FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the educational aide for teaching physical properties of light showing my new design;

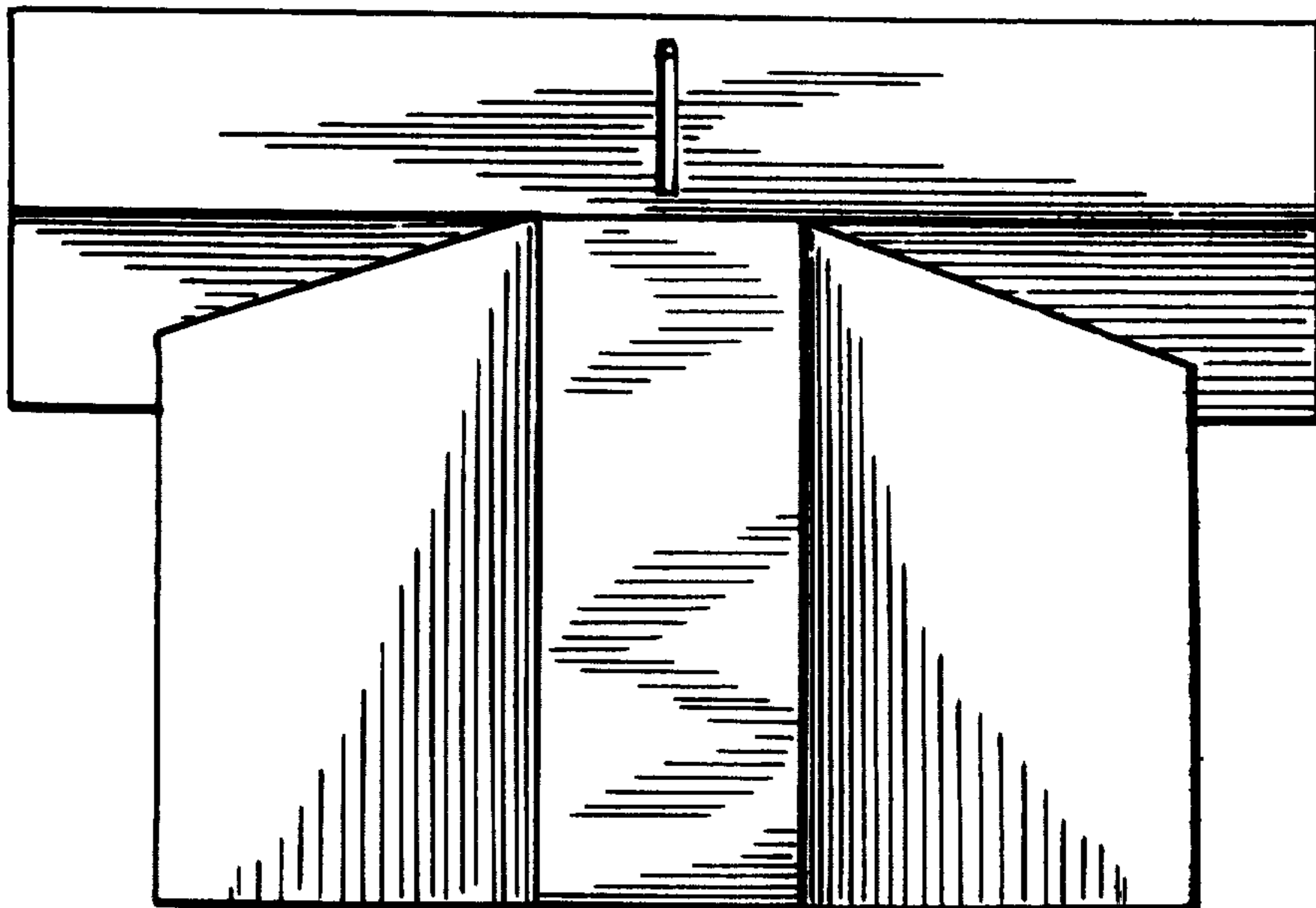
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



