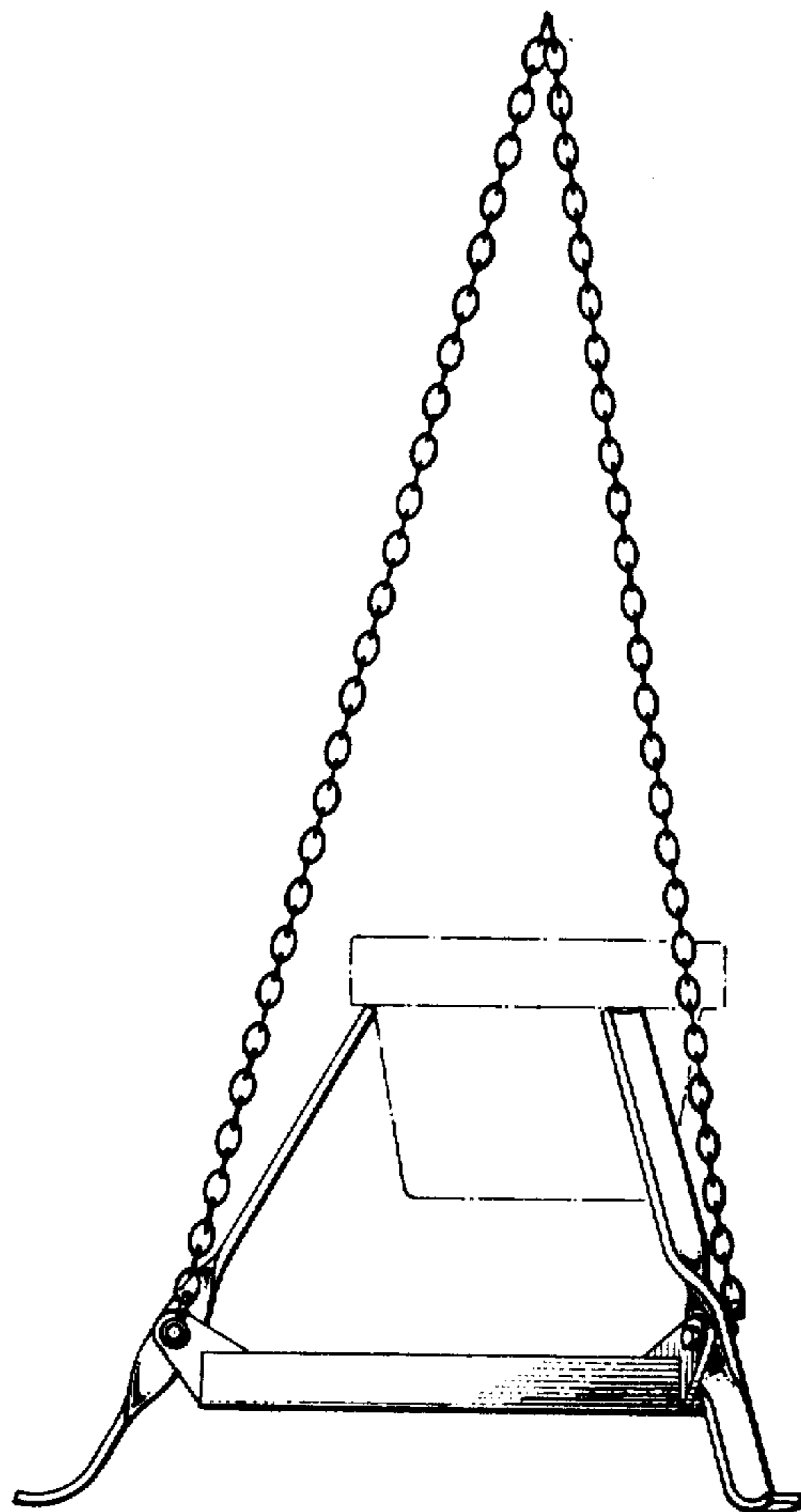

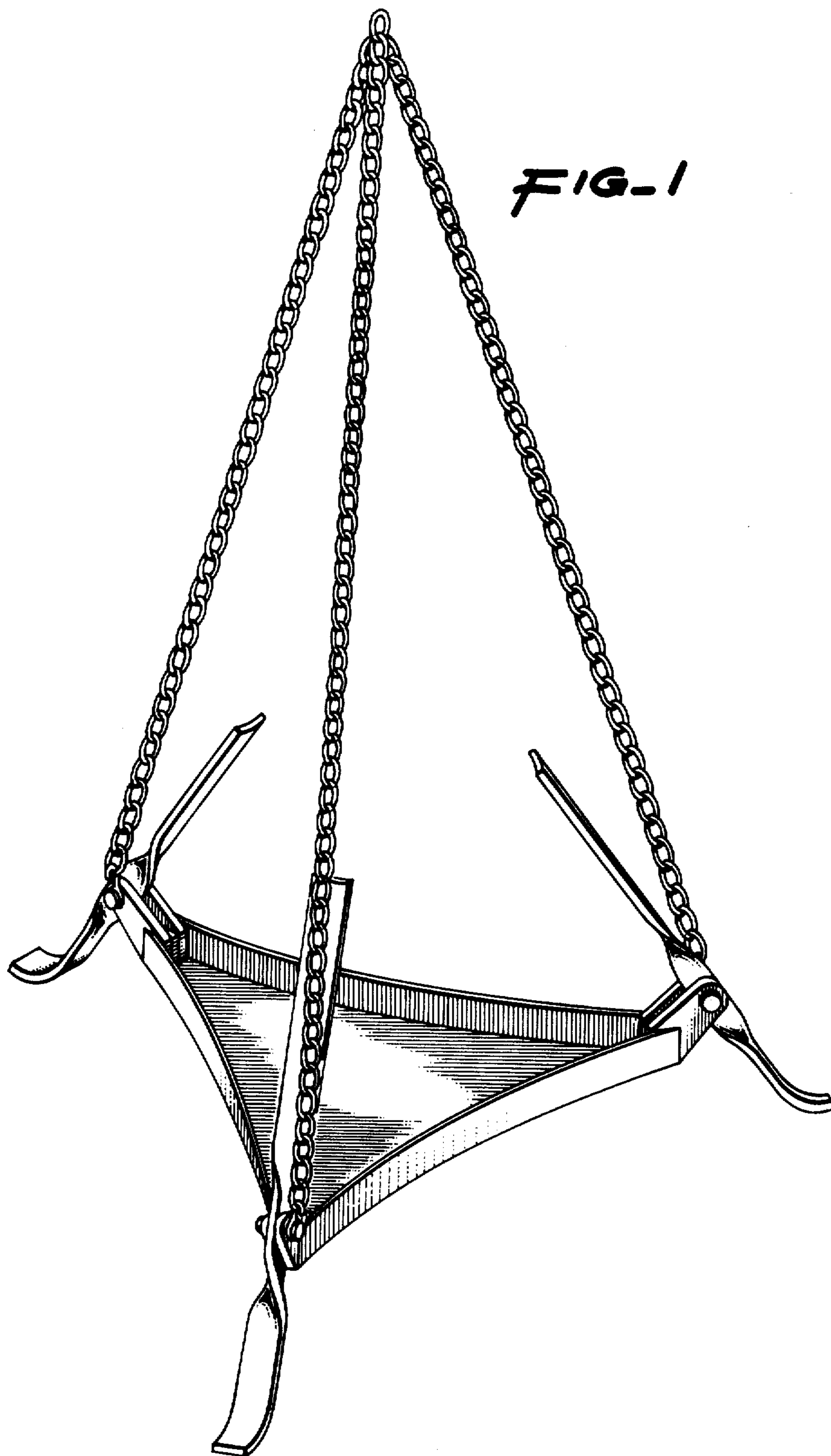
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view of a combined water reservoir and holder for potted flowers and plants showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view with the flower pot shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.





