FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chart recording instrument, showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

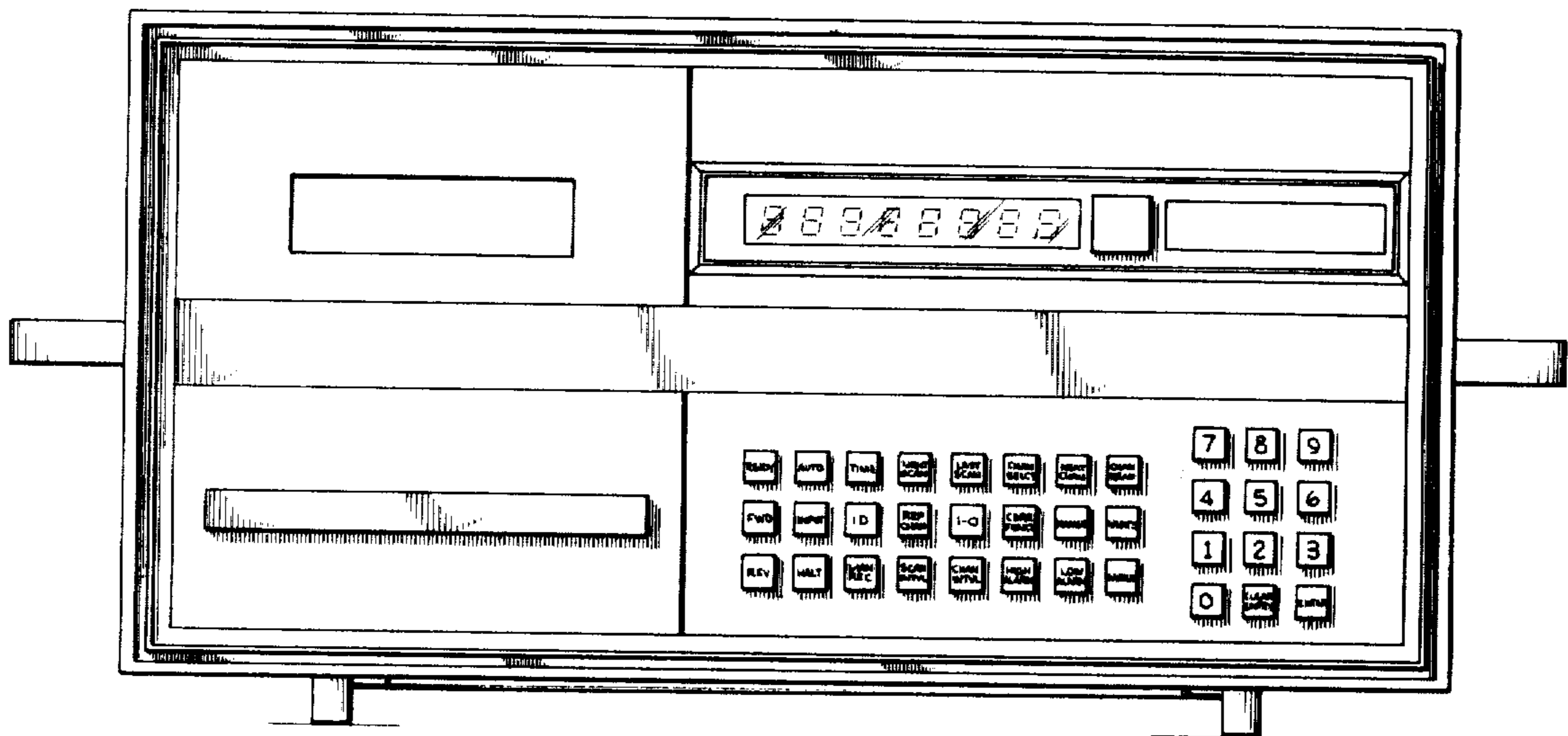
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