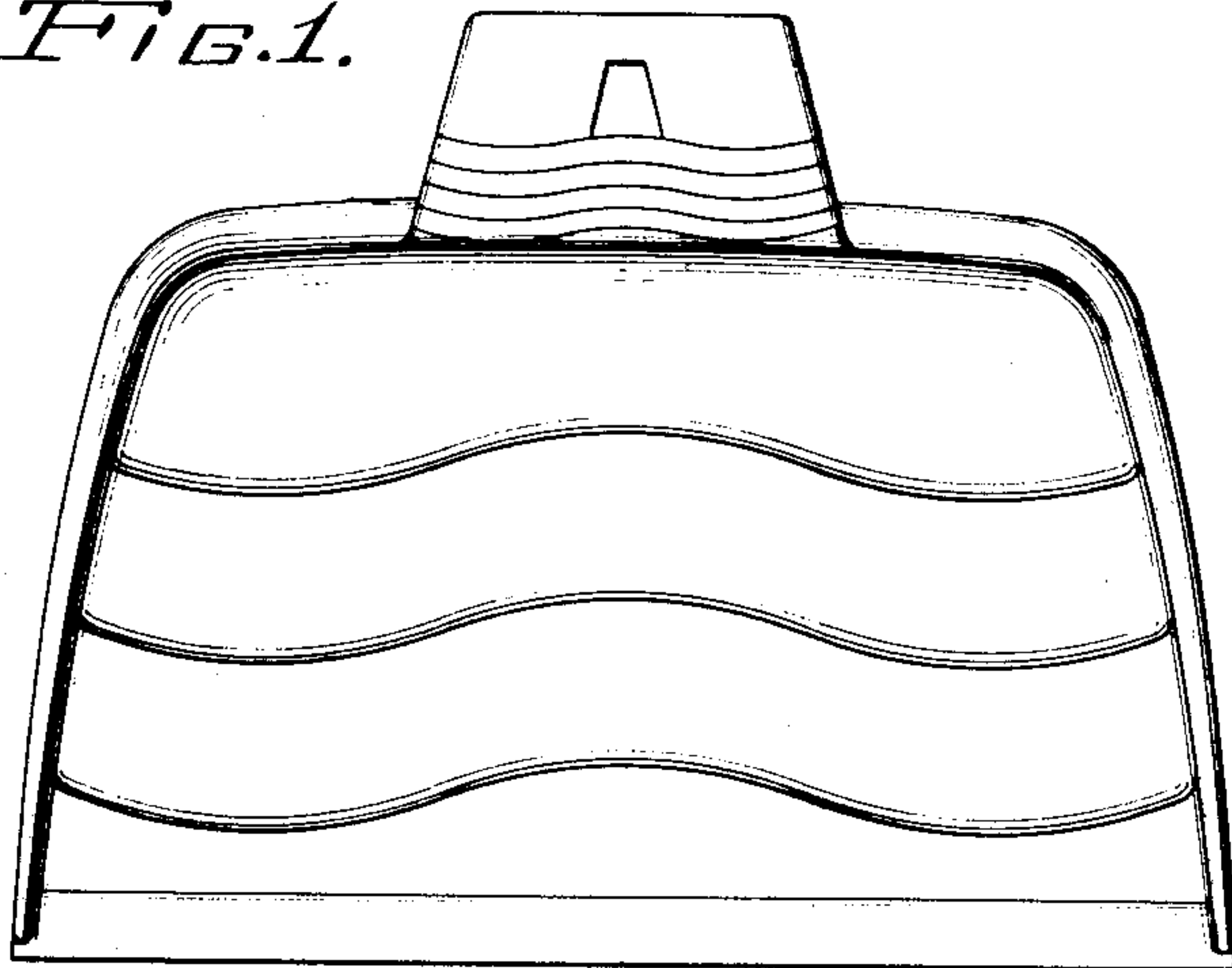

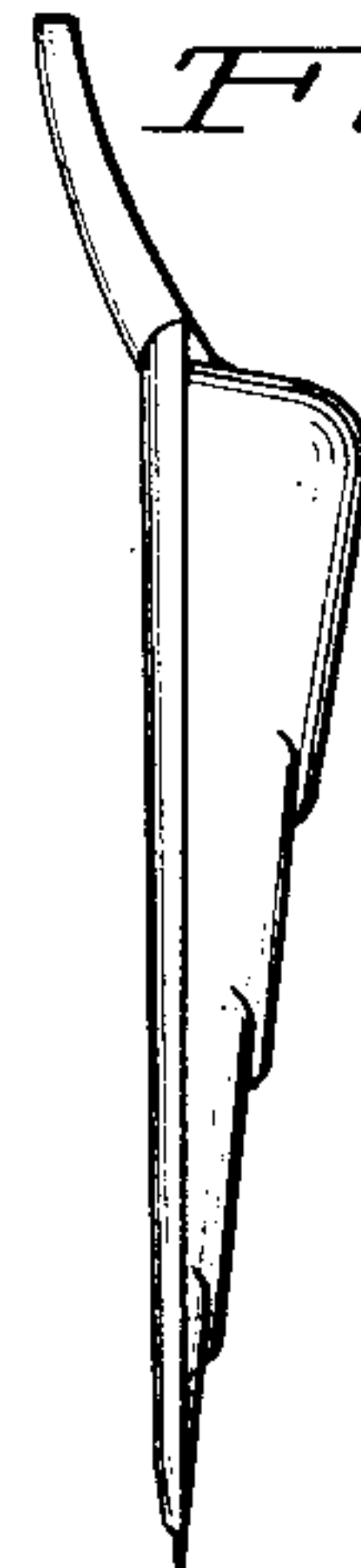

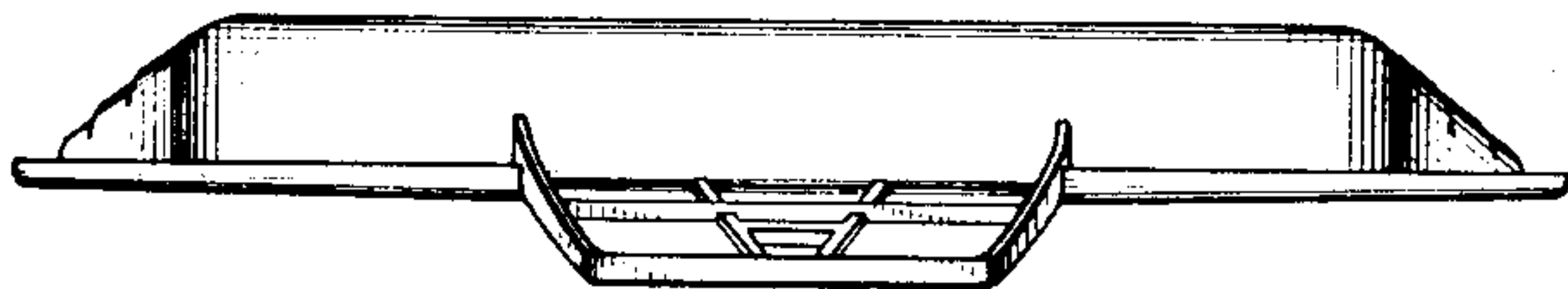
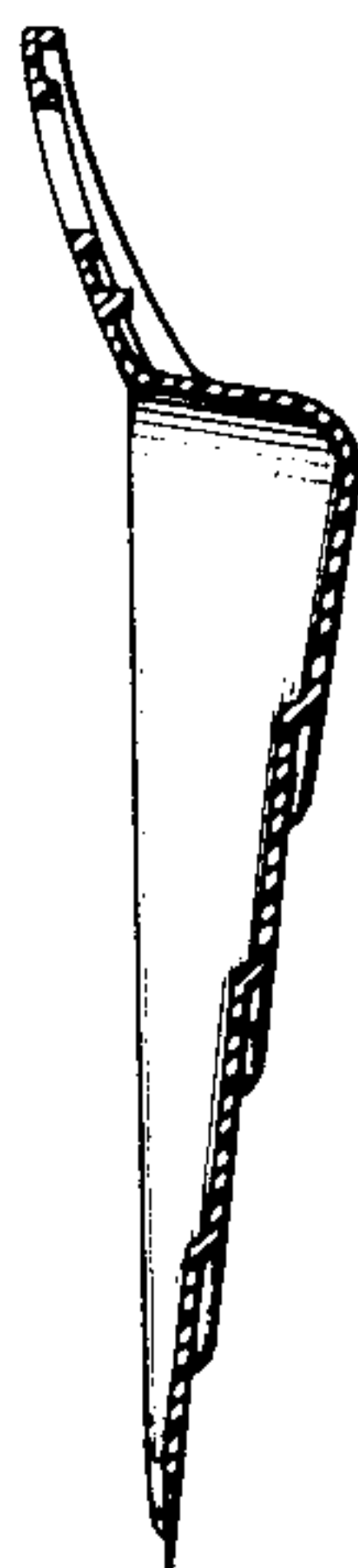
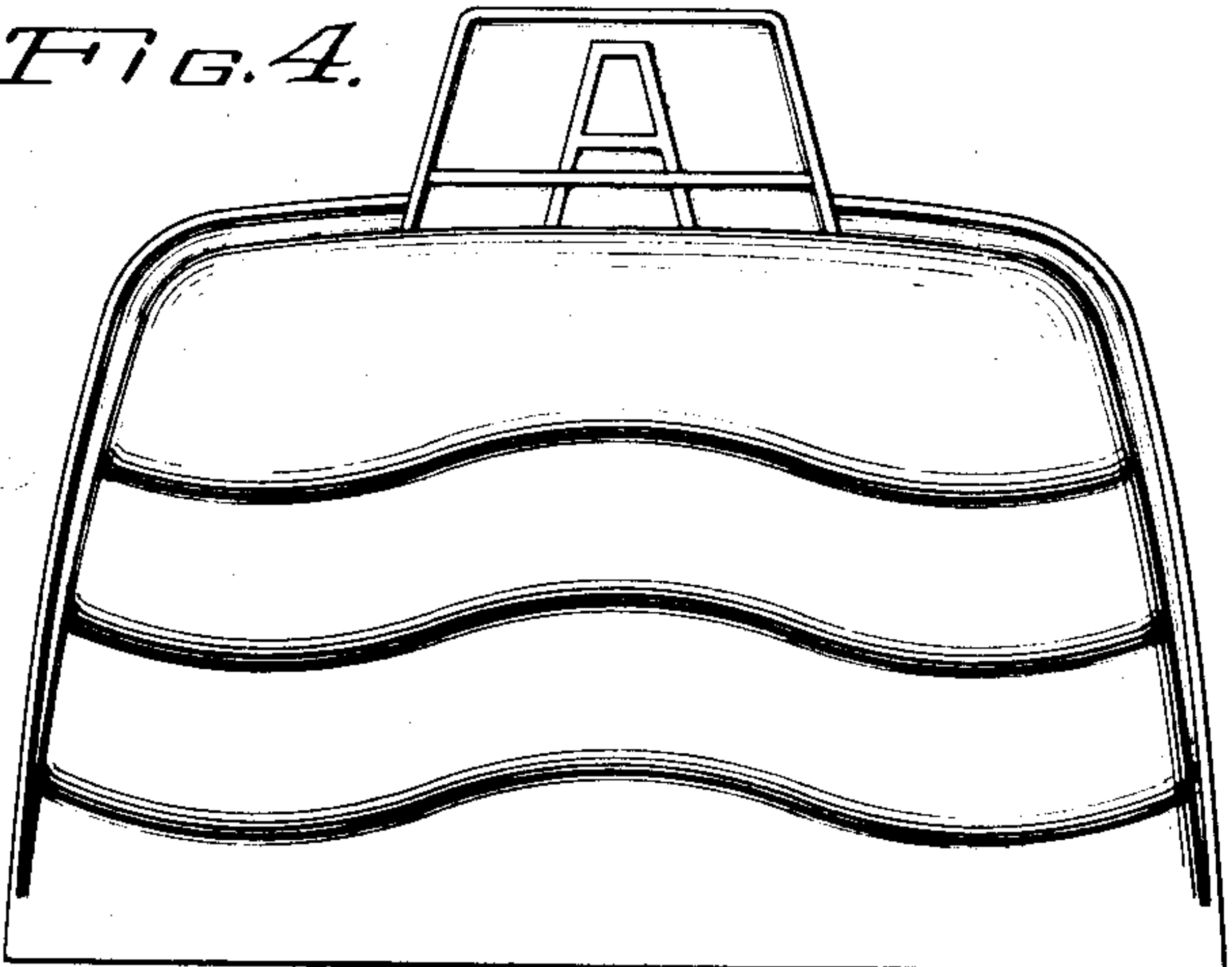

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Richard J. Andersen and Joseph A. Hill, both citizens of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dustpan, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a dustpan showing our new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

Fig. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
Fig. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof.
