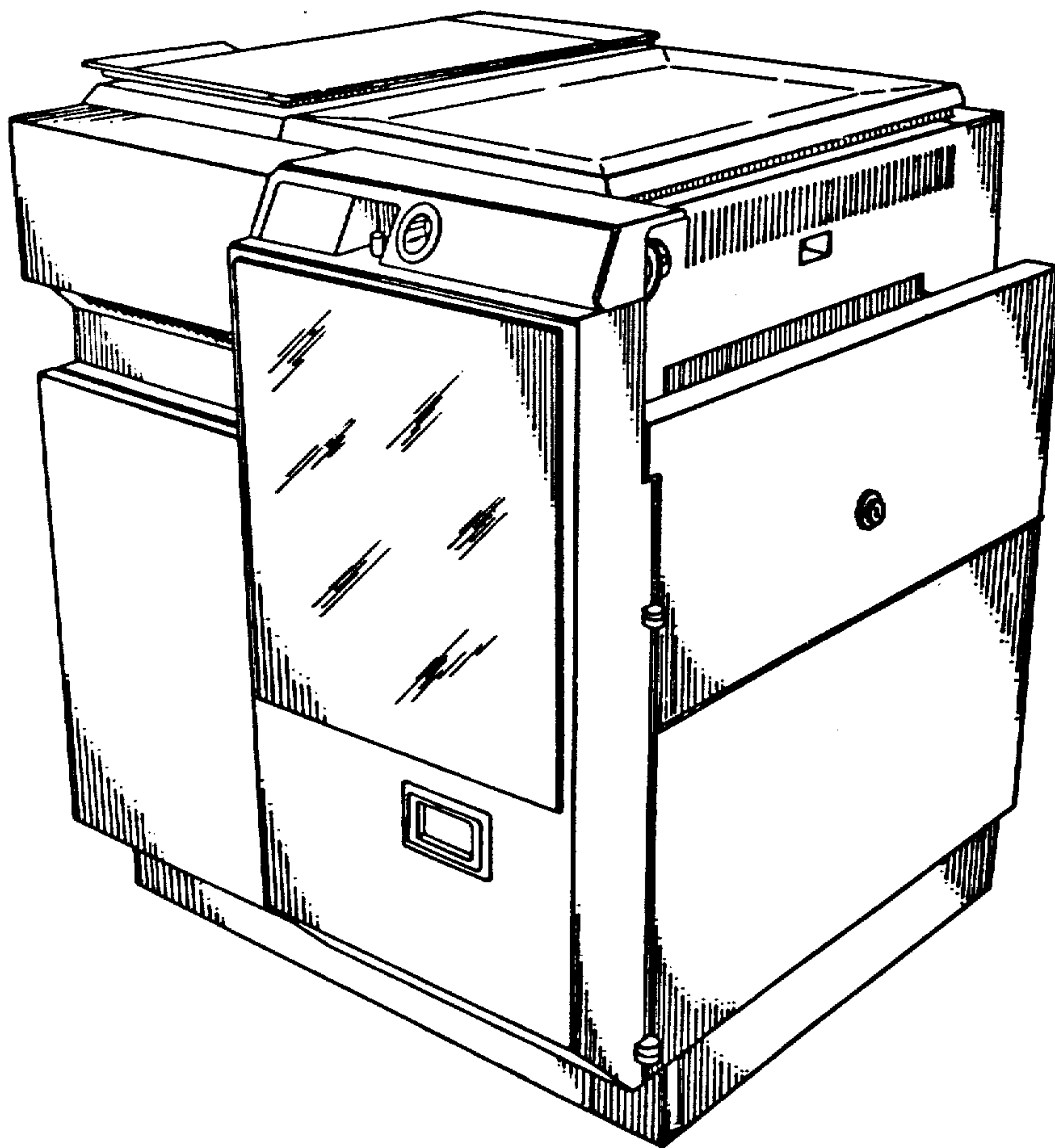

The ornamental design of a coin operated reproduction machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a coin operated reproduction machine showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right-hand side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left-hand side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a top plan view of our design.



