FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

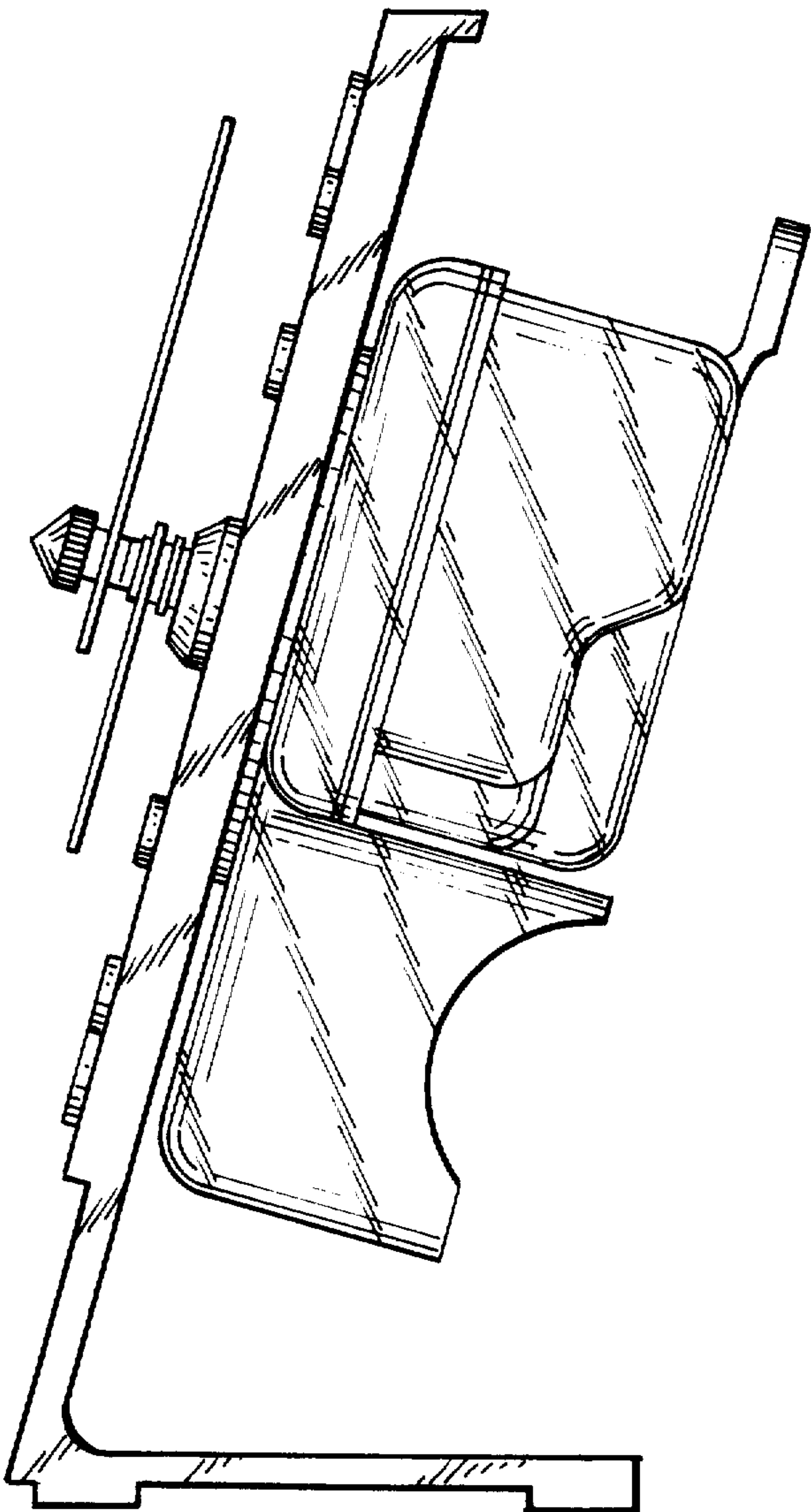

