FIG. 5 is an enlarged transverse sectional view taken along the line 5-5 of FIG. 1.

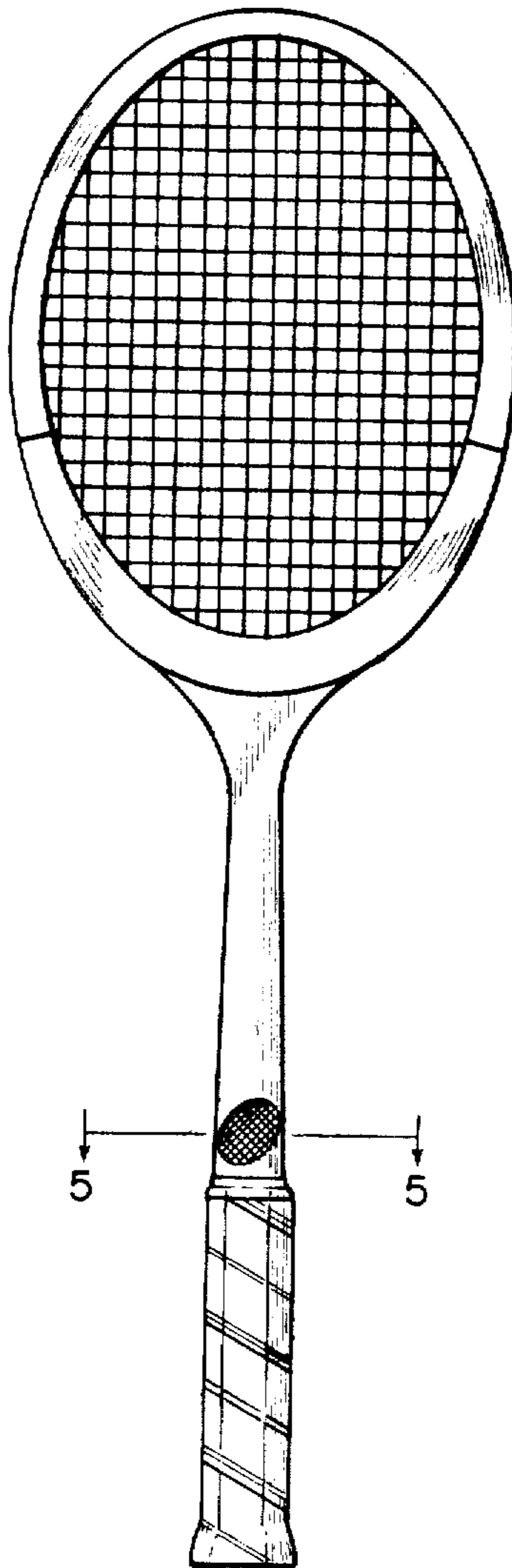

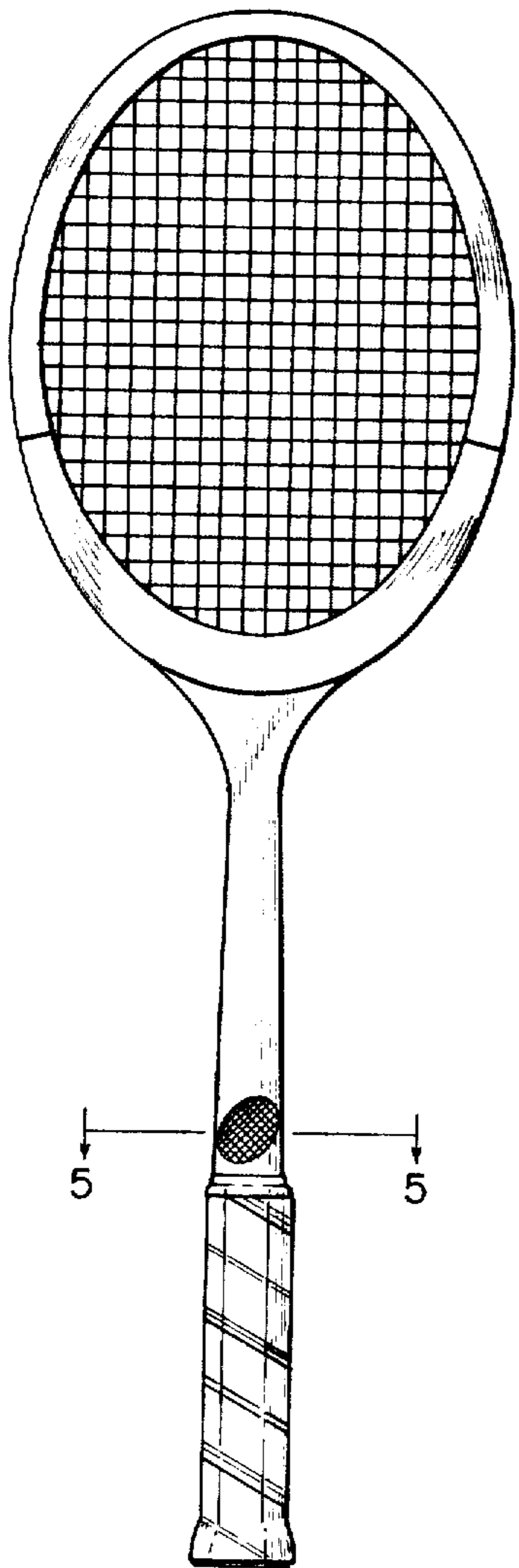

