DESCRIPTION

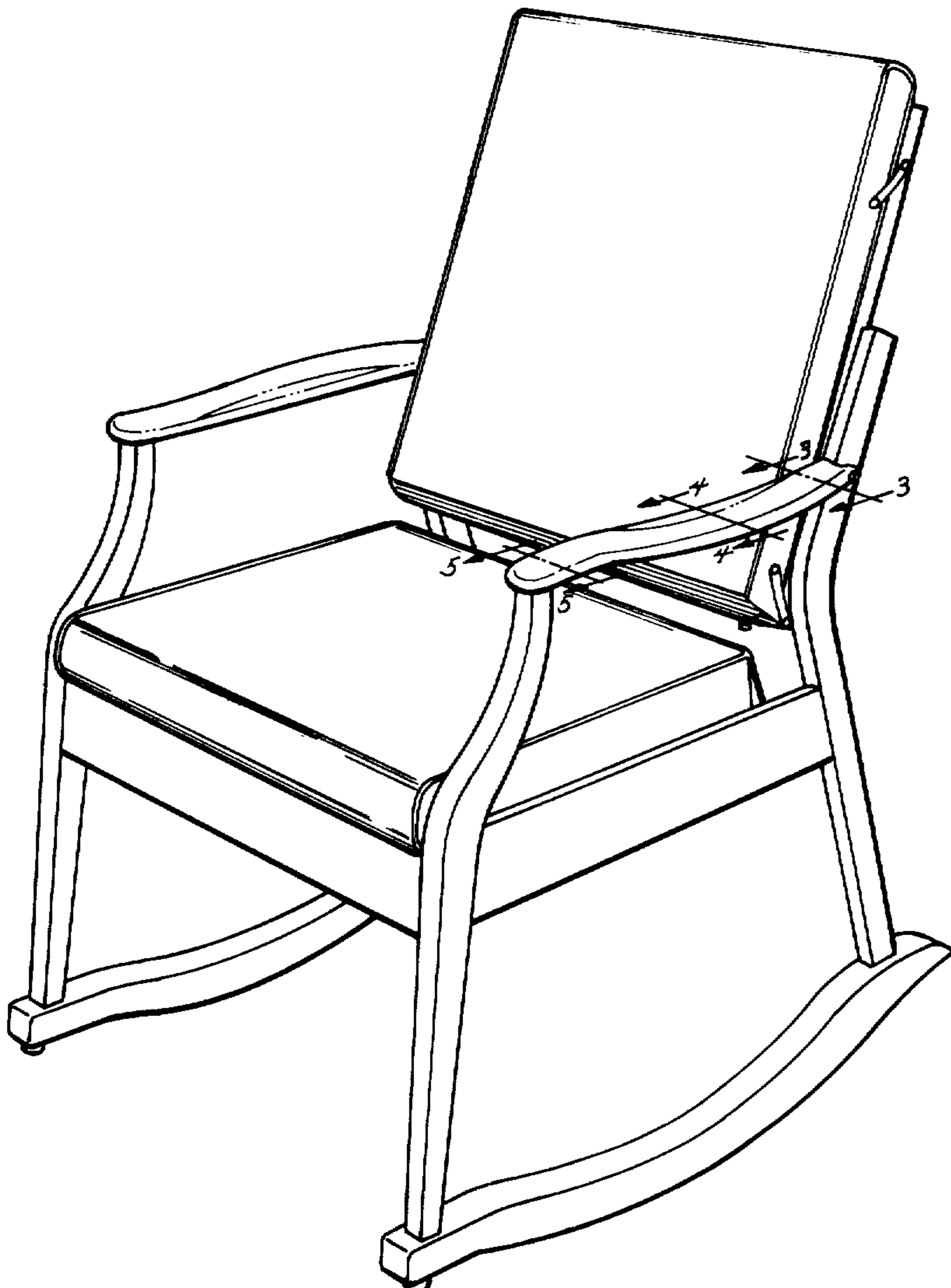
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rocking chair embodying