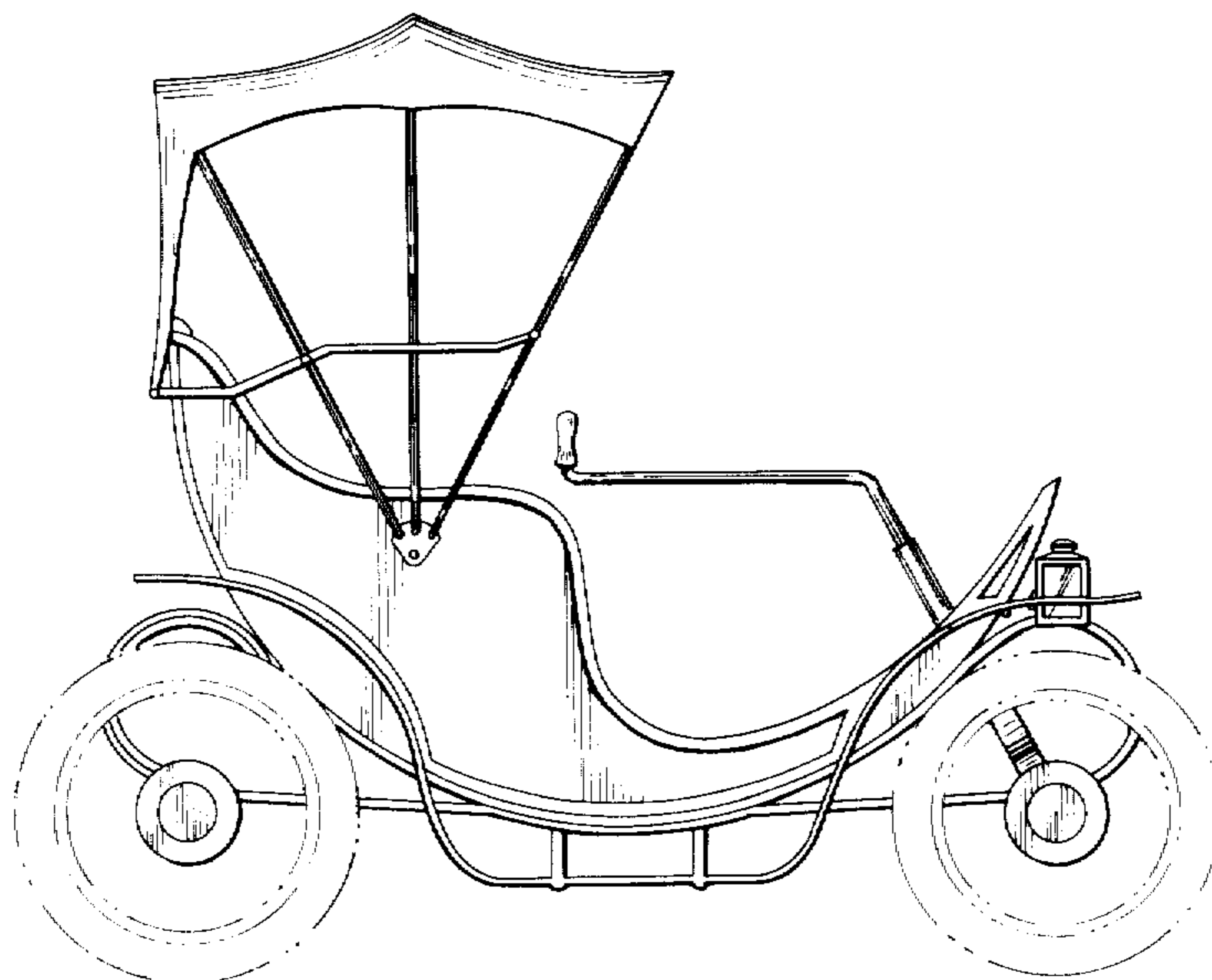
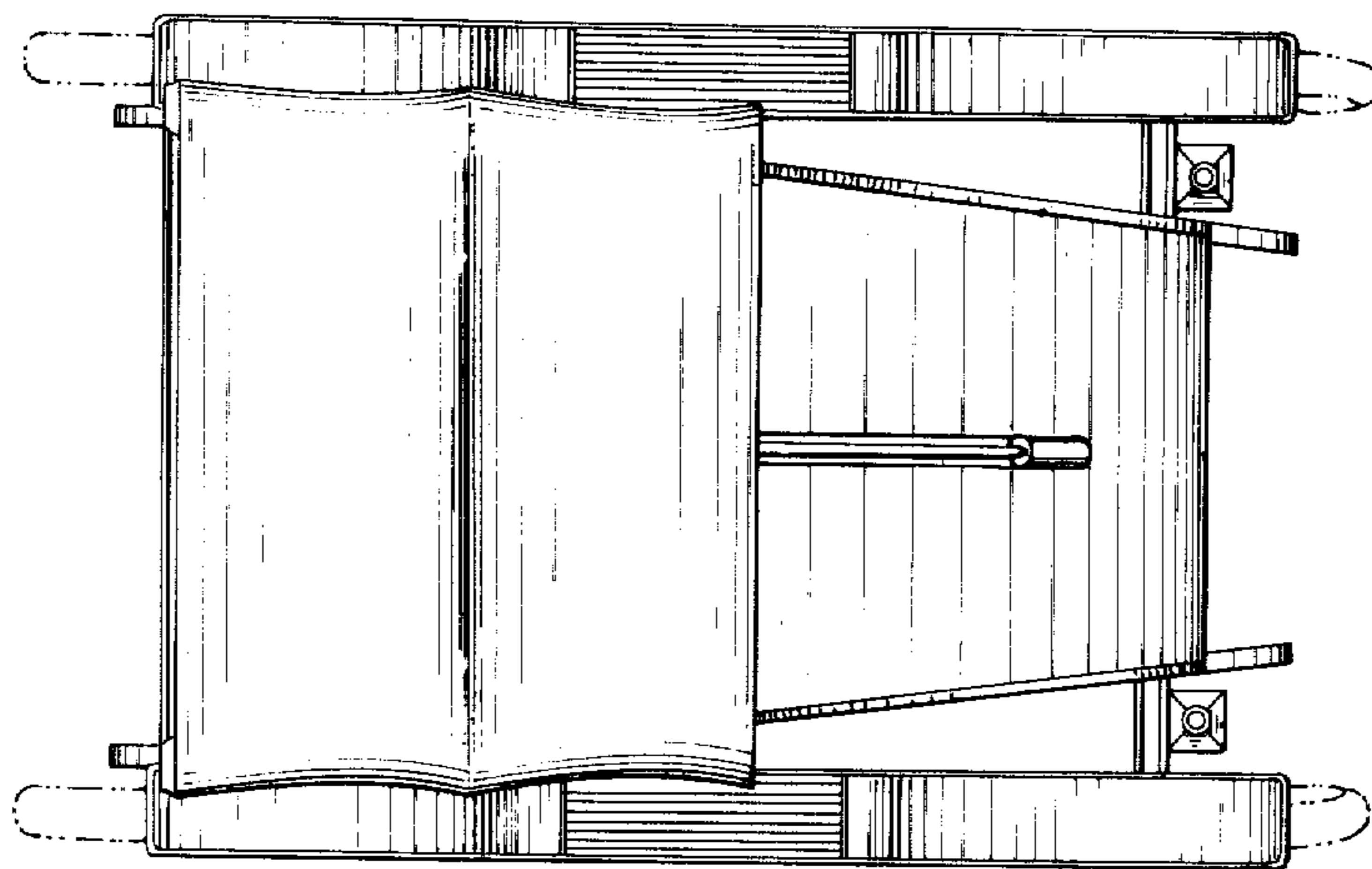

 FIG. 4, is a front elevational view thereof.



