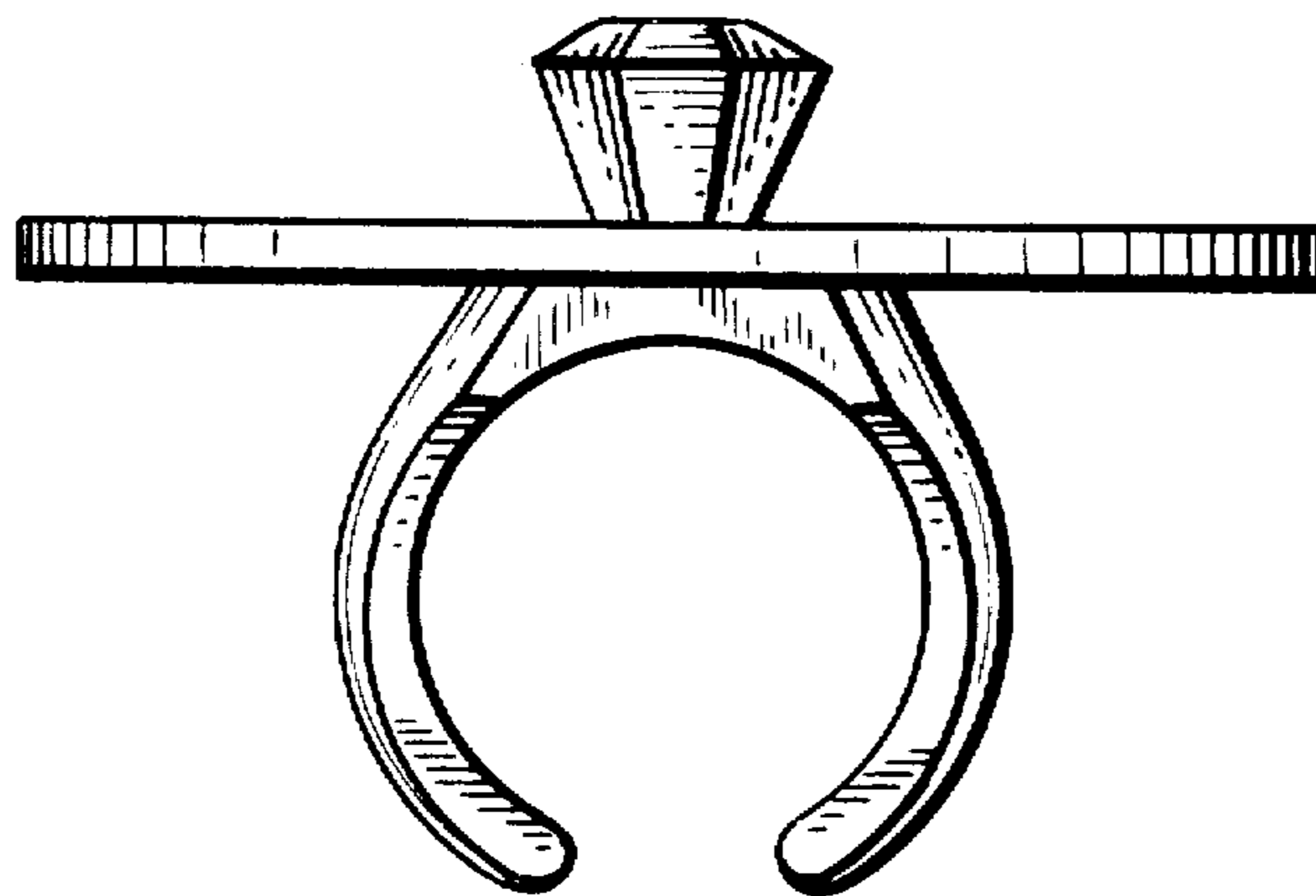

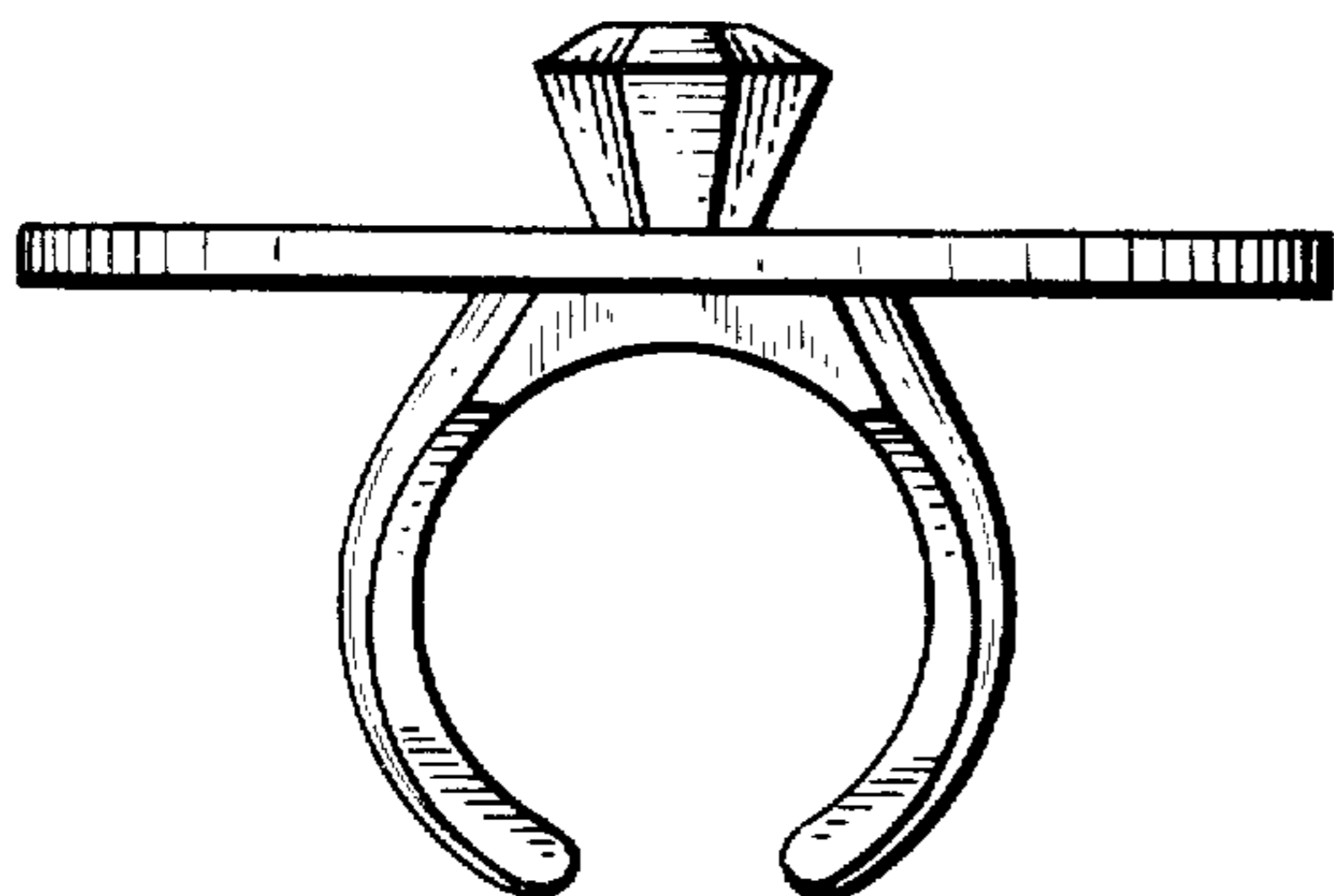