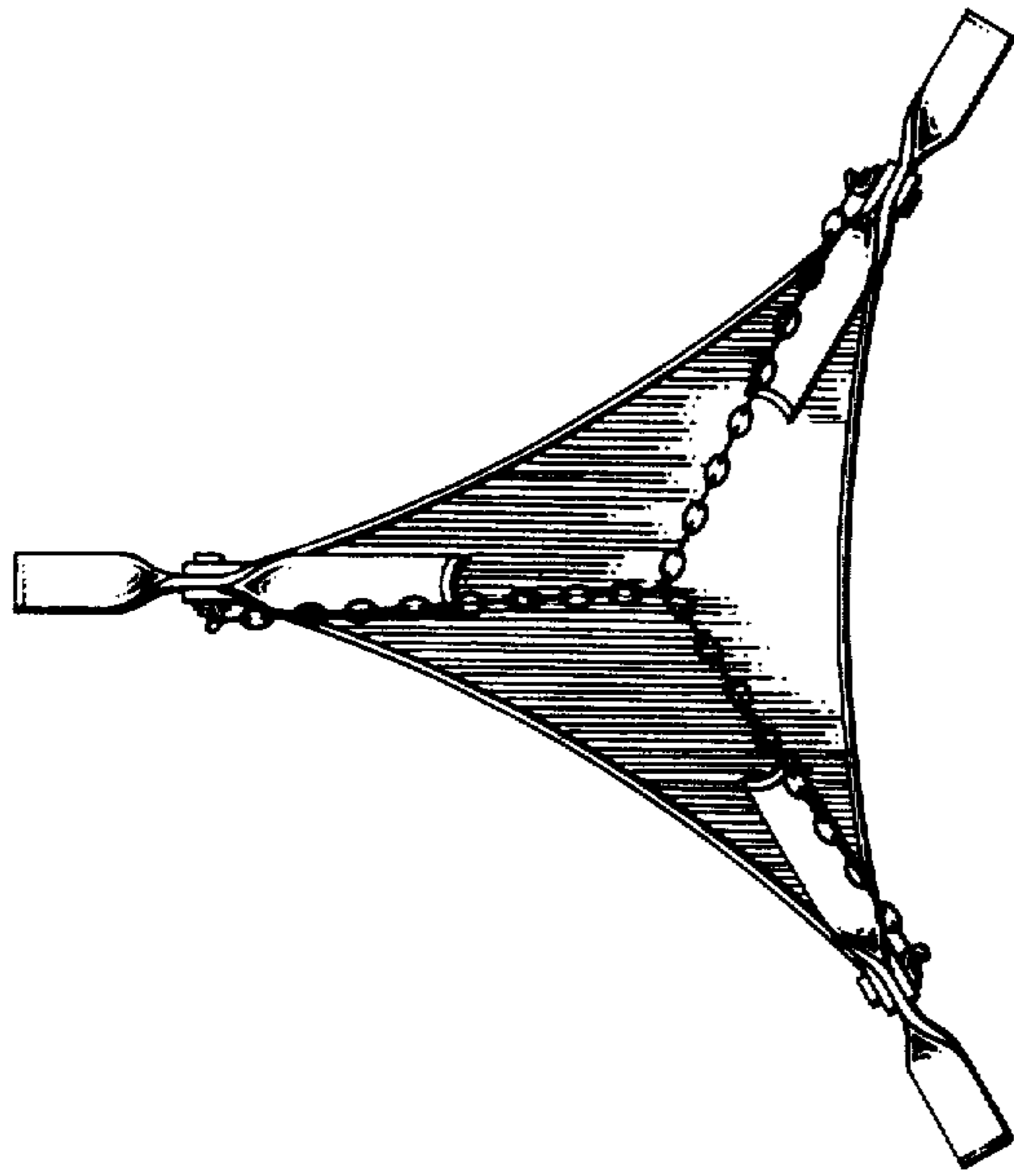

