FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nail clipper showing my new design;

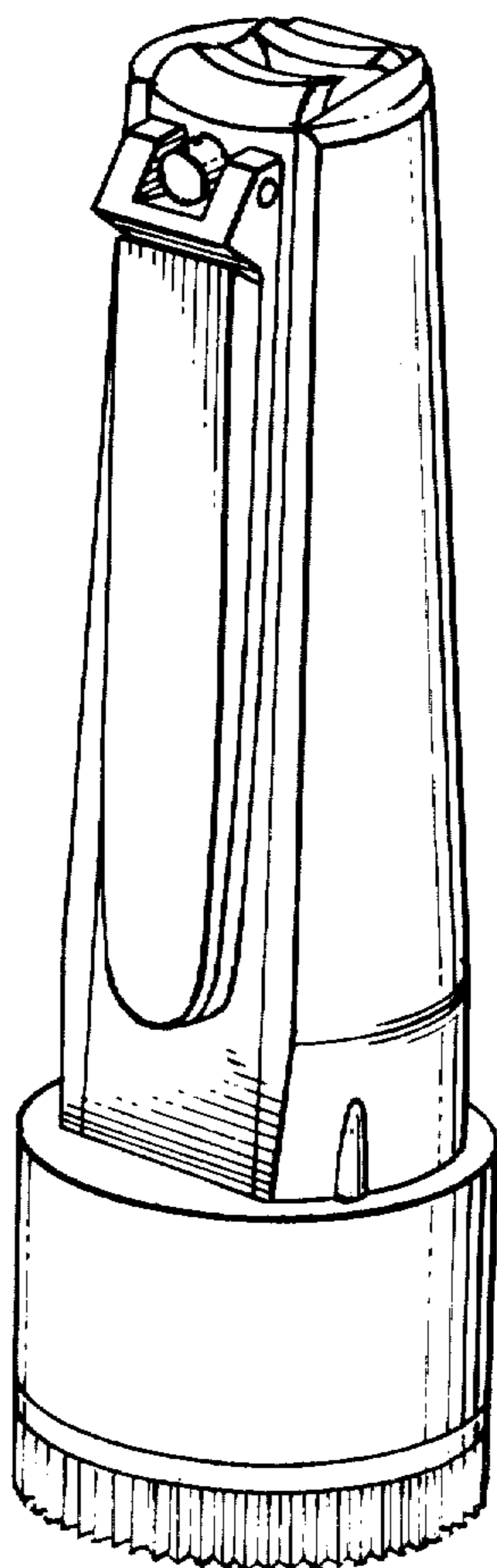
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



