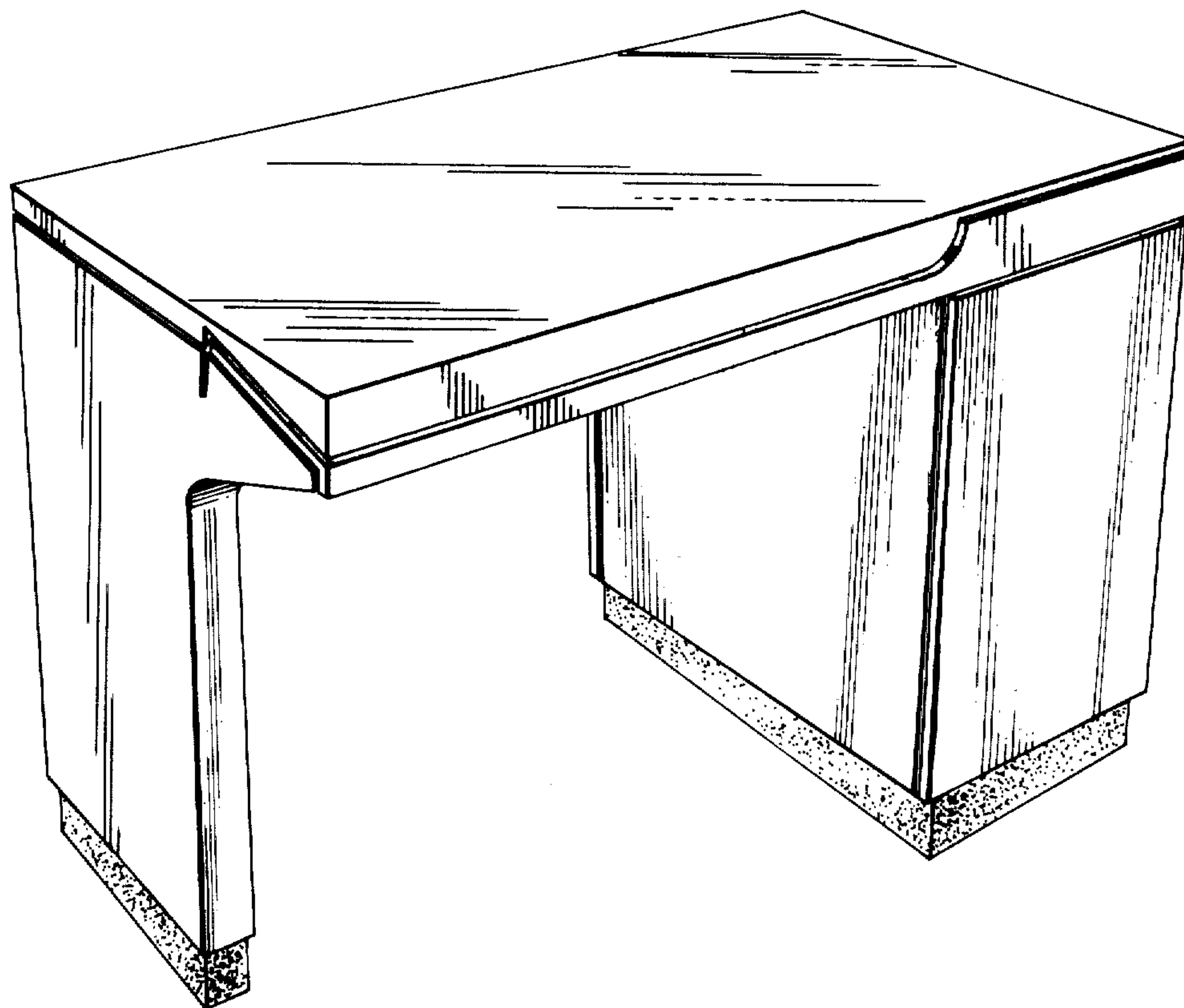

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of