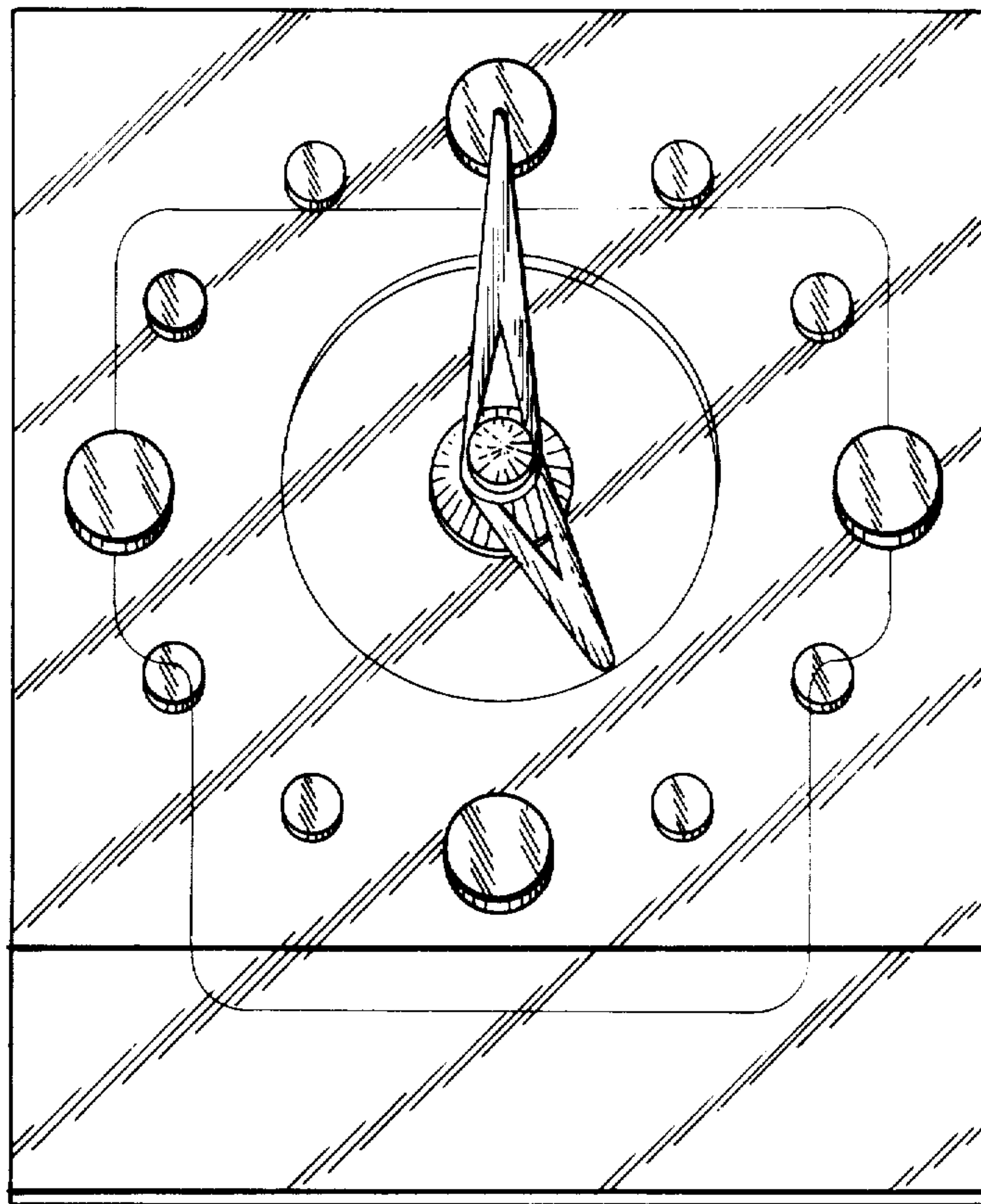
