FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof.

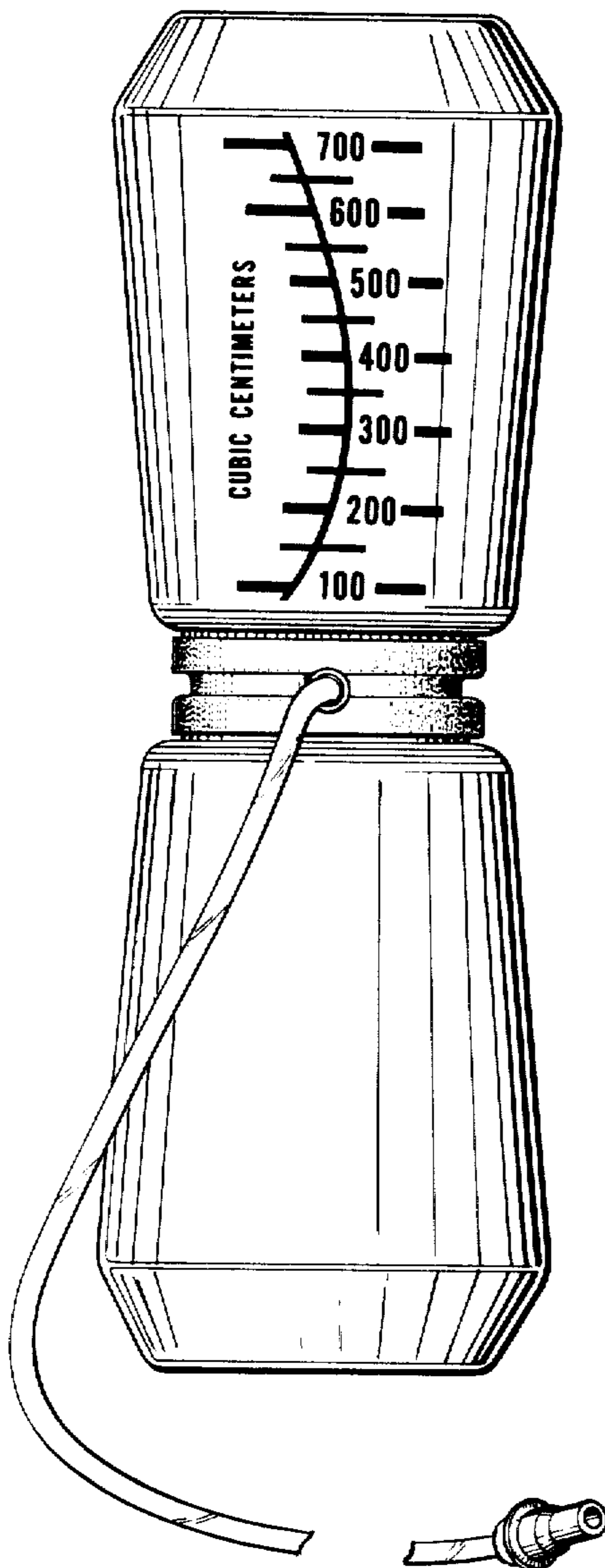