of the display numerals in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



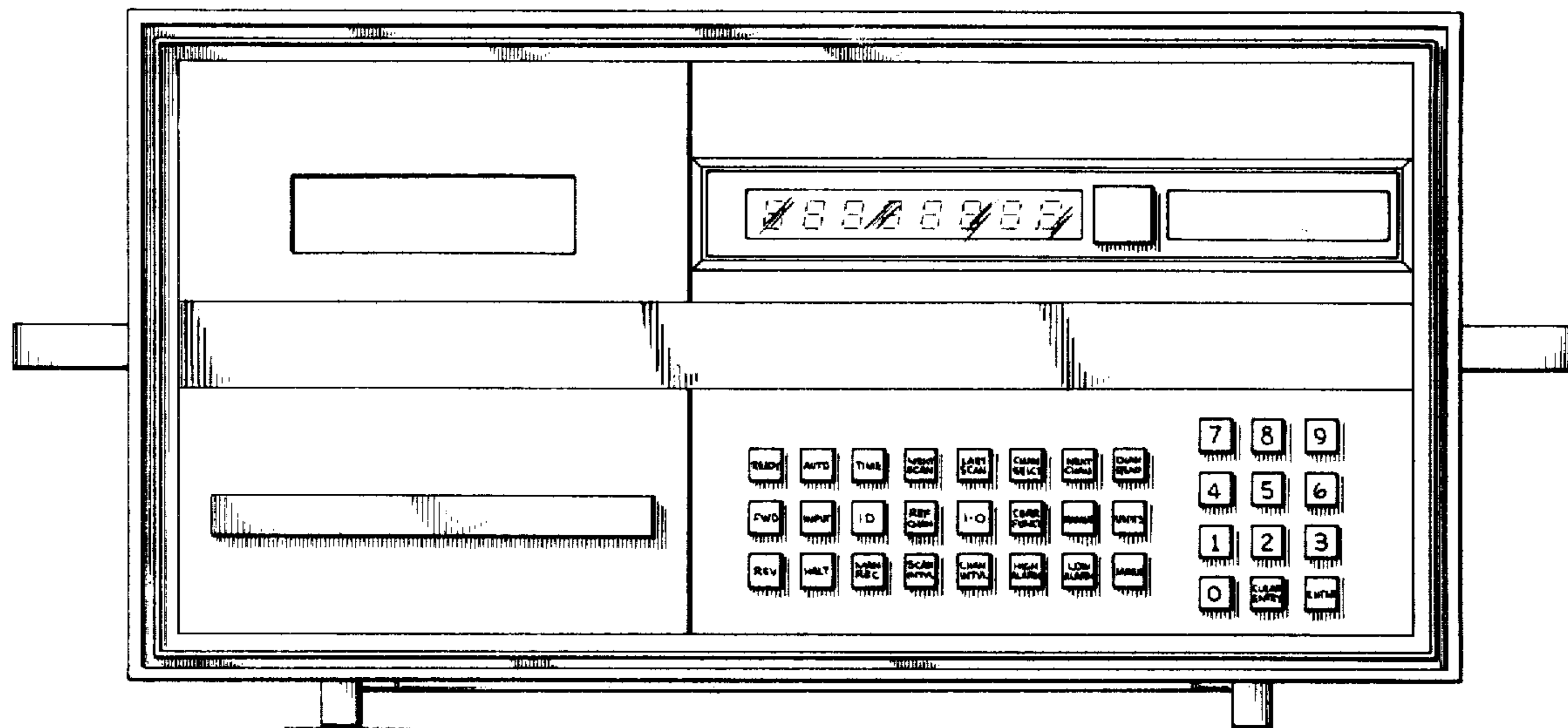

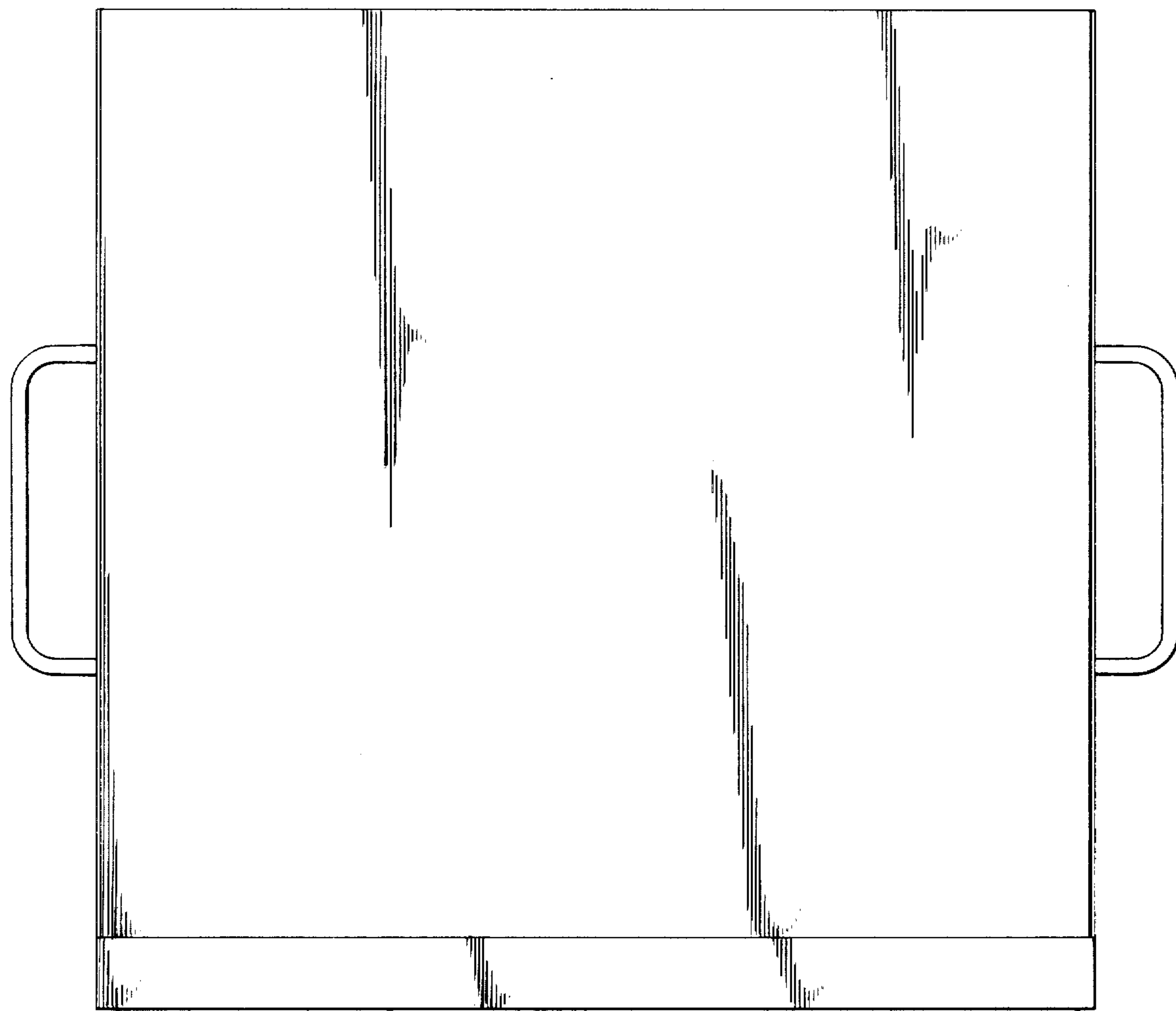

