FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a doll house showing my new design;

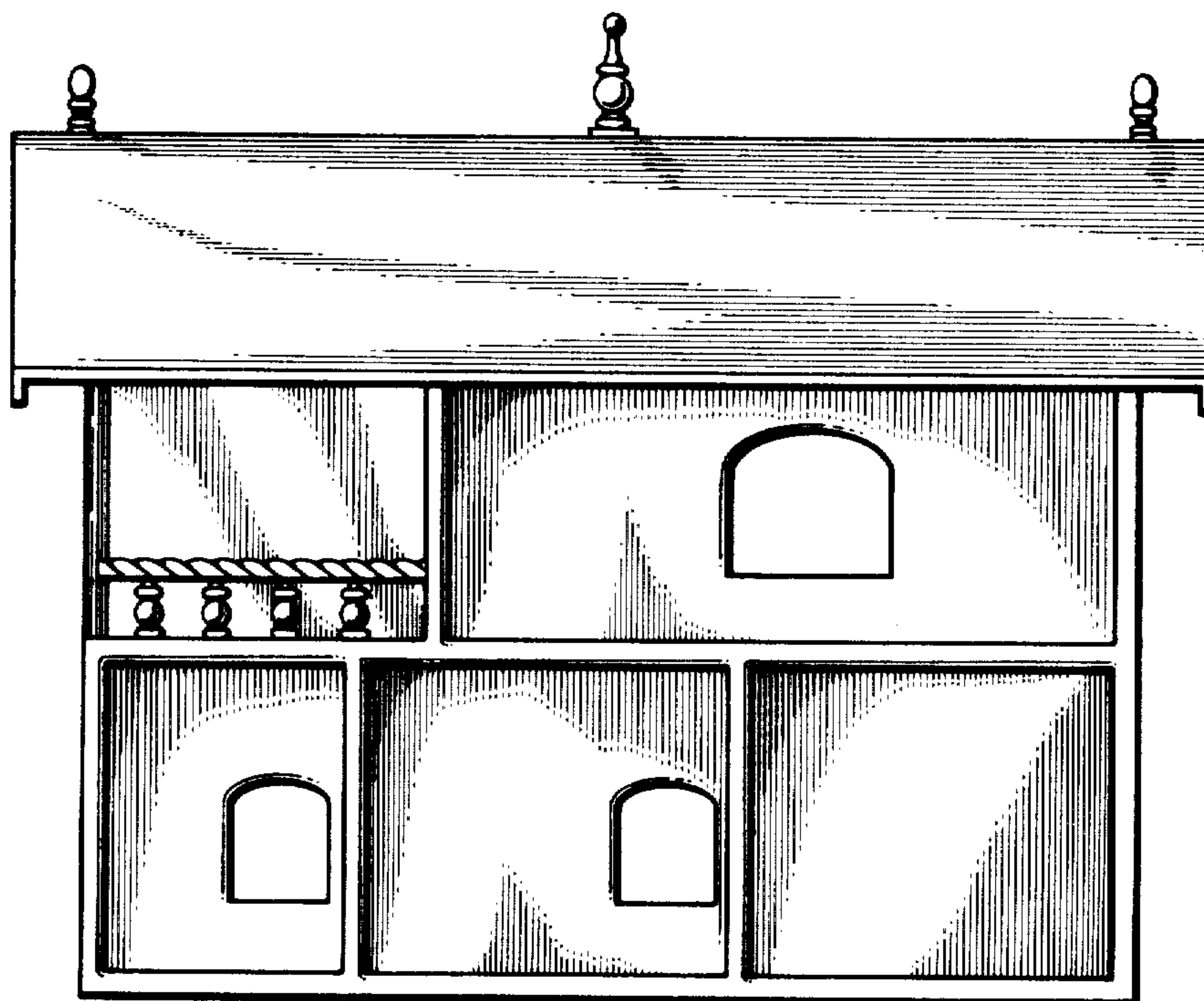
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 4.



