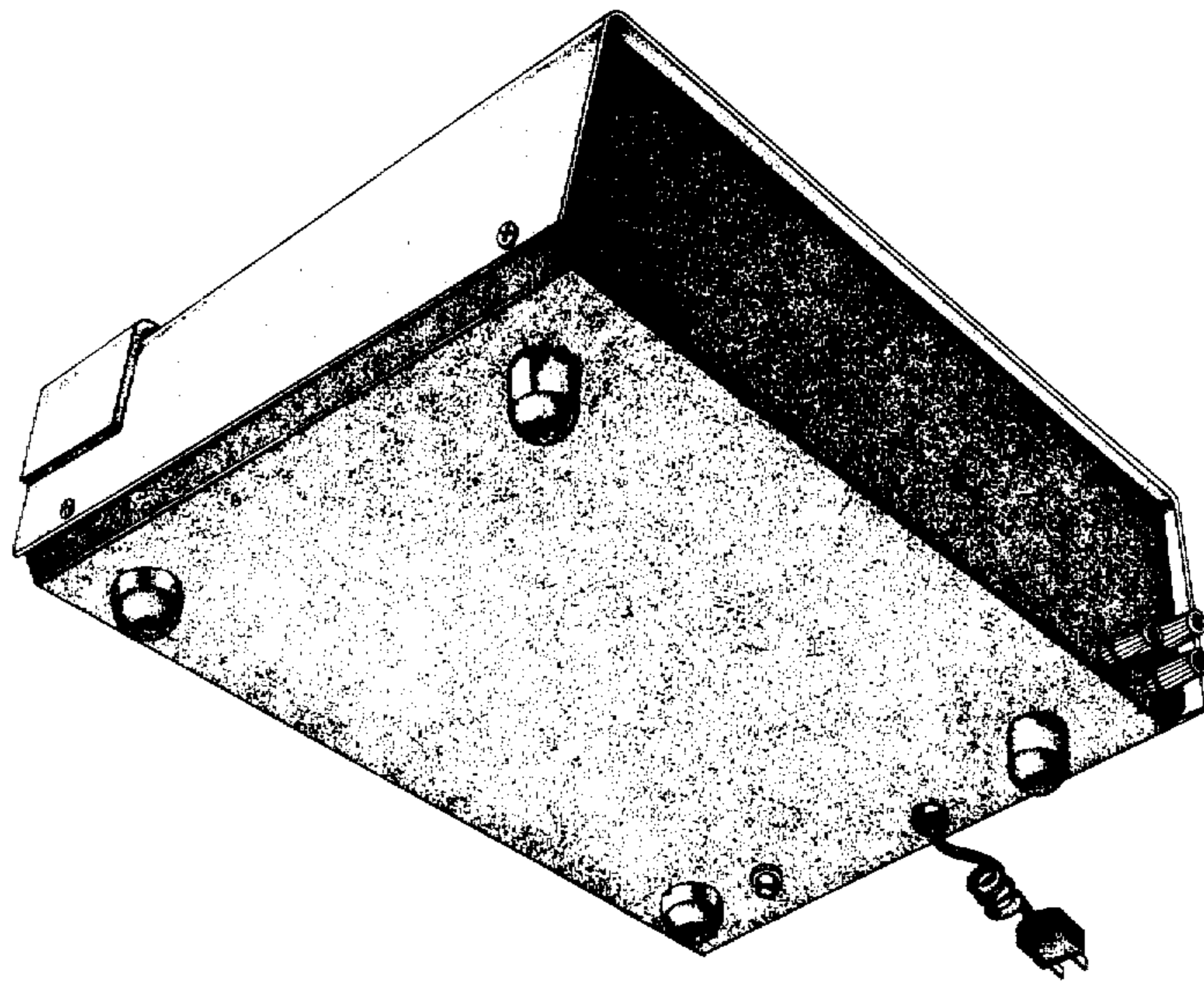
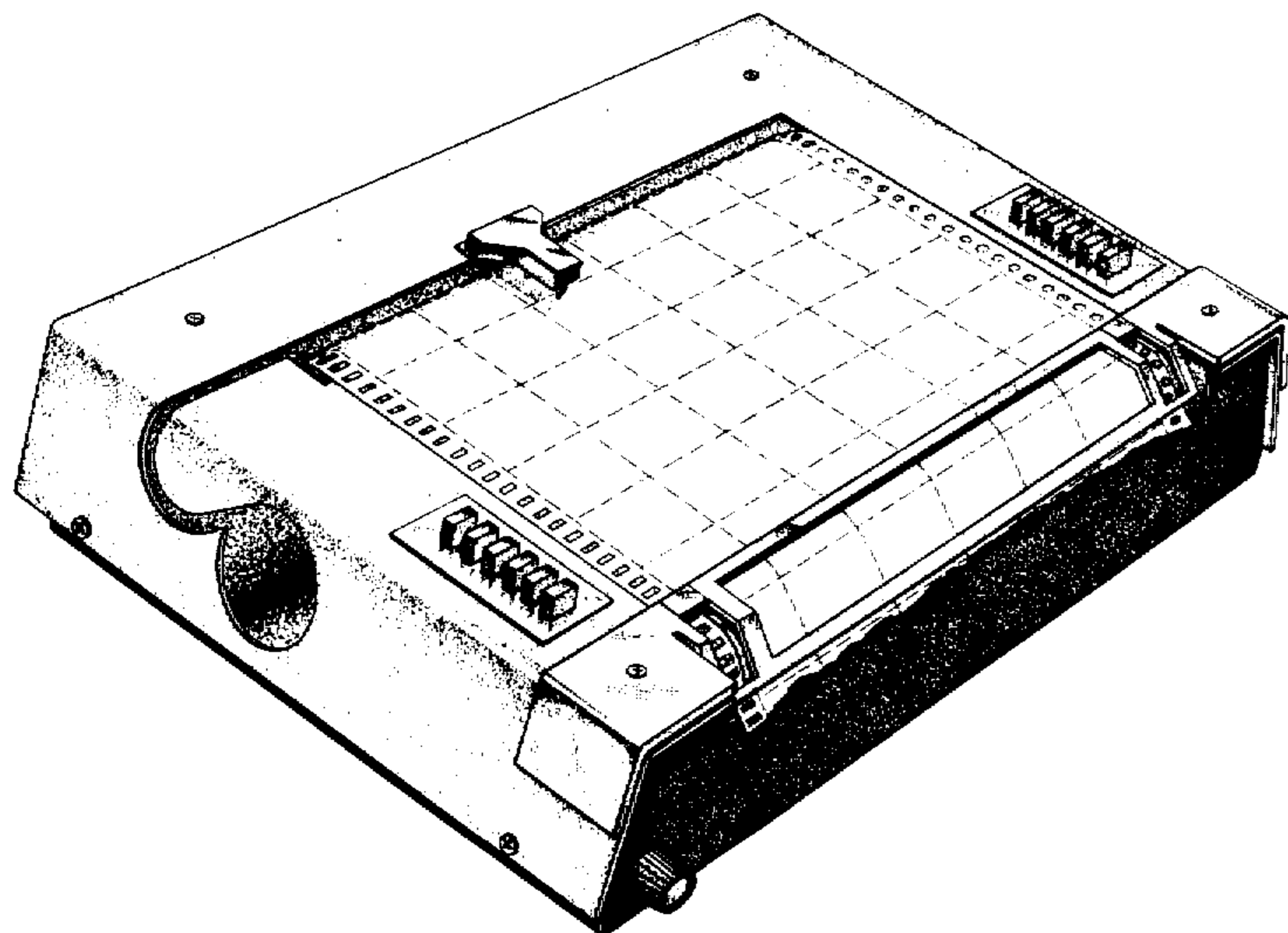
The ornamental design for a recording instrument, as shown and described.