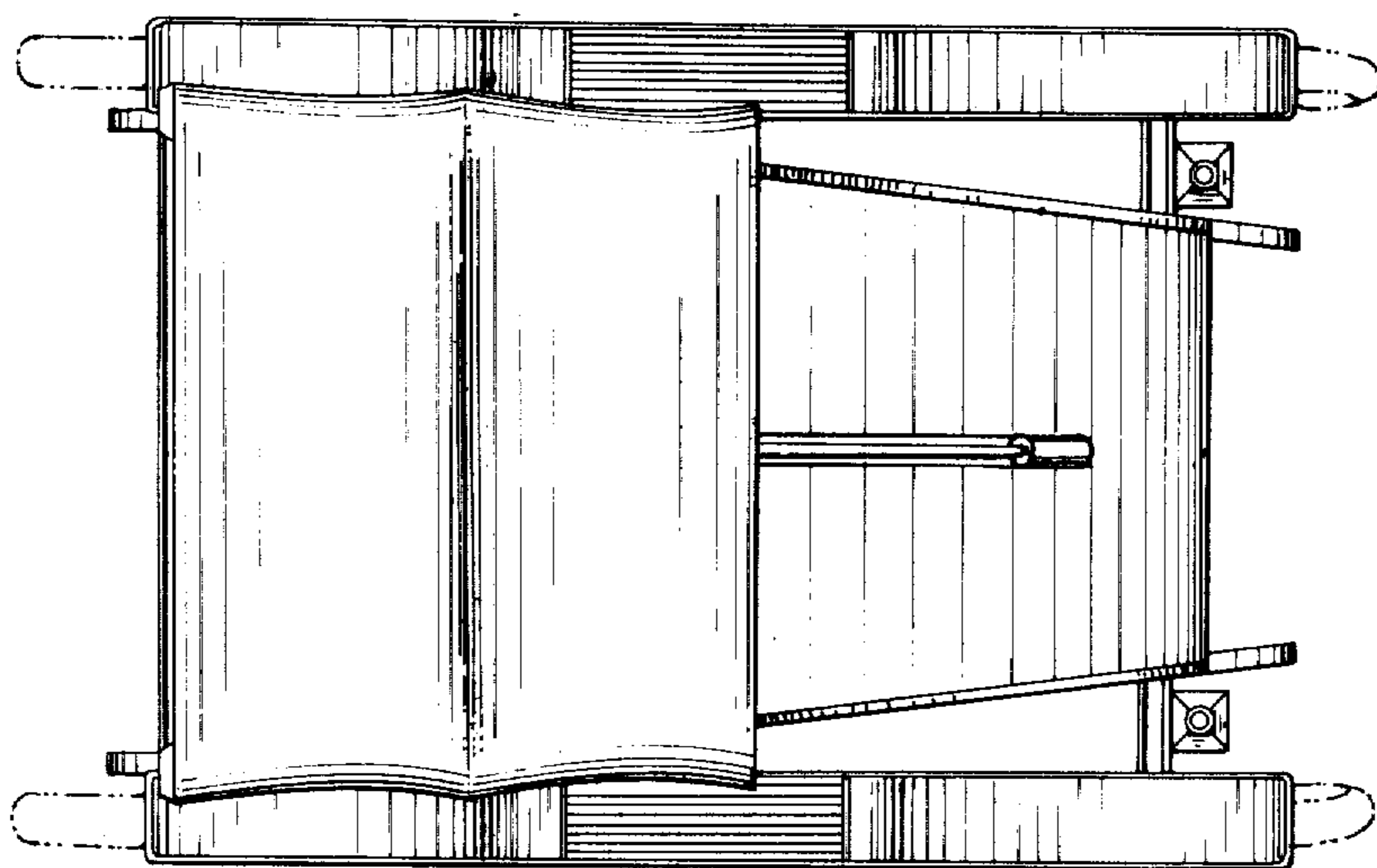