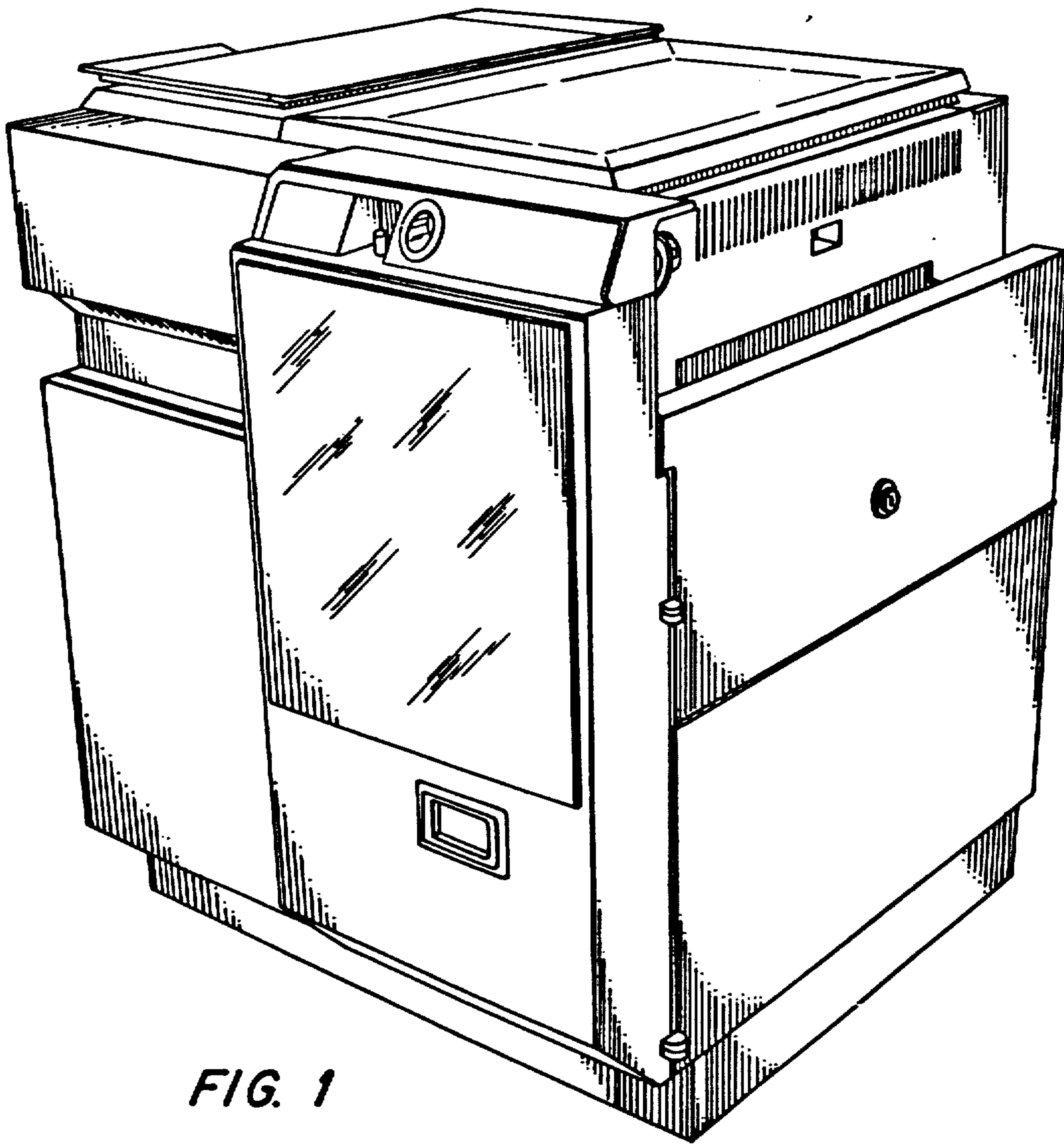