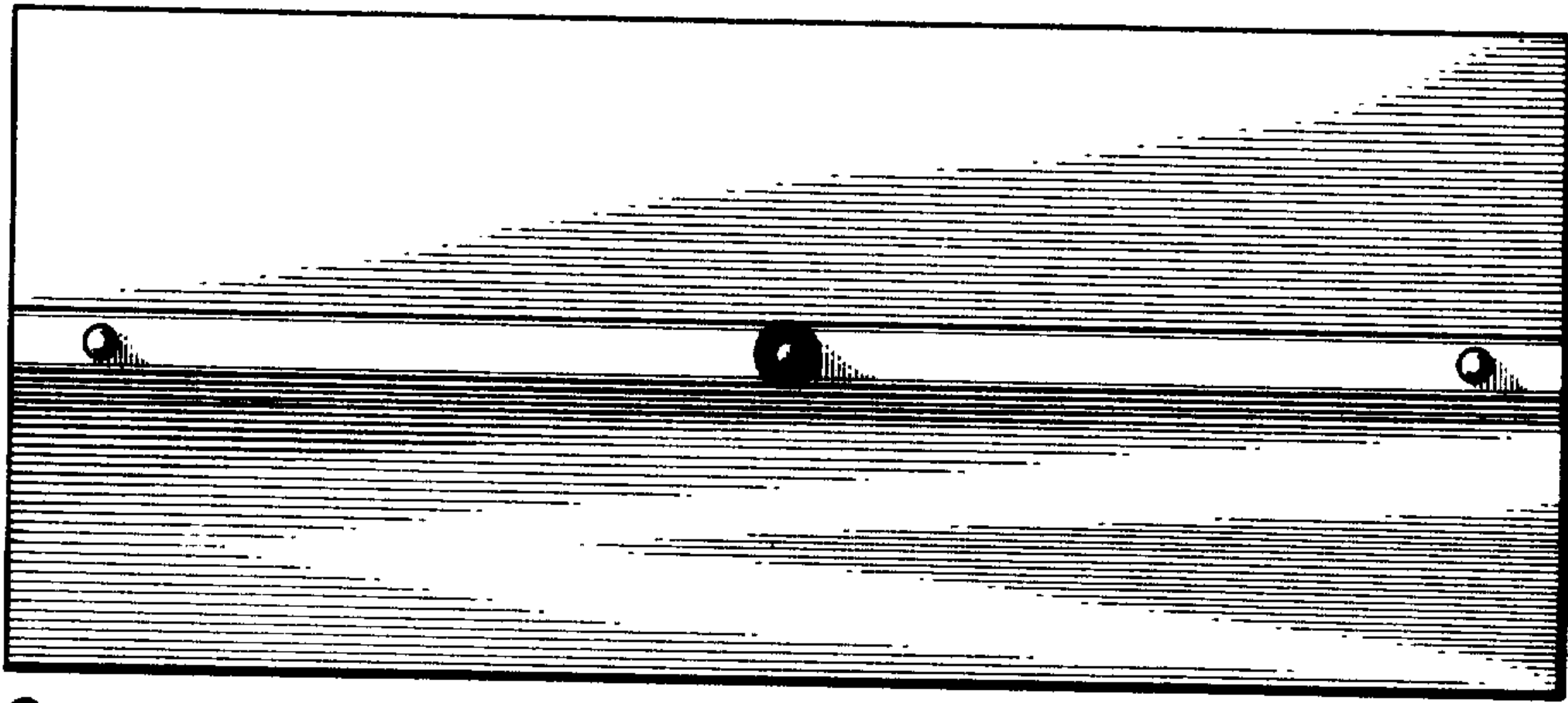

