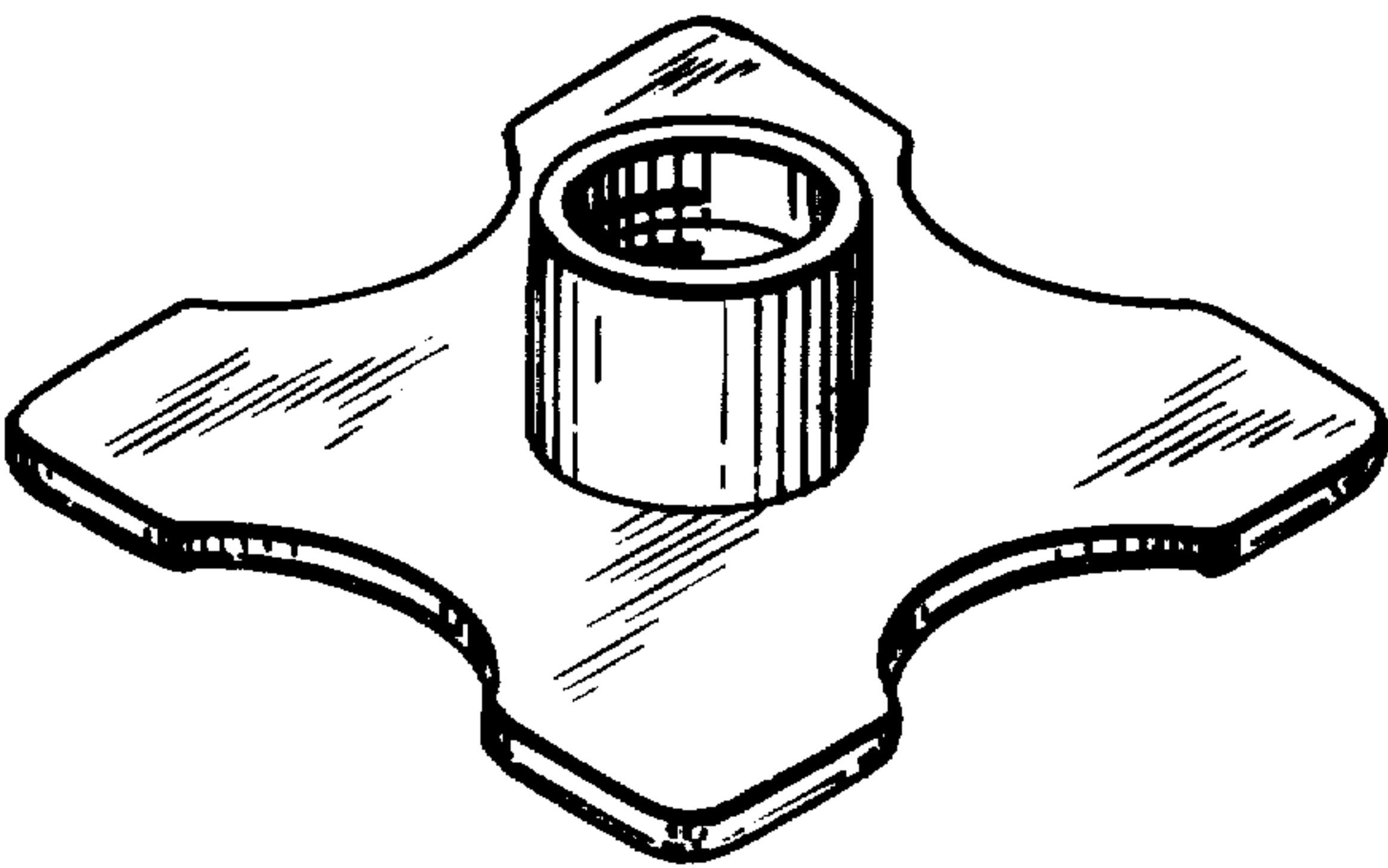

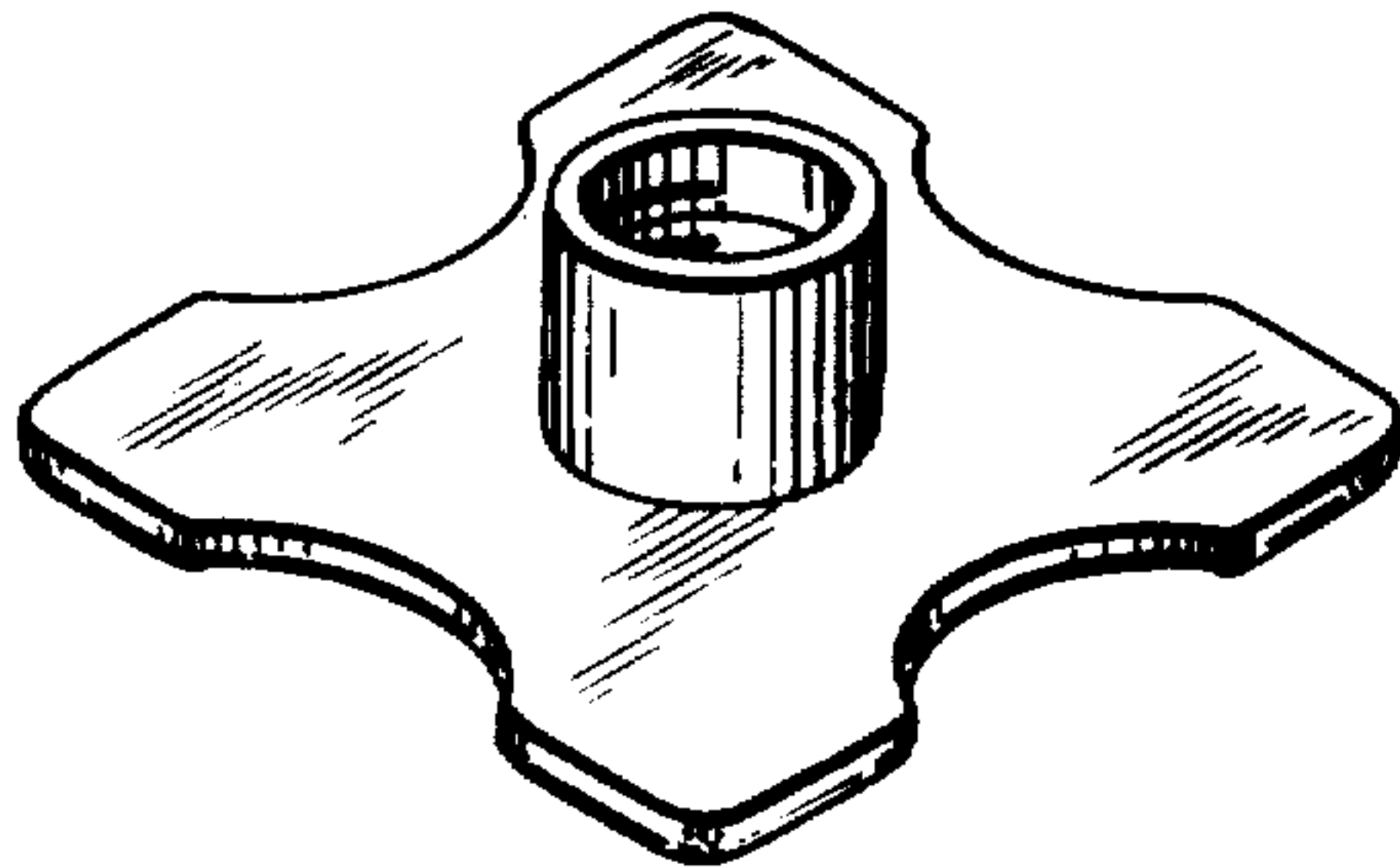