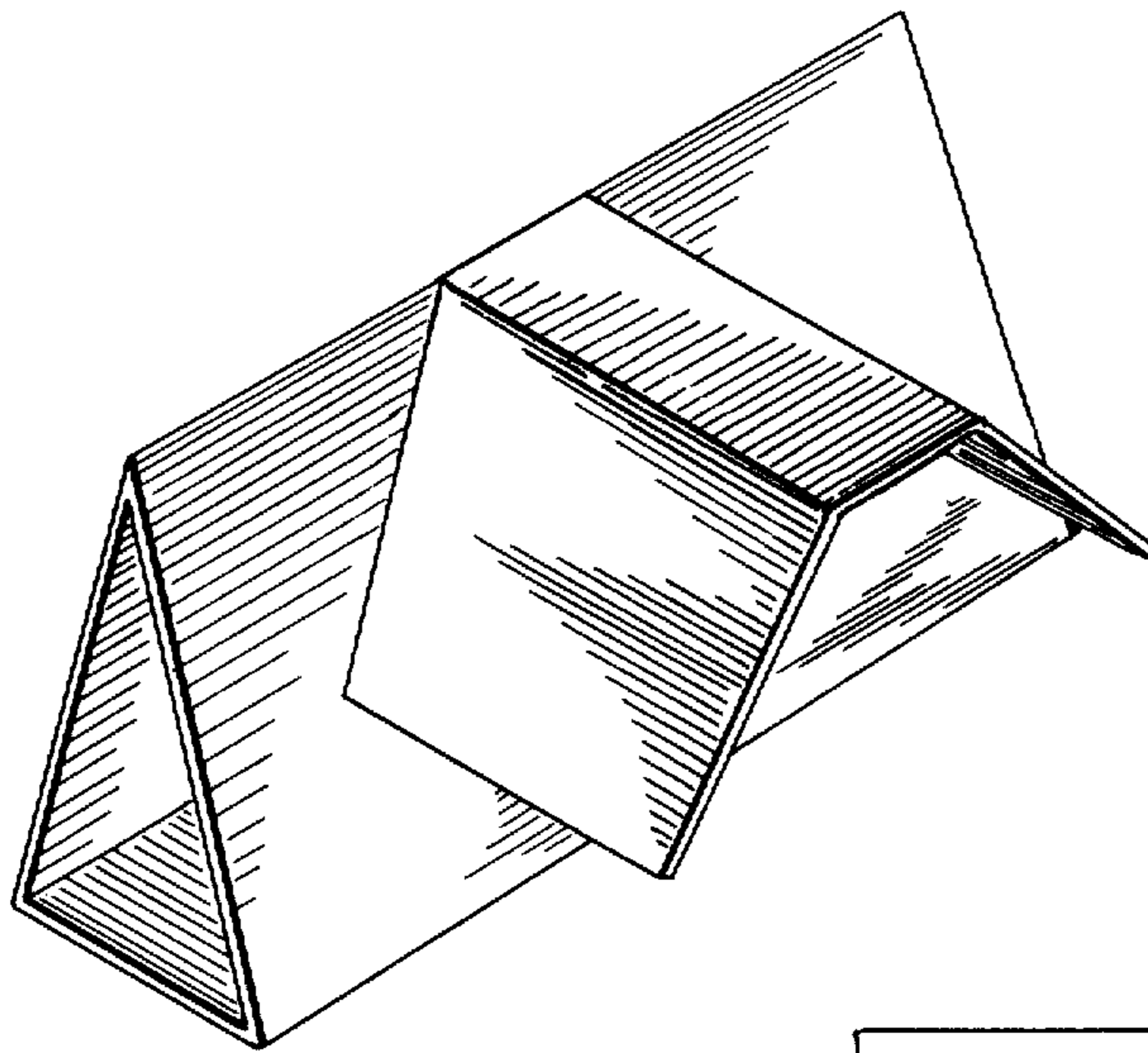

