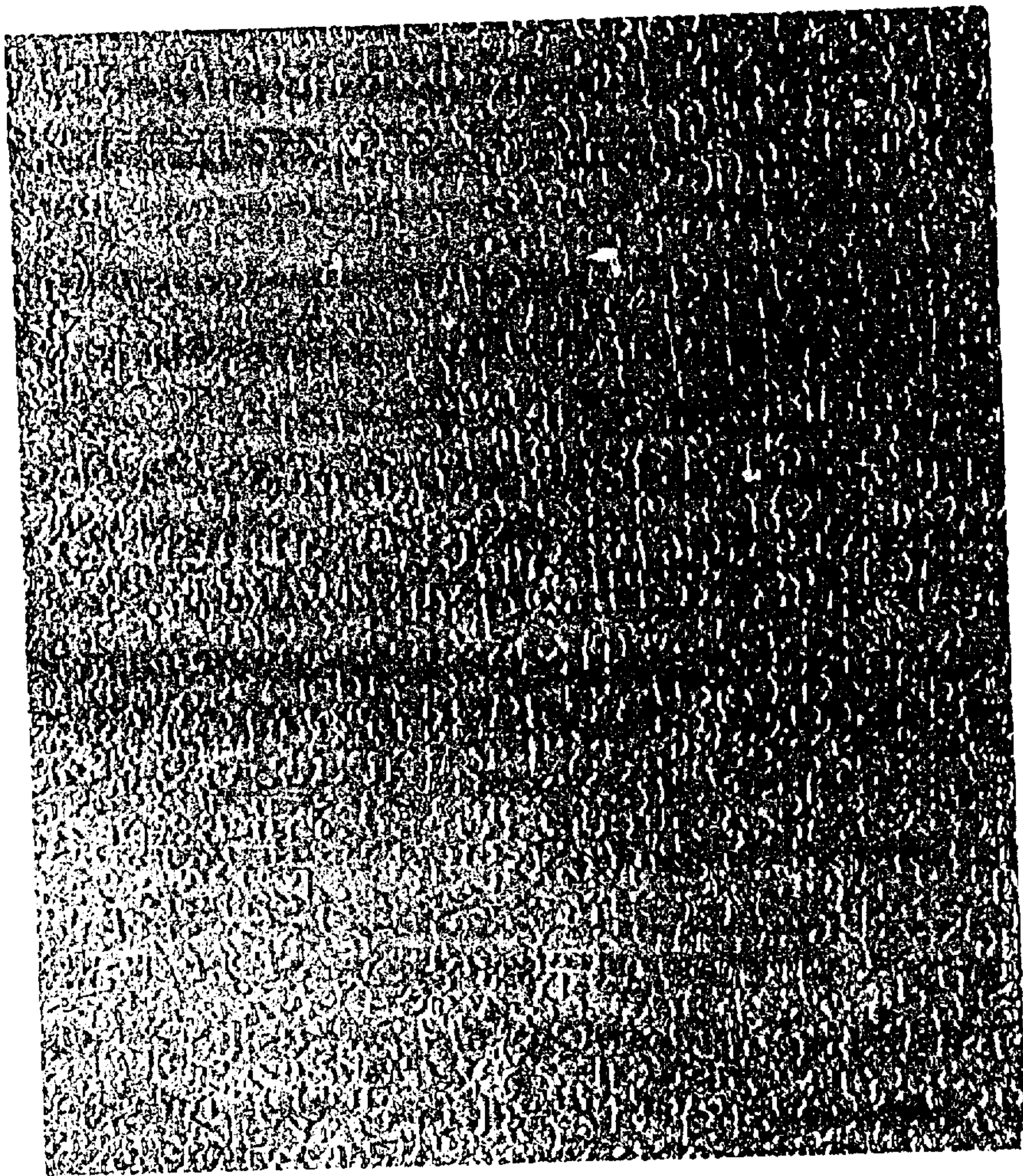
CLAIM

