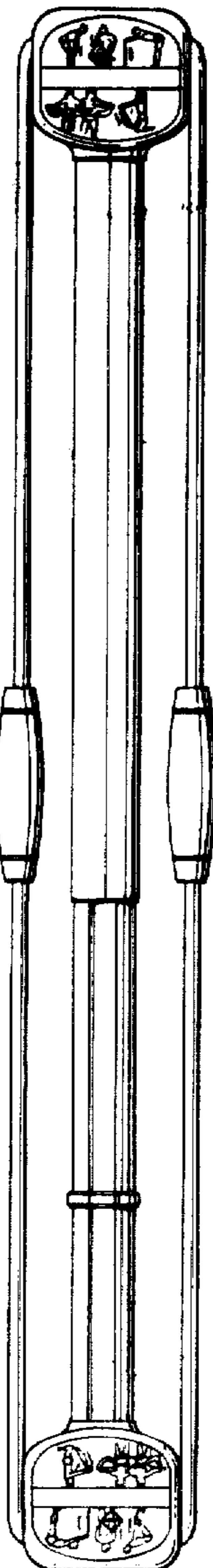

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a physical exerciser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a physical exerciser showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the handle member of FIG. 1, shown in an enlarged scale partially in fragment.



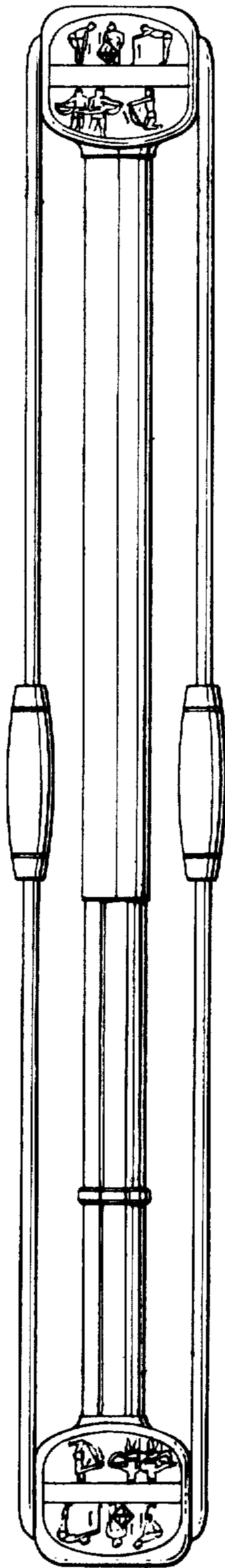

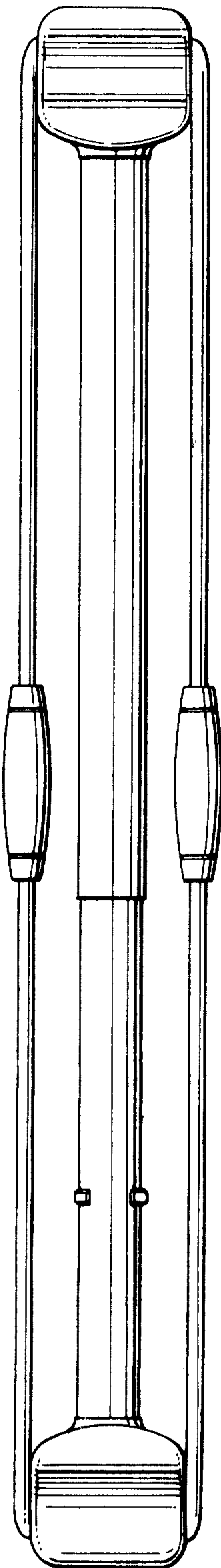

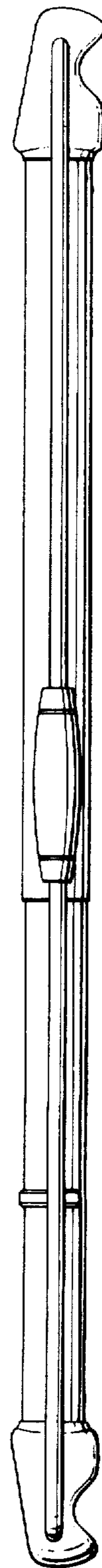

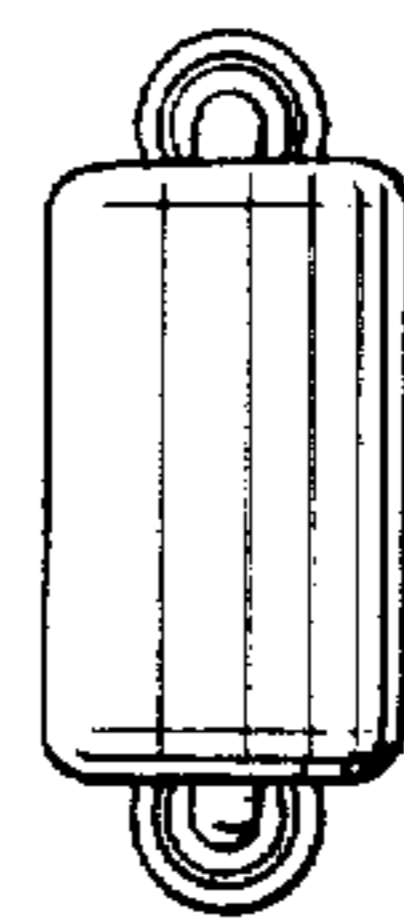
