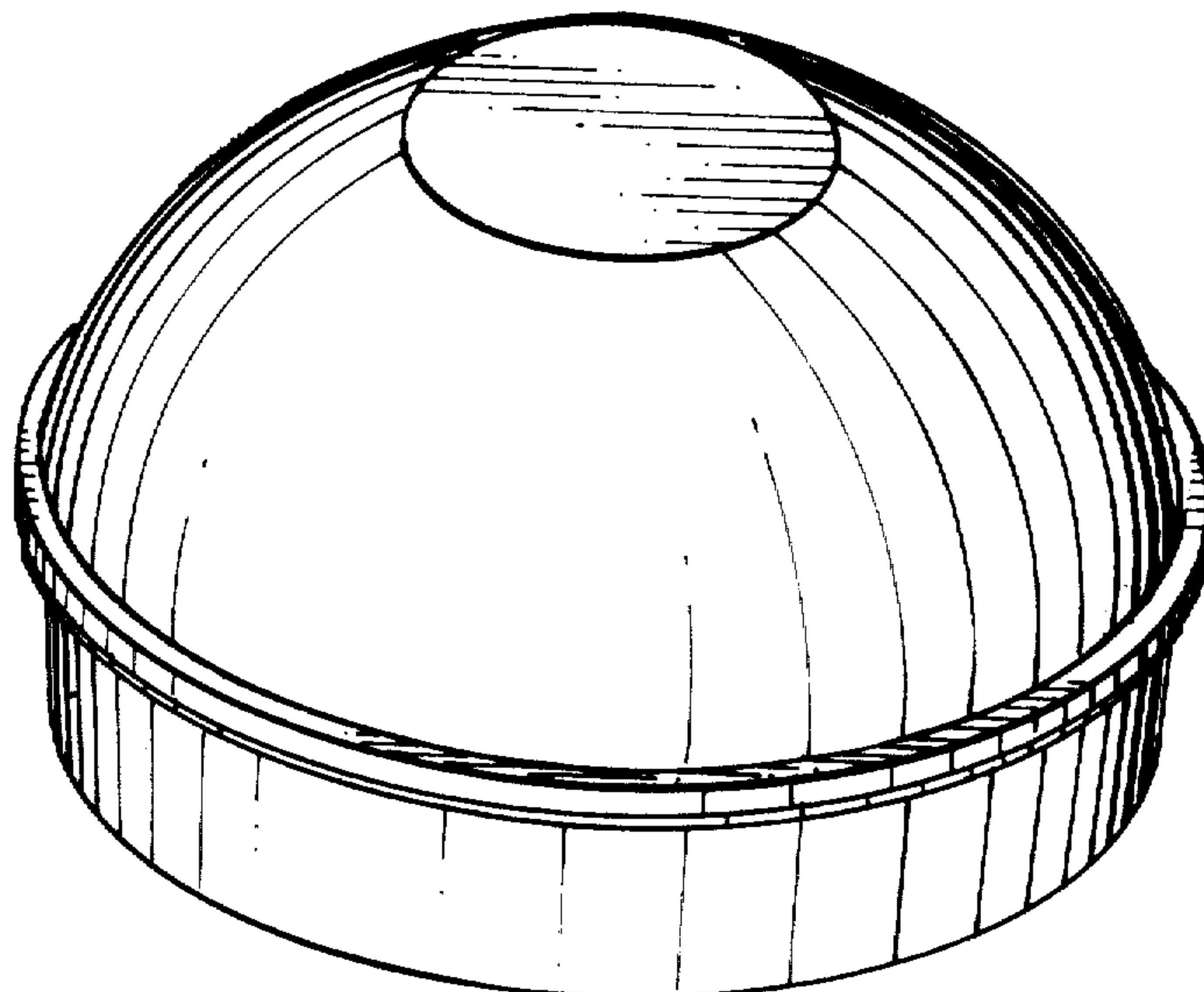

FIG. 4 is a top perspective view thereof.