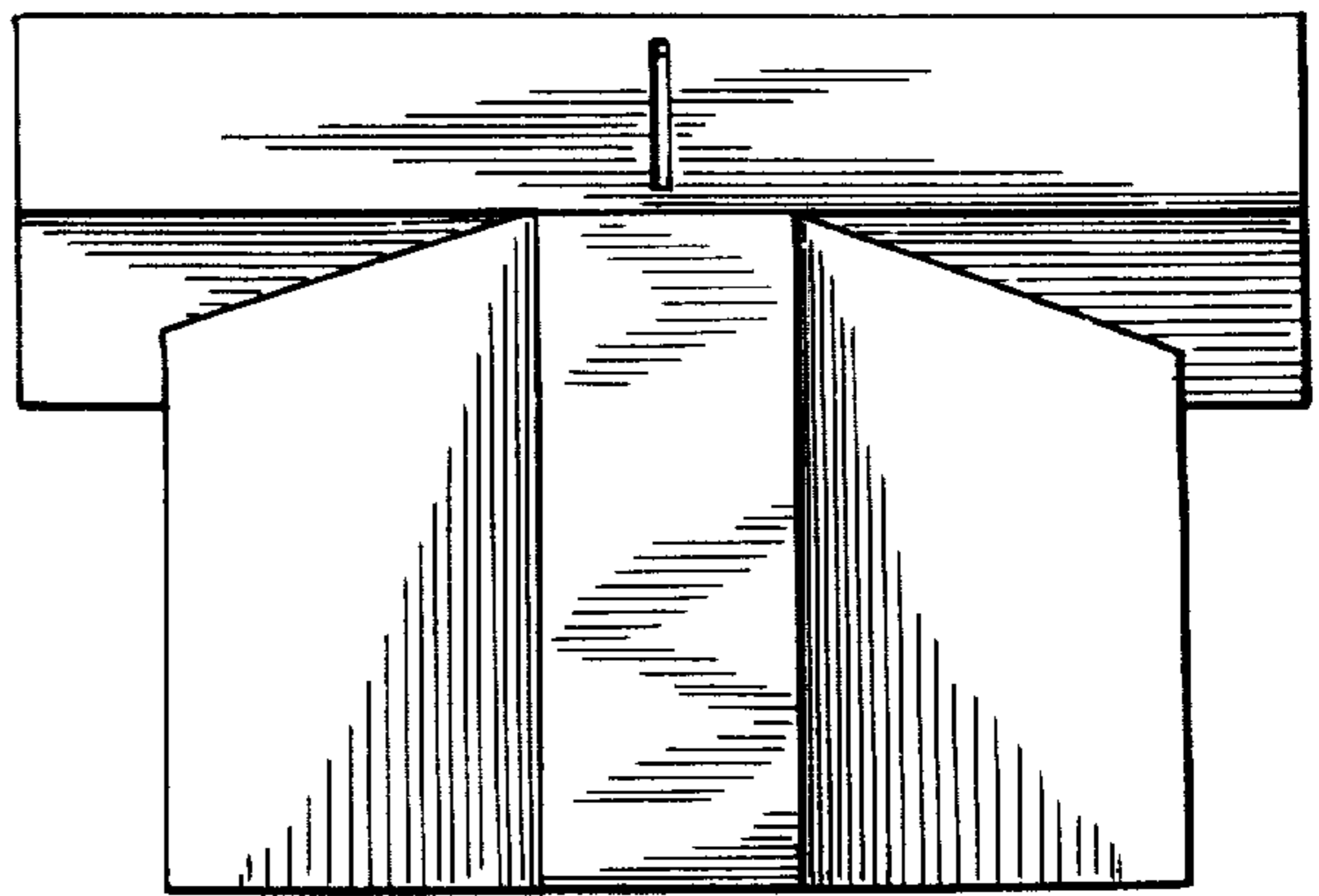

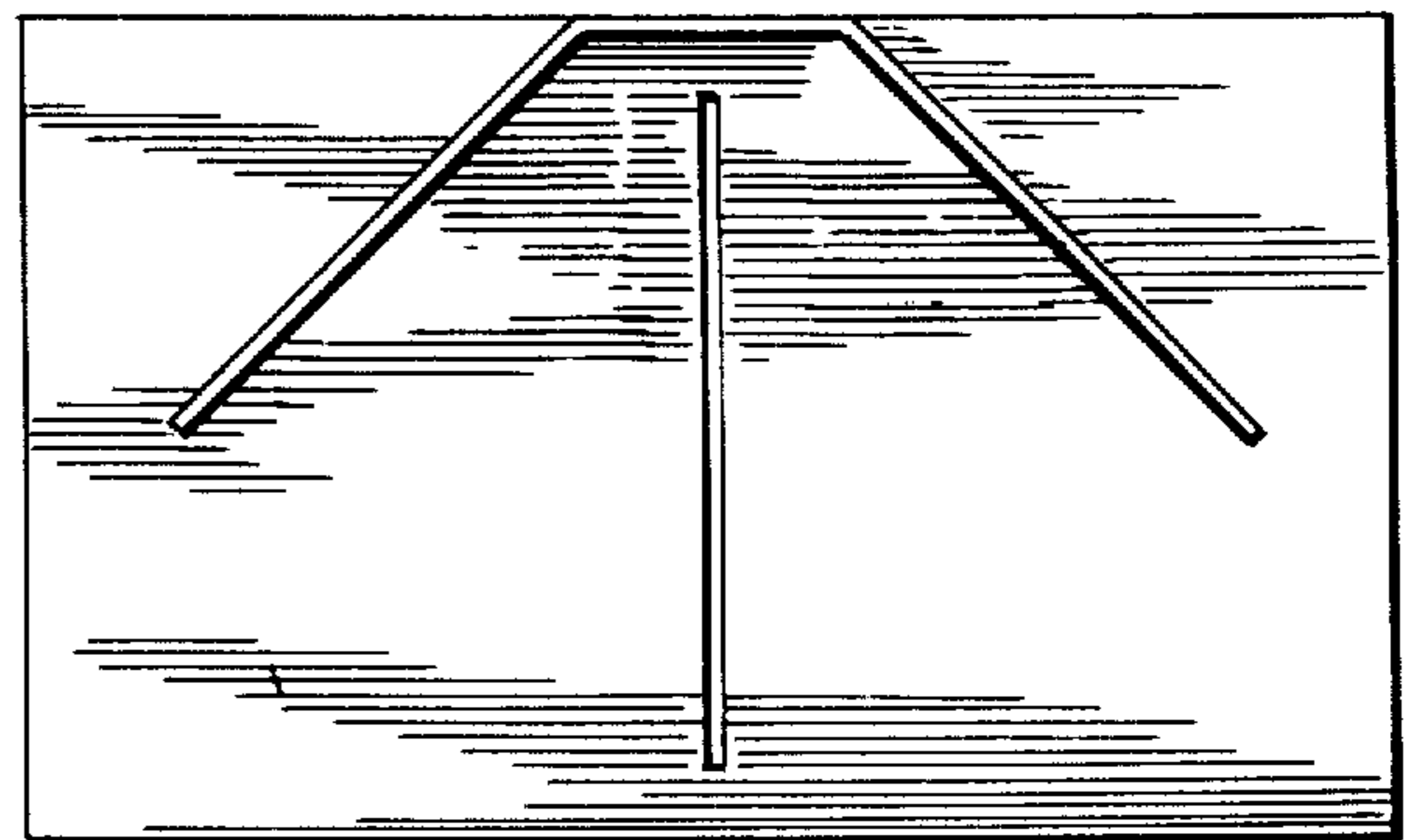

