[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a looking glass or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a looking glass or similar article, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view; FIG. 3 is front elevational view; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

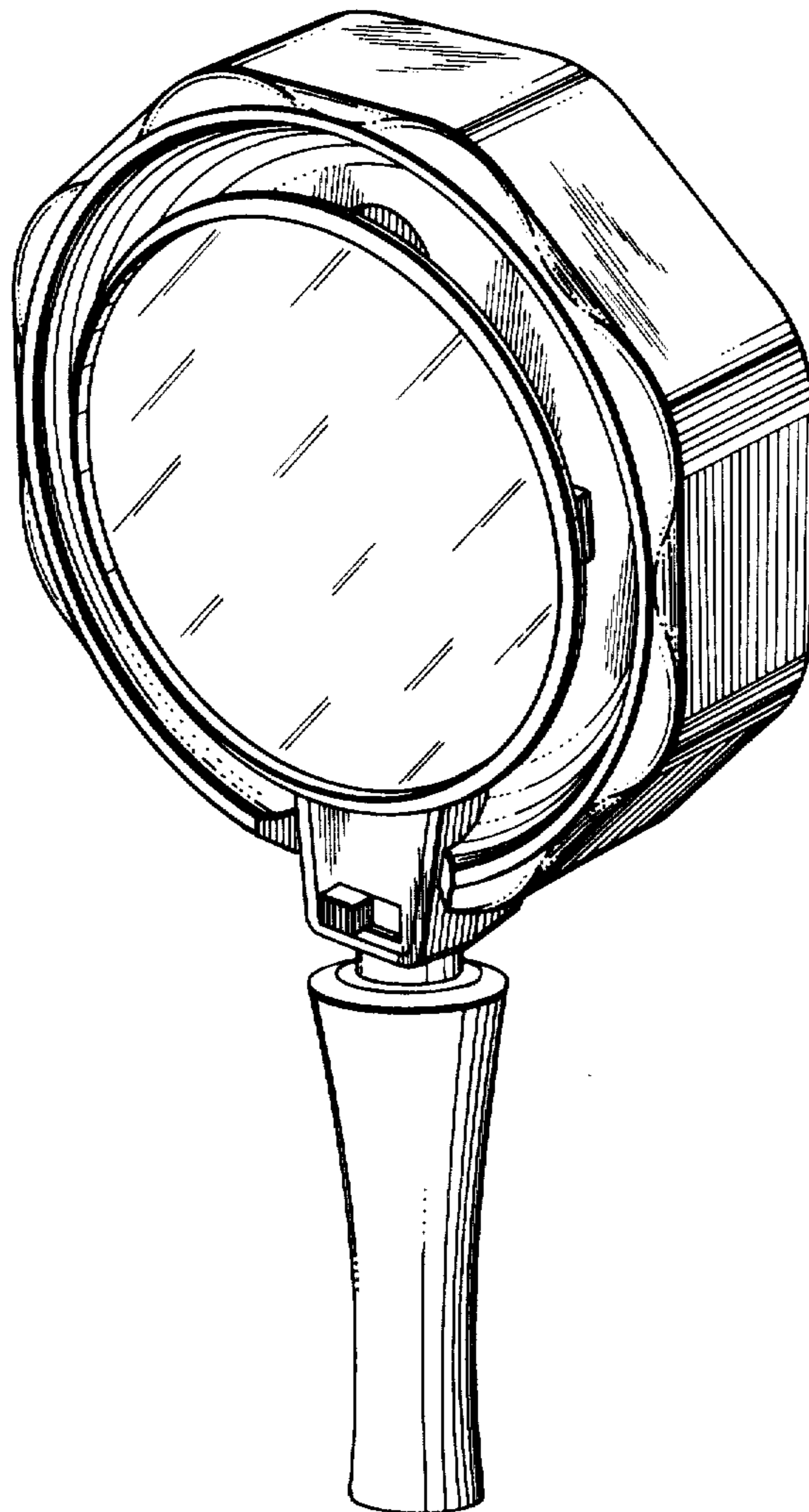

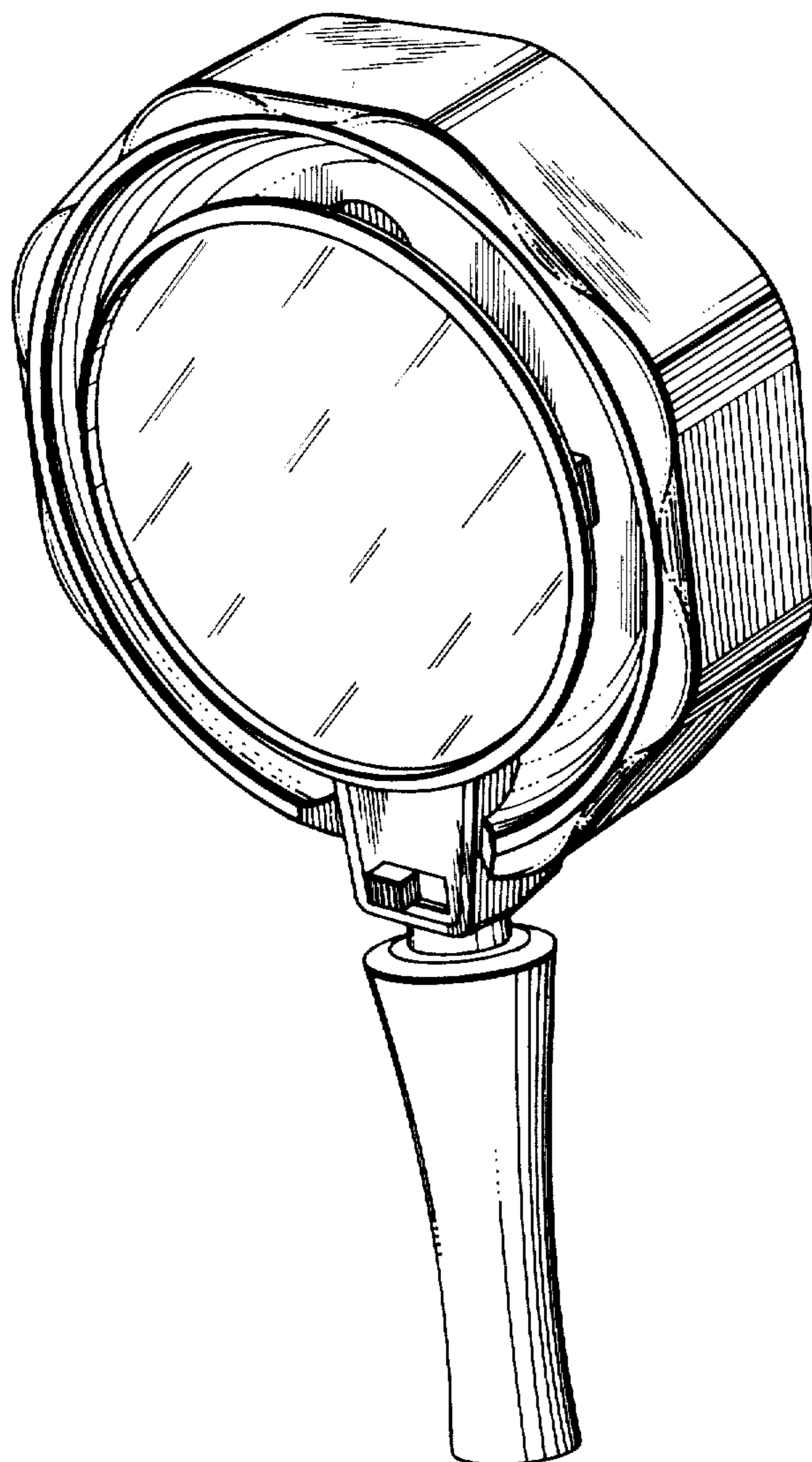

