FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bathtub tread showing my new design; and

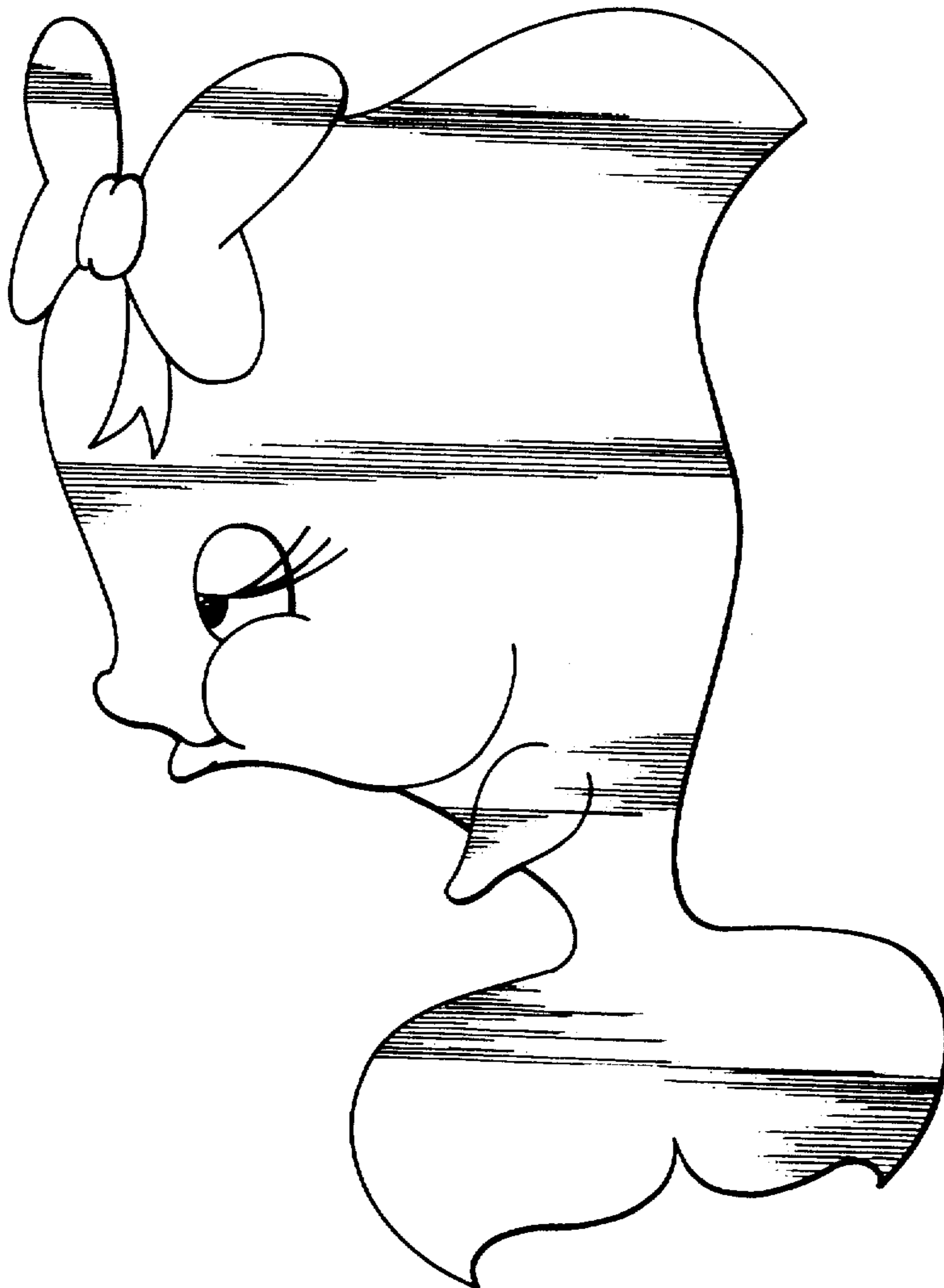
FIG. 2 is an edge elevational view thereof as seen from the bottom of FIG. 1.

