FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a power module, showing my new design;

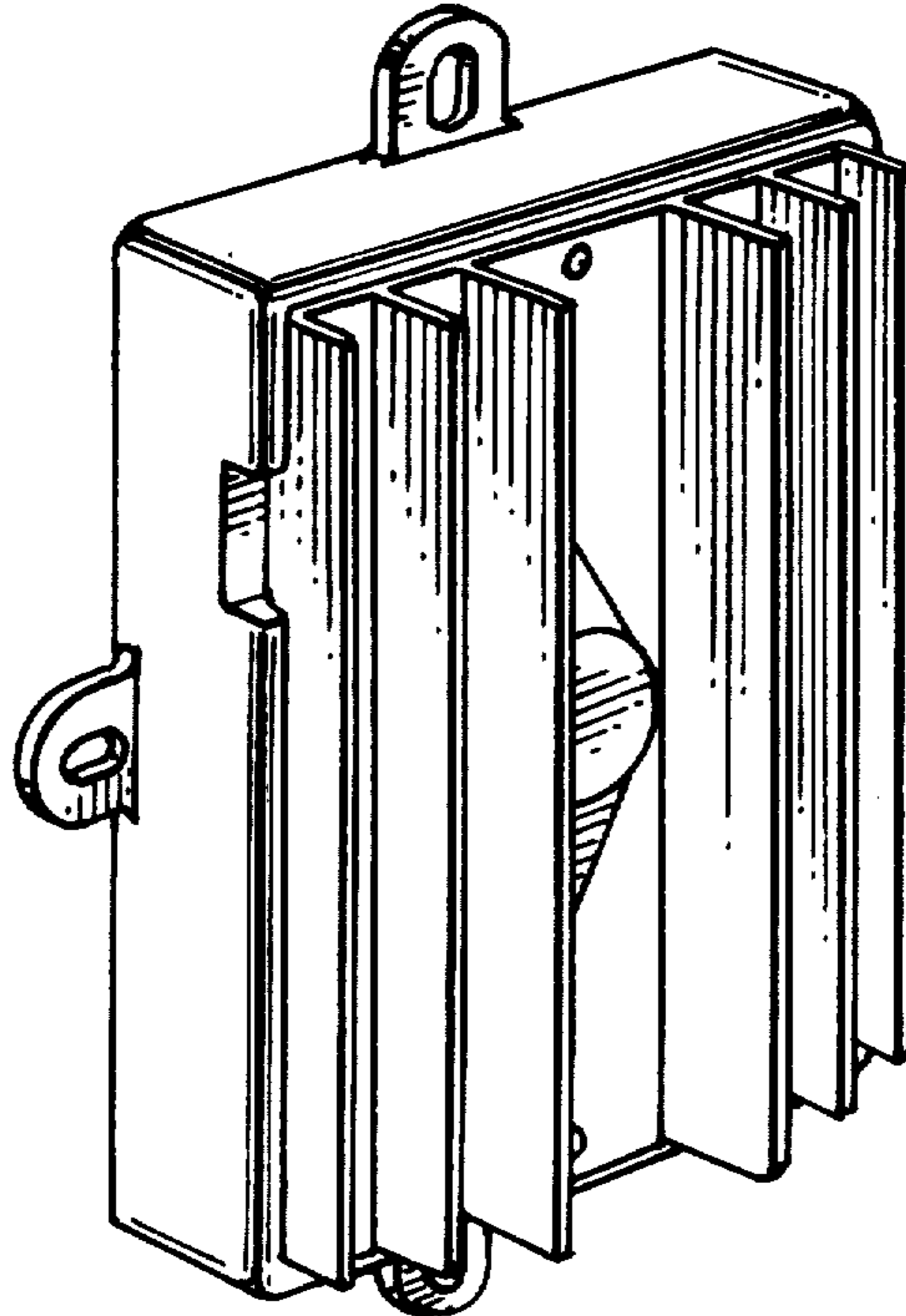
