[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for female urinary device or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of the female urinary device showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view similar to FIG. 2 with the spongy pad exploded away for clarity of illustration.

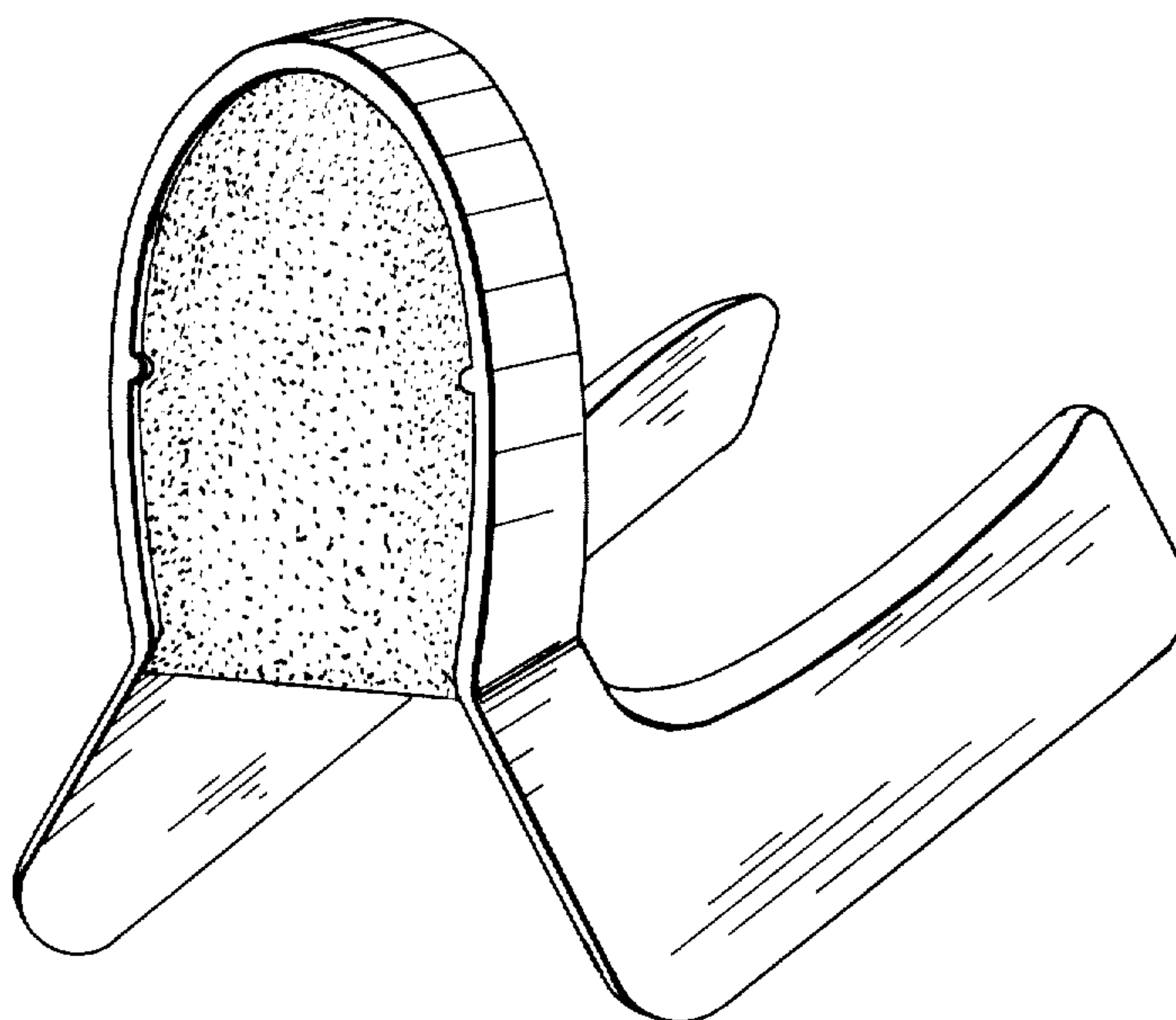