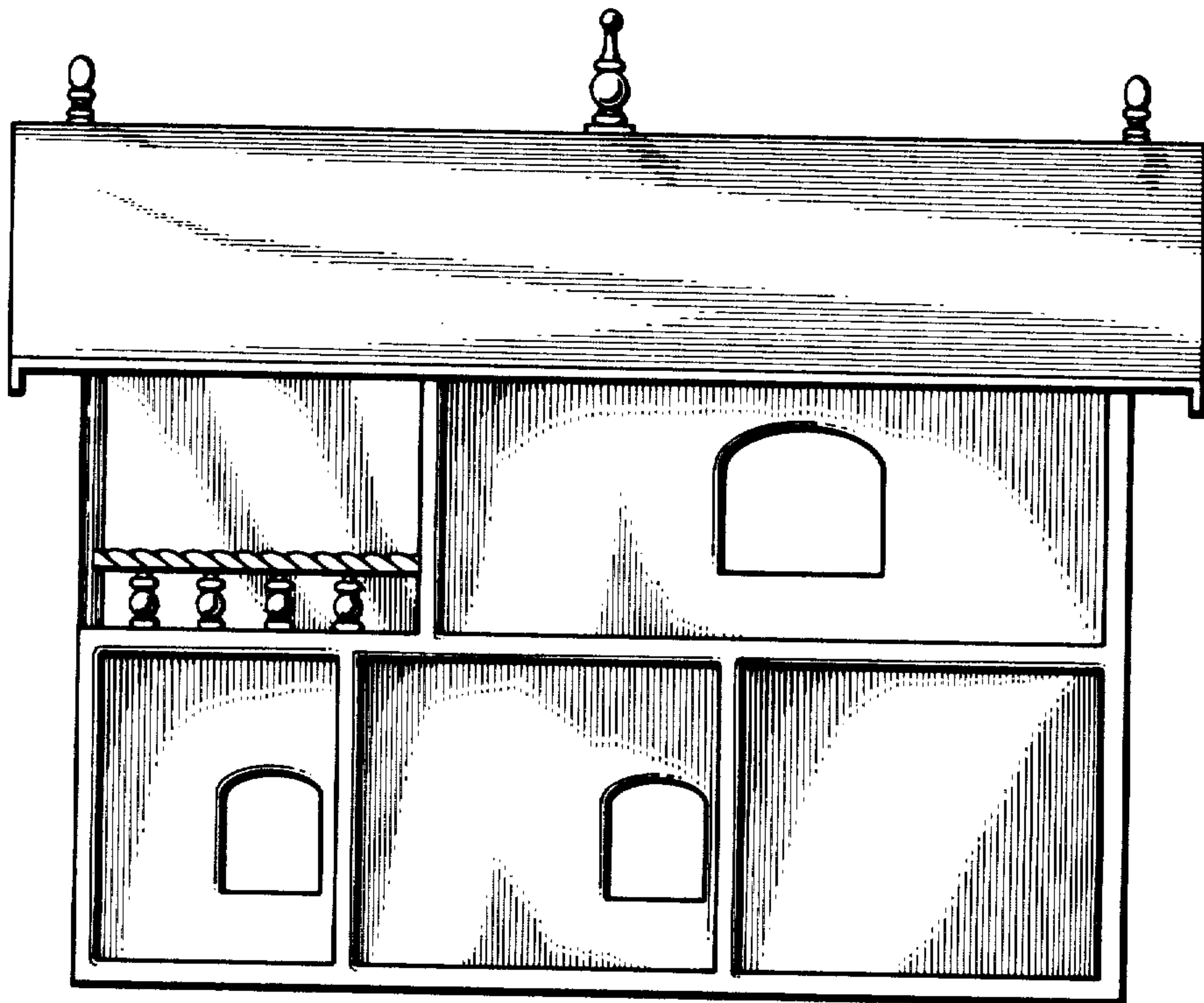

