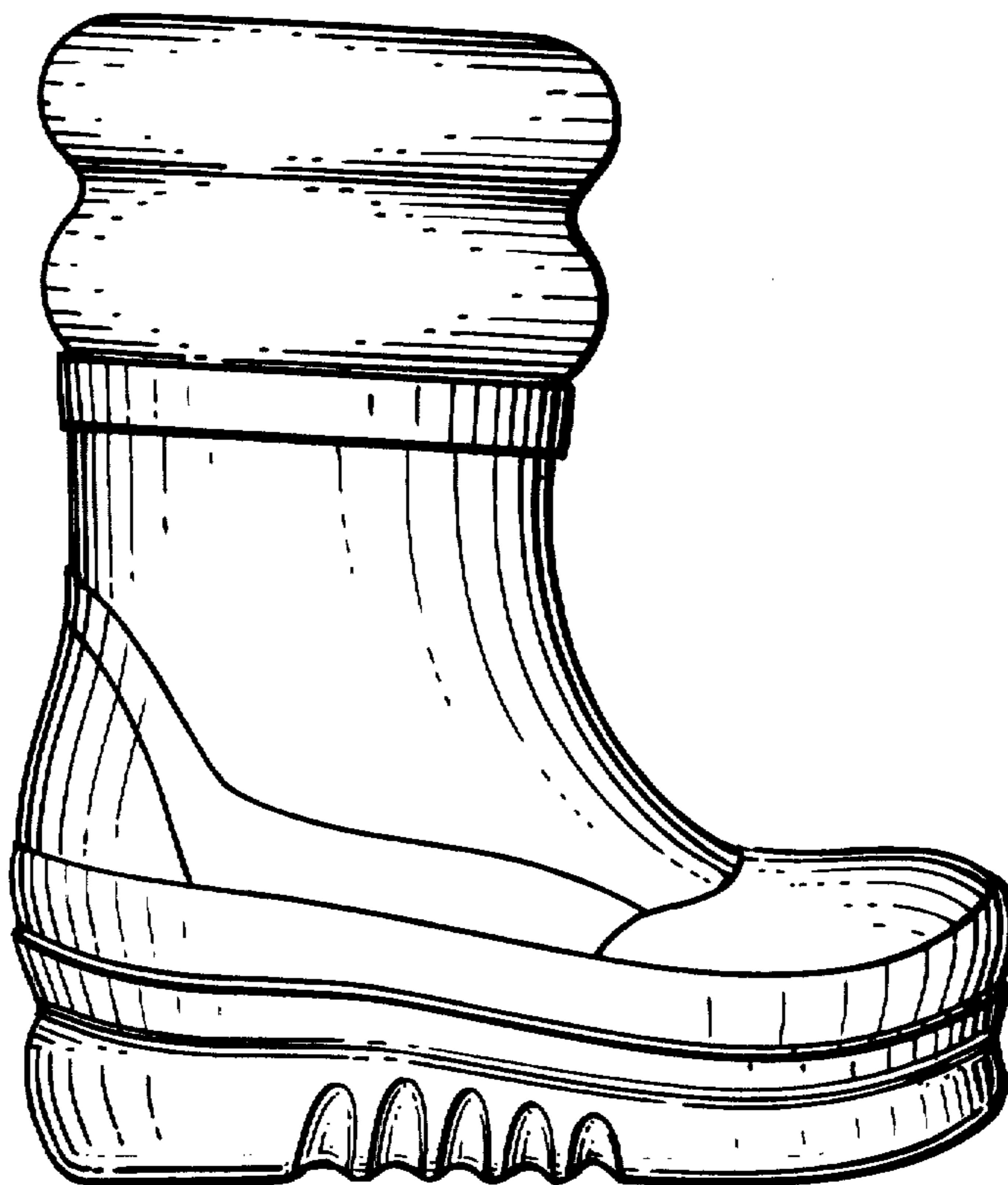

**DESCRIPTION**

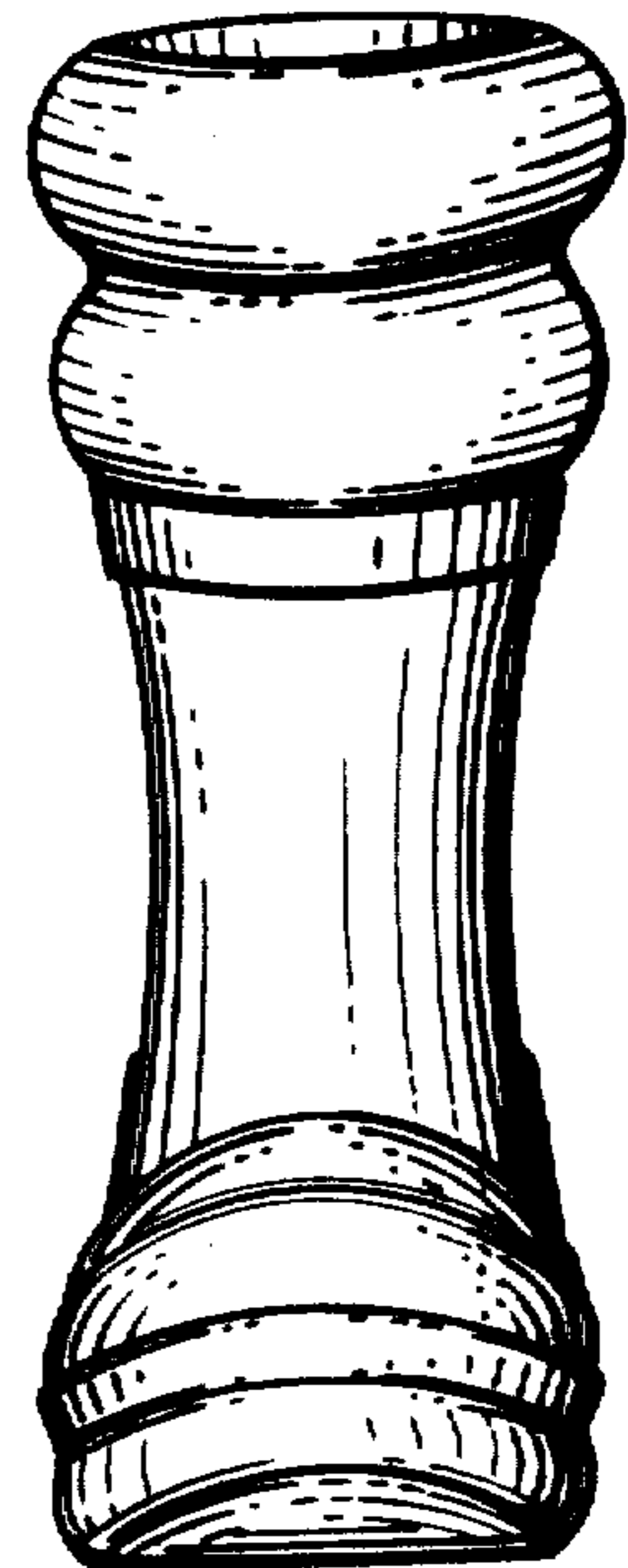
FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a boot showing my new design,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



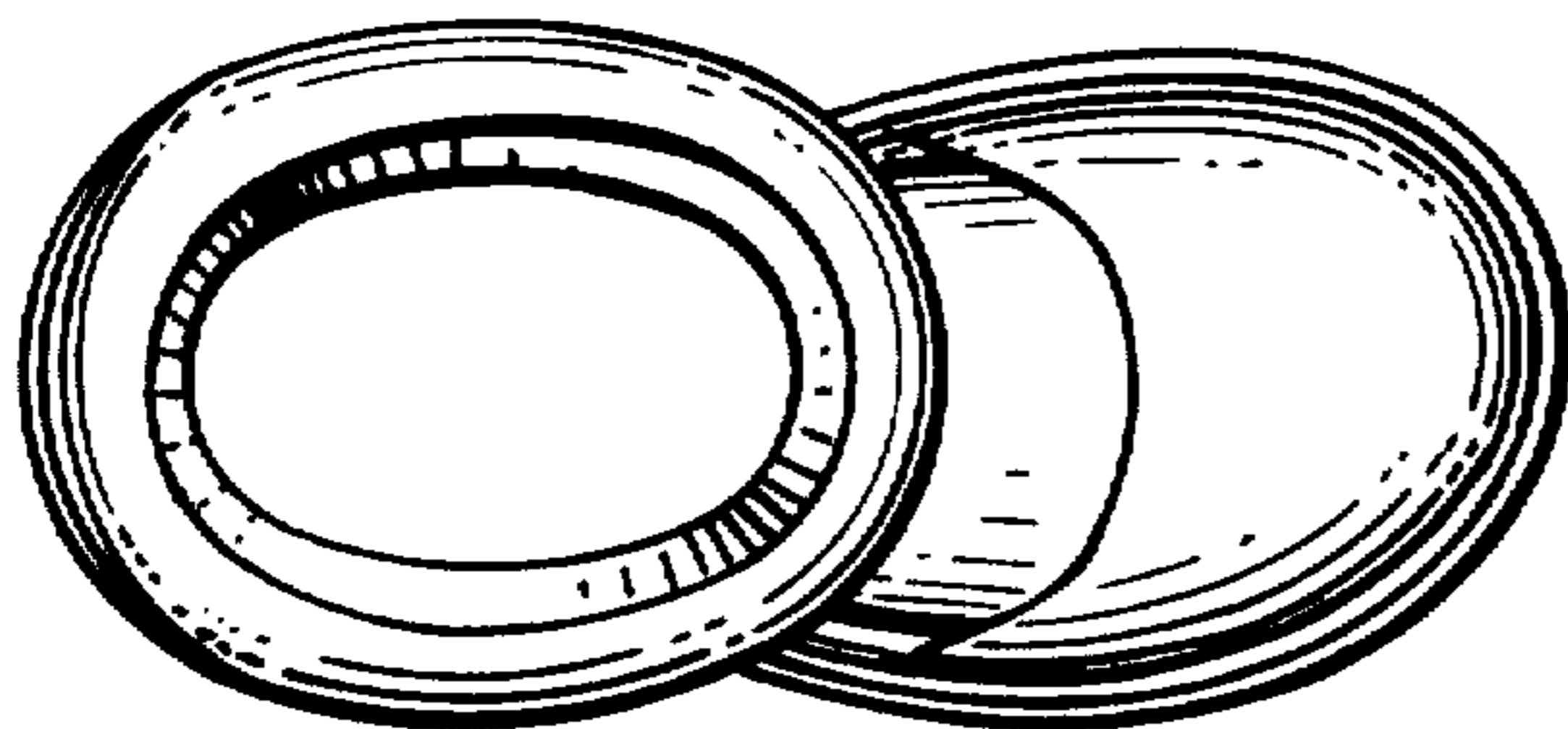

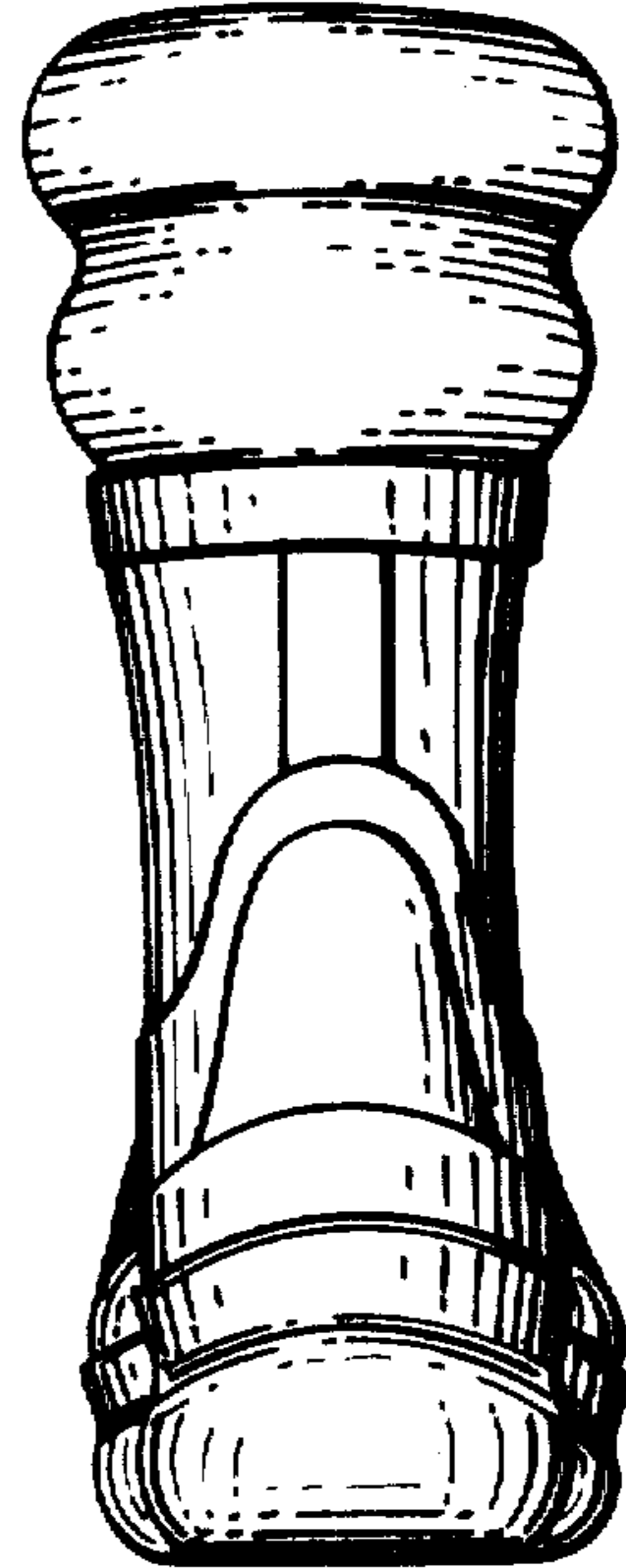