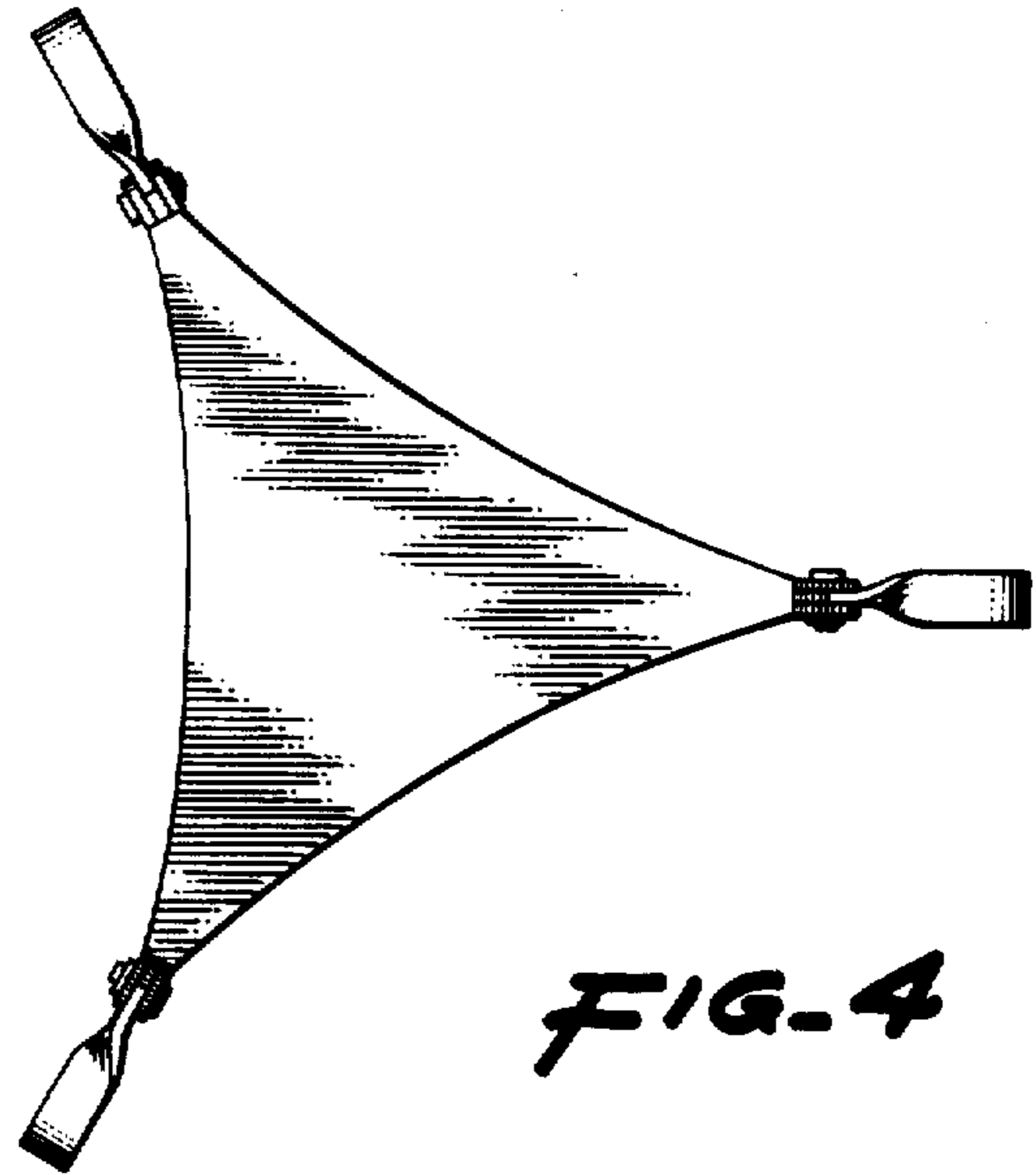