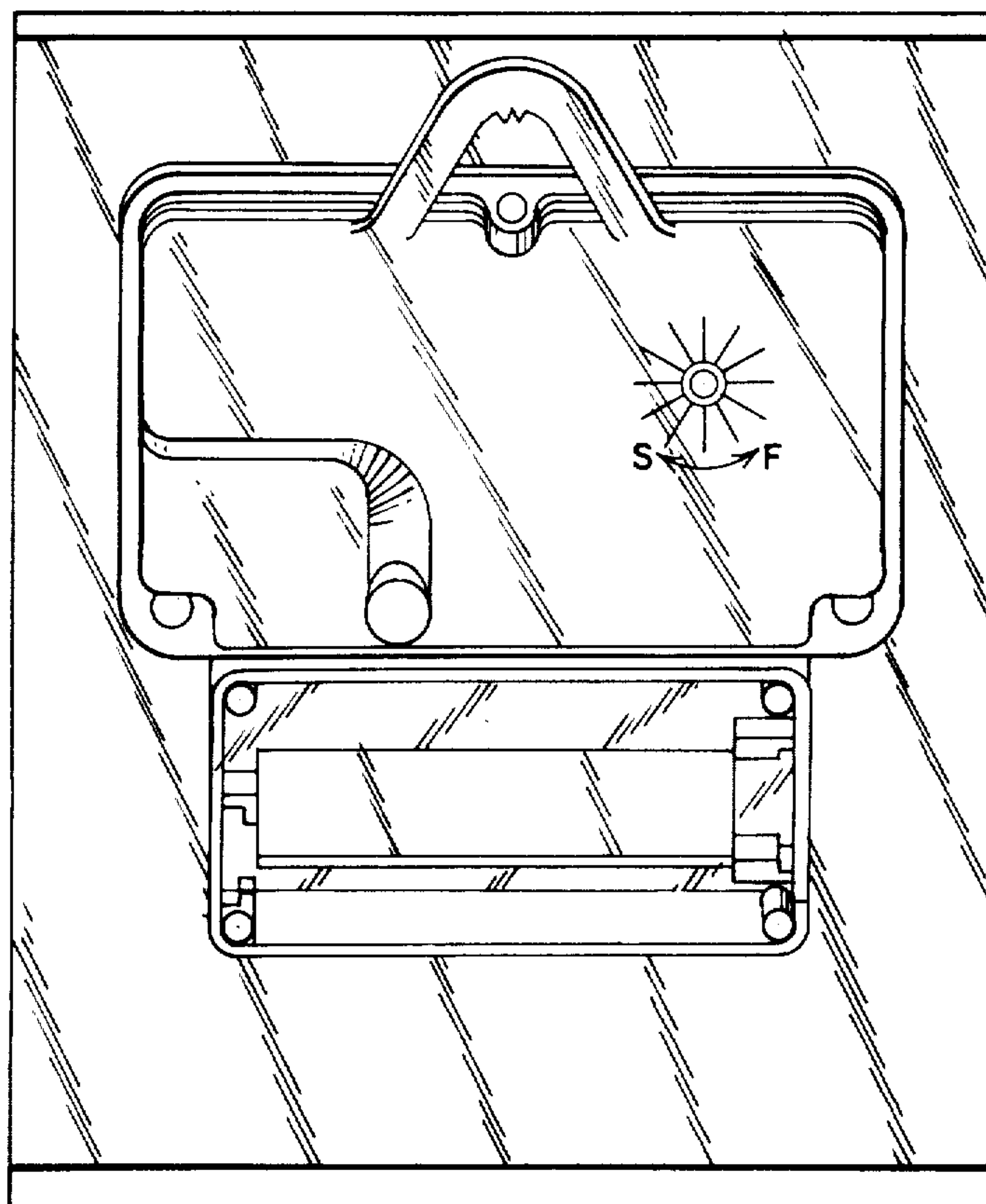

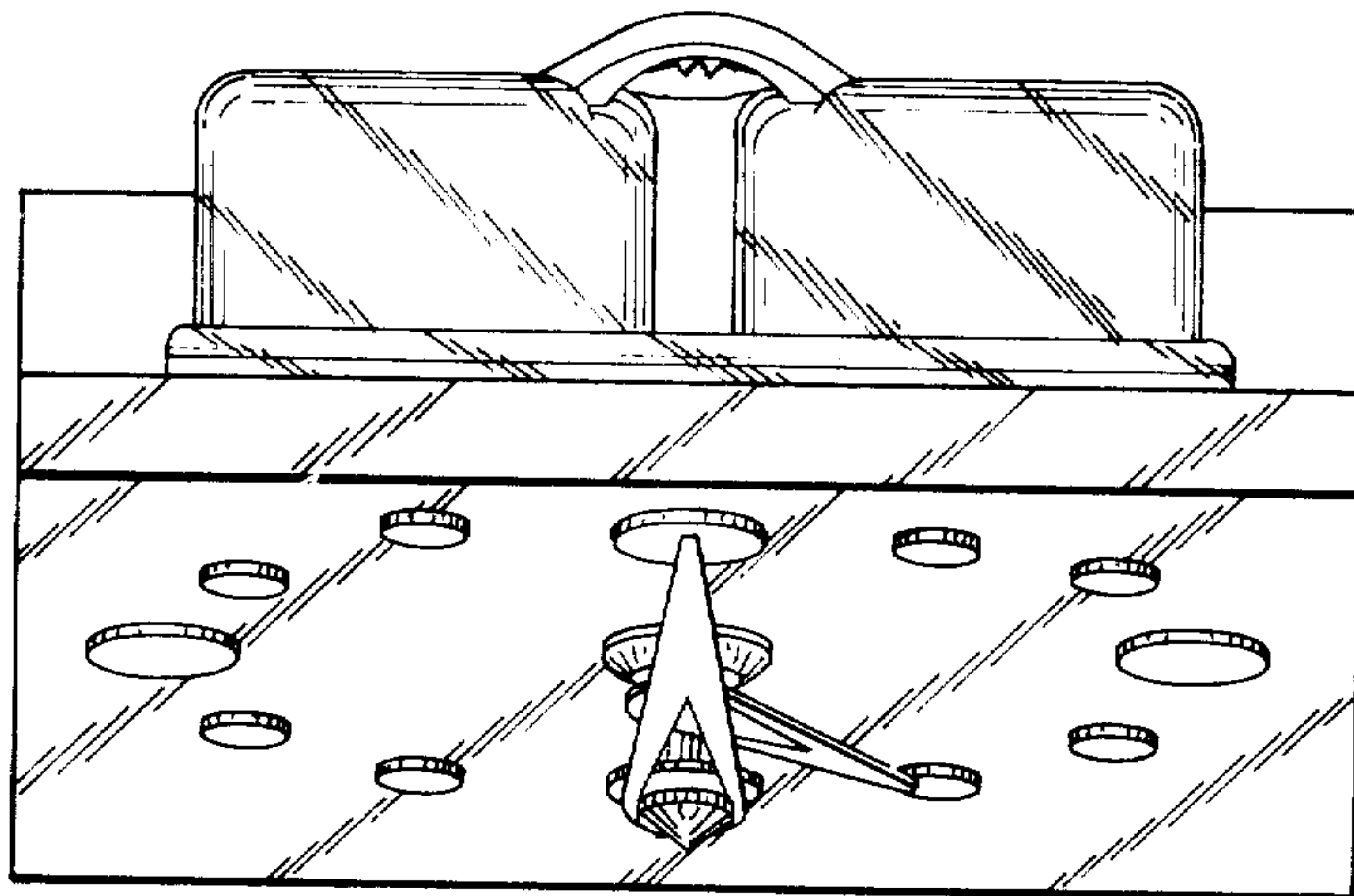

