[57] CLAIM

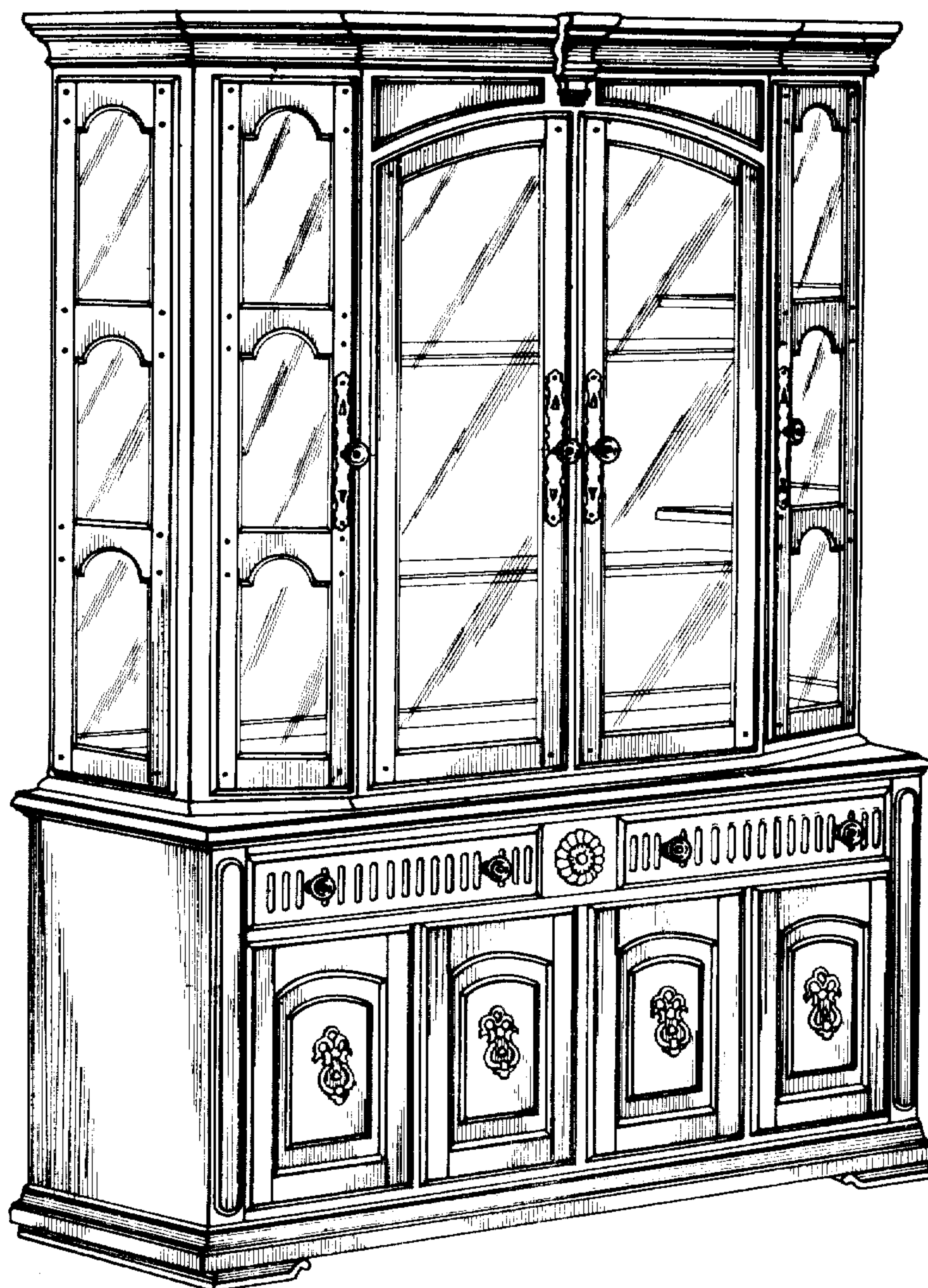
The ornamental design for a two piece provincial style breakfront or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a top plan view, the back of the breakfront being plain.