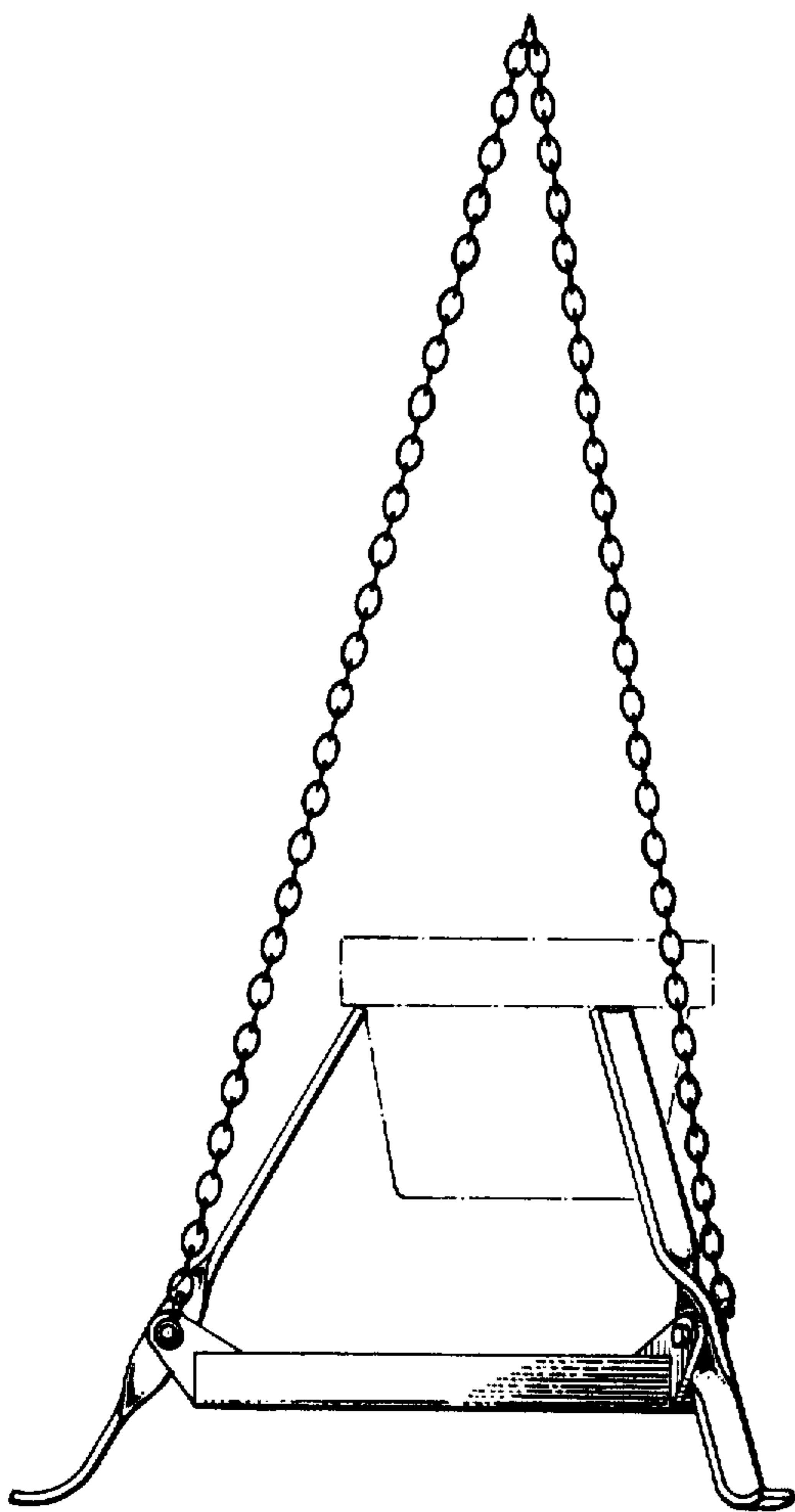