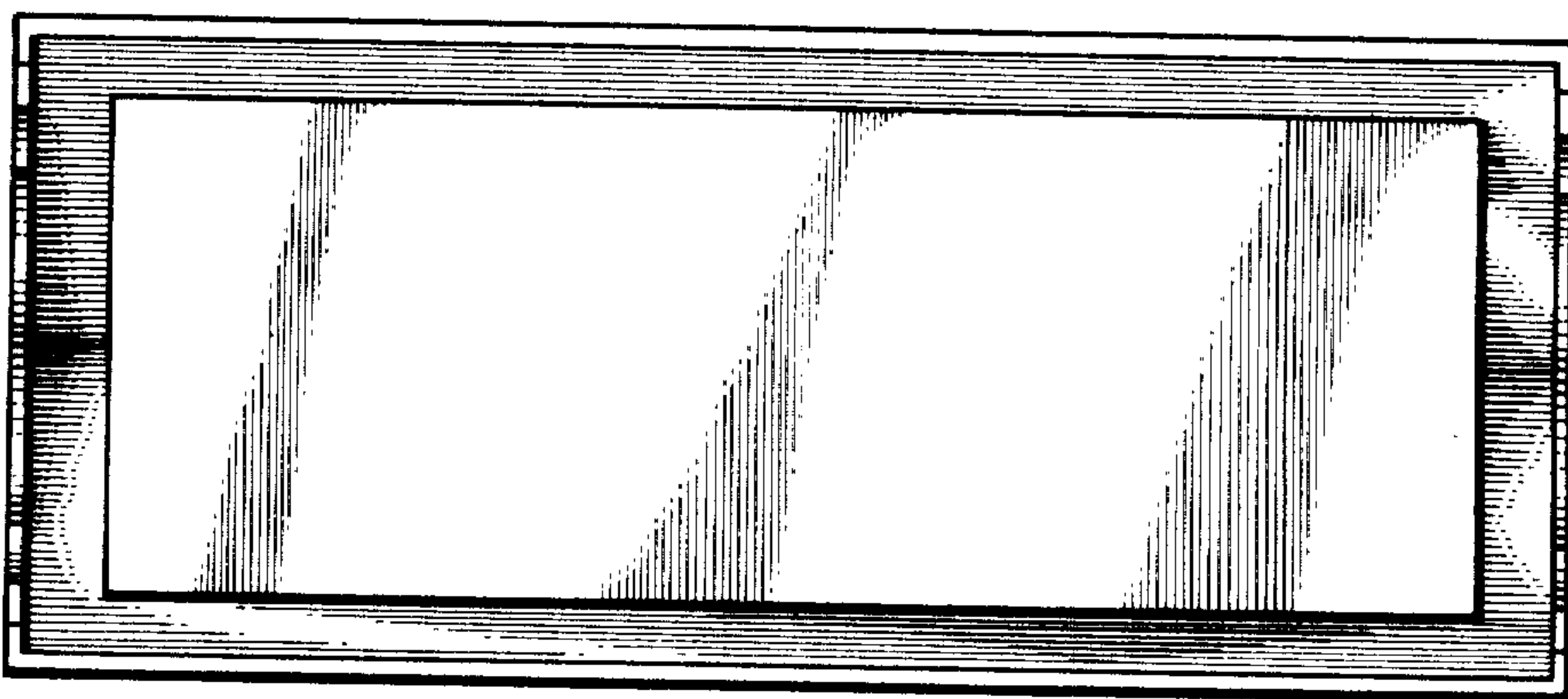

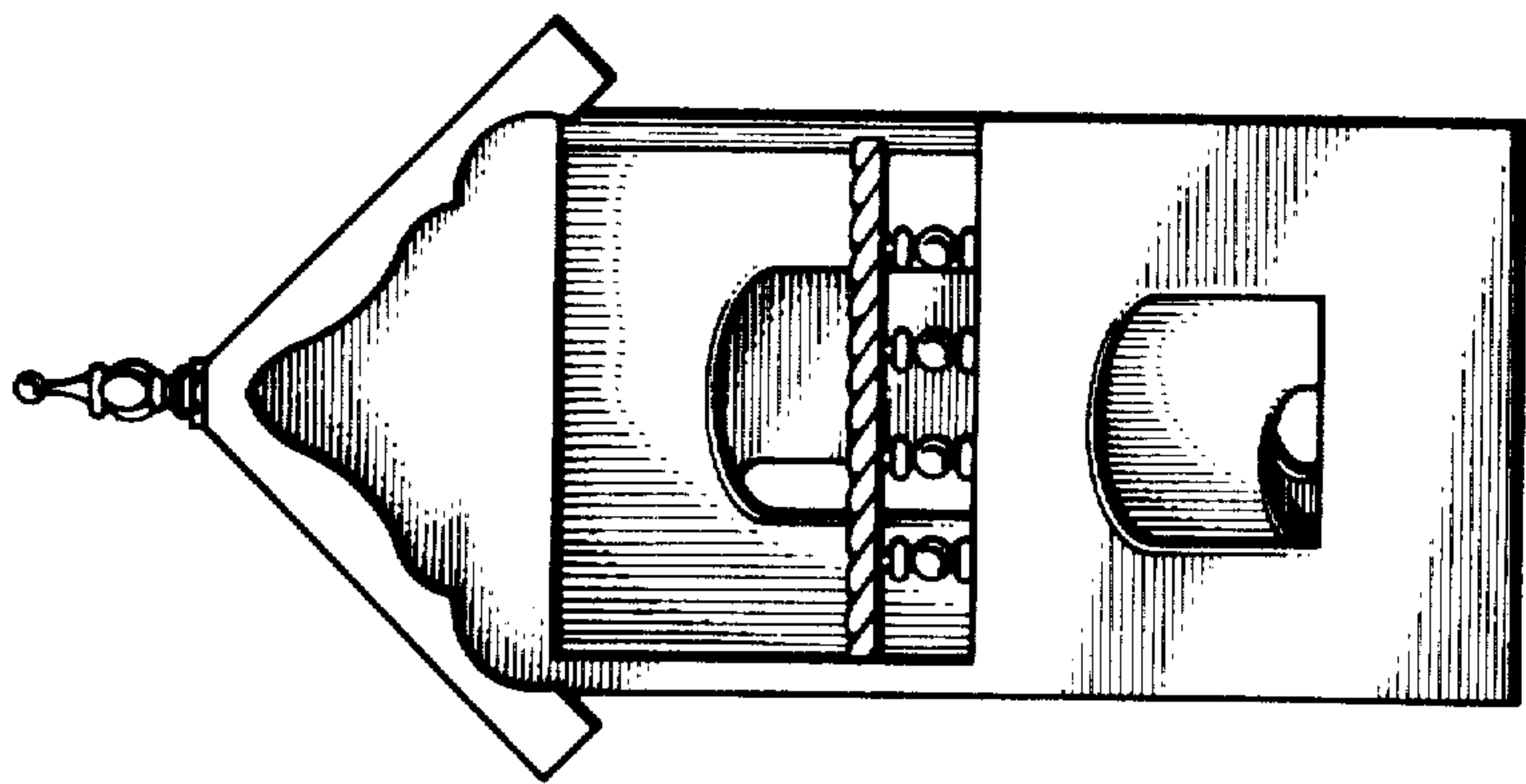