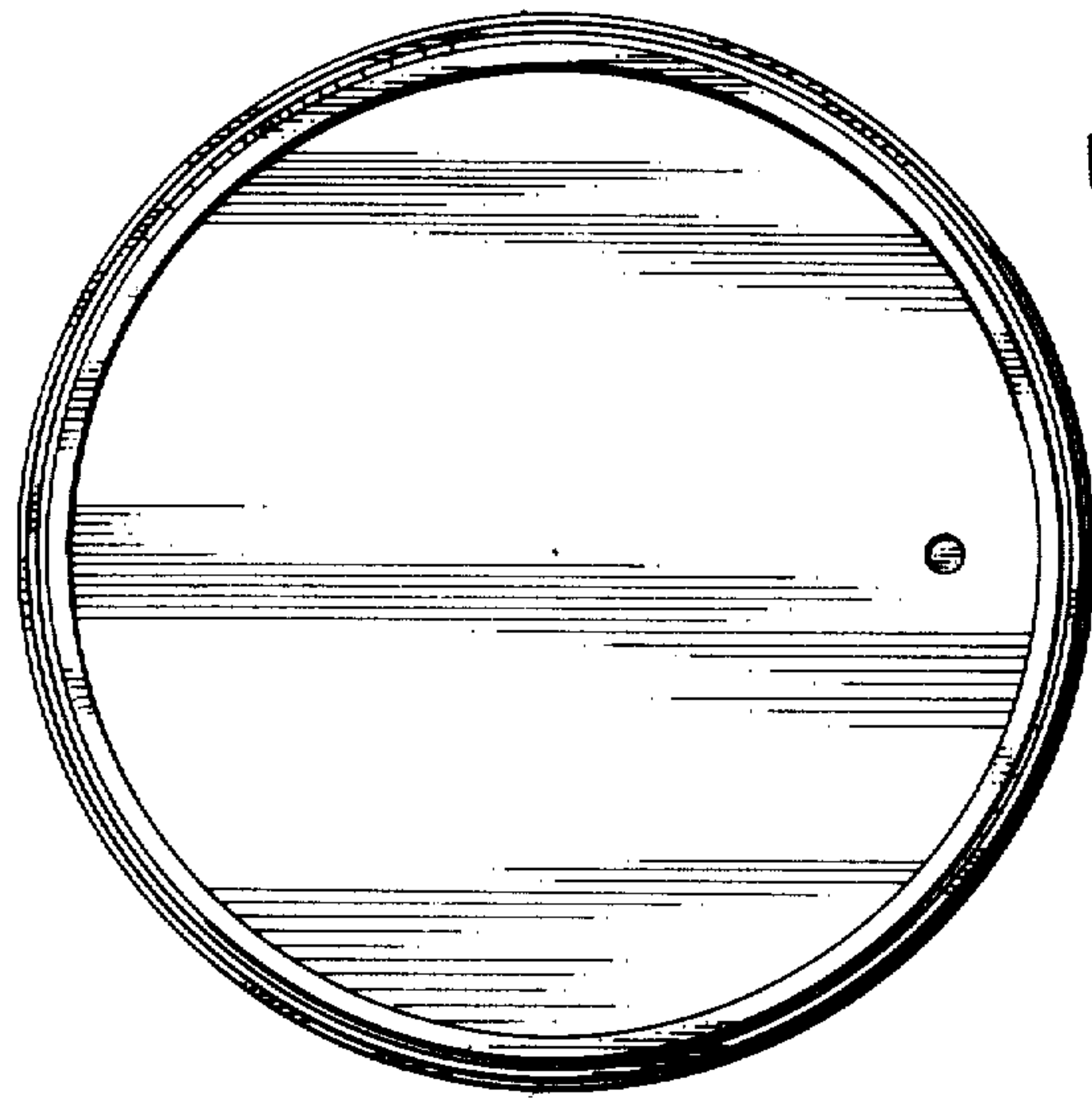