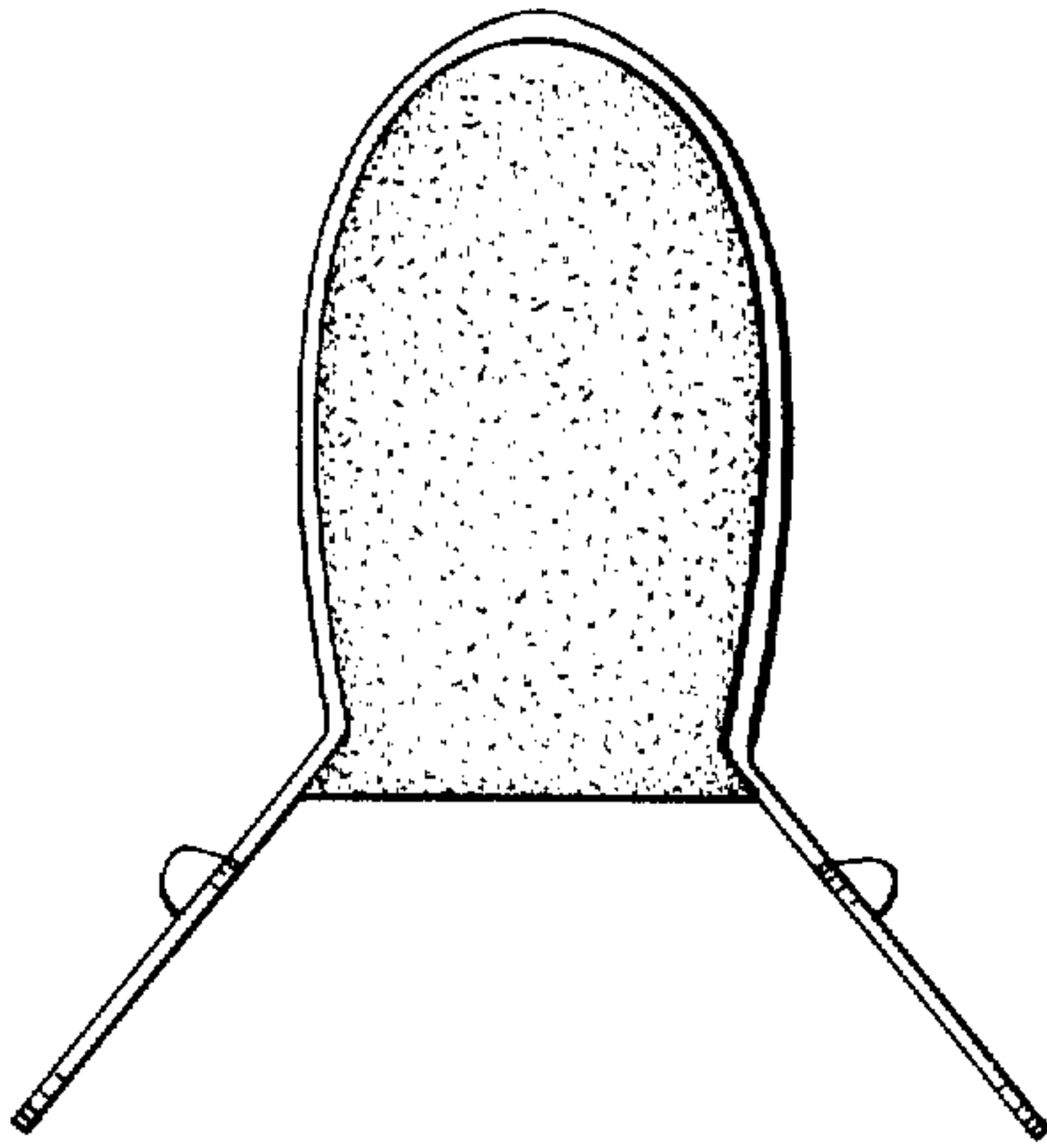

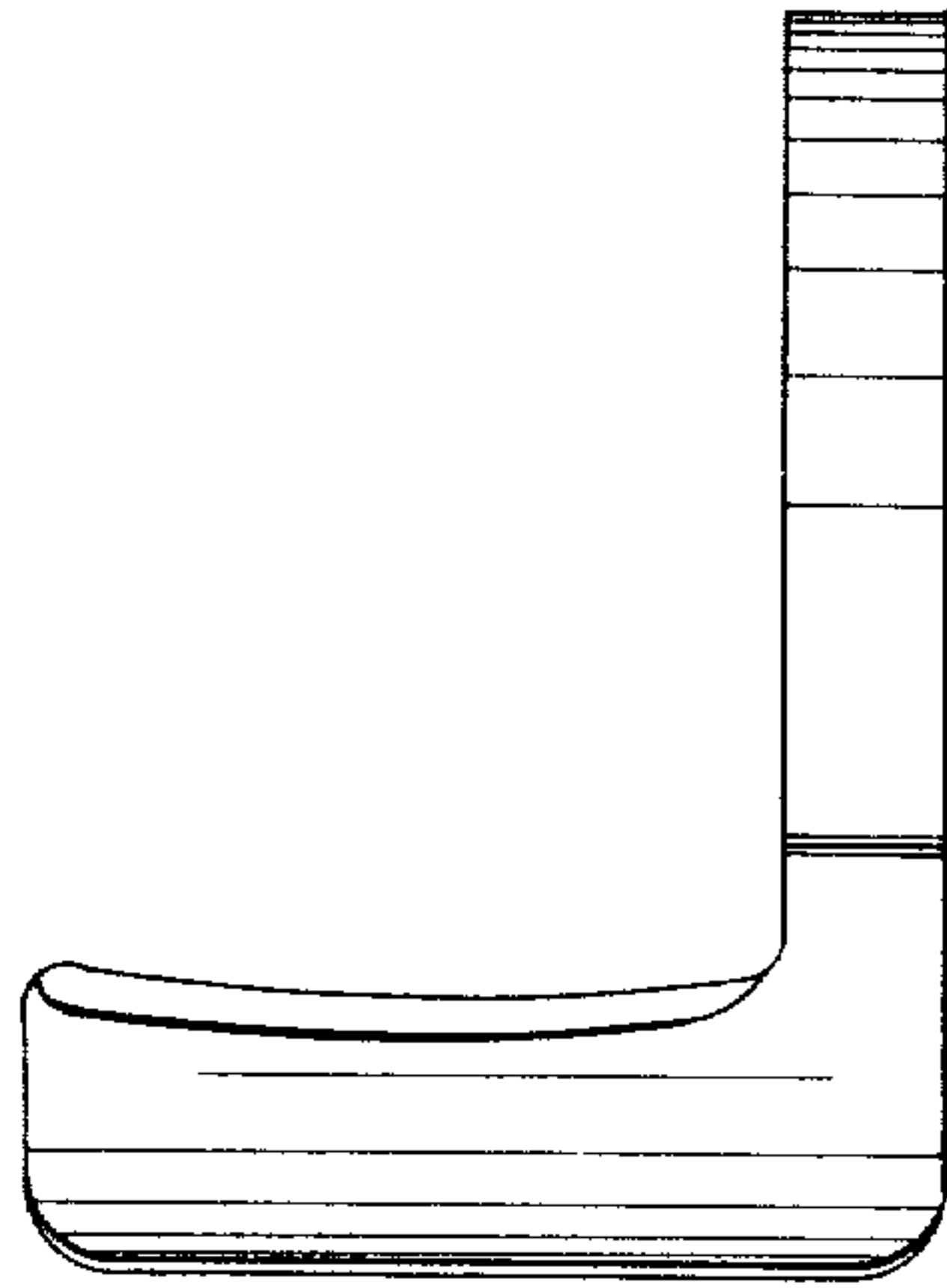