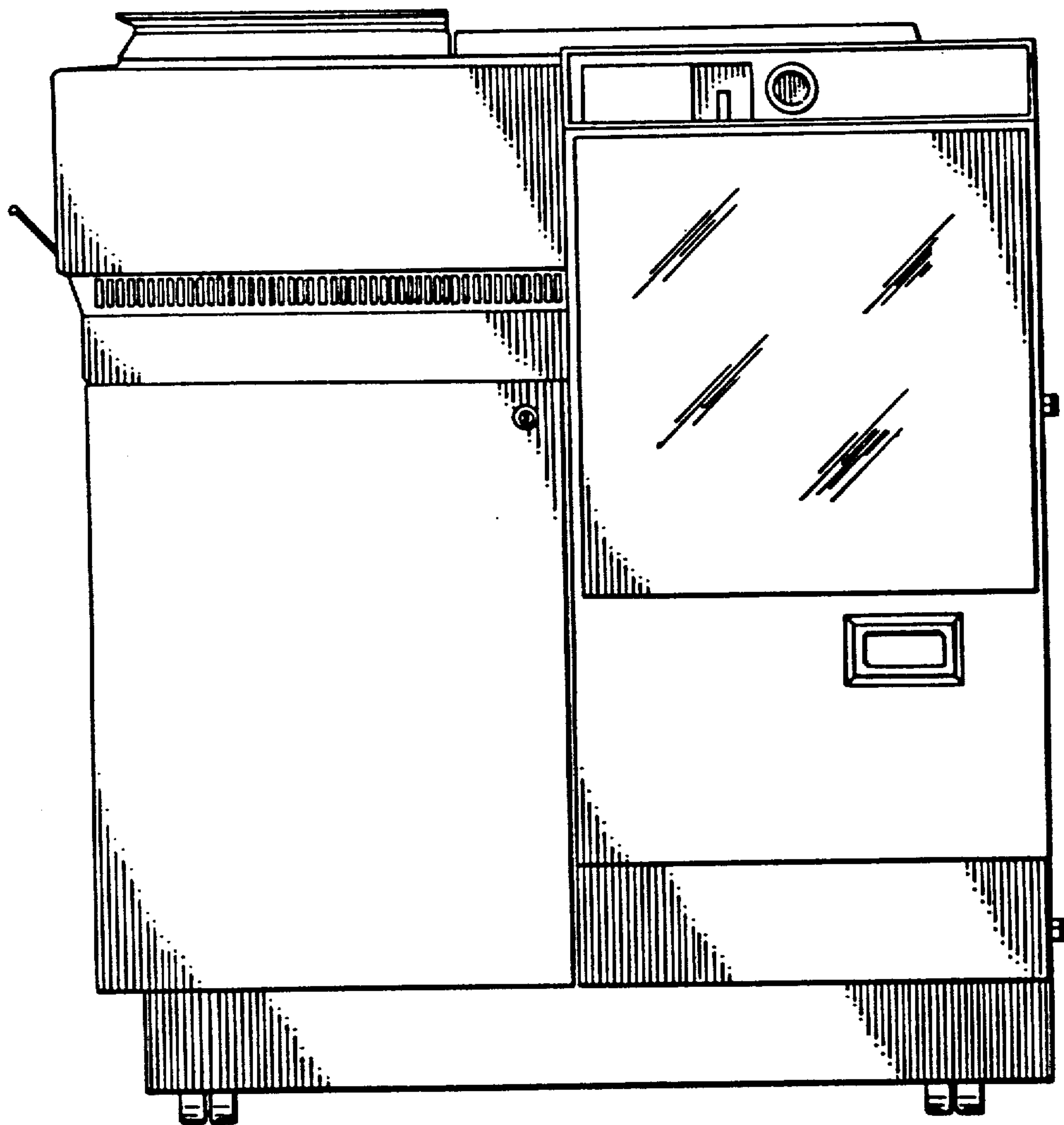