The ornamental design for a combined closure and support for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

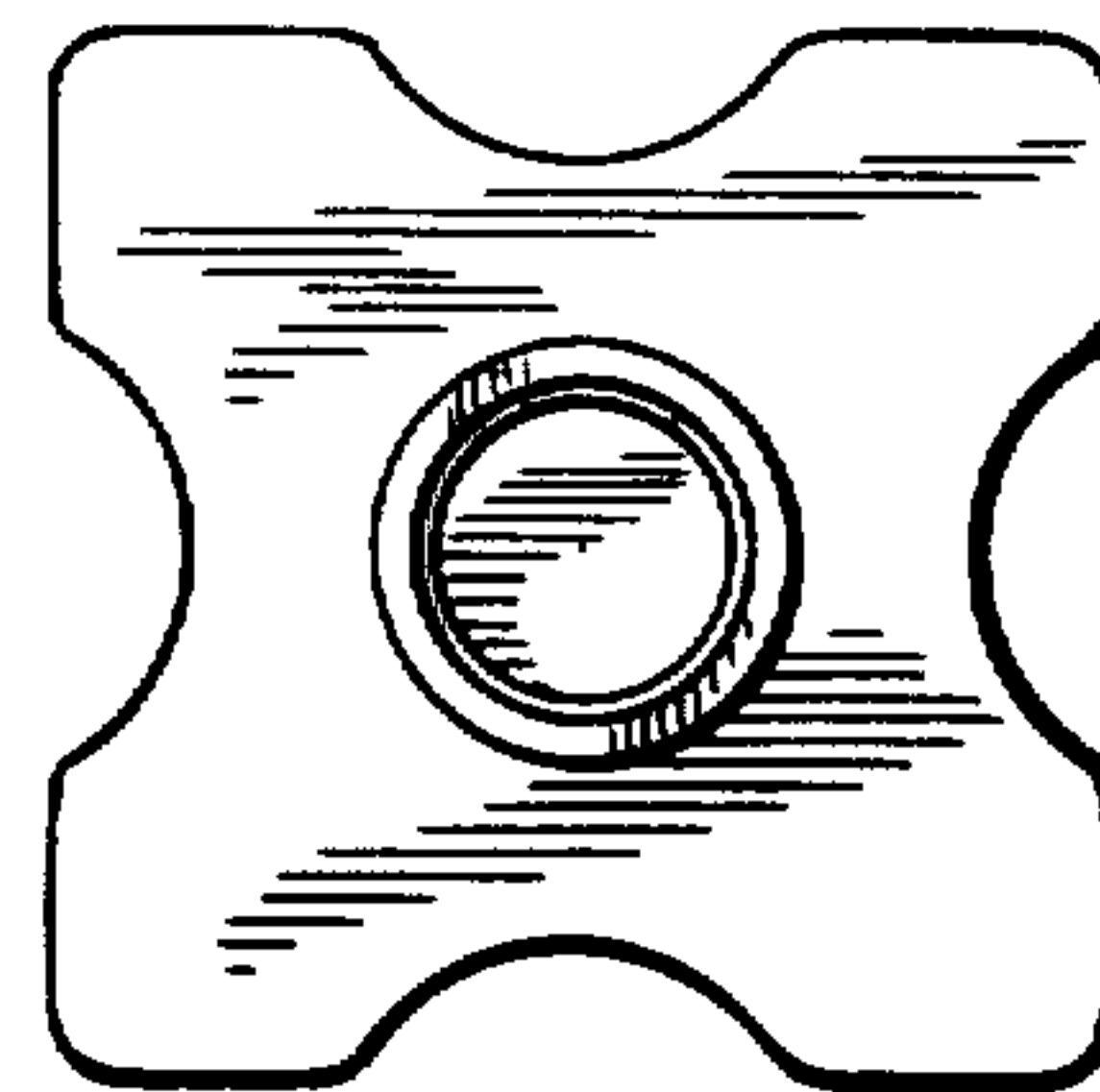

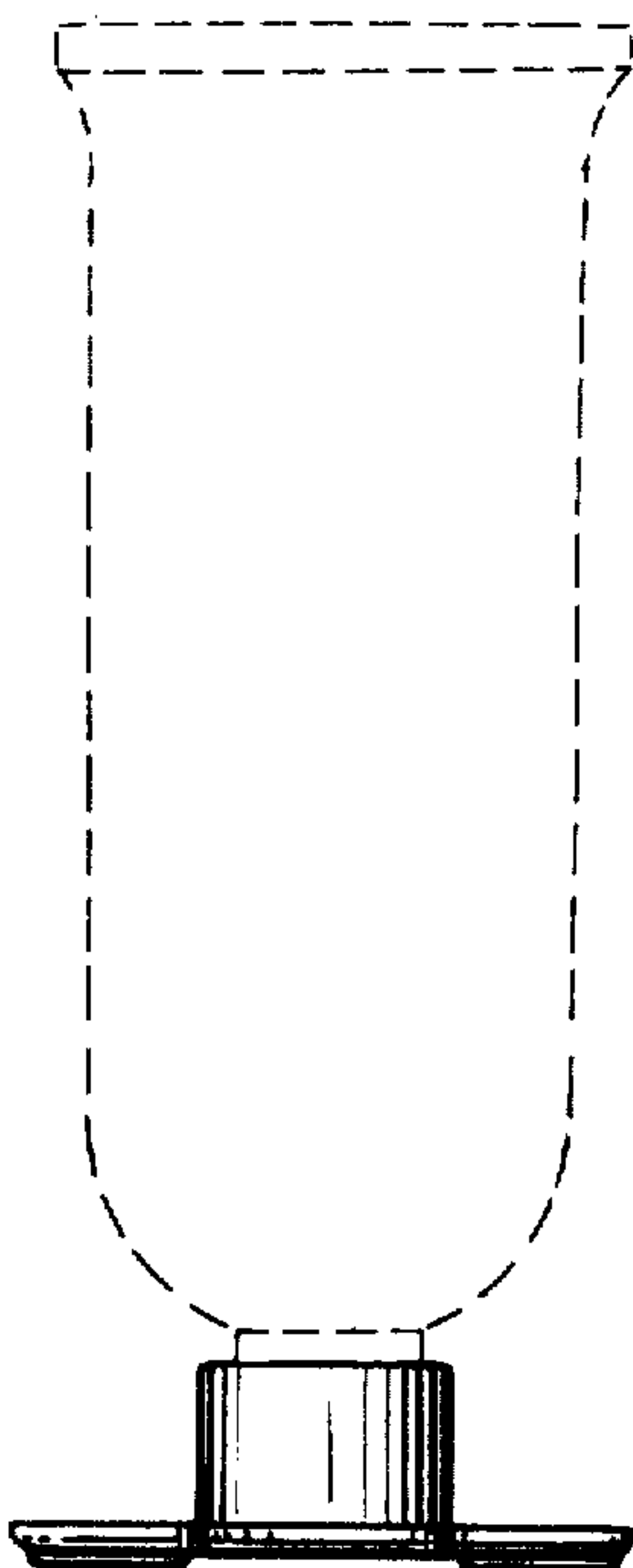
