[57] **CLAIM**

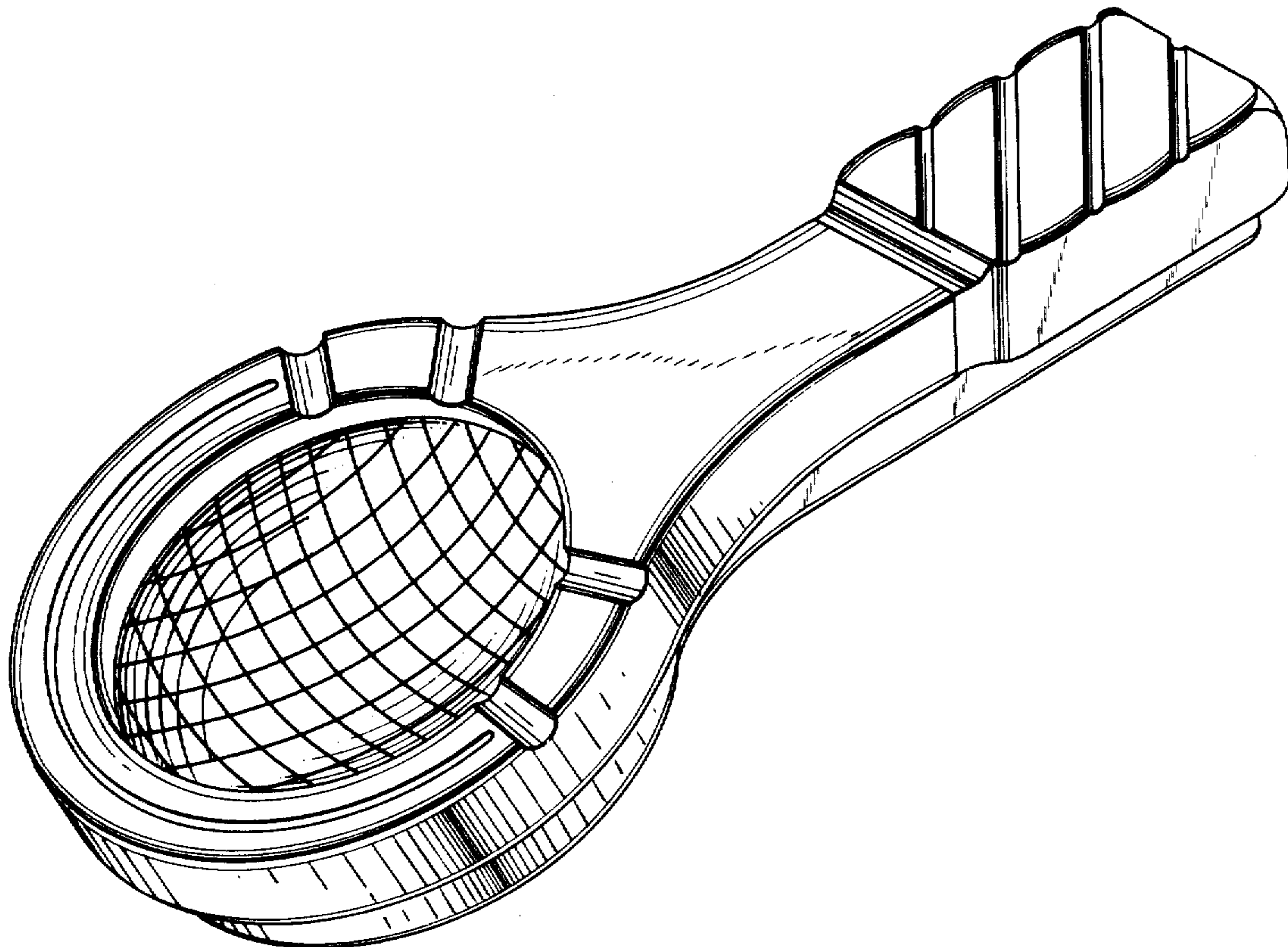
The ornamental design for an ashtray, substantially as shown.

FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof as viewed from the handle end.

The opposite side of the ashtray is a mirror image of the side shown, and the bottom is plain.



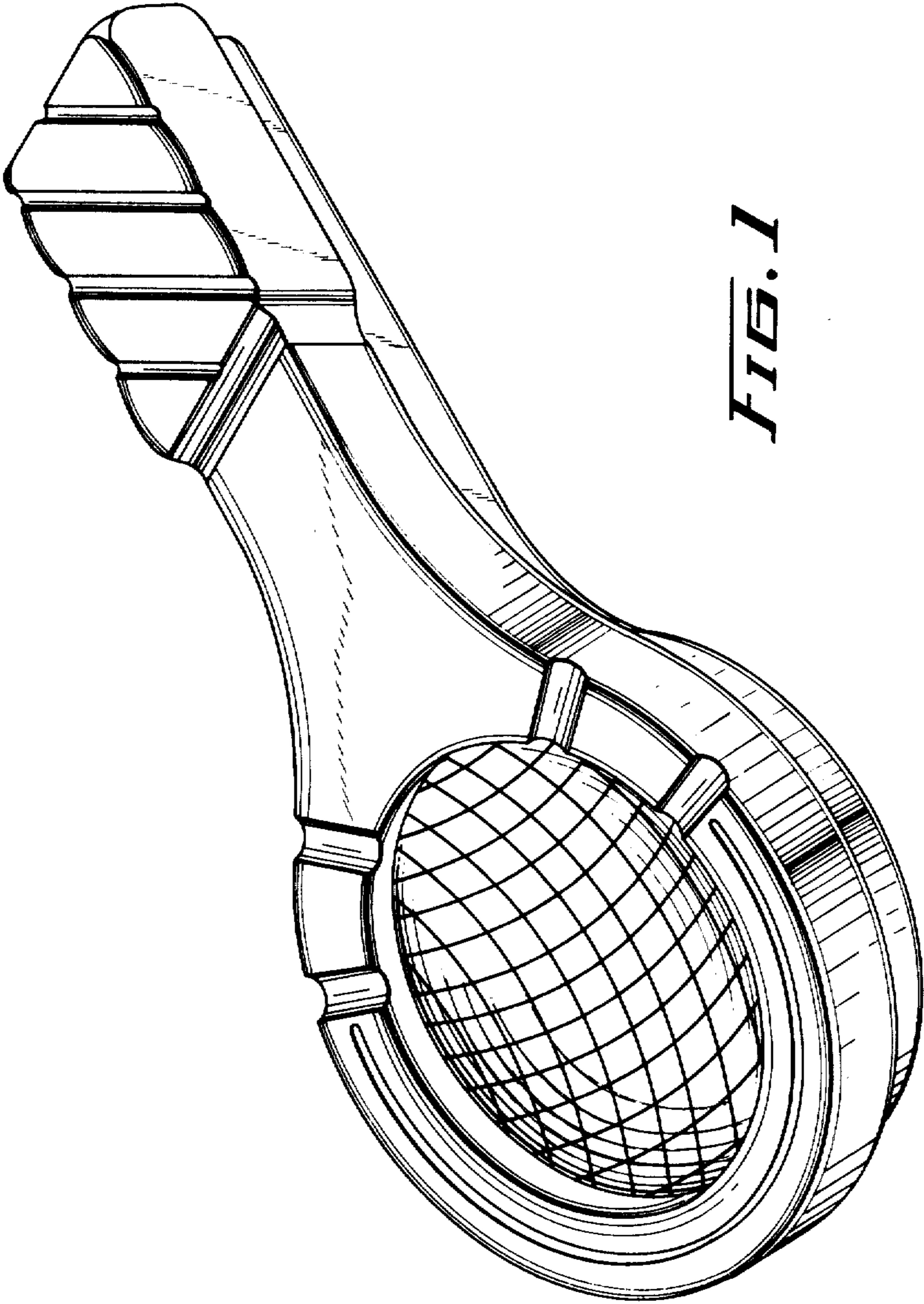