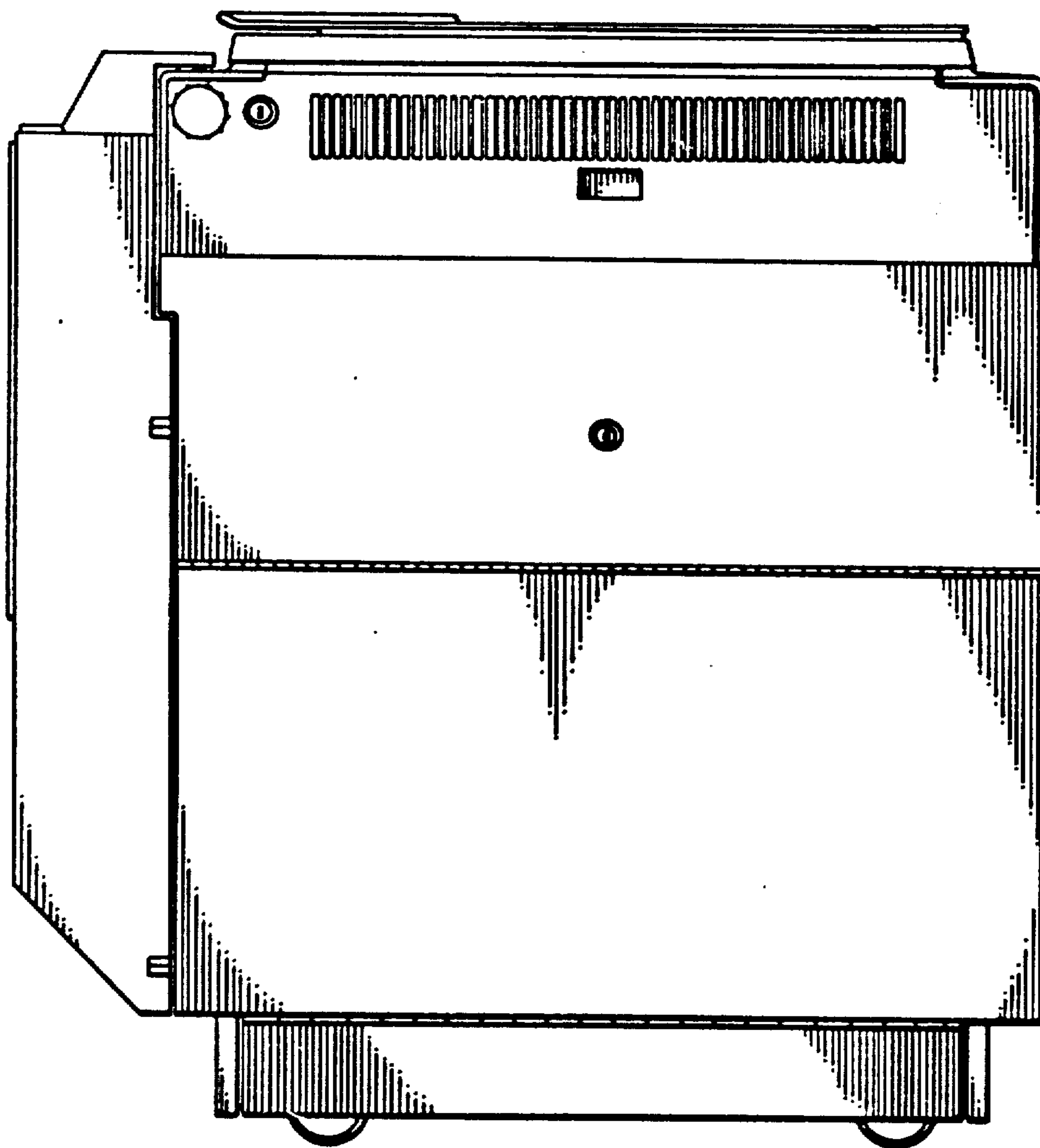