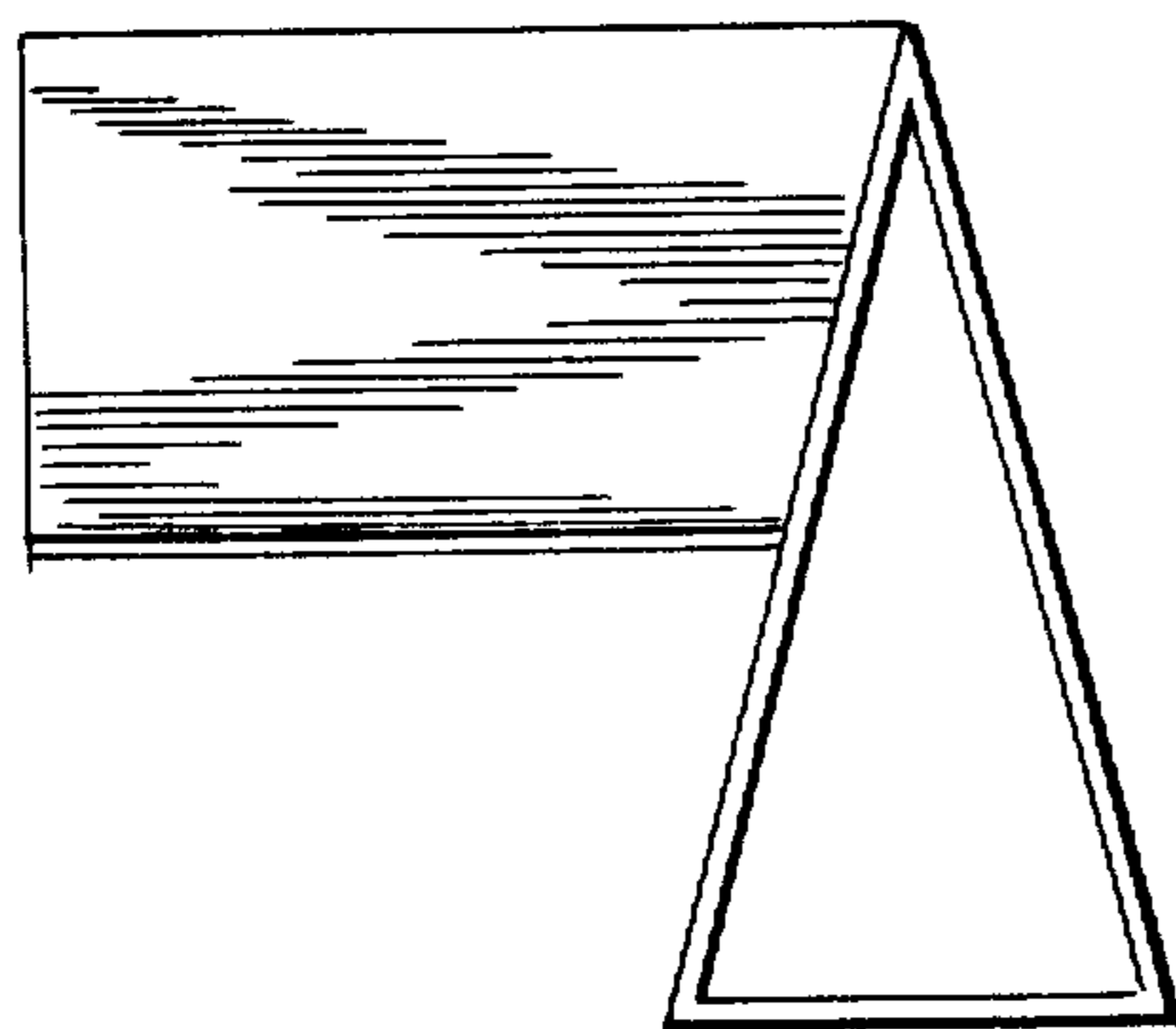

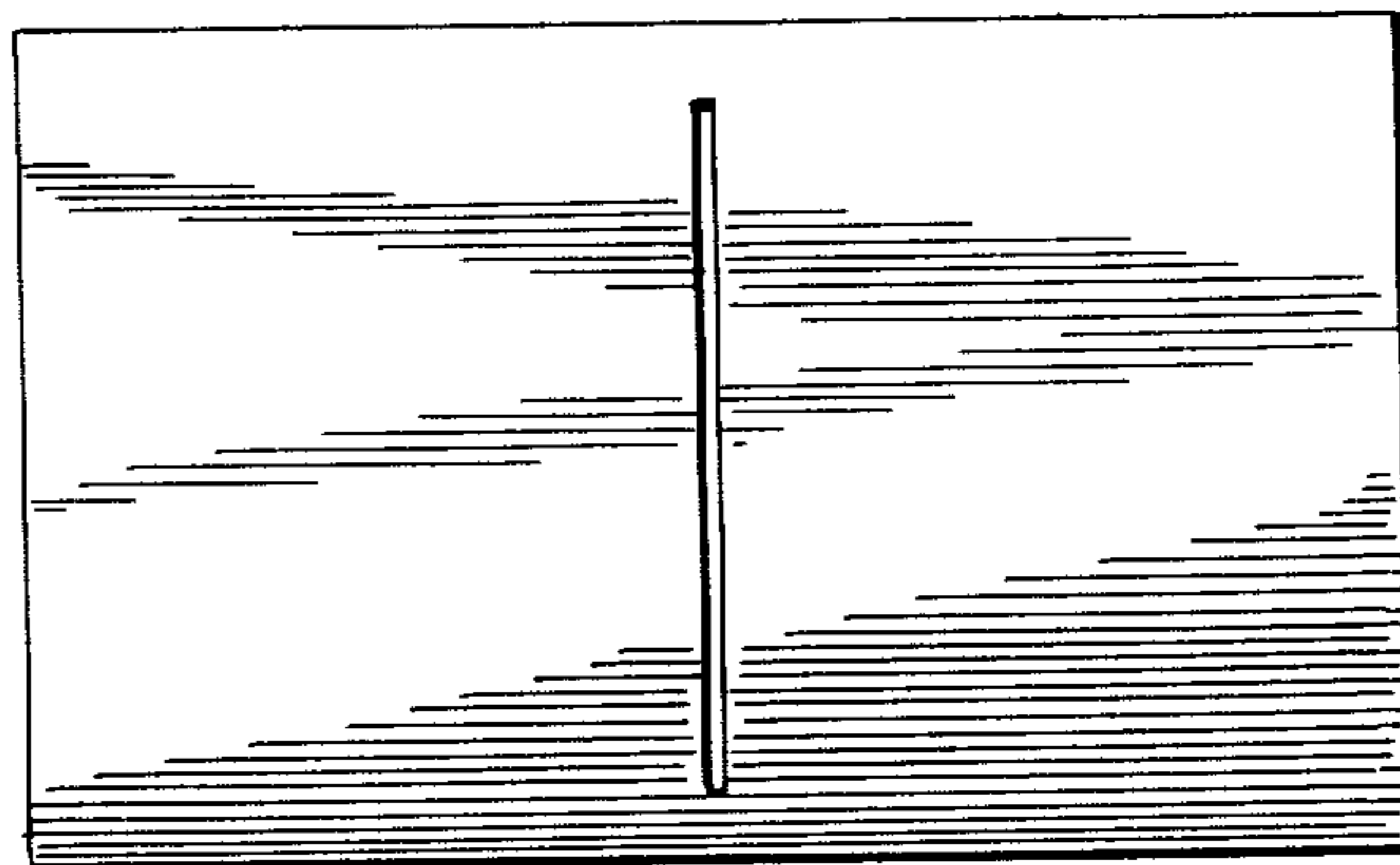
