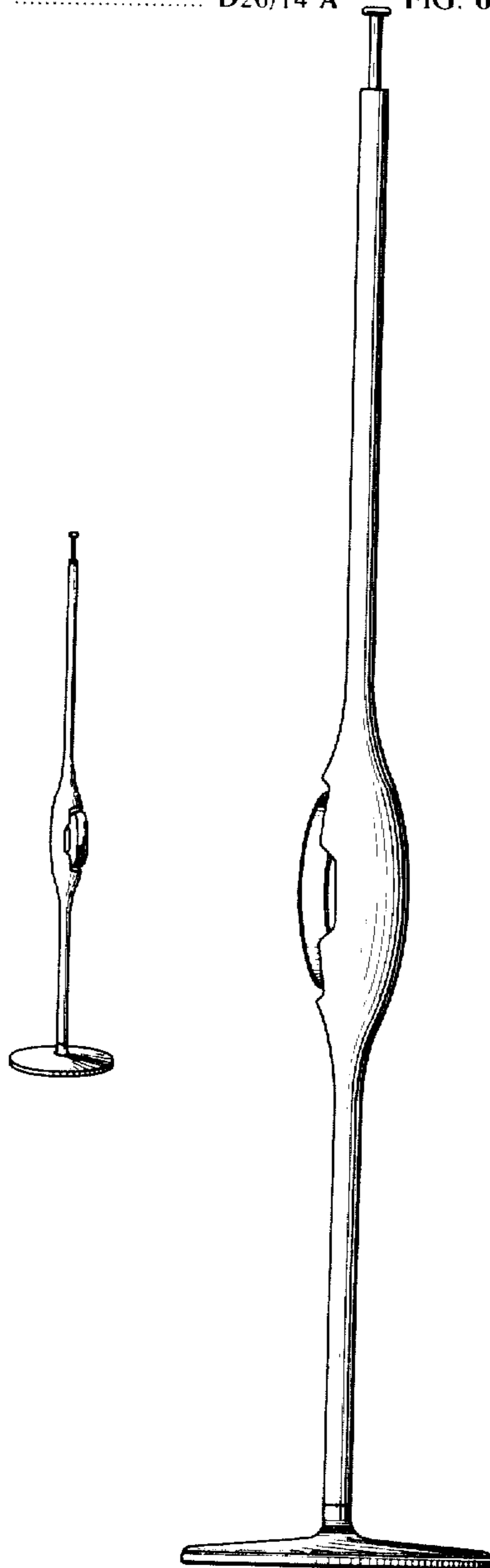
The ornamental design for a pole telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pole telephone