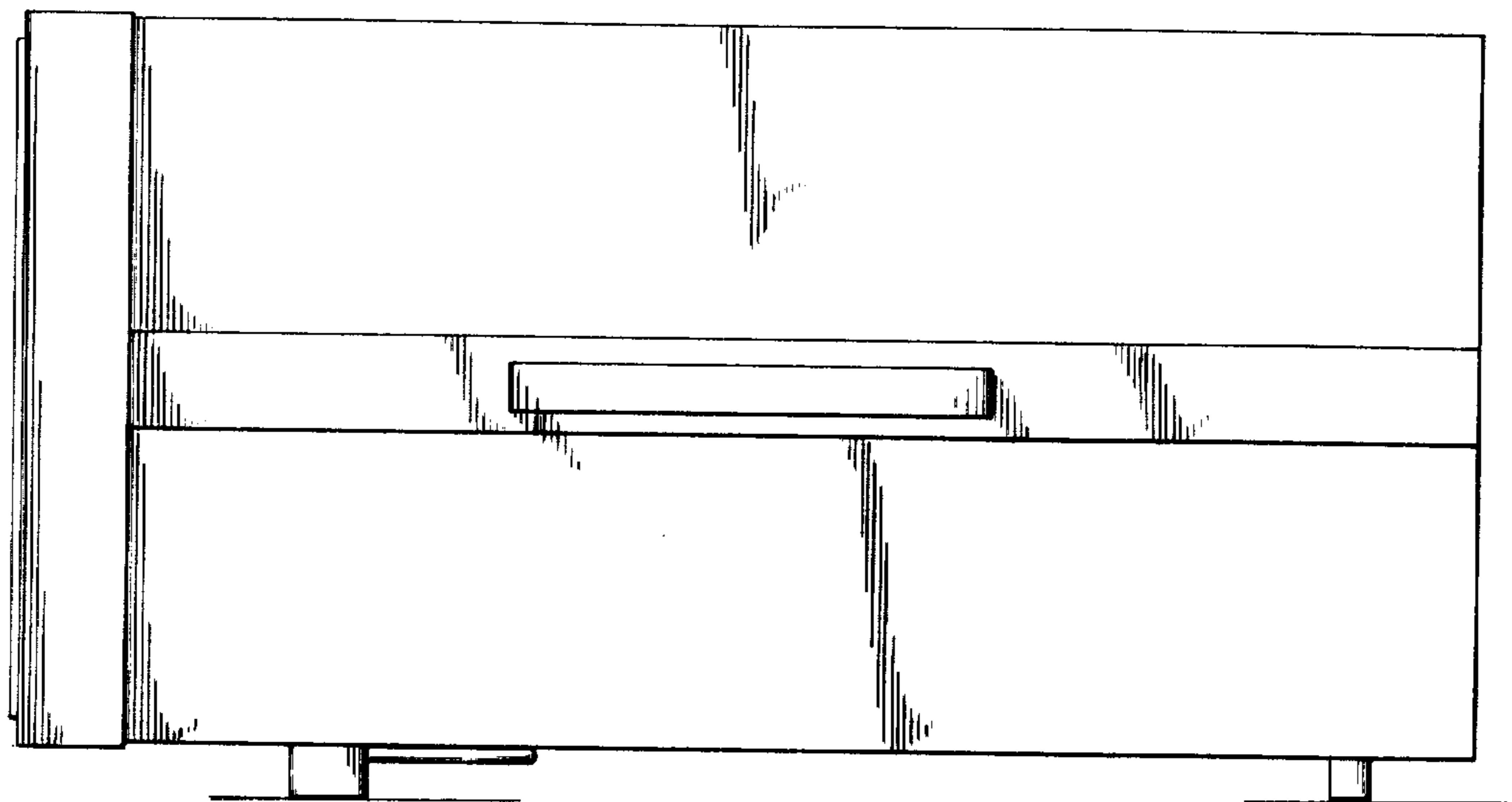

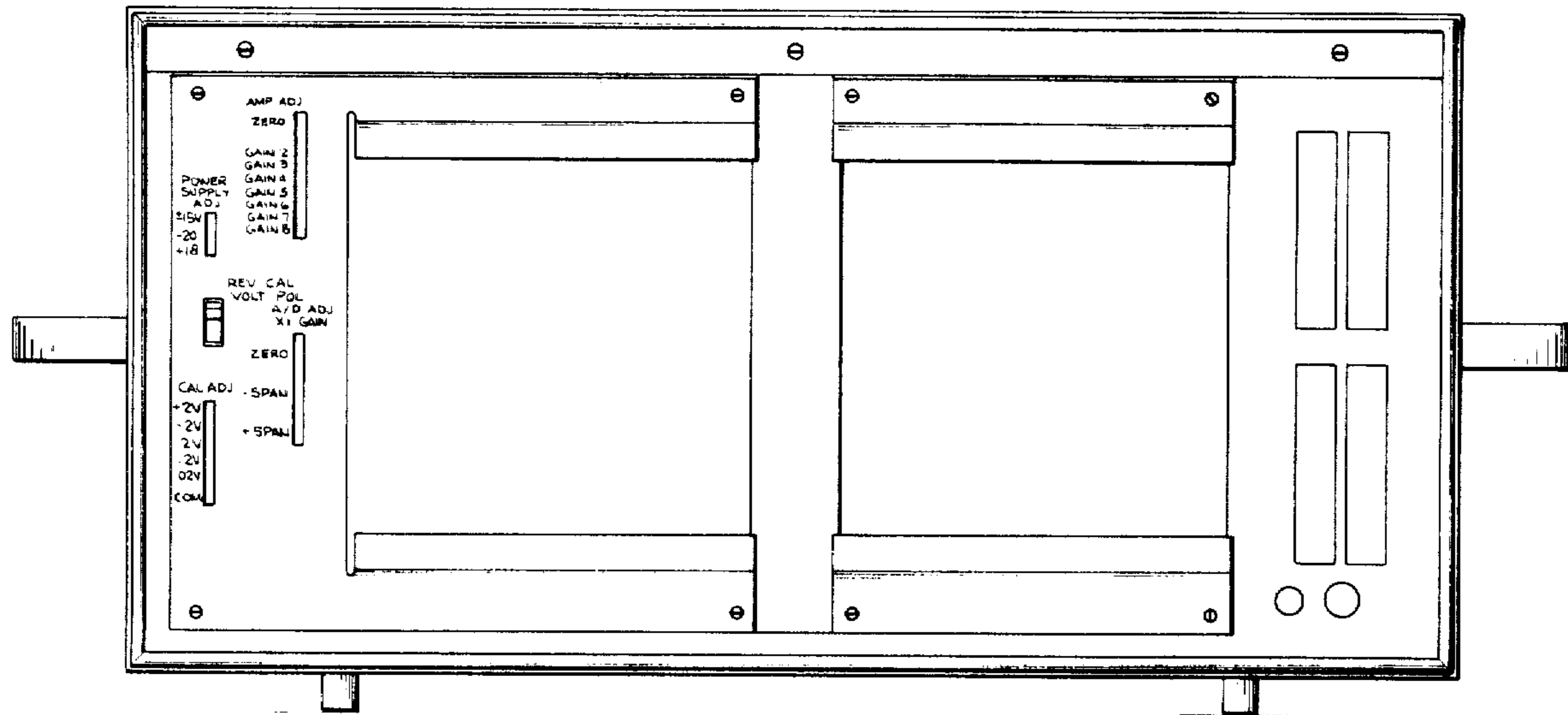

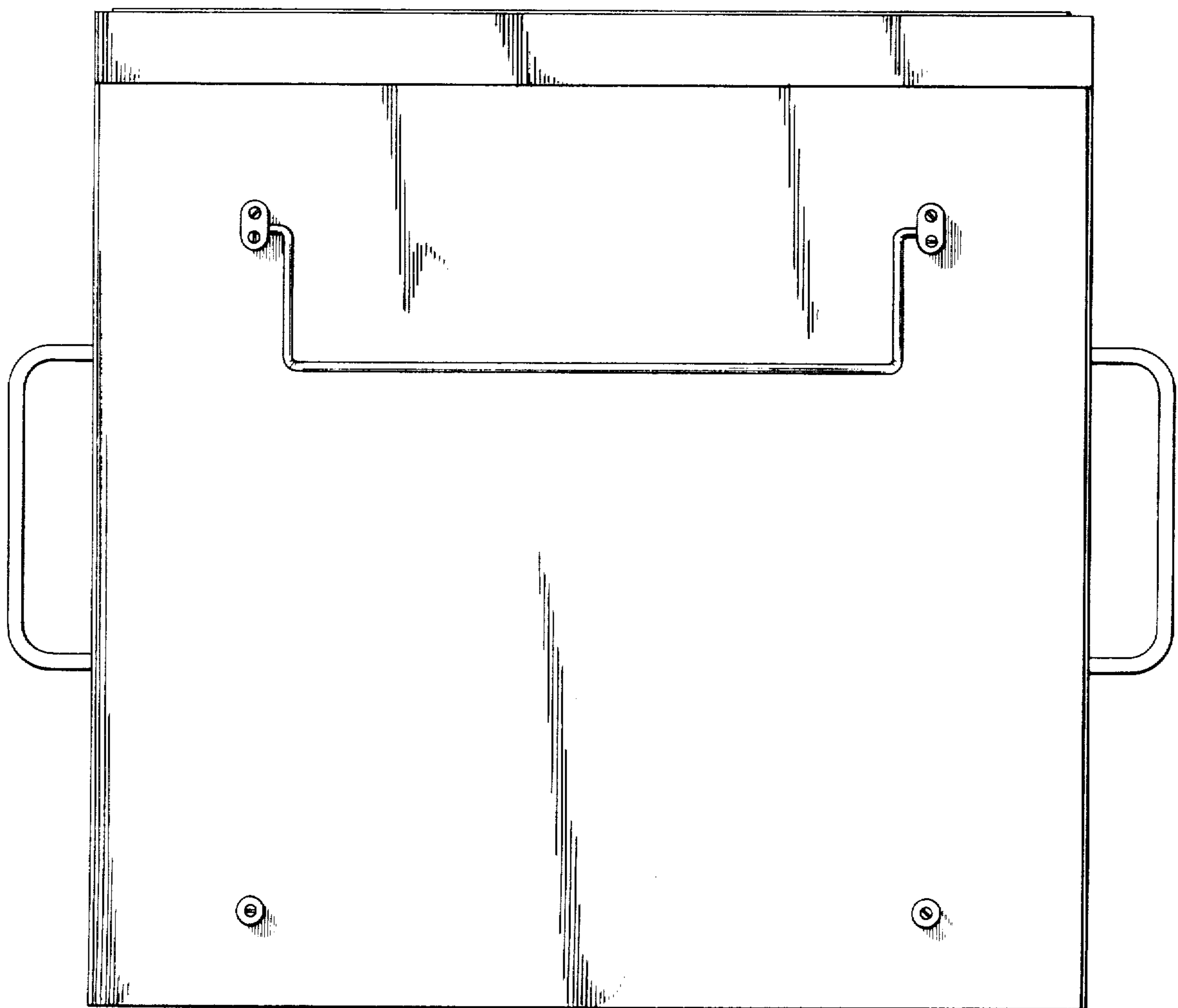