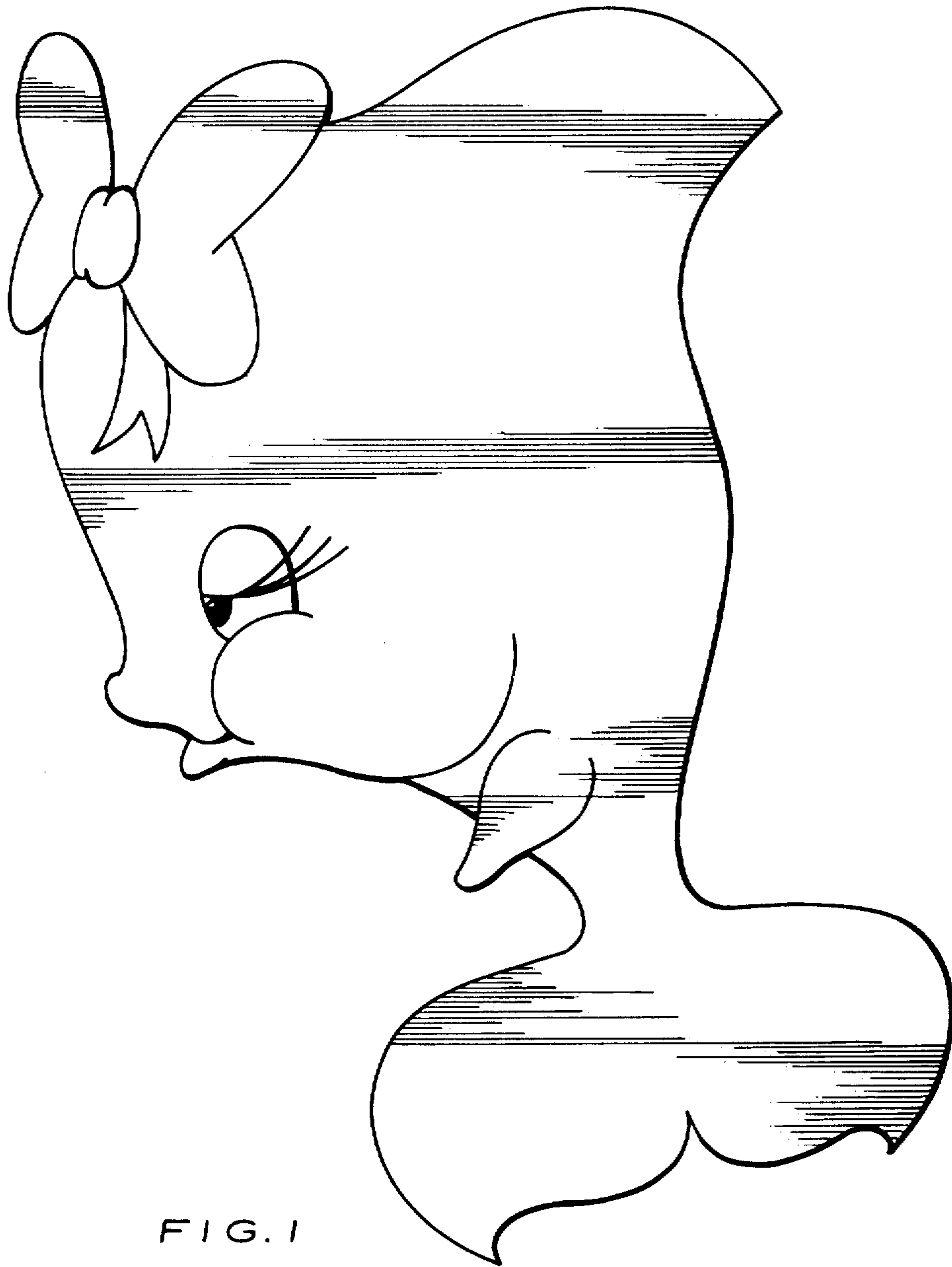

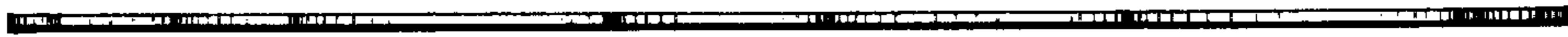