embodying the design of our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

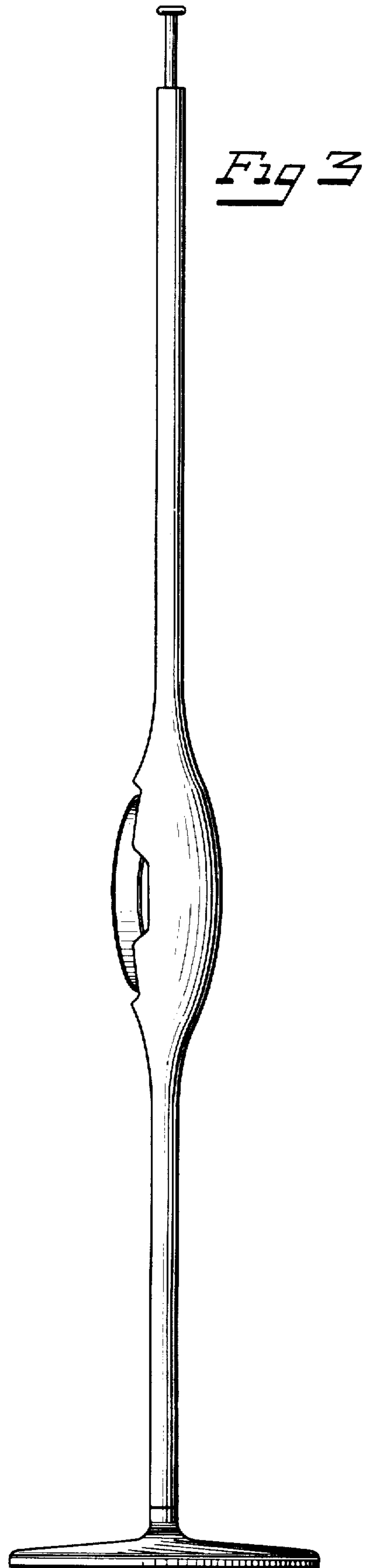
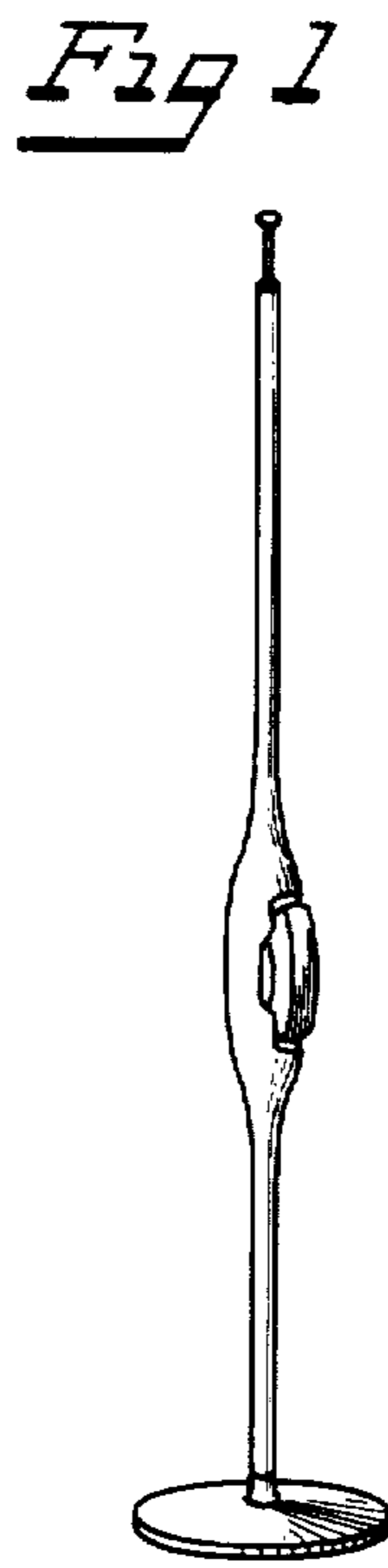