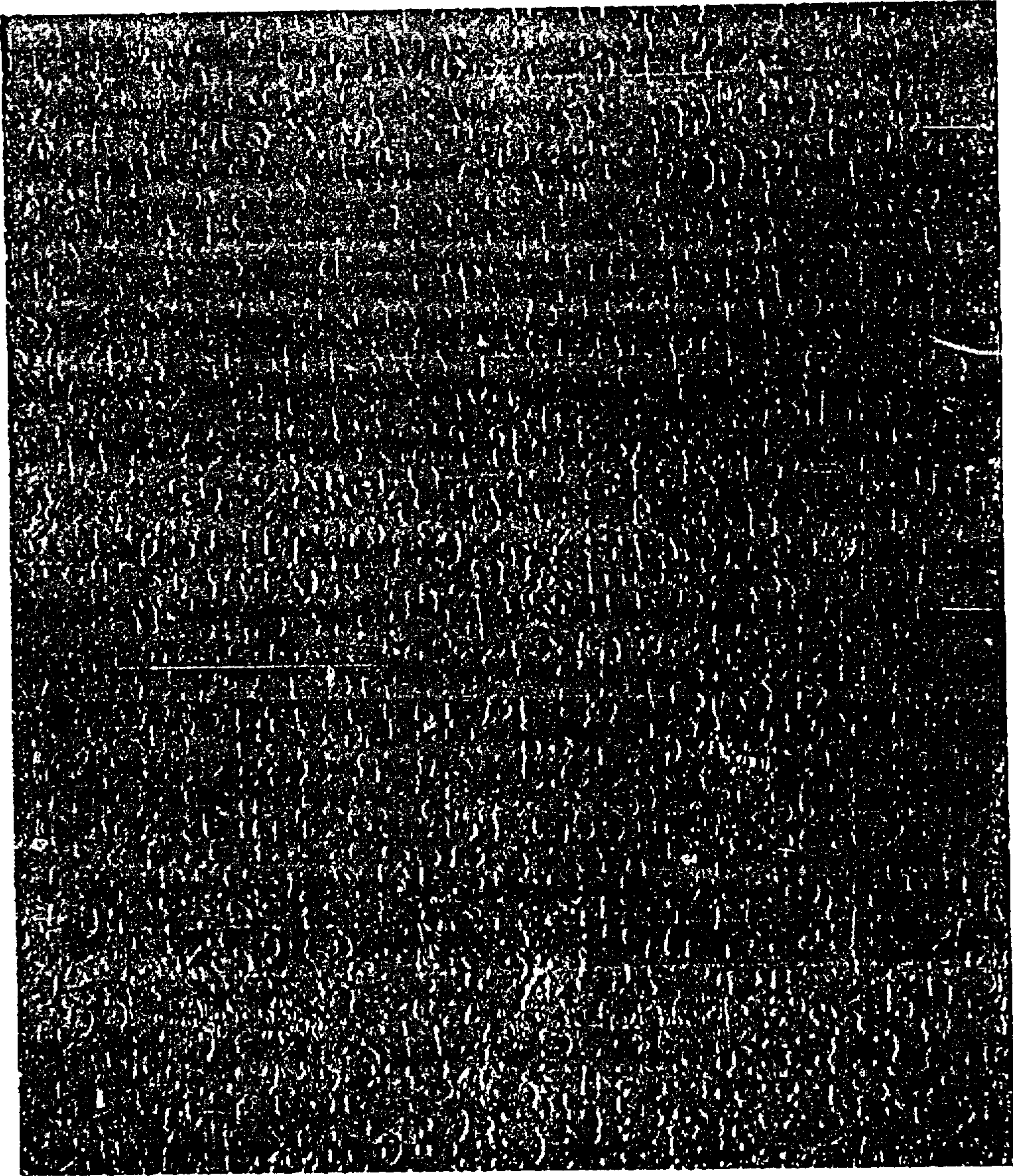

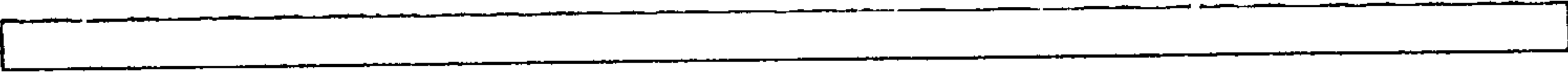