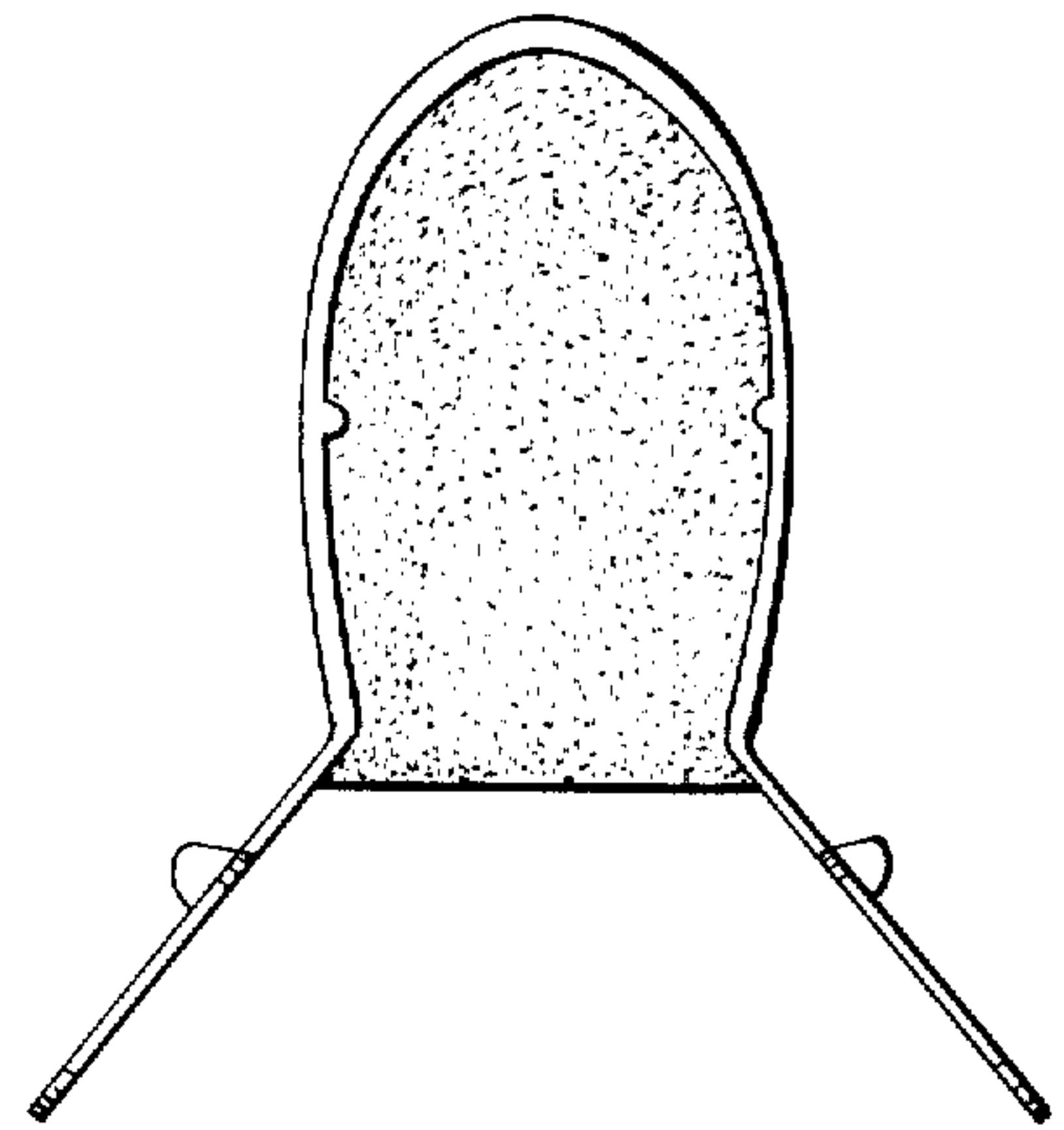

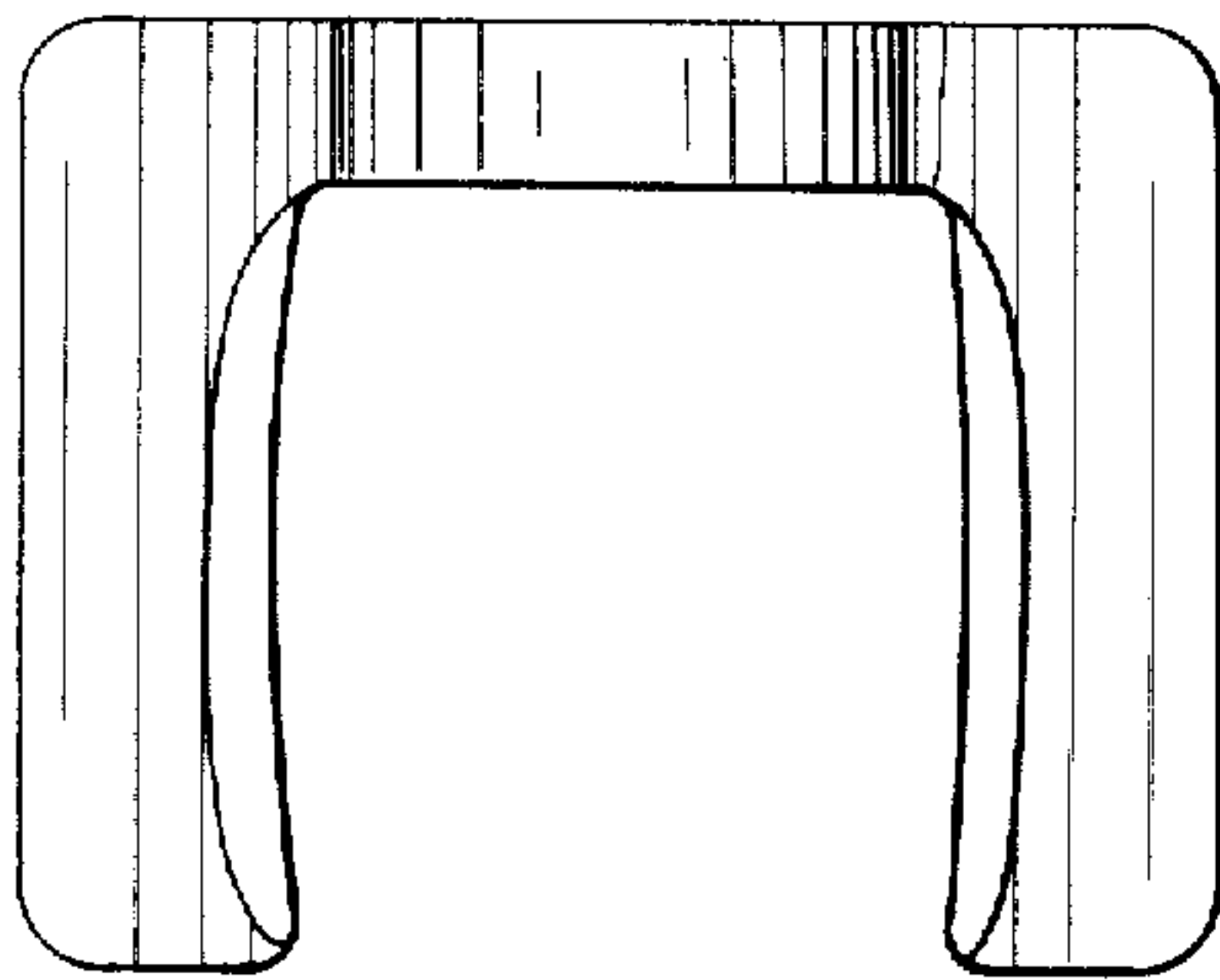