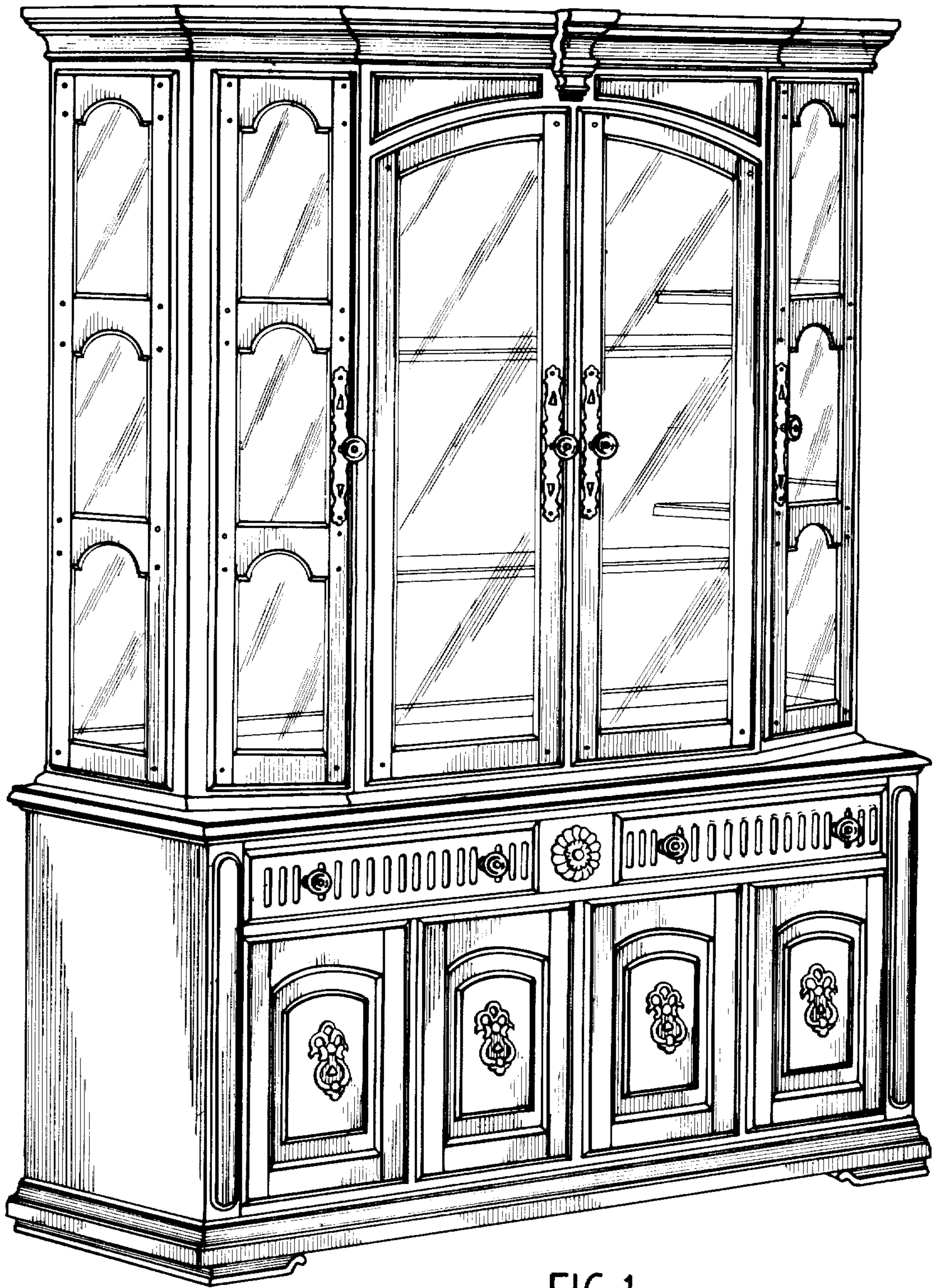