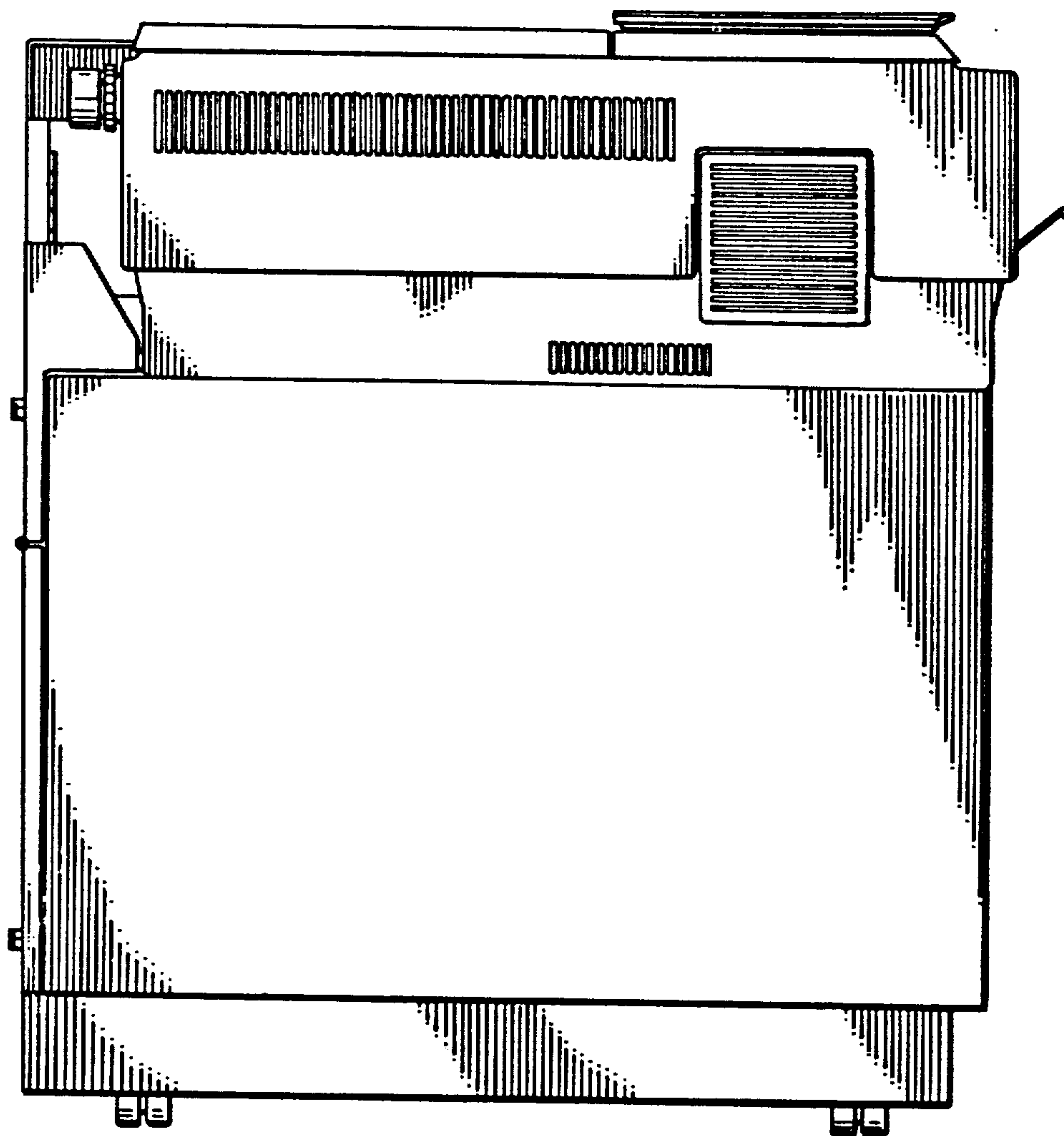

