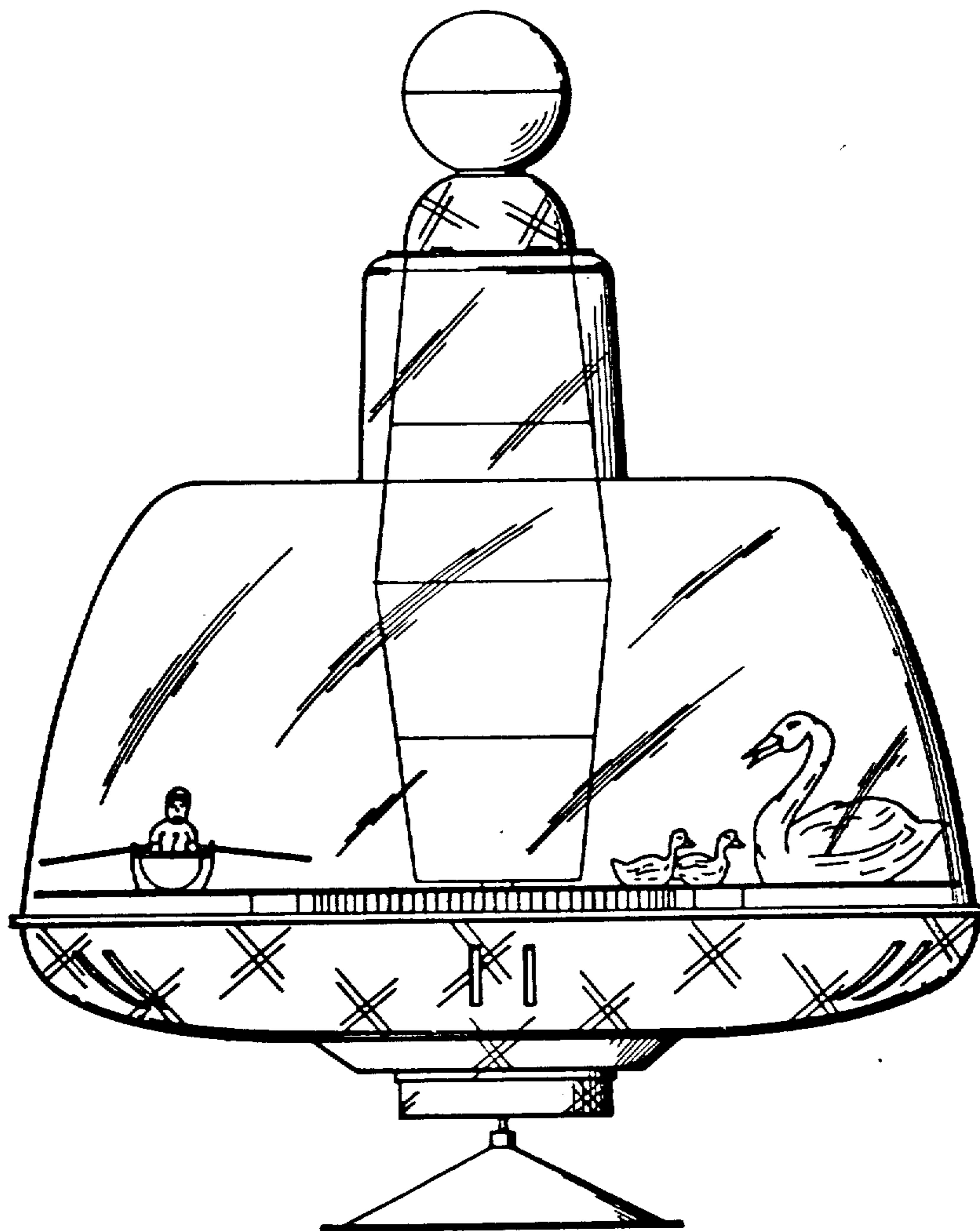
The ornamental design for a toy spinning