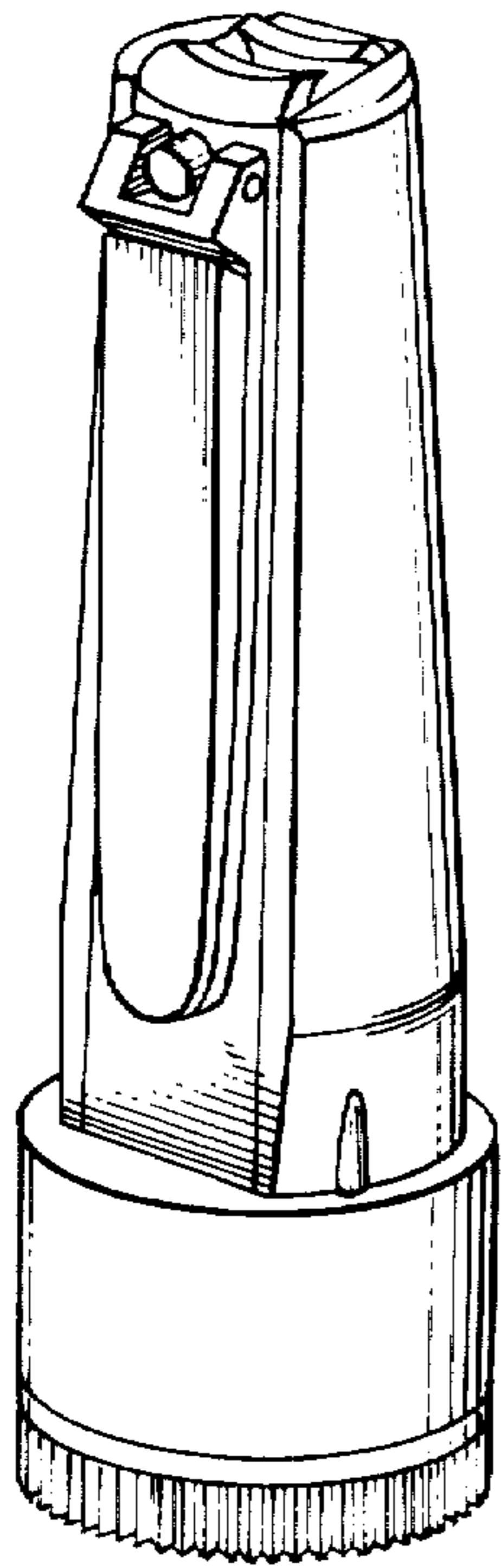

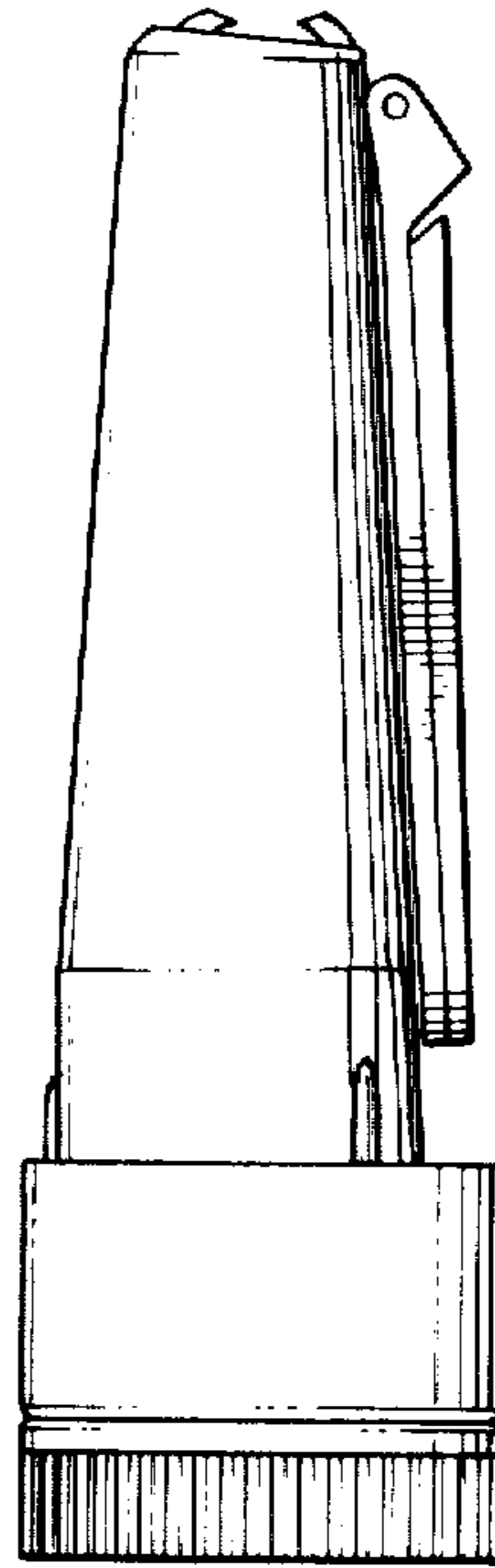

