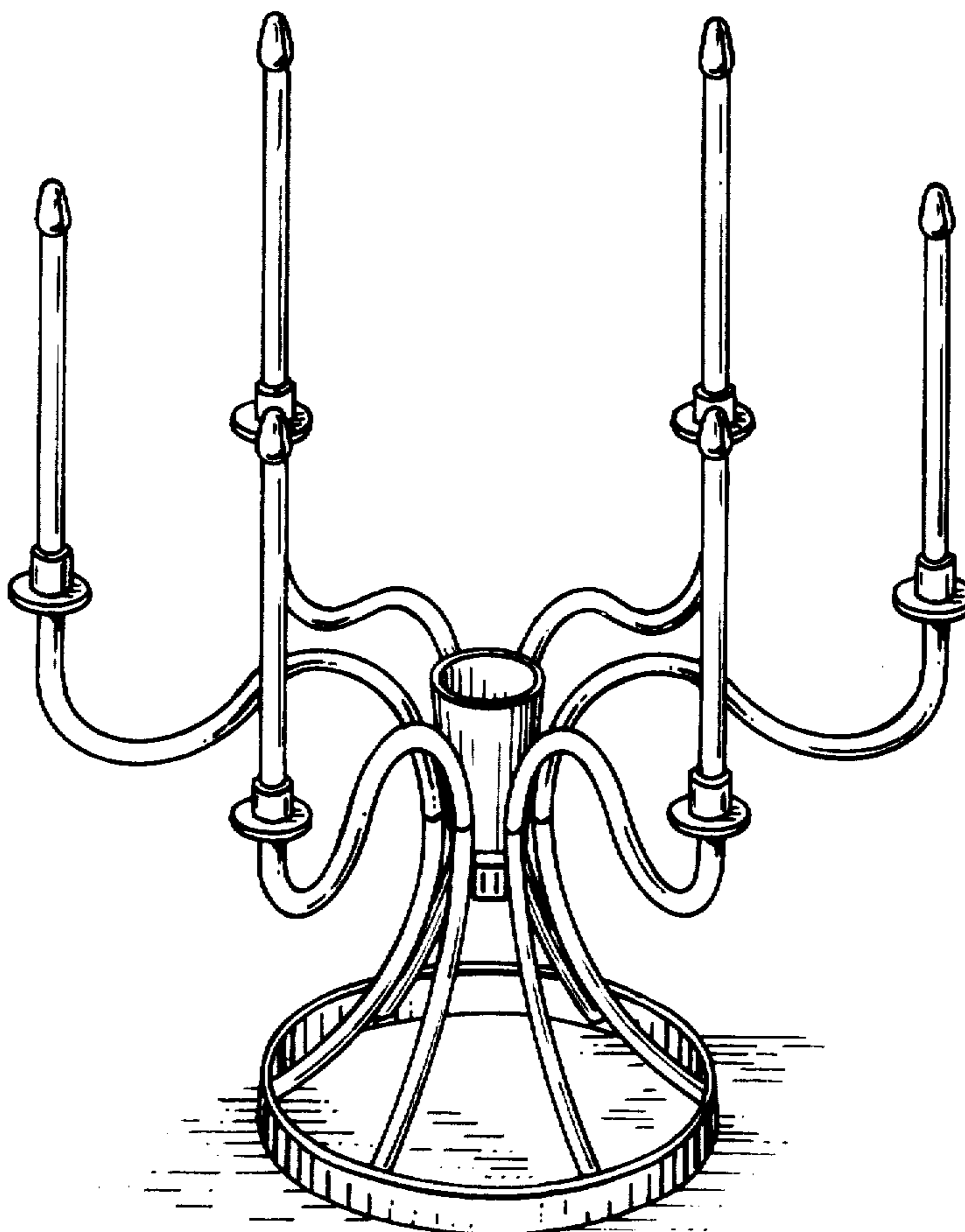

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an assembled combined candelabra tree stand showing my new design, and FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.



