

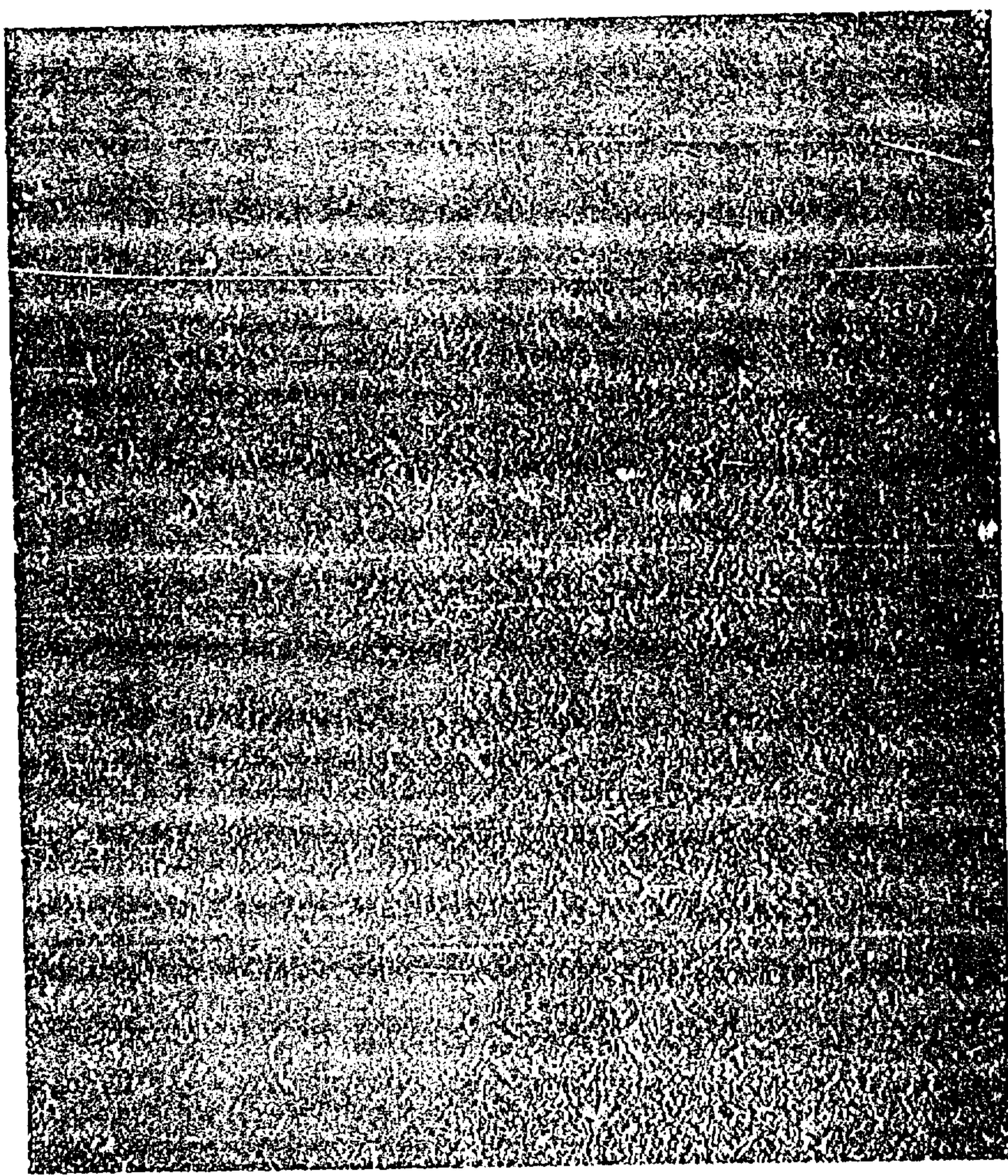

FIG. 2 is an end view of the ceiling tile as shown in FIG. 1.