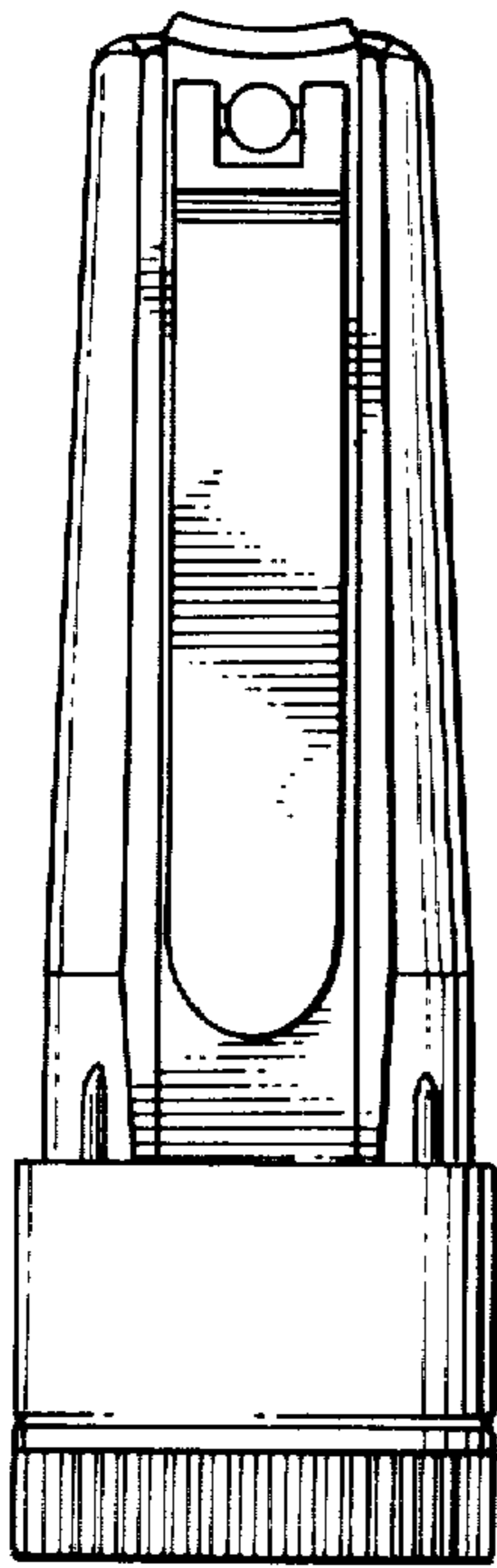

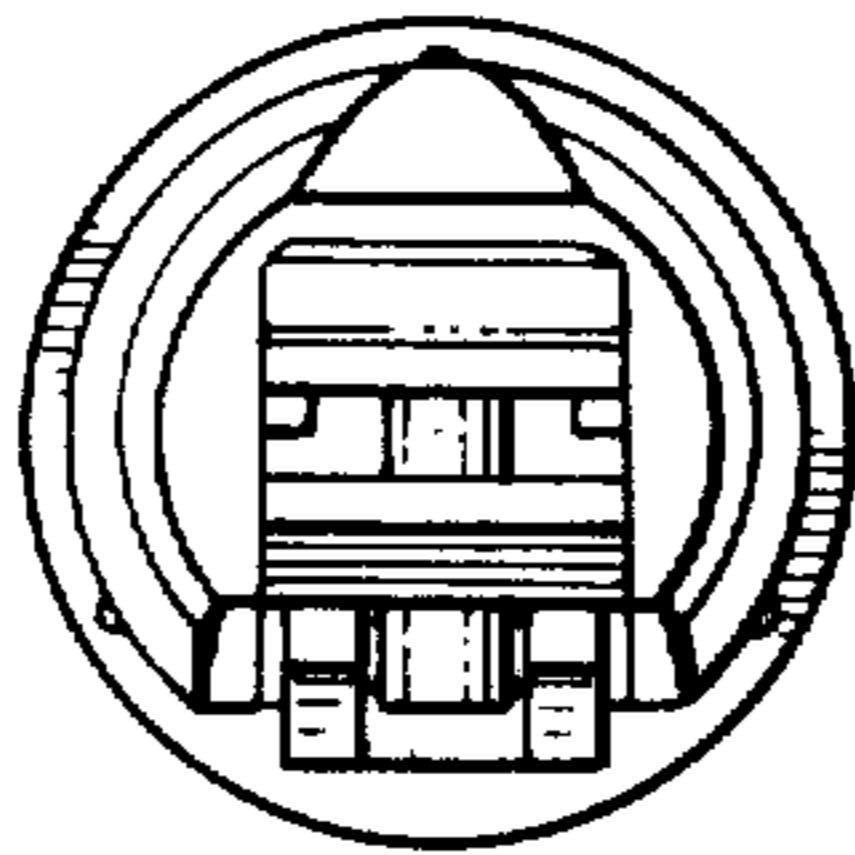