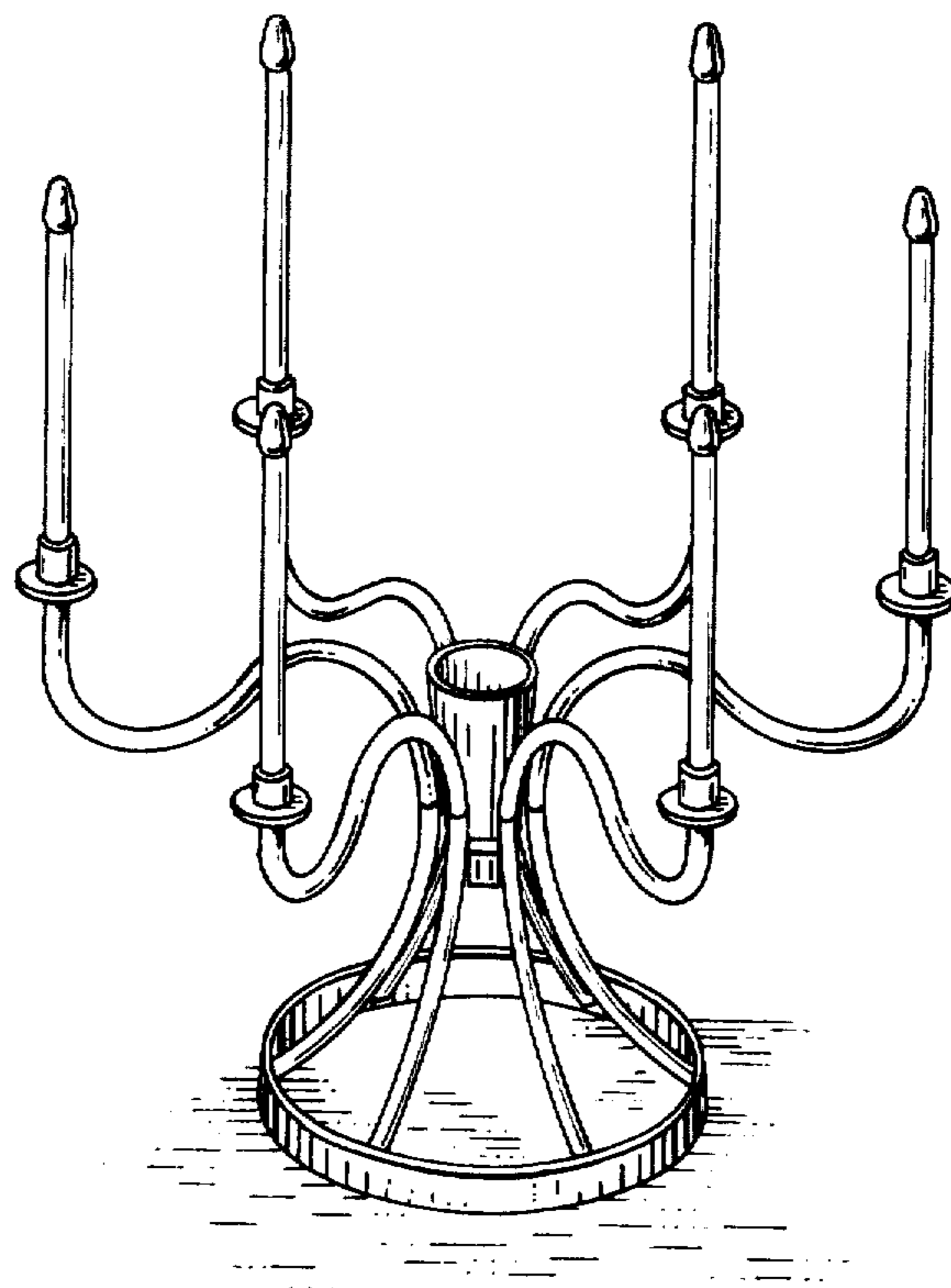