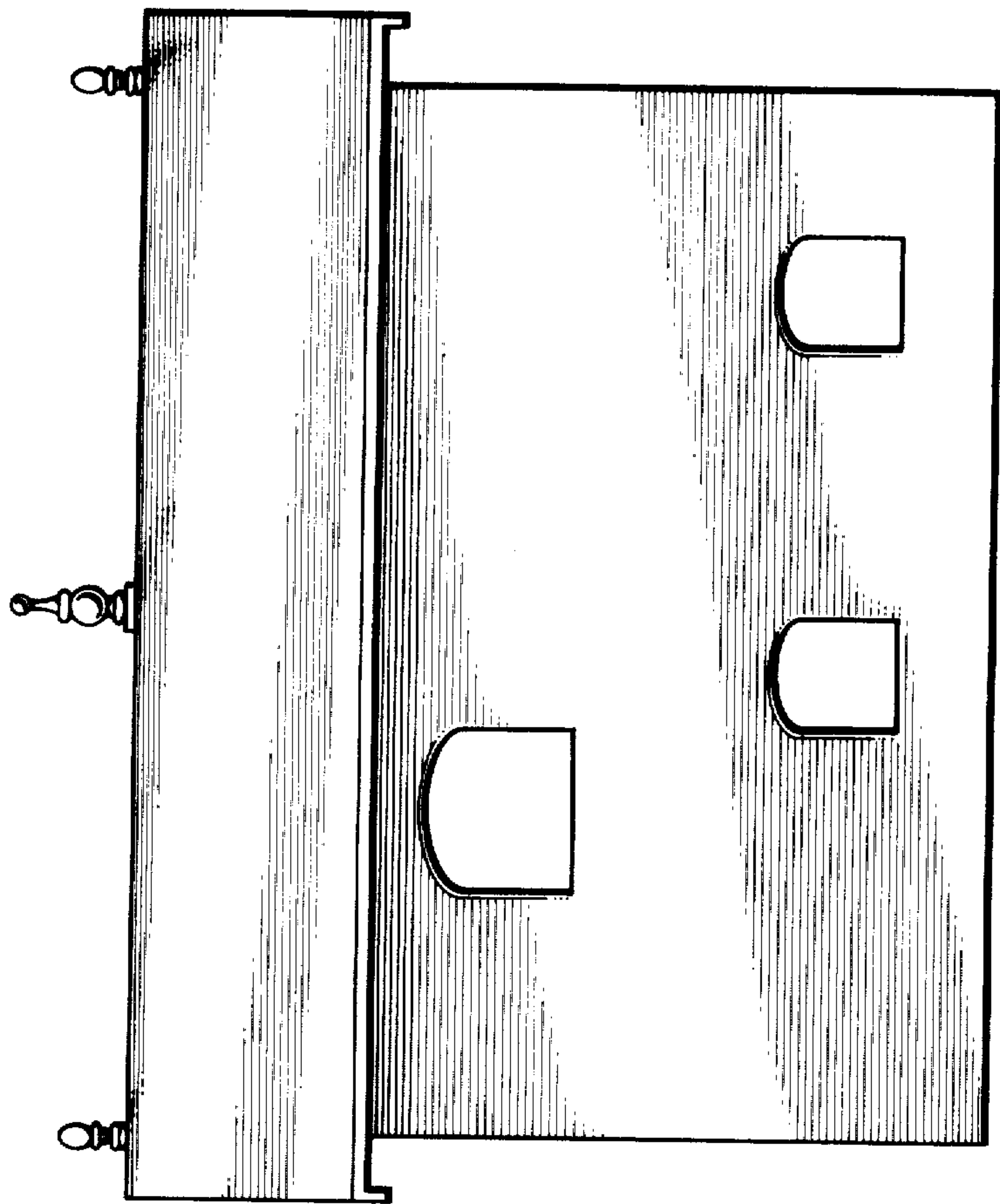