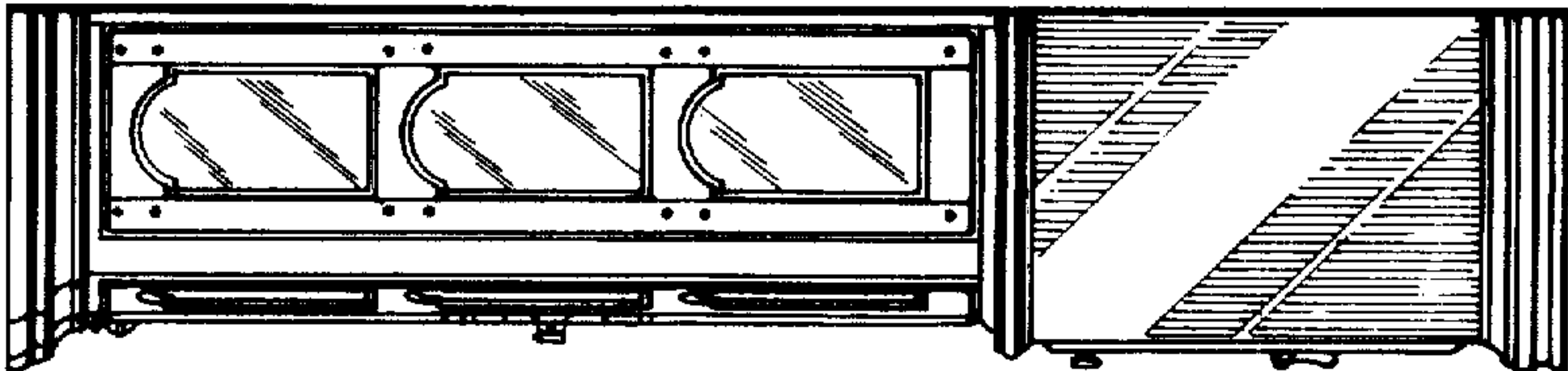

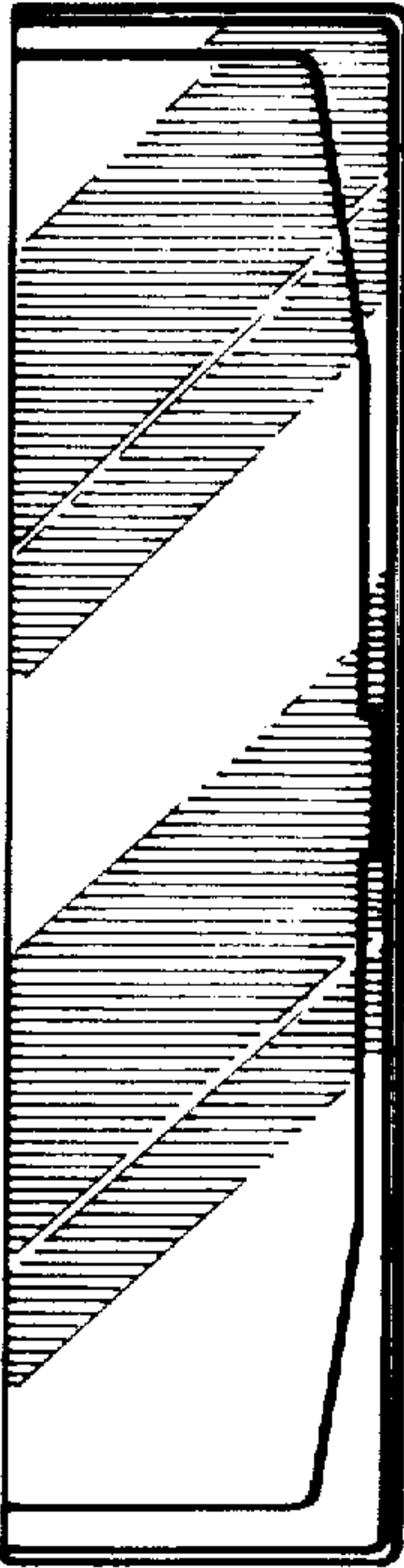