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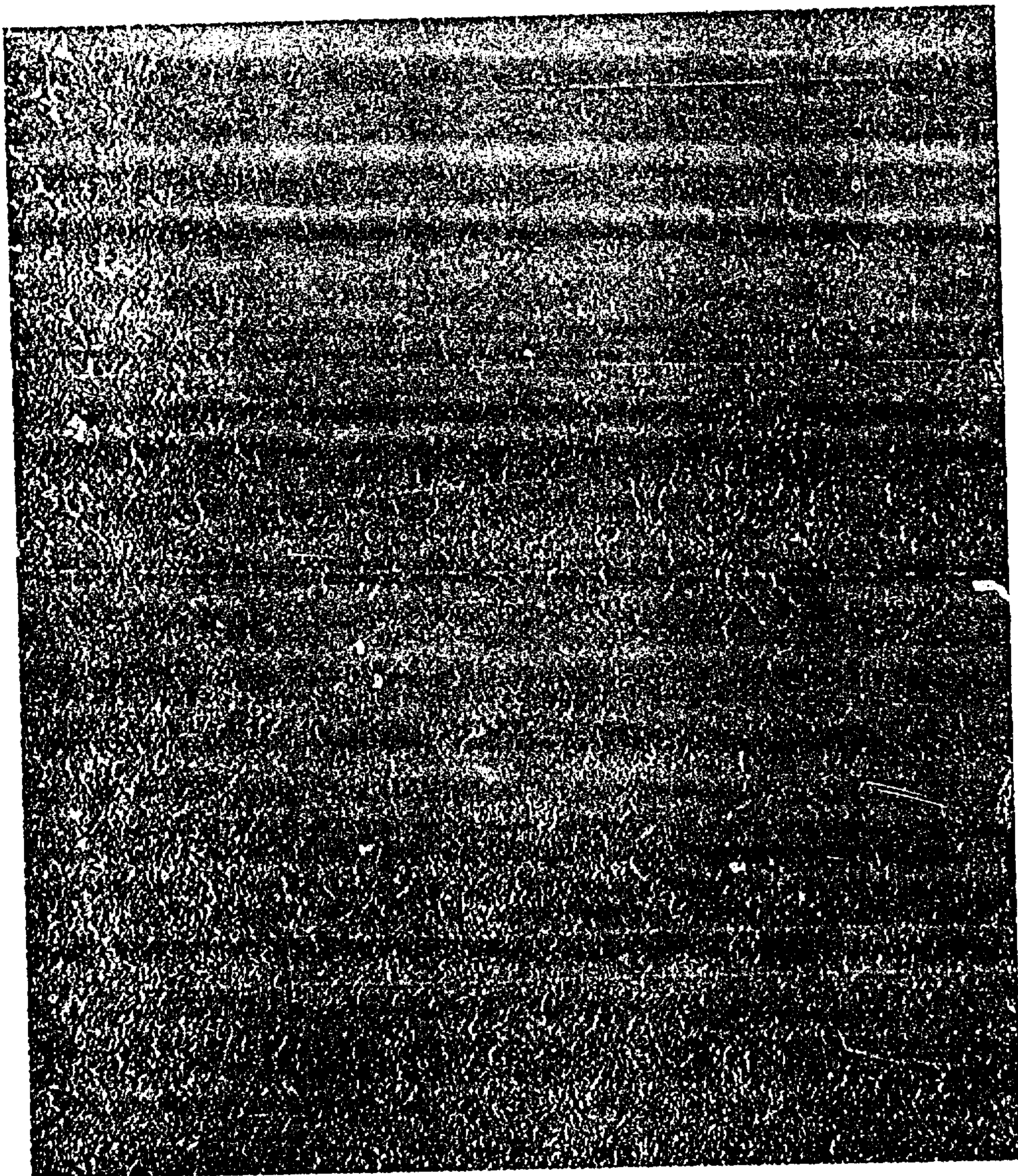

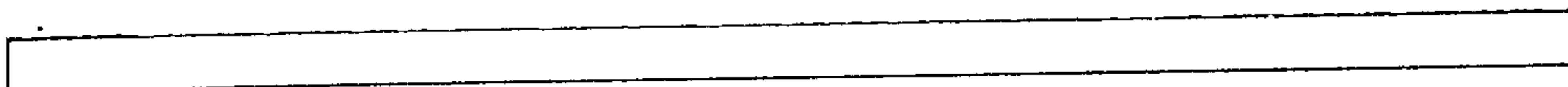
