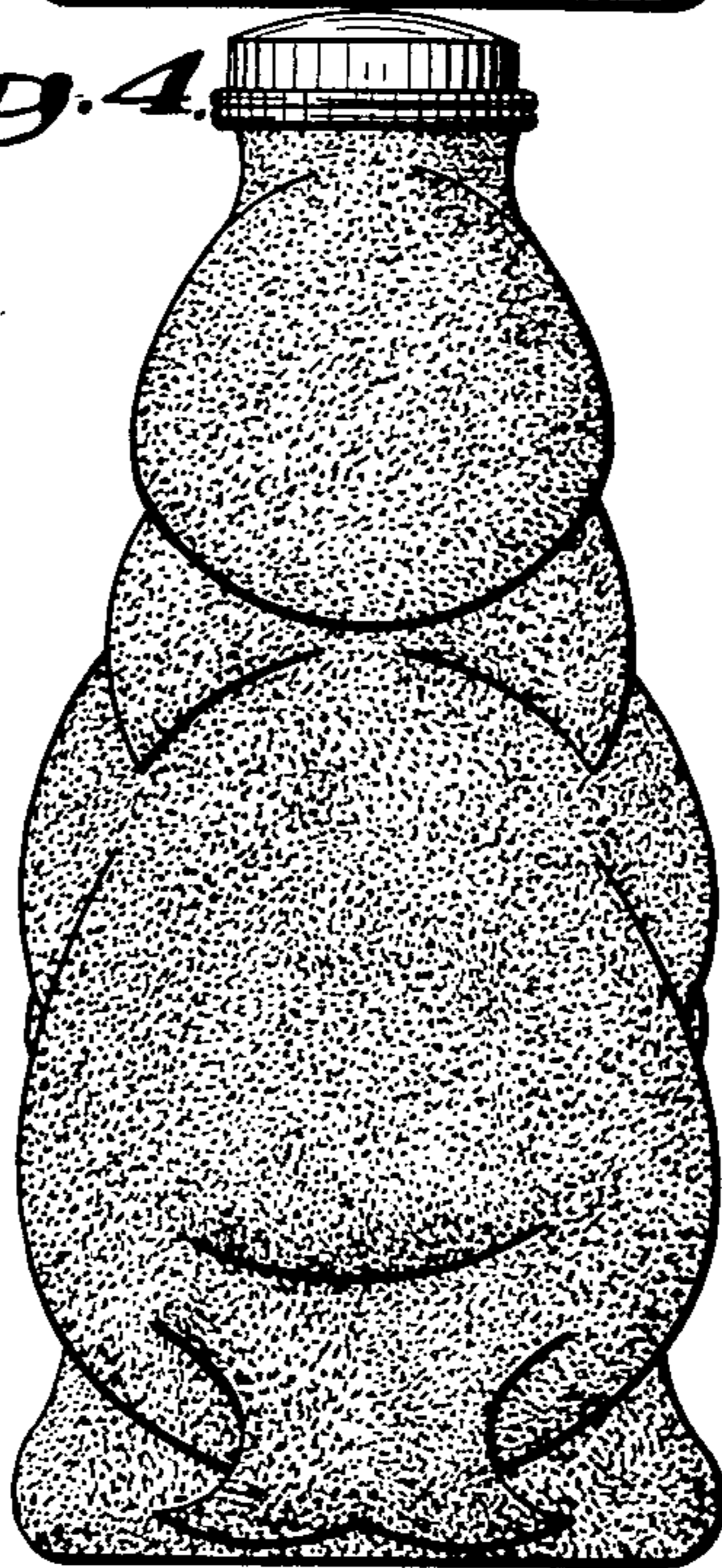

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward Rachins, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Brookline, in the county of Norfolk and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a bottle showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front view of the bottle;

Fig. 3 is a side view of the bottle looking to the right of Fig. 2; and

Fig. 4 is a rear view of the bottle.