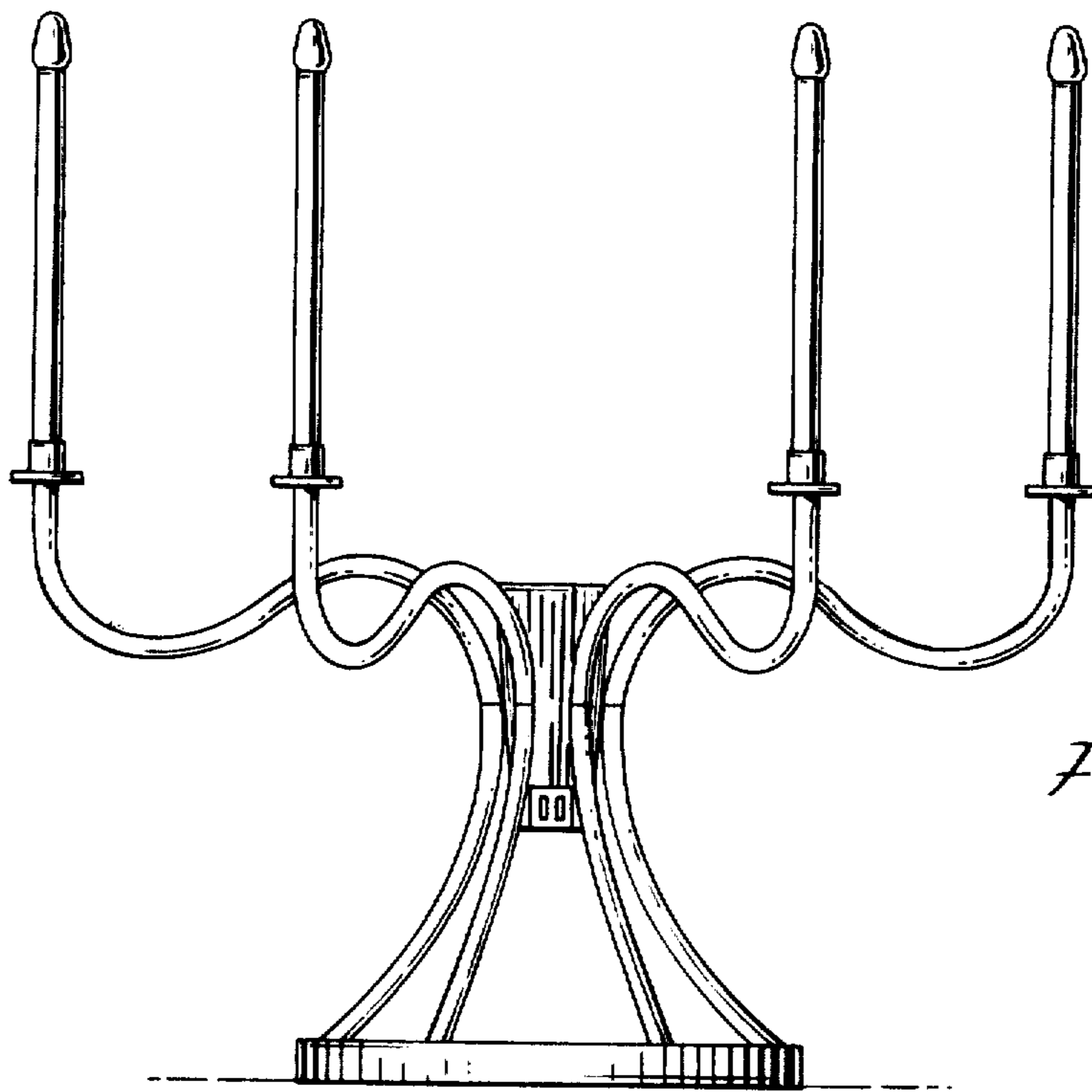