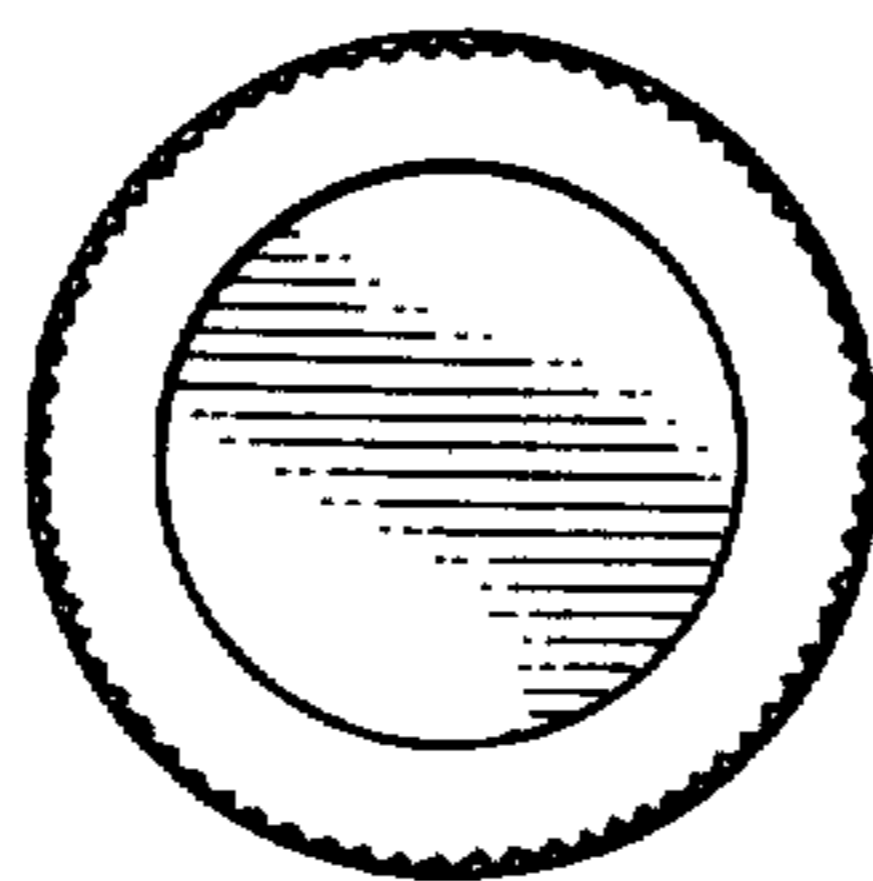

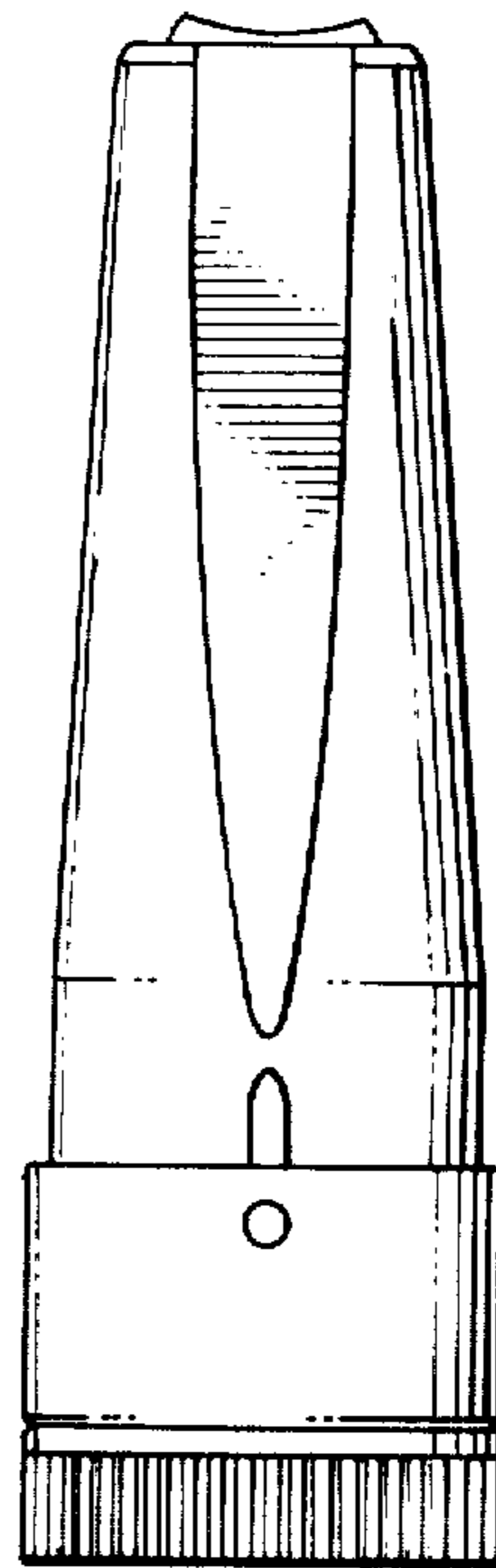