The ornamental design for a ring having a matrix for candy, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

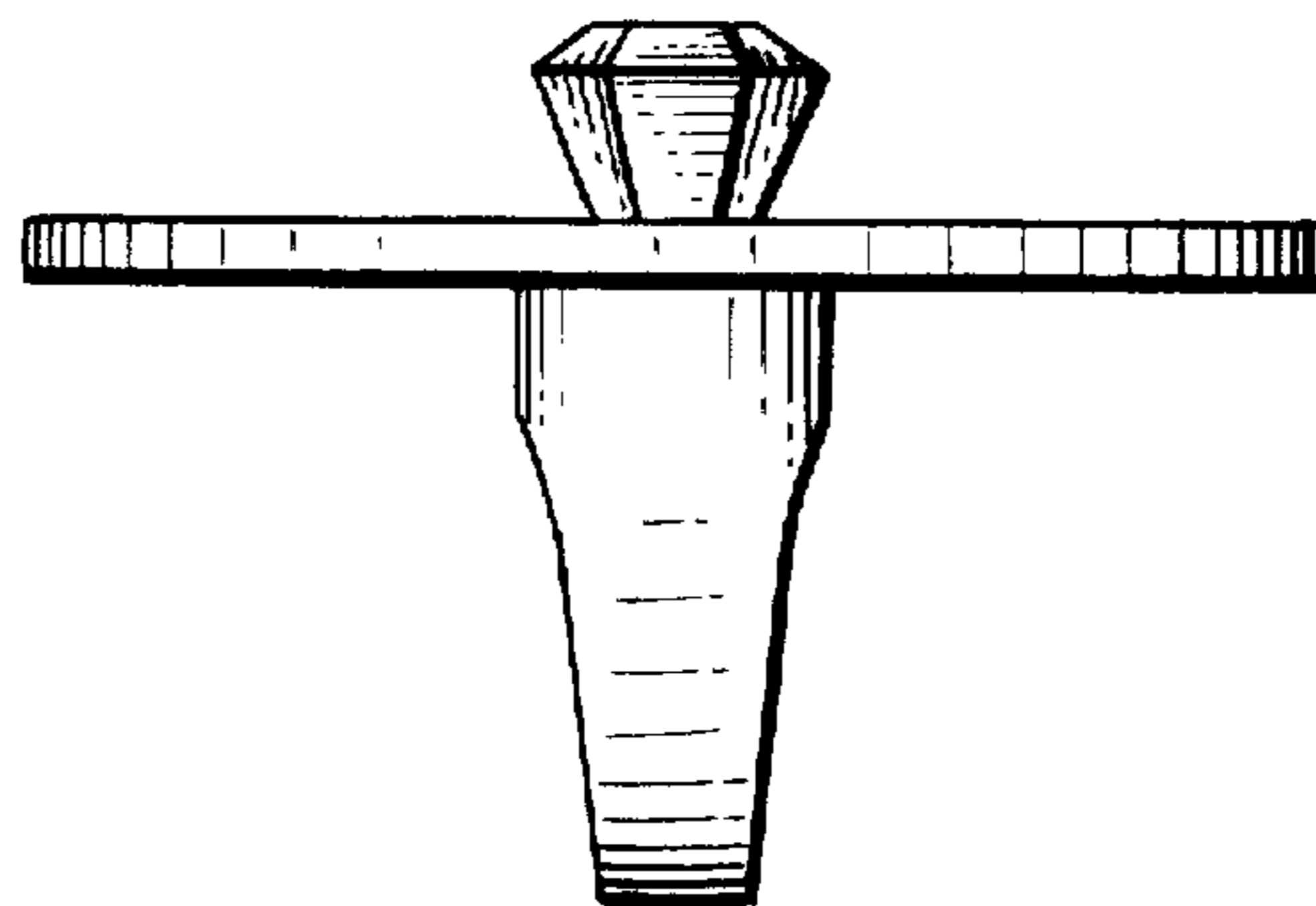

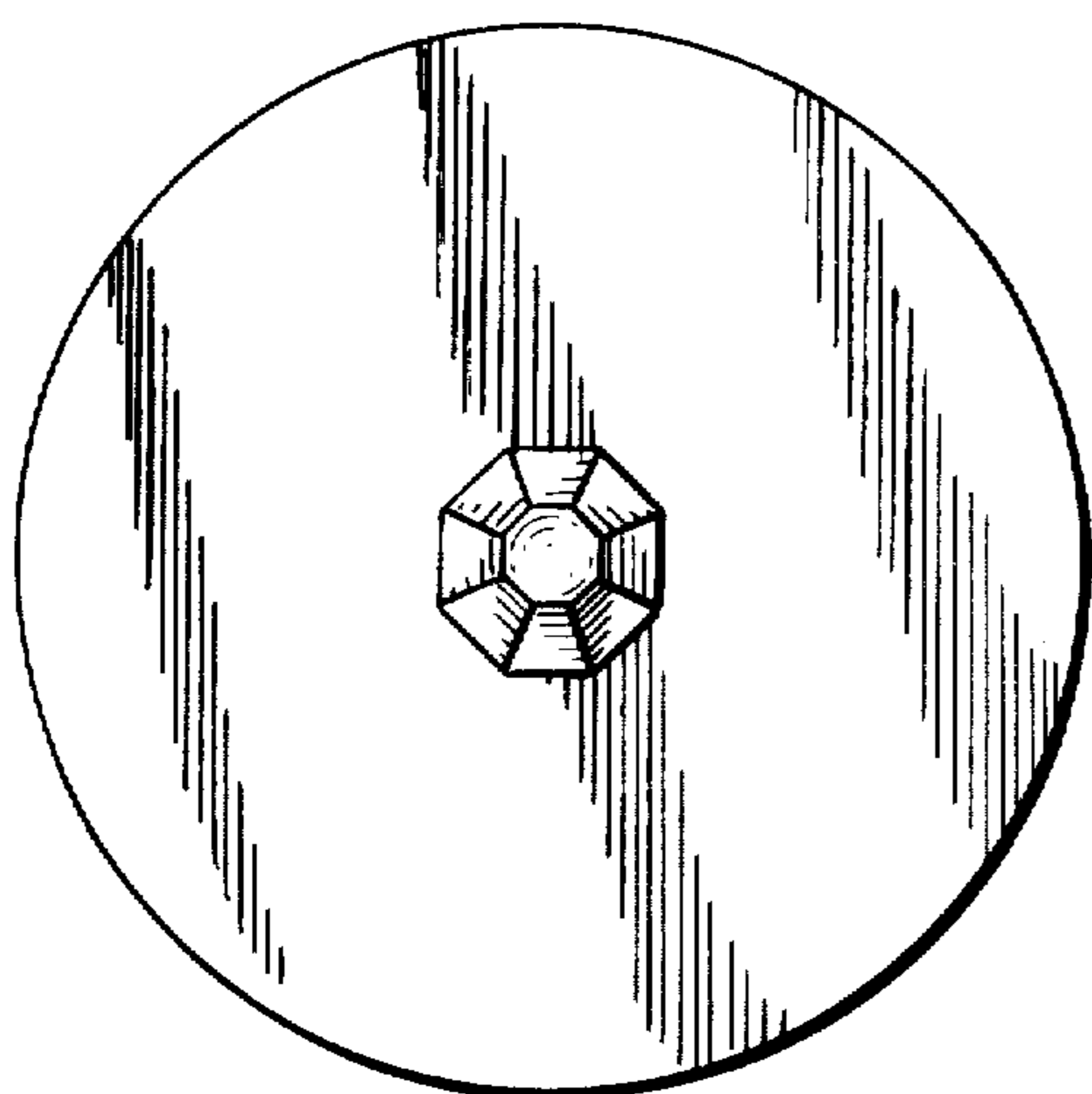