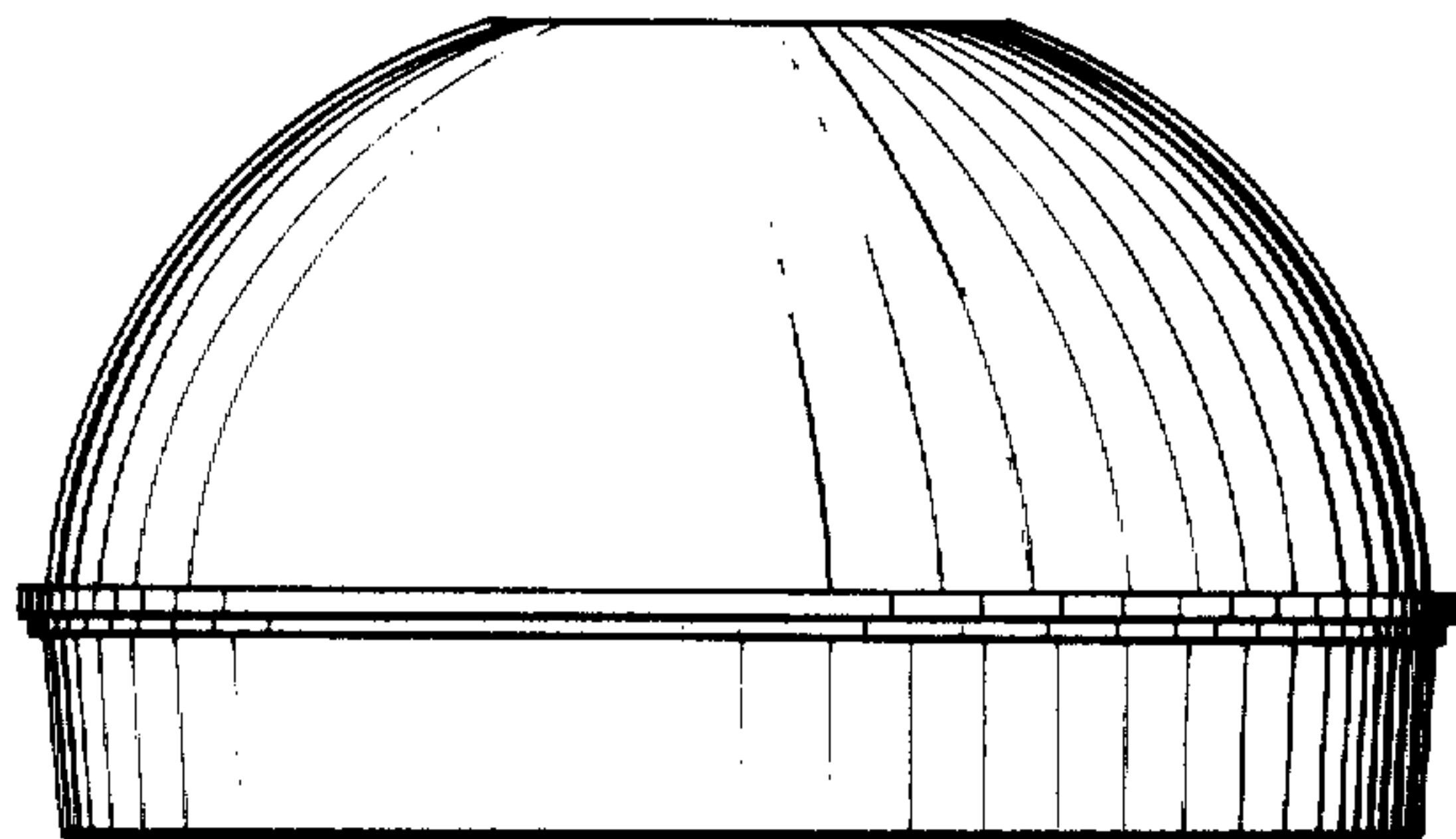

