DESCRIPTION


FIG 1 is a side elevational view of a game playing piece showing my new design, a portion of which is shown fragmentarily for convenience of illustration.


FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of a game playing piece.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a game playing piece.


FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a game playing piece.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a game playing piece.







