[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a ventilated sports goggles, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-elevational view of a ventilated sports goggles embodying my new design;


FIG. 2 is a bottom-plan view of the goggles of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear-elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top-plan view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a side view of the goggles.