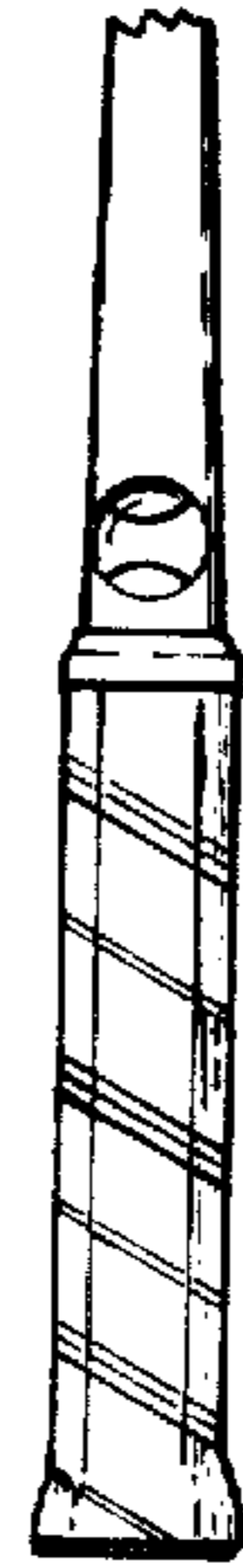

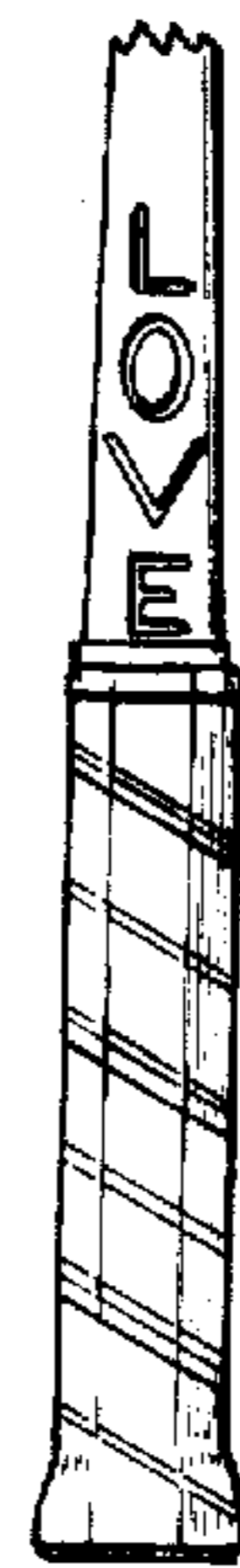

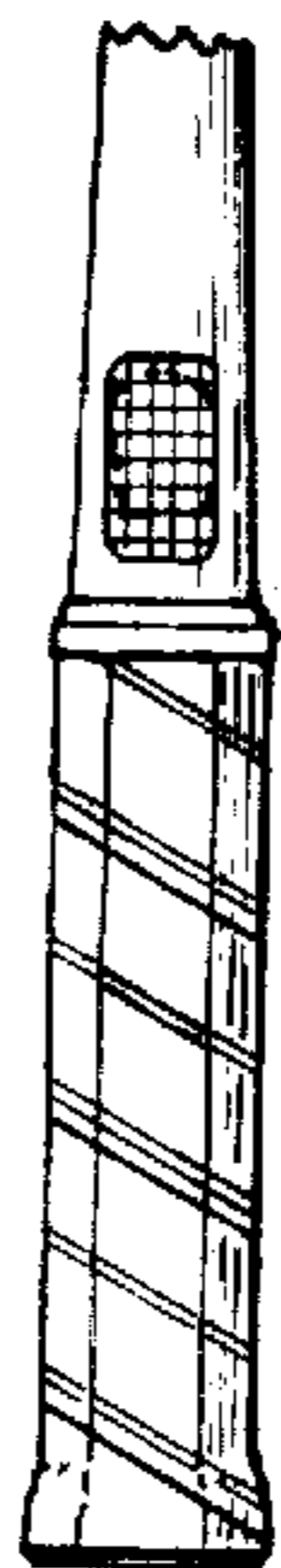

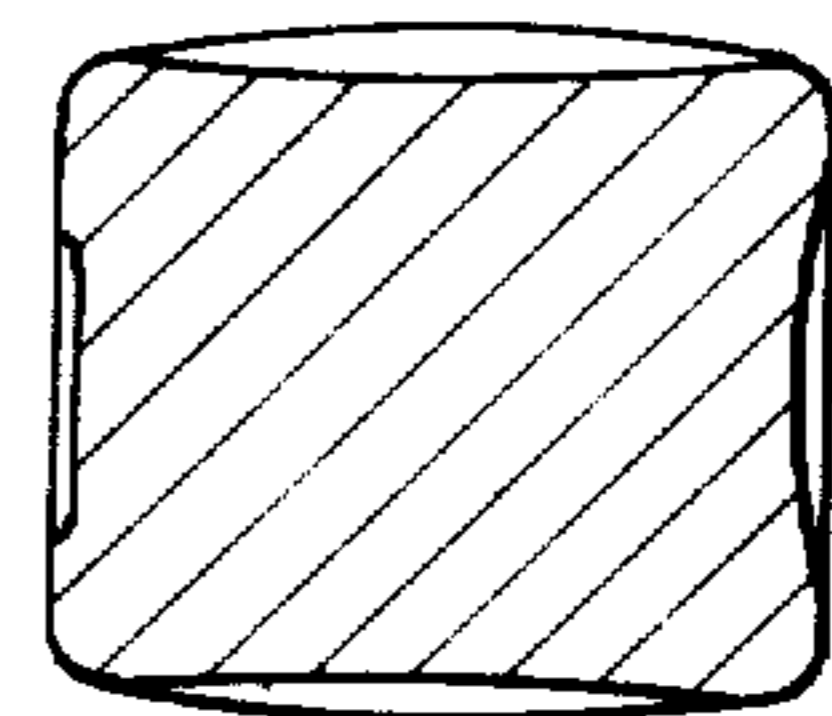