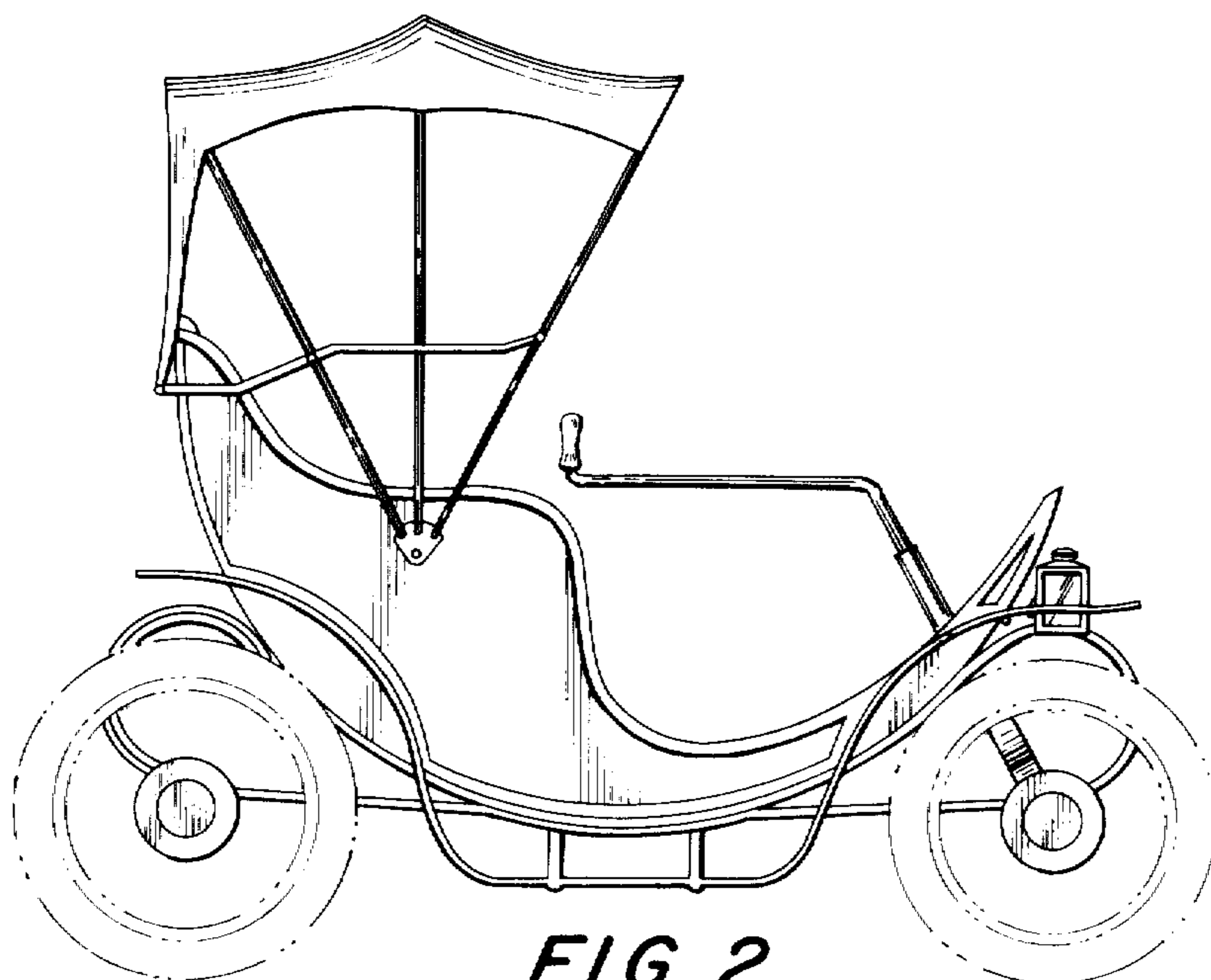