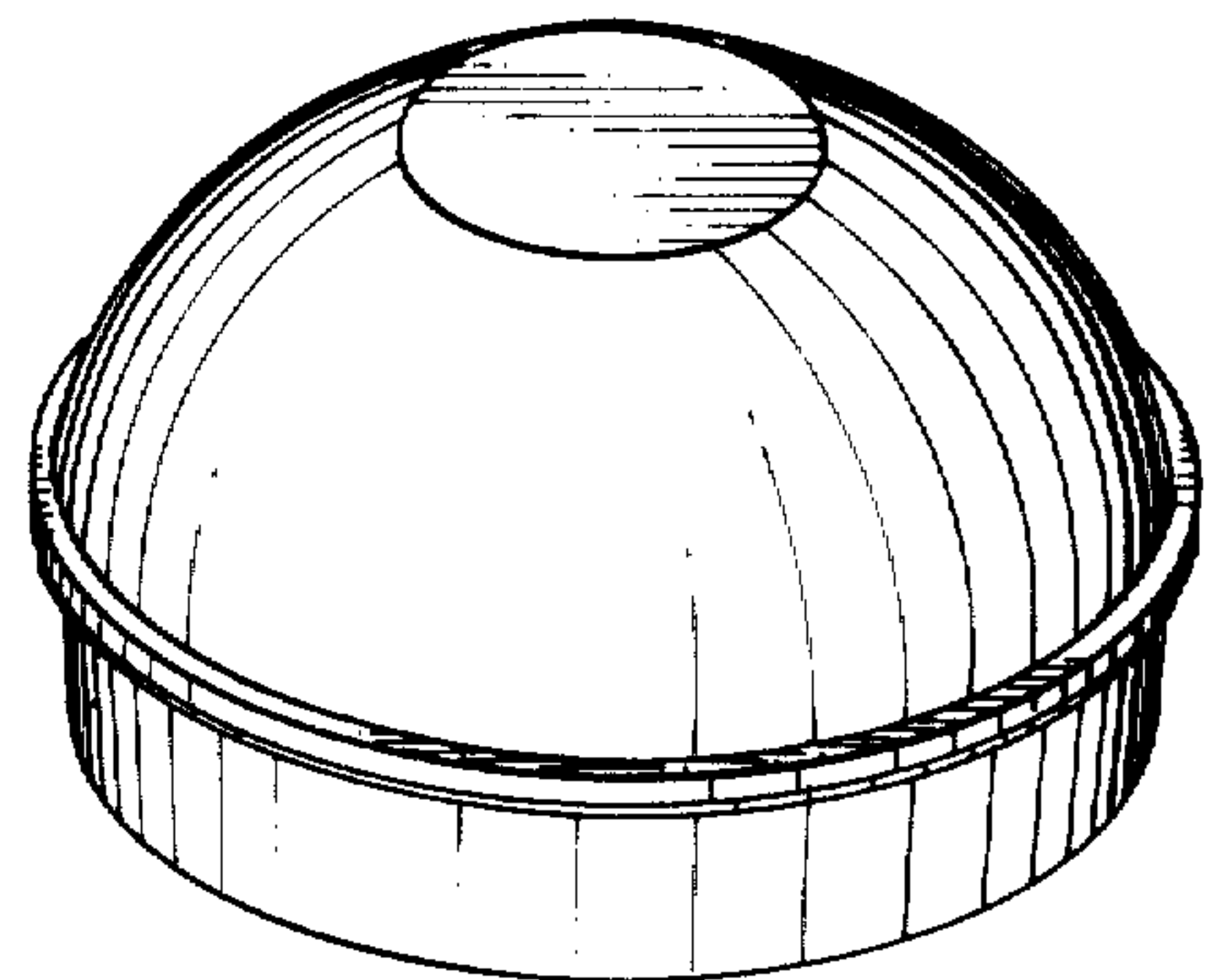