The broken line showing of the chart in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only.



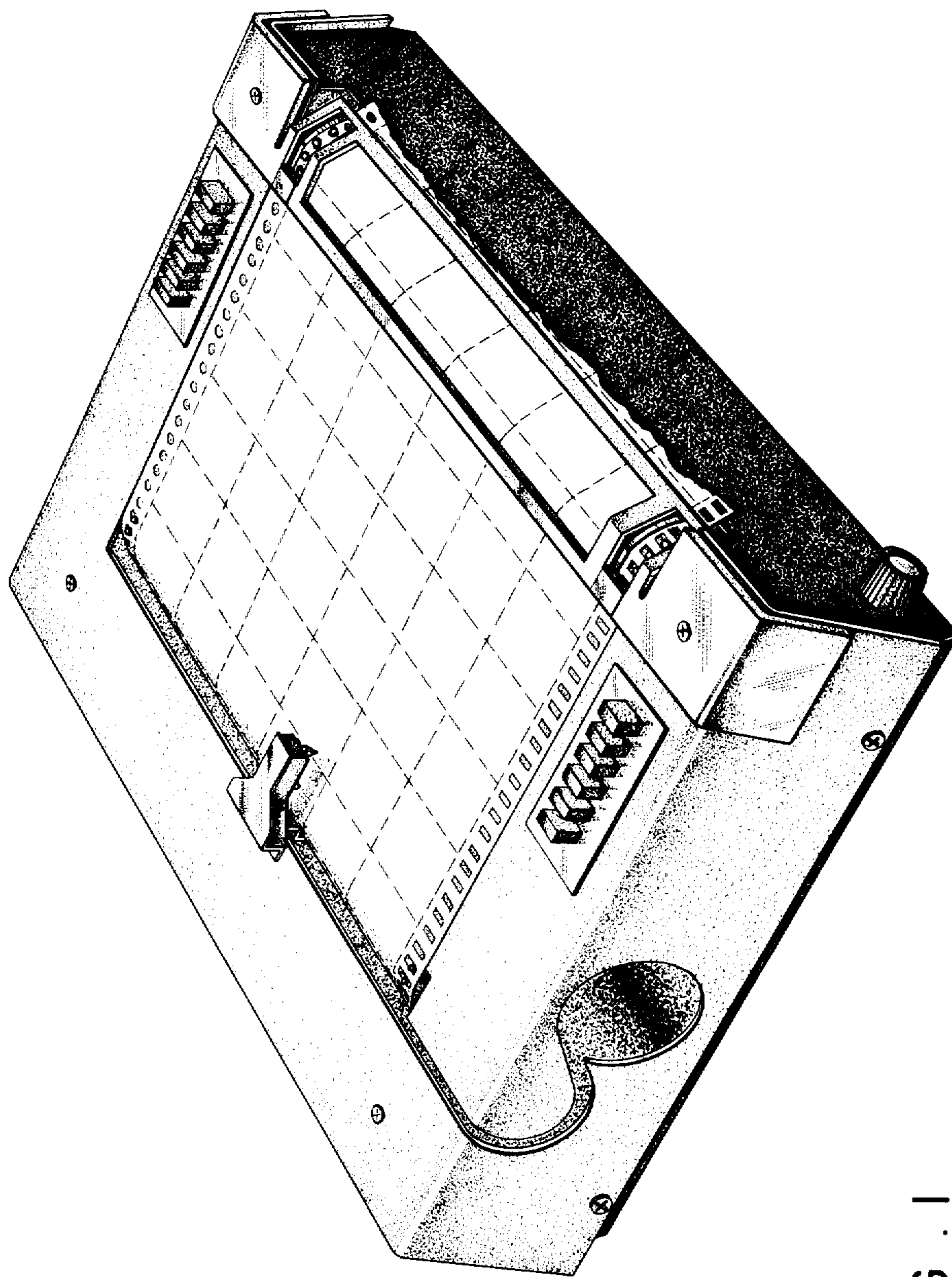

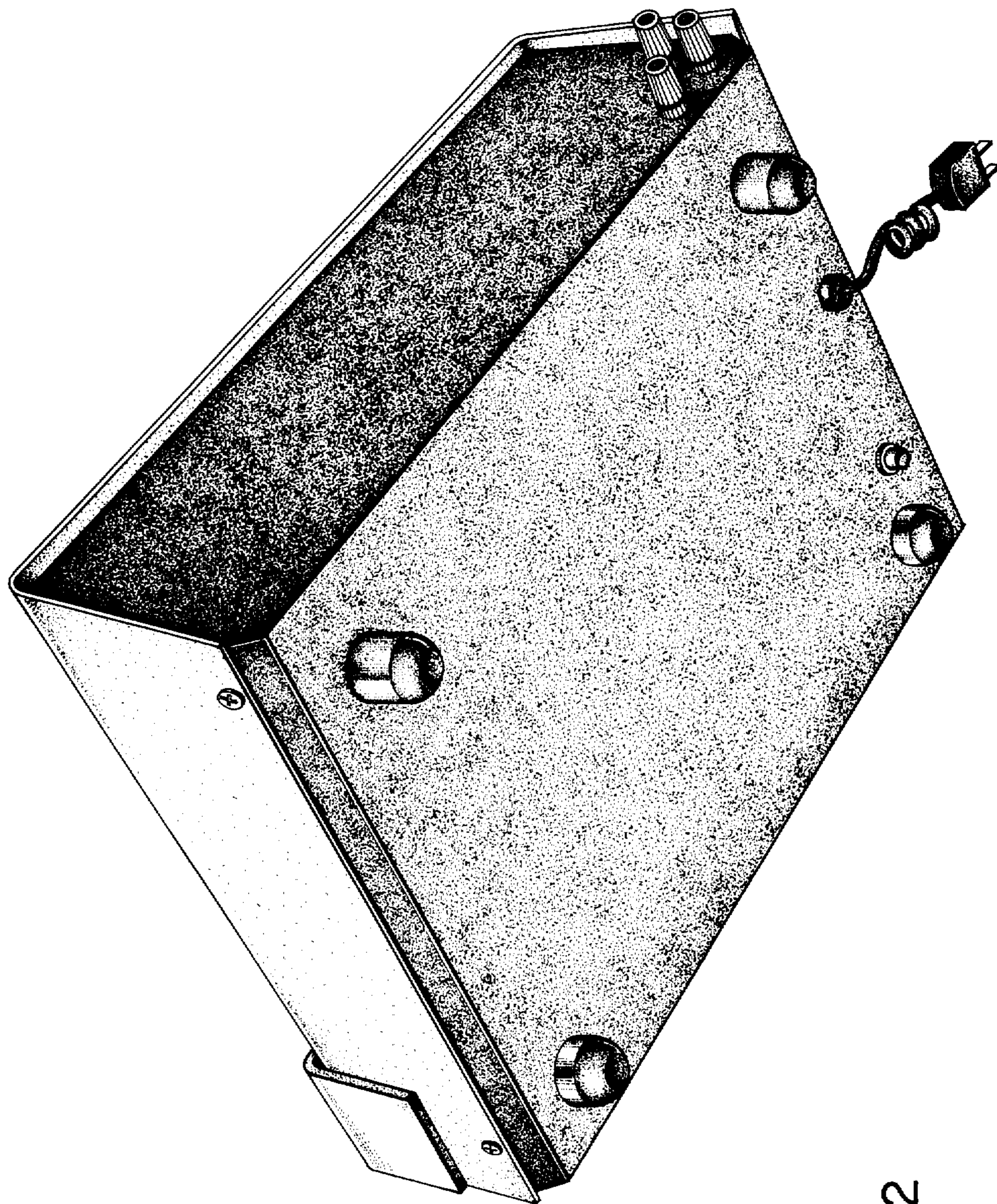