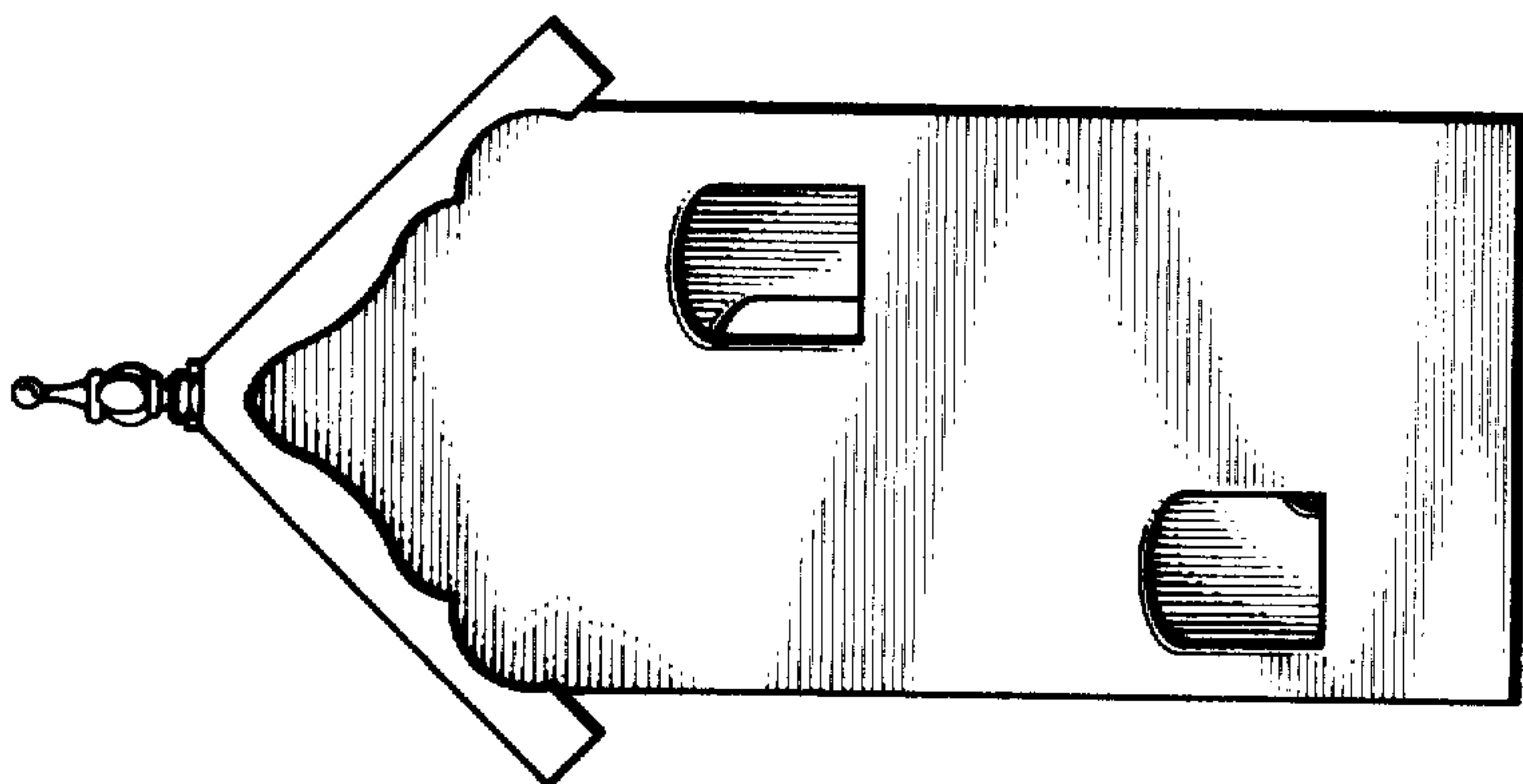