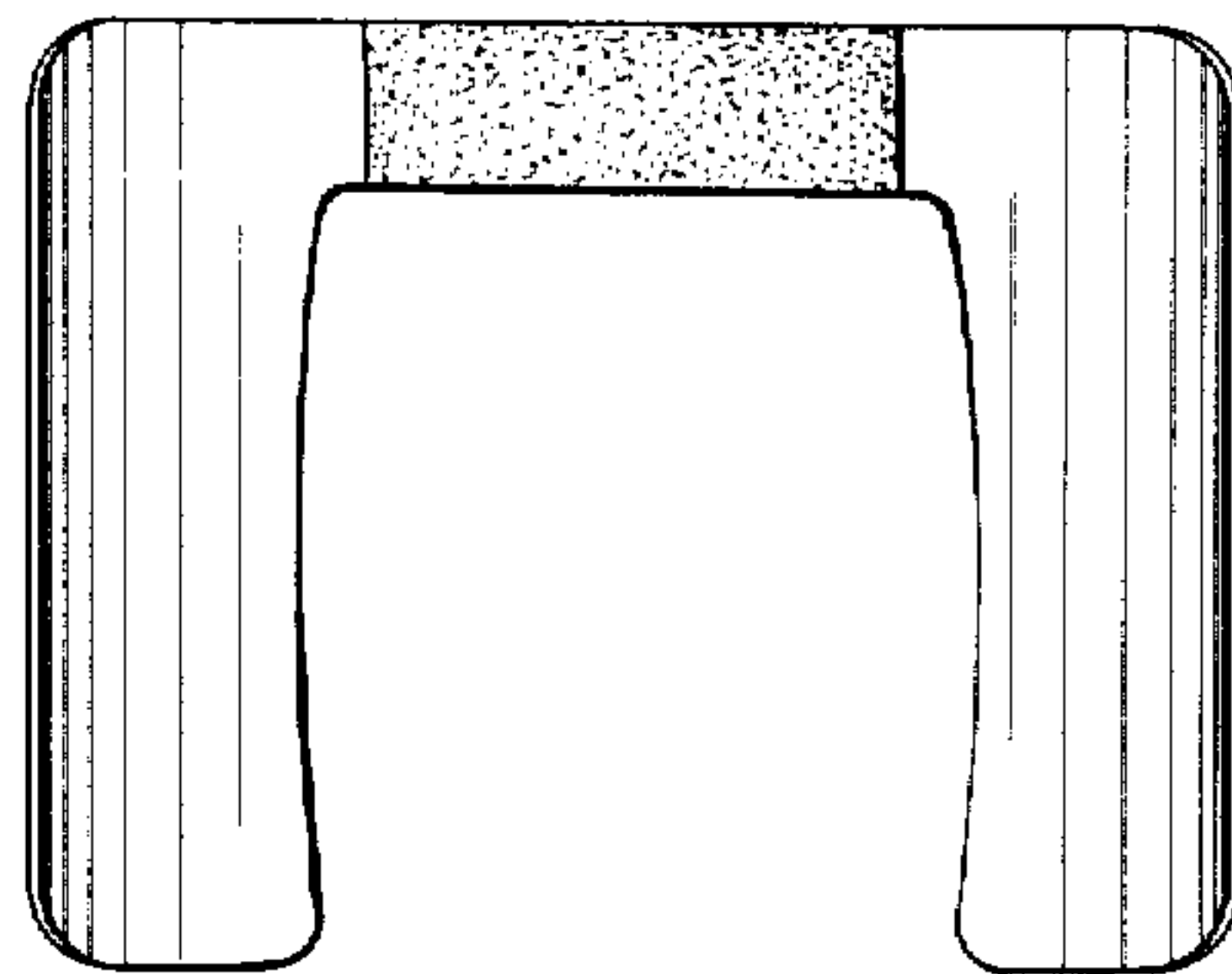

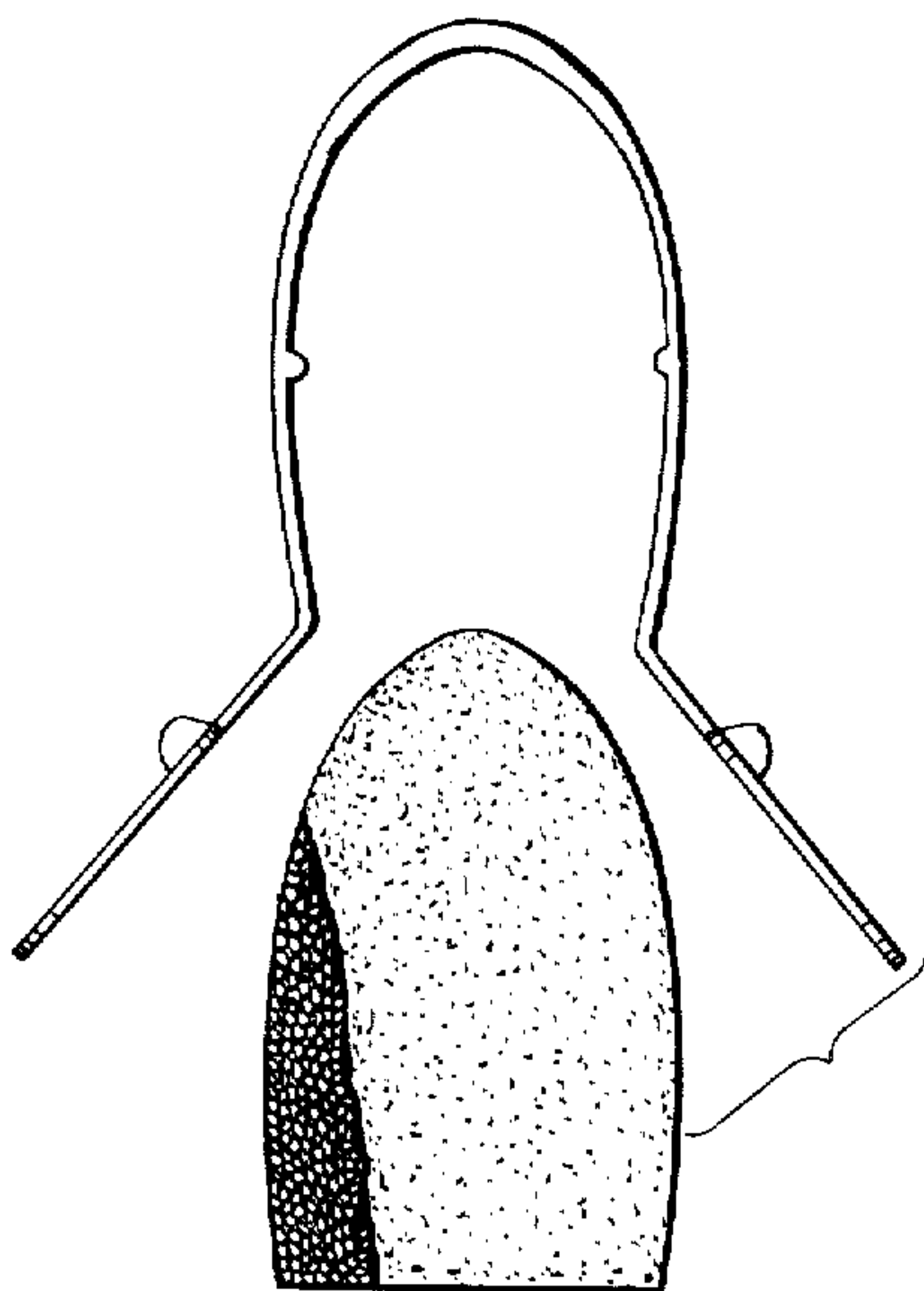