FIG. 4 is a top plan thereof and also is a mirror image of the bottom thereof; and

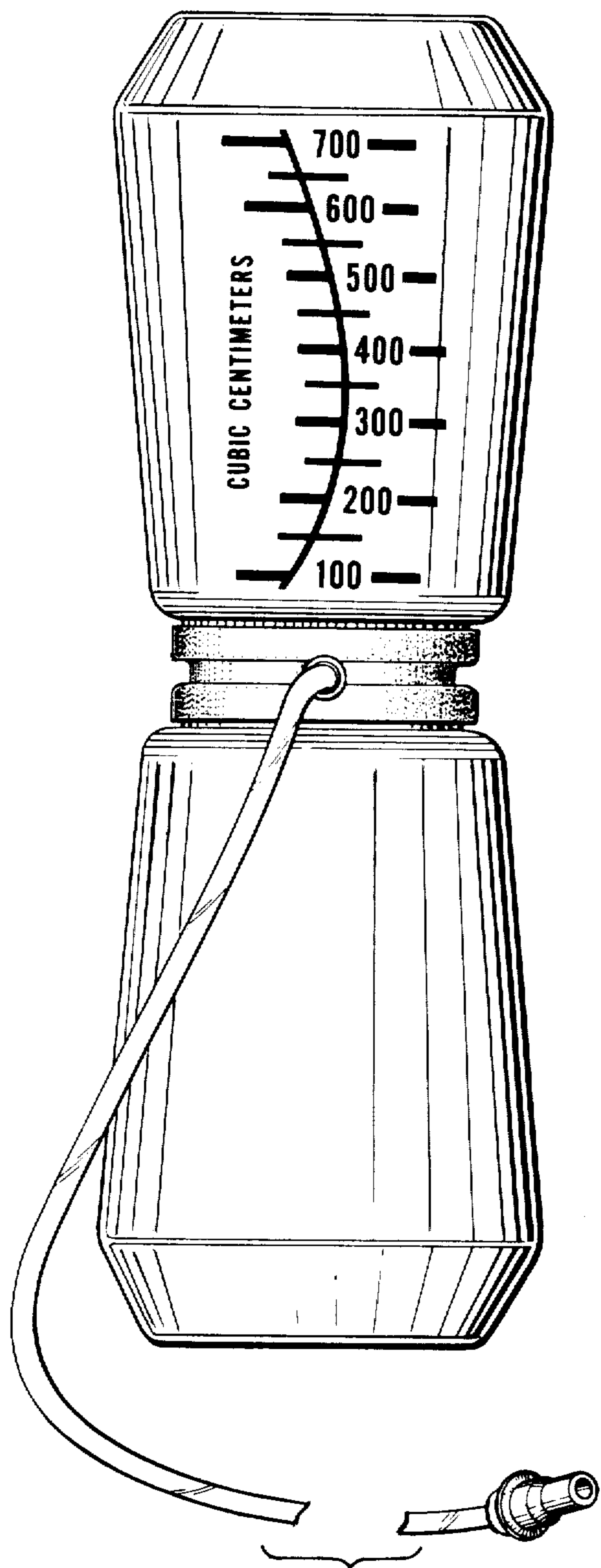

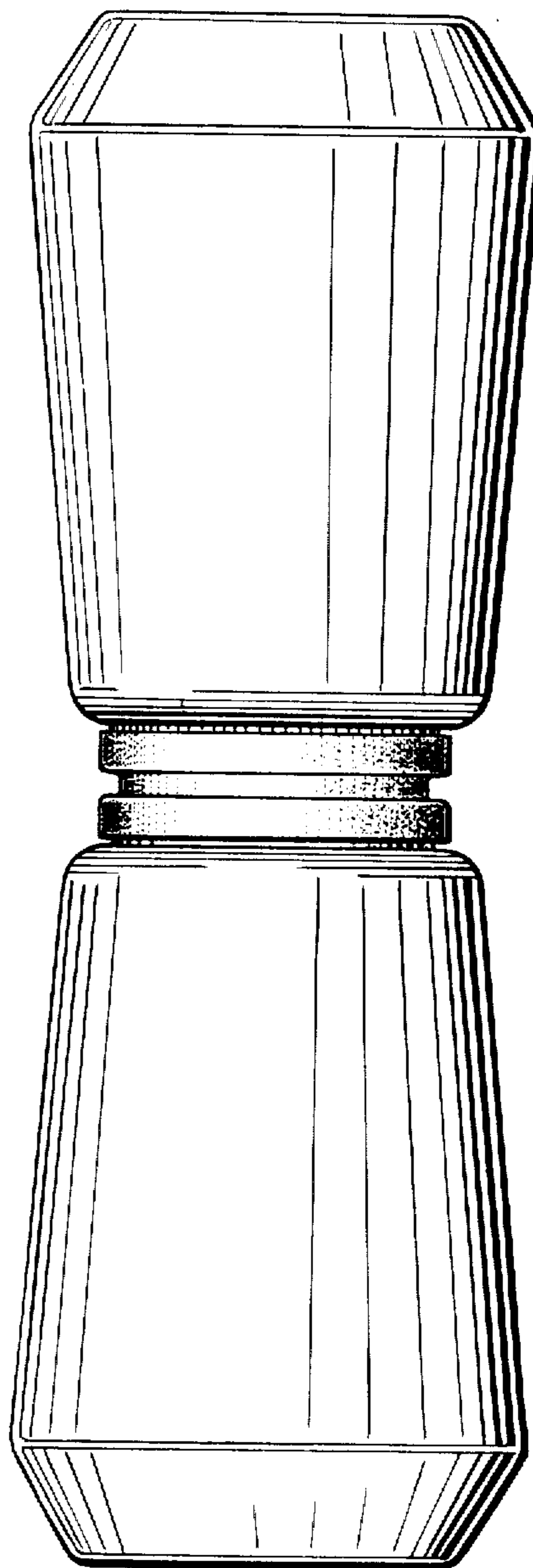

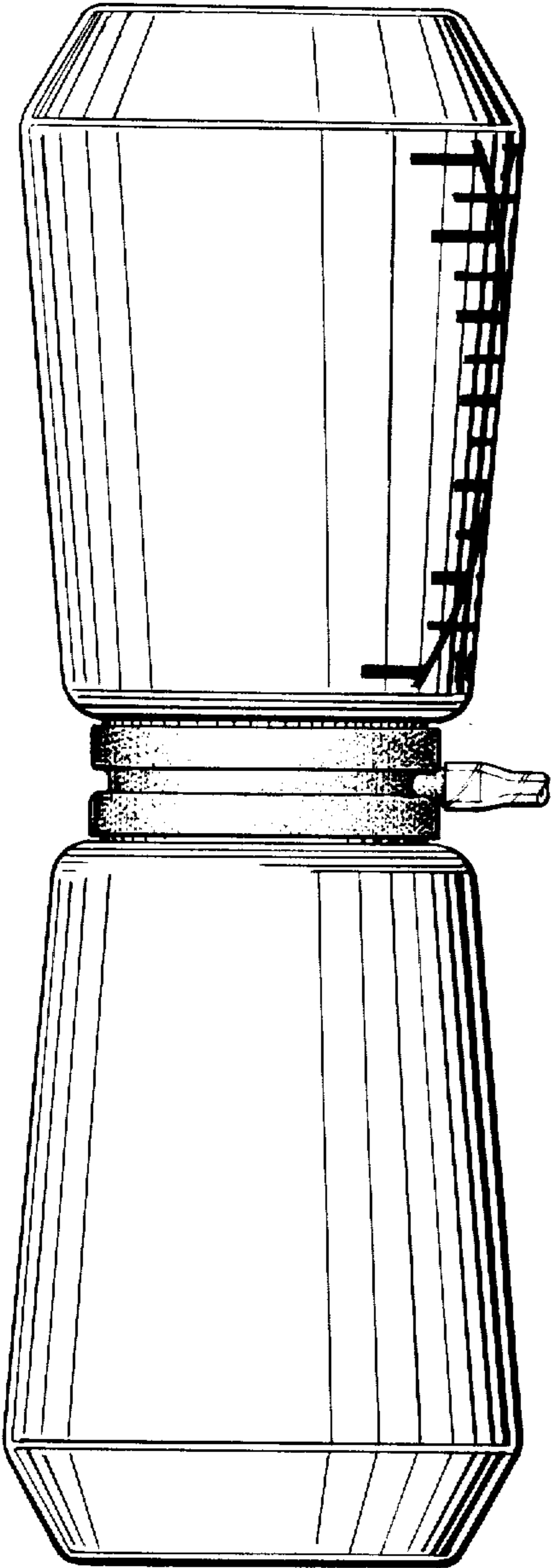

