[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a jar, or the like as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a jar or the like, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view, the side not shown being the same in appearance as the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on the line 3— 3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