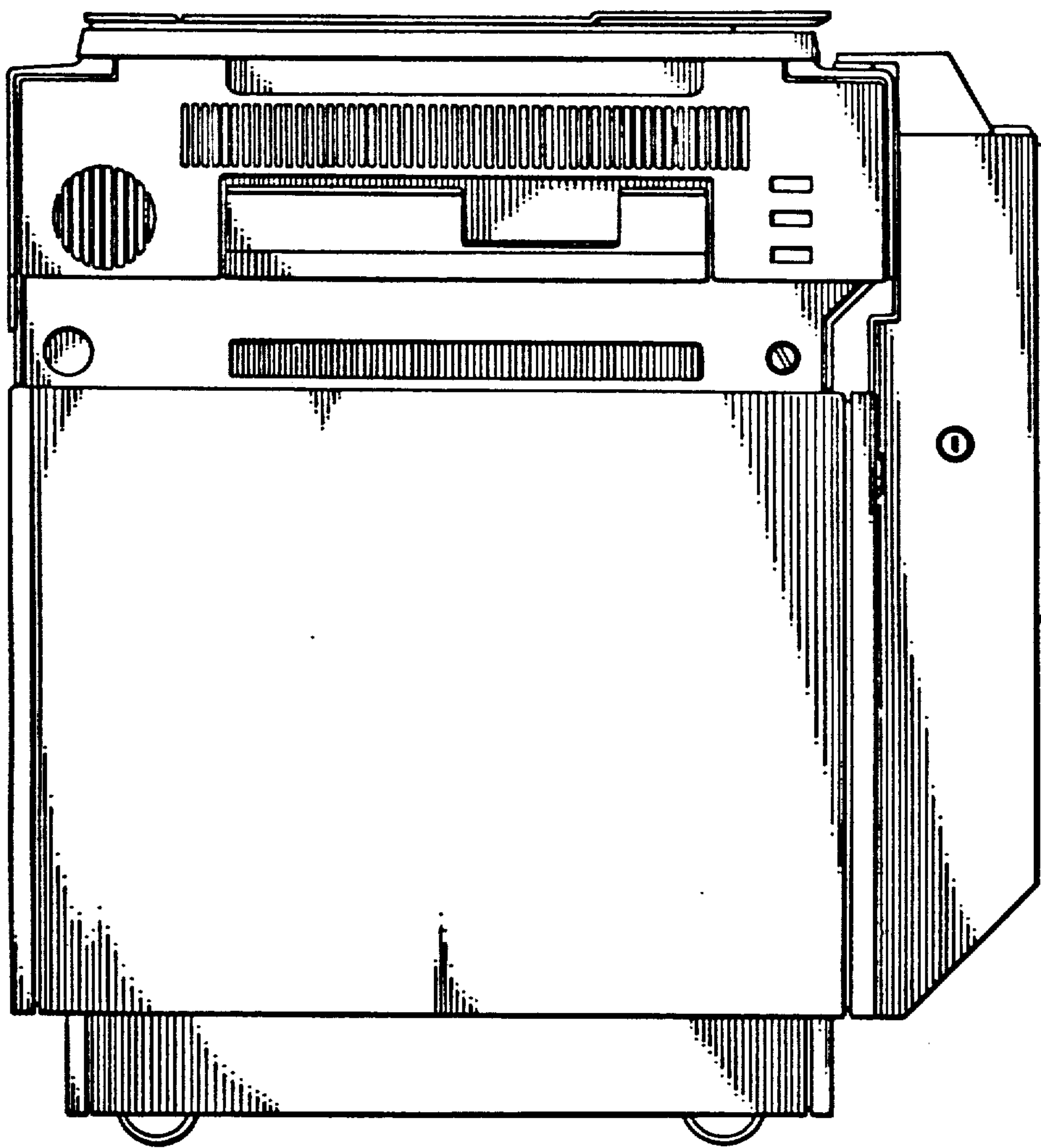