the present design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of the rocker shown in FIG. 1, FIG. 2 being on a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



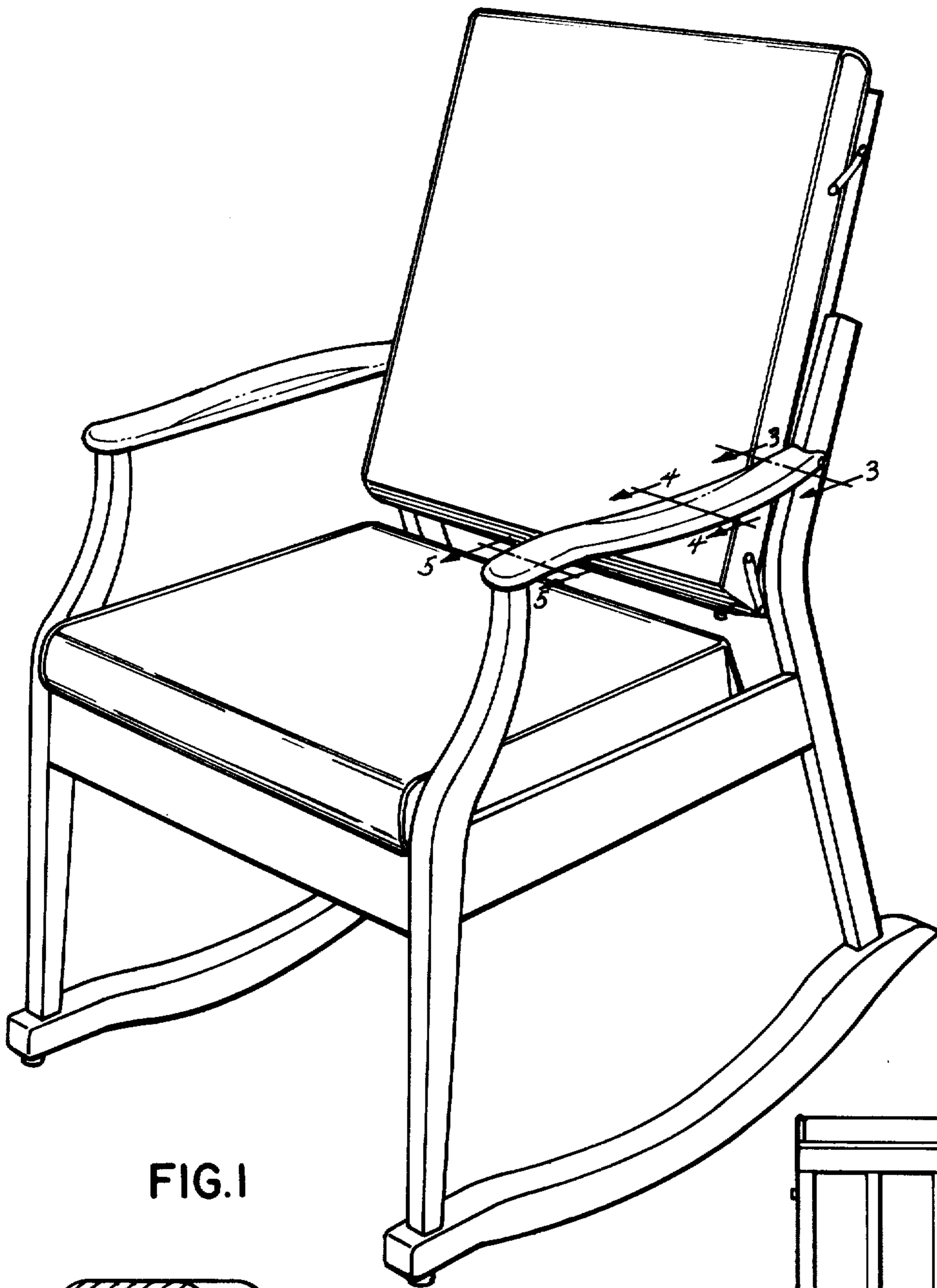

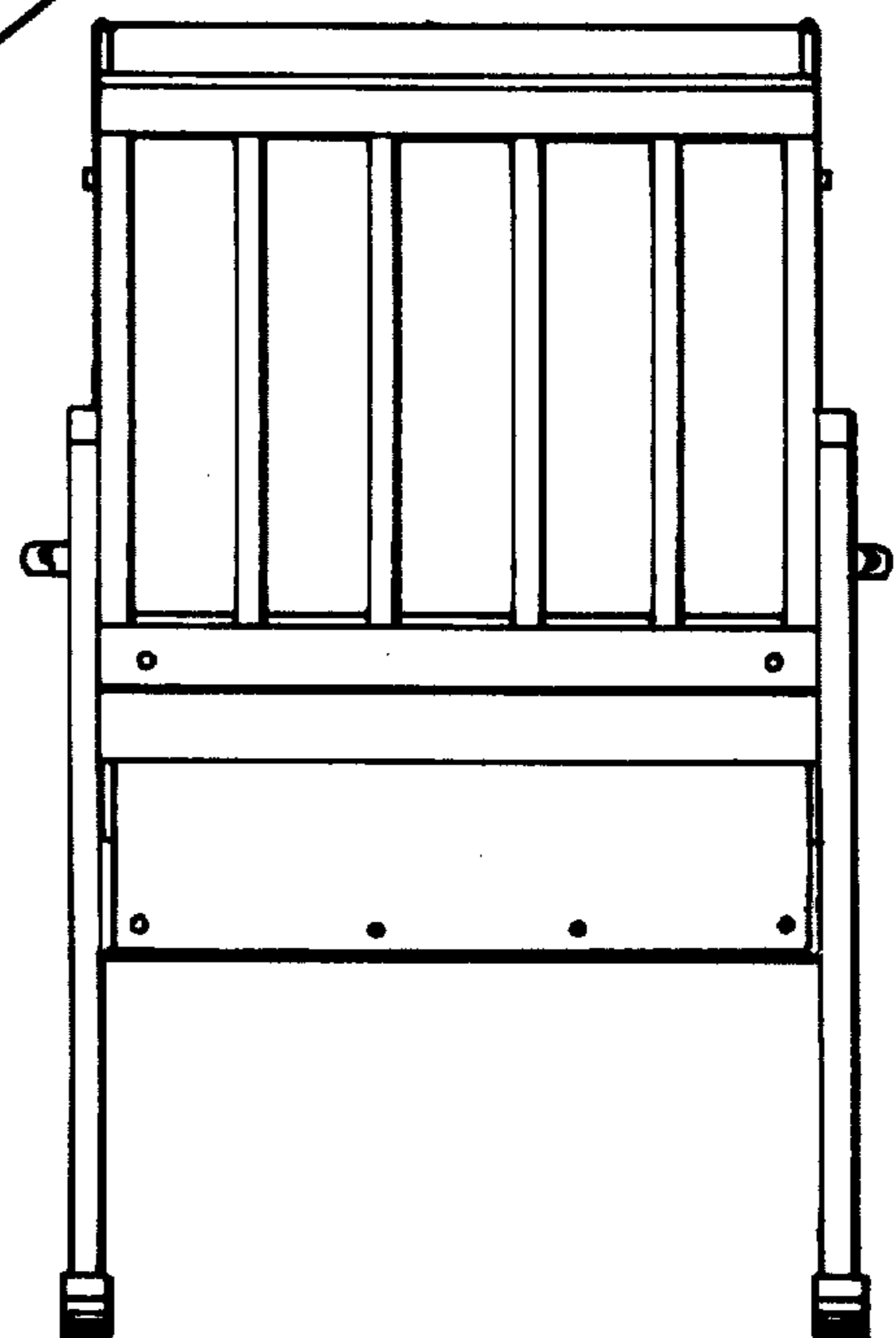