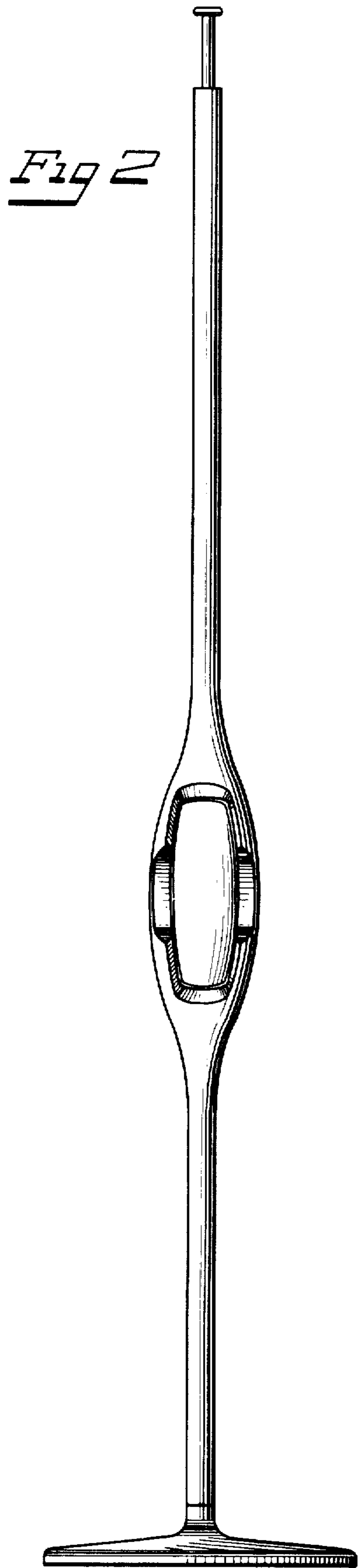

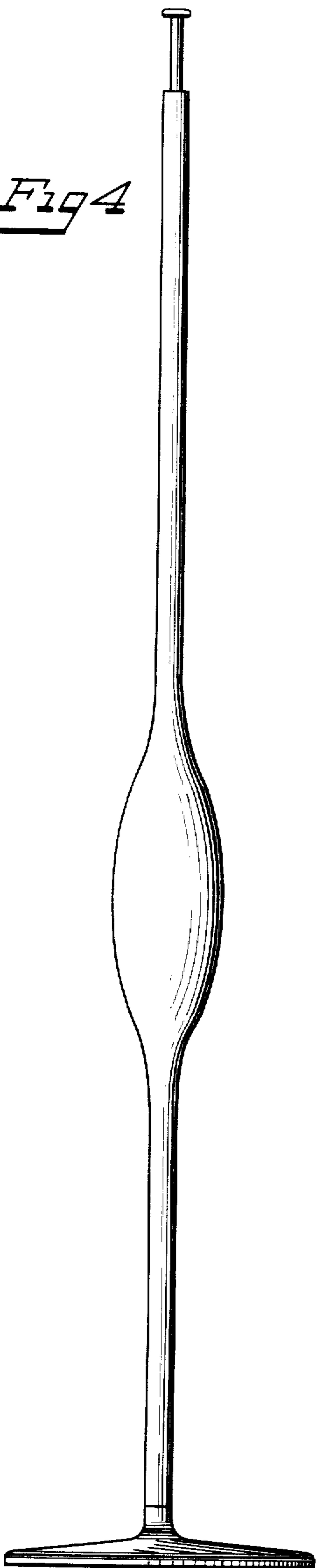

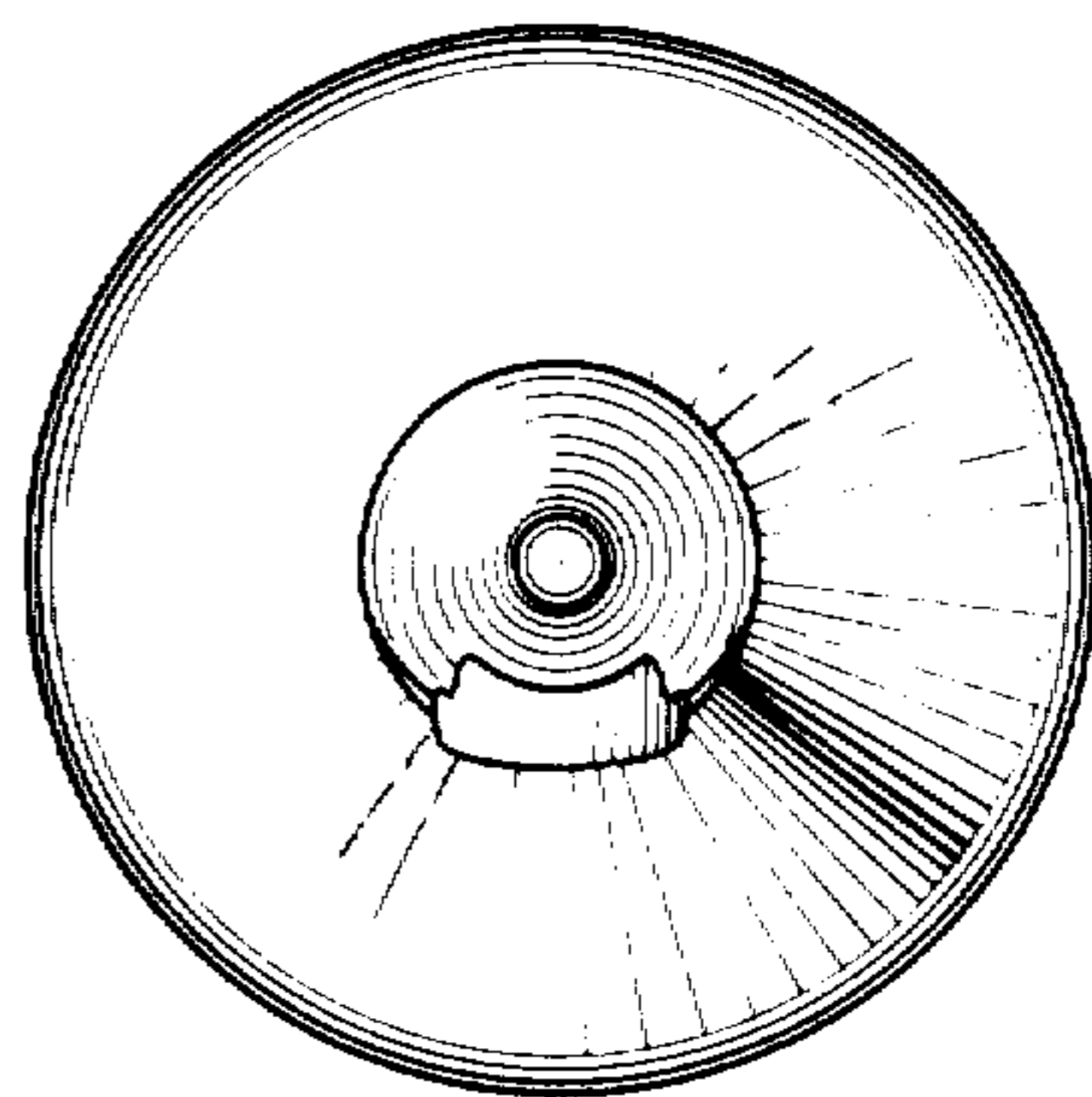