top, as shown

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



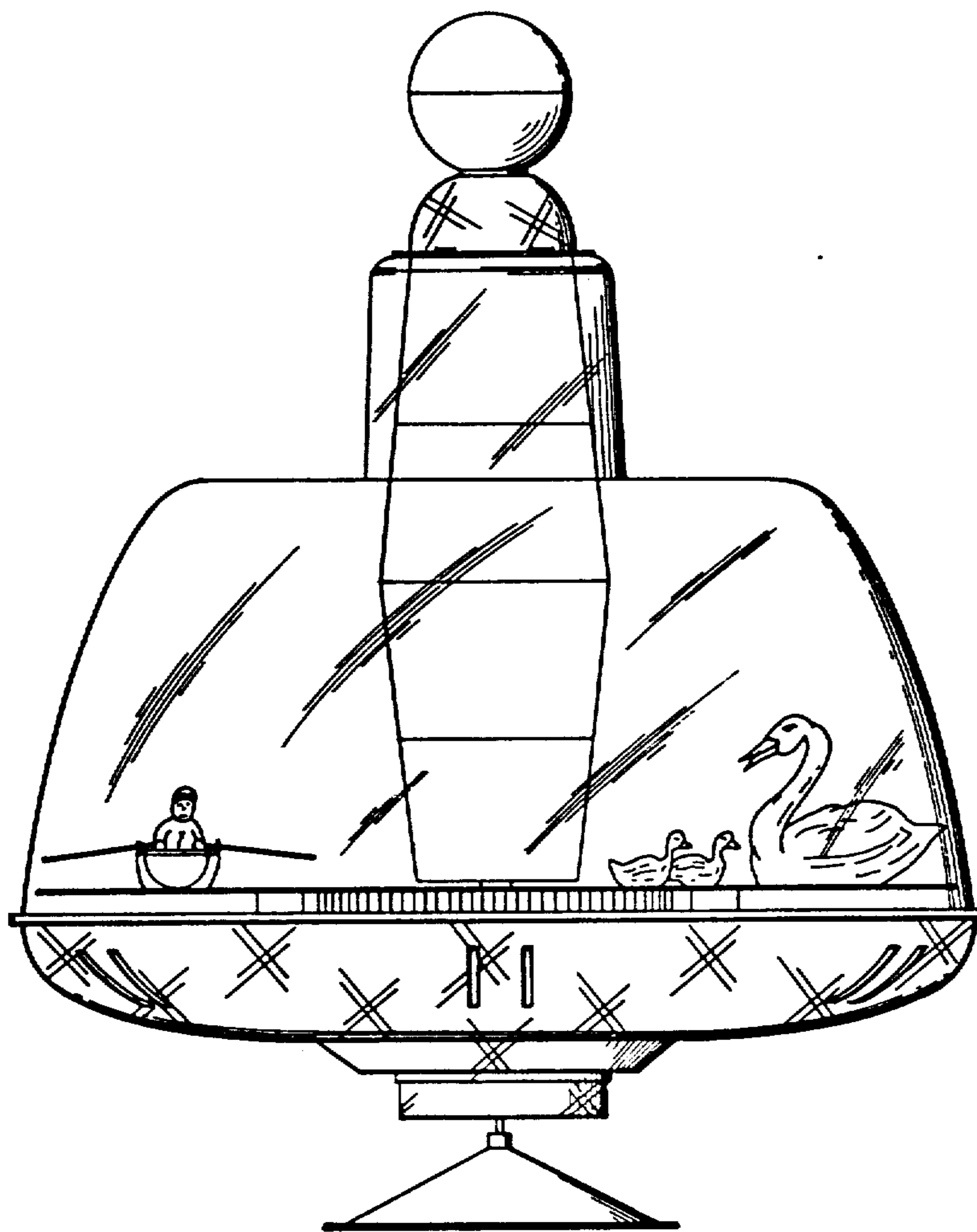

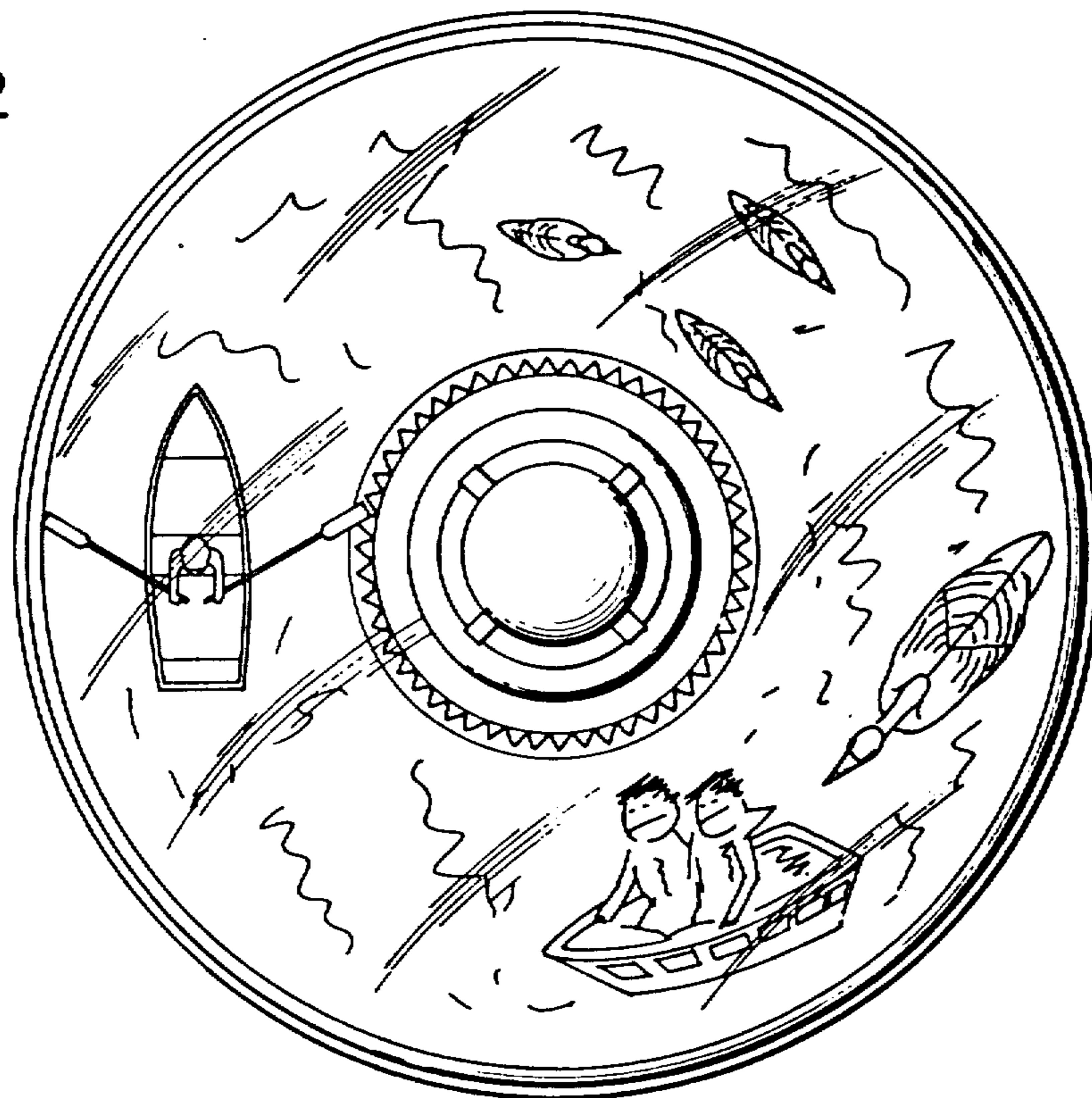