encoder console with removable desk top showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



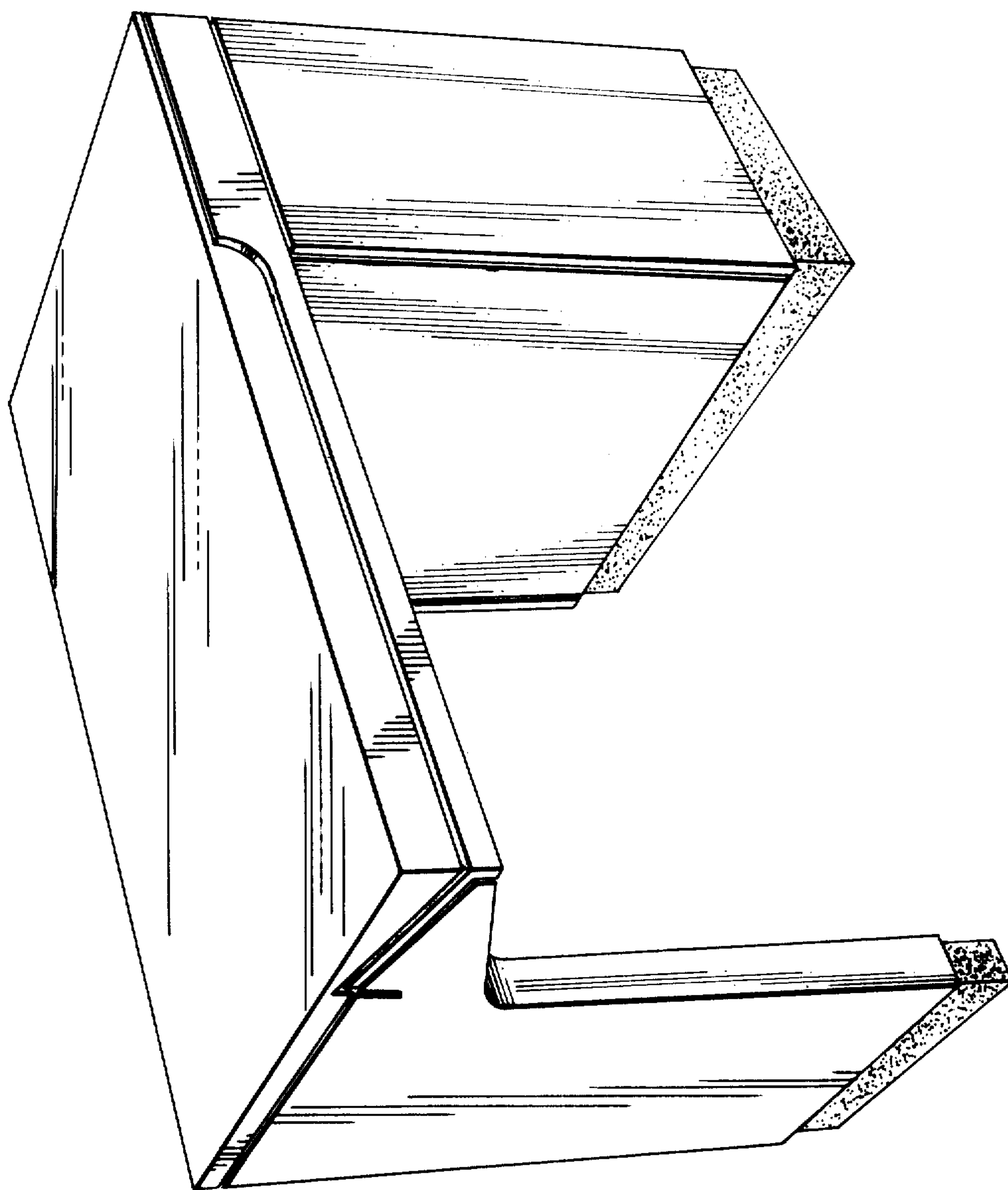

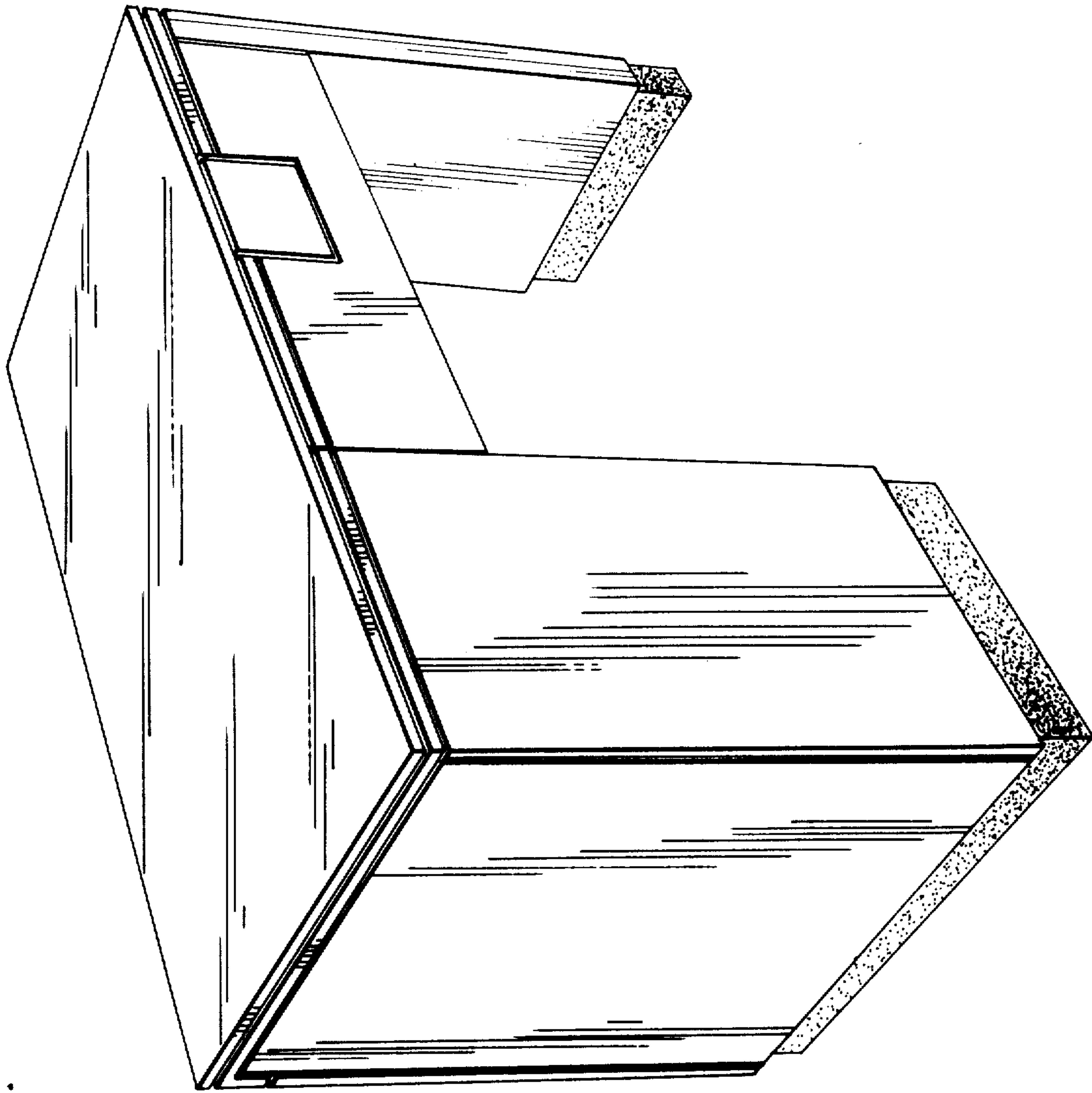