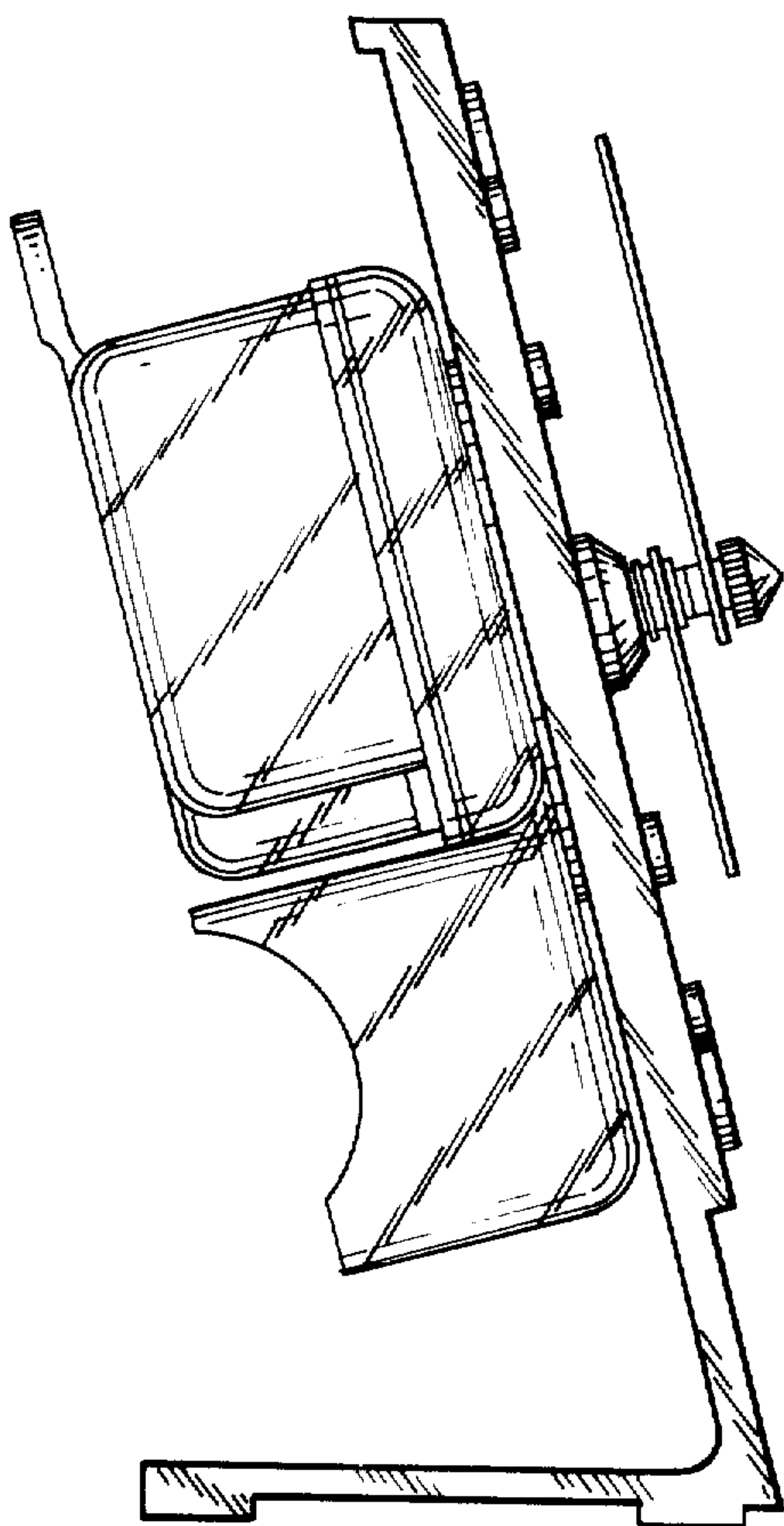
