
The ornamental design for a trunk compartment for an automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a rear side perspective view of a trunk compartment for an automobile showing my new design; the side opposite to that shown being a mirror image thereof; and

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.