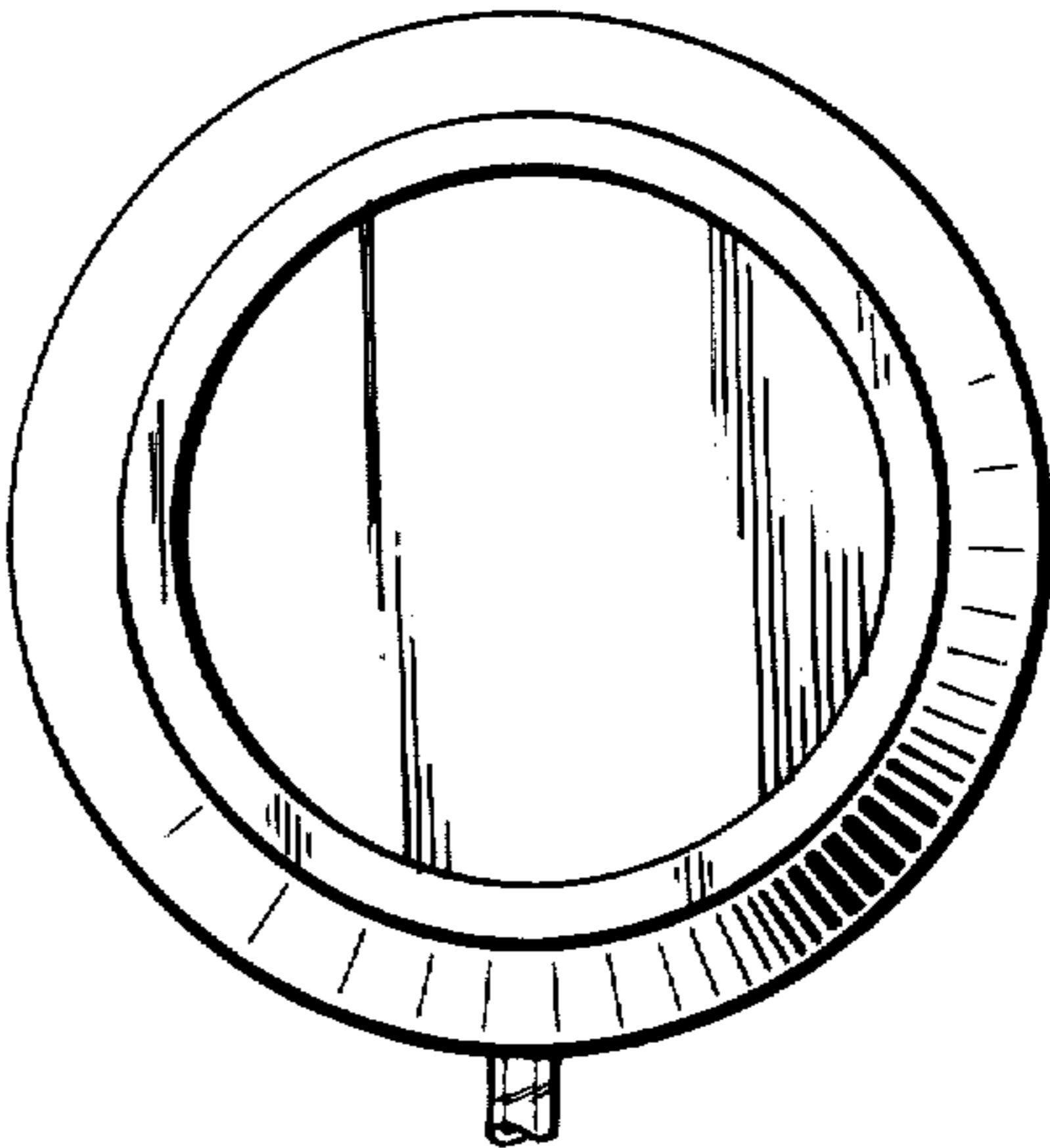

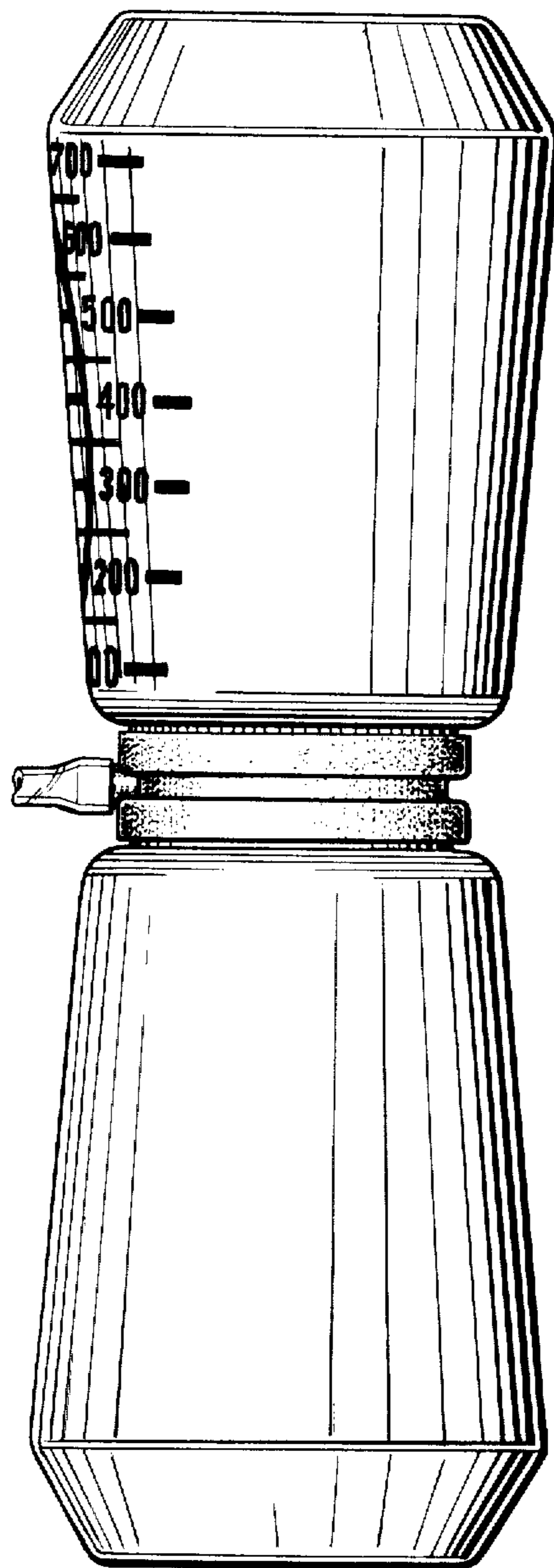