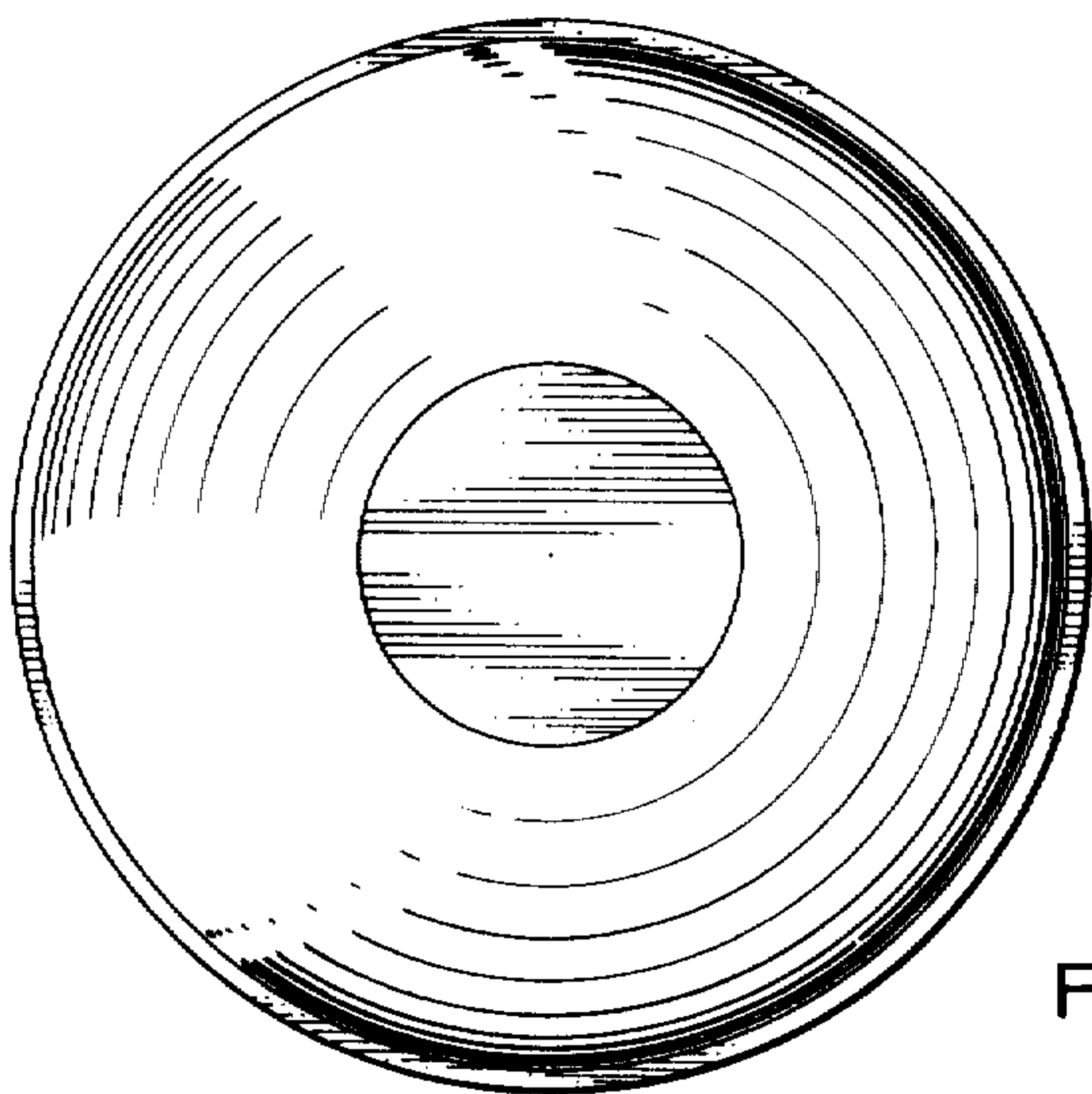
