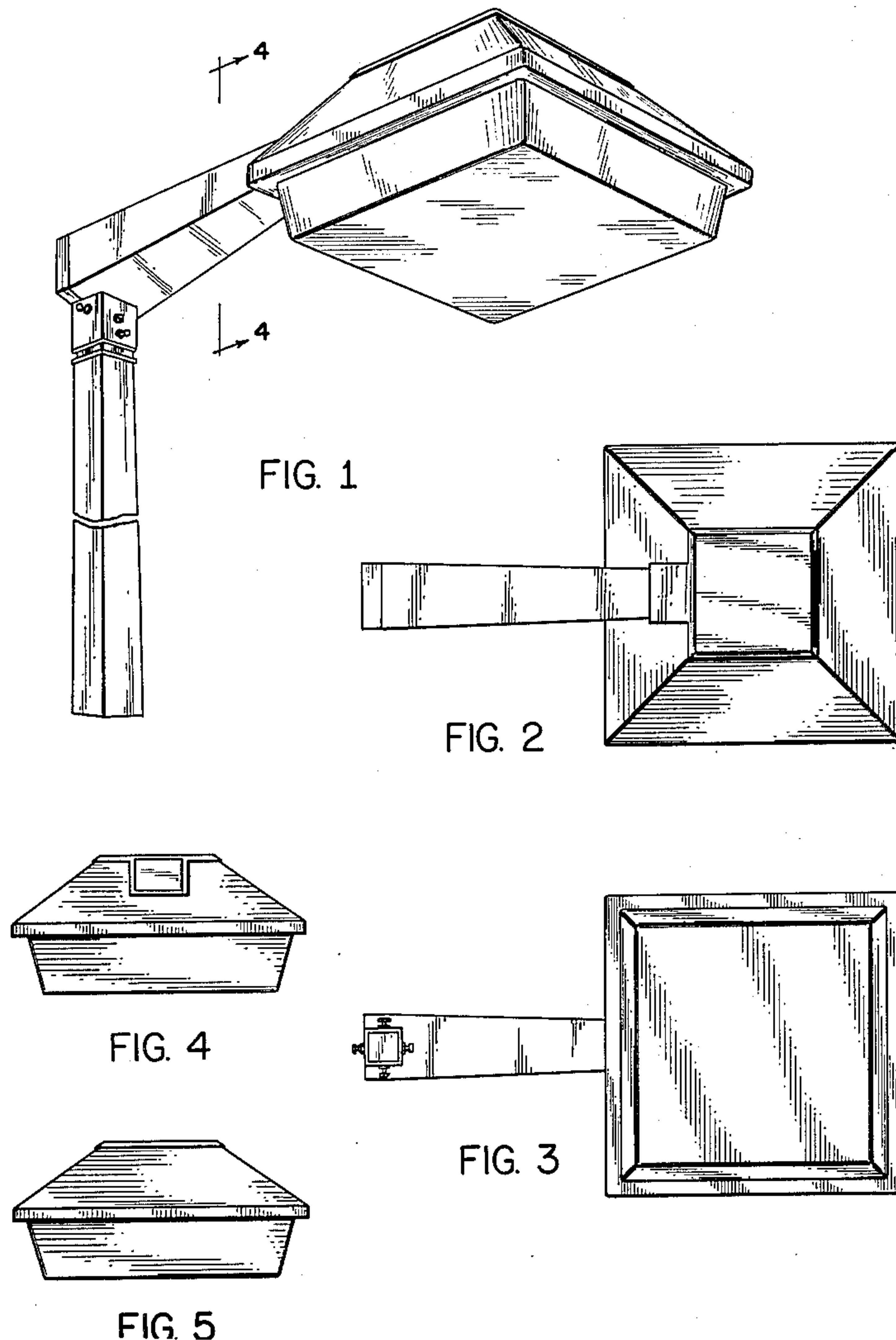


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined single outdoor lighting fixture and support showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof taken along section line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The support standard is broken away in FIG. 1 to indicate indeterminate length and is fragmentarily shown in FIGS. 2, 3 and 5 for convenience of illustration.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a combined single outdoor lighting fixture and support, as shown and described.