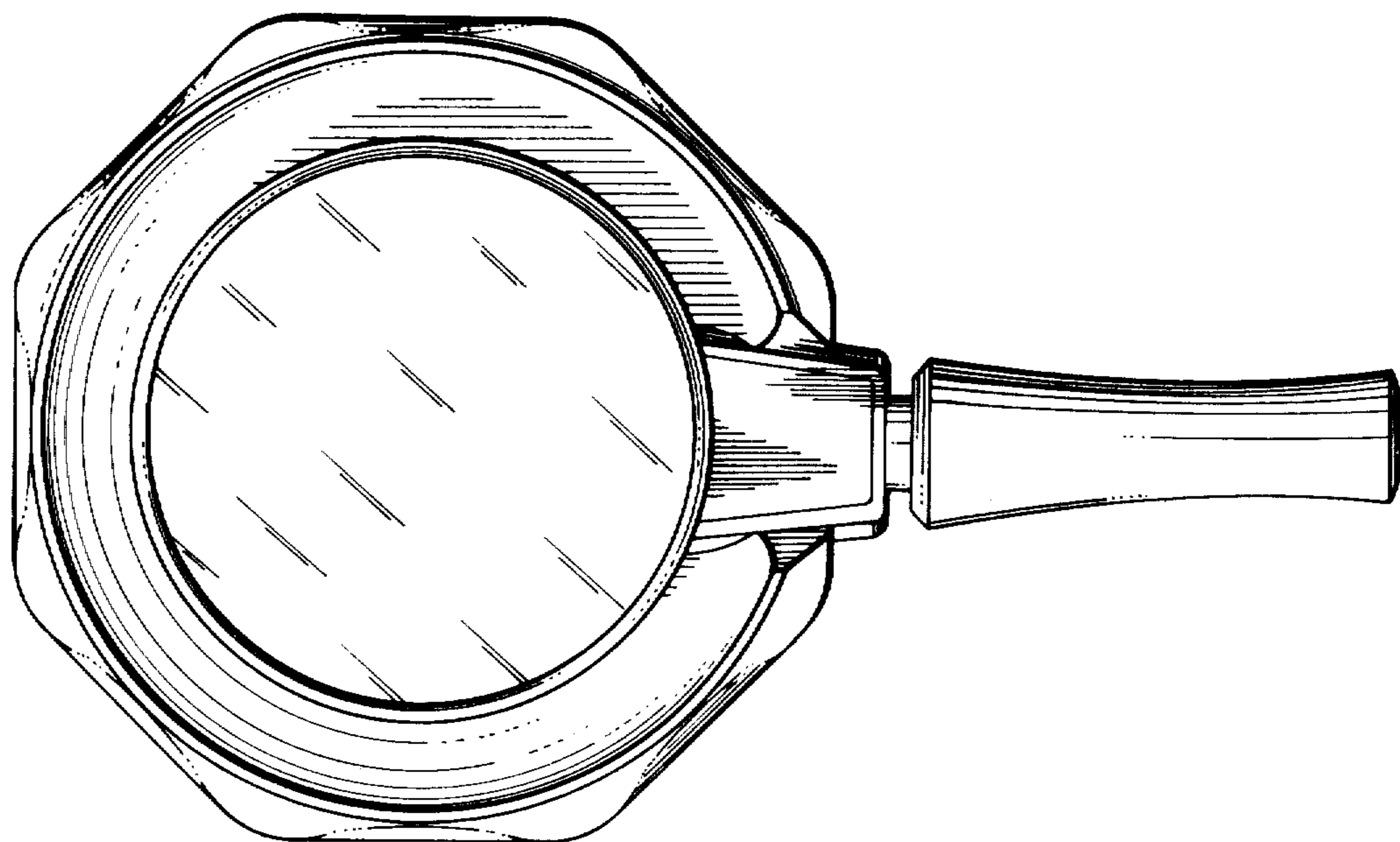

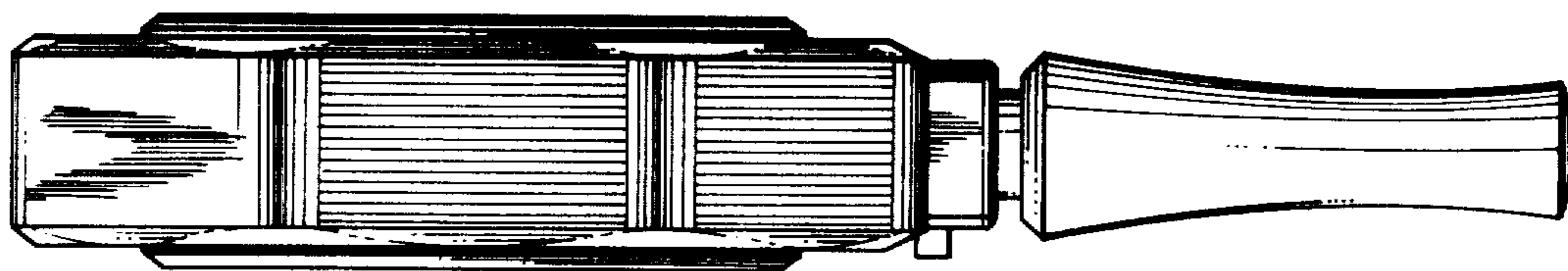

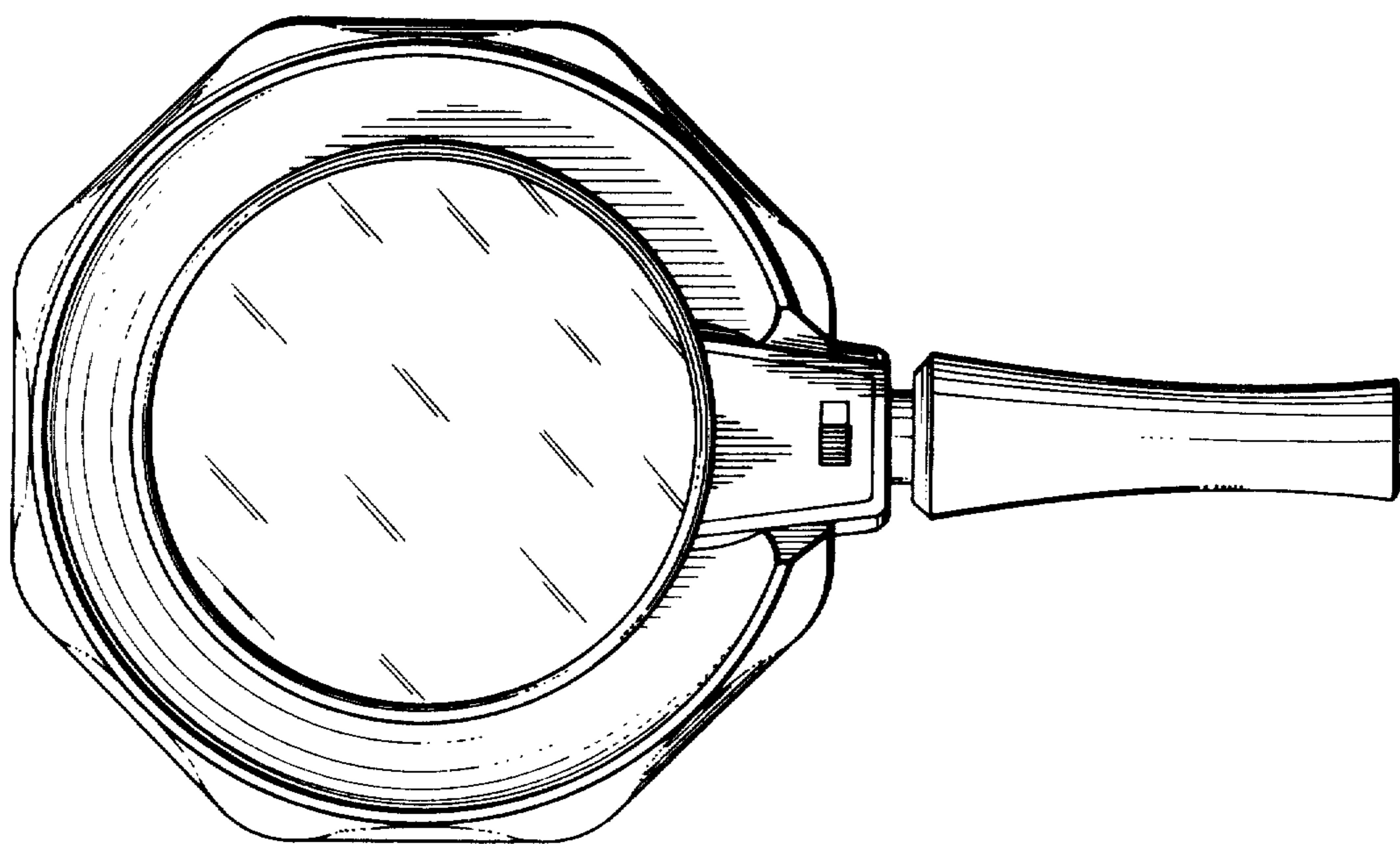