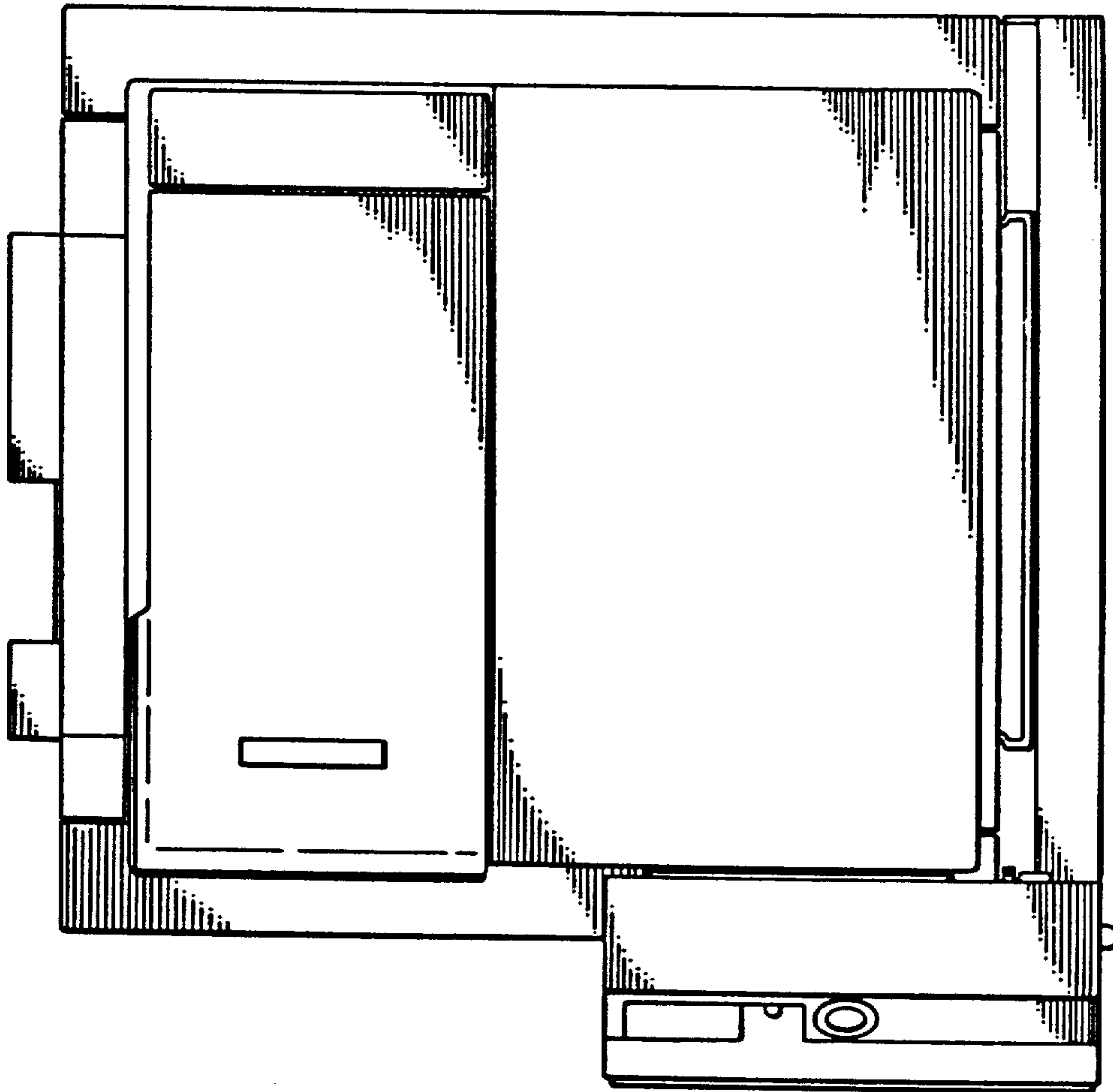