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

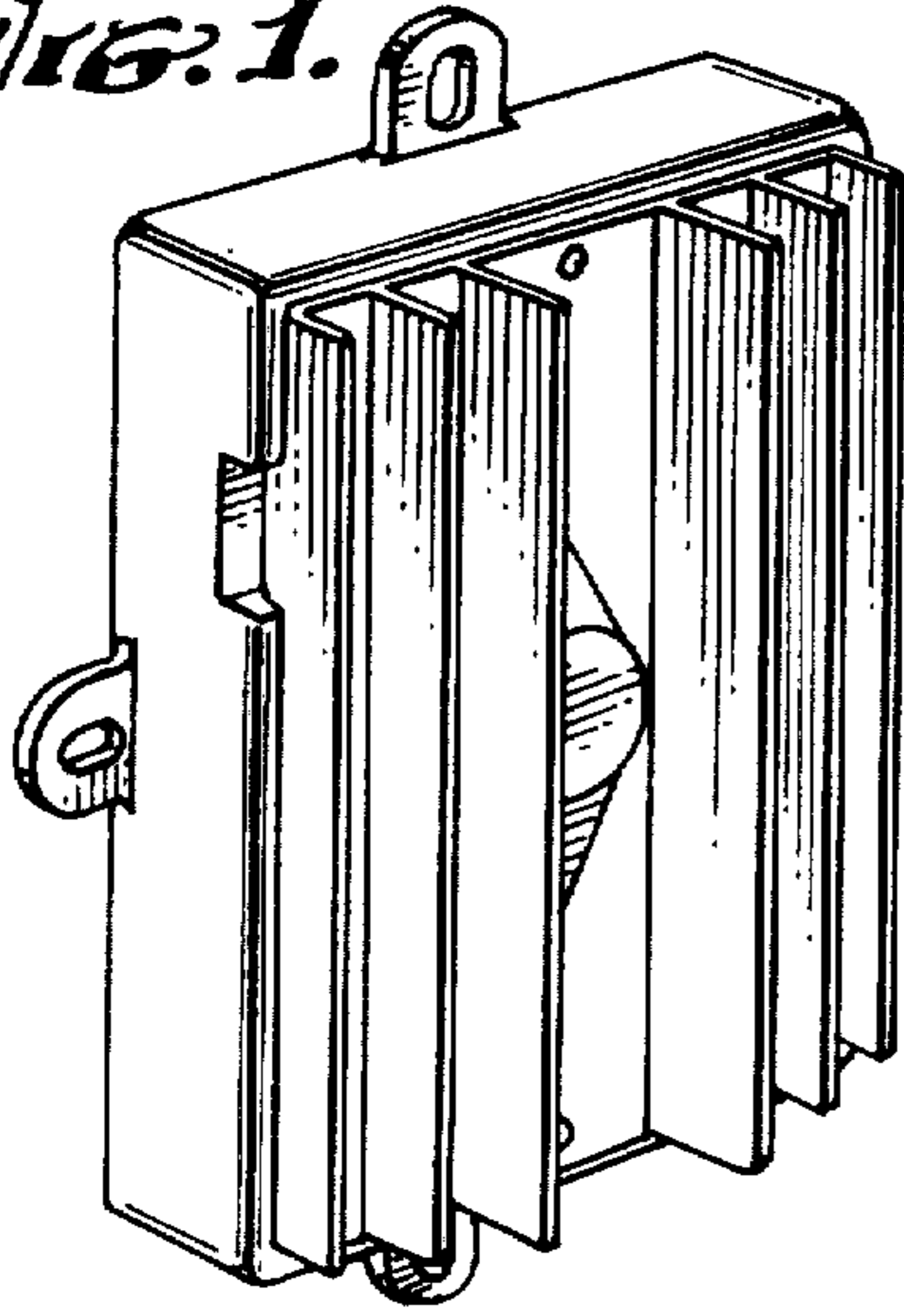
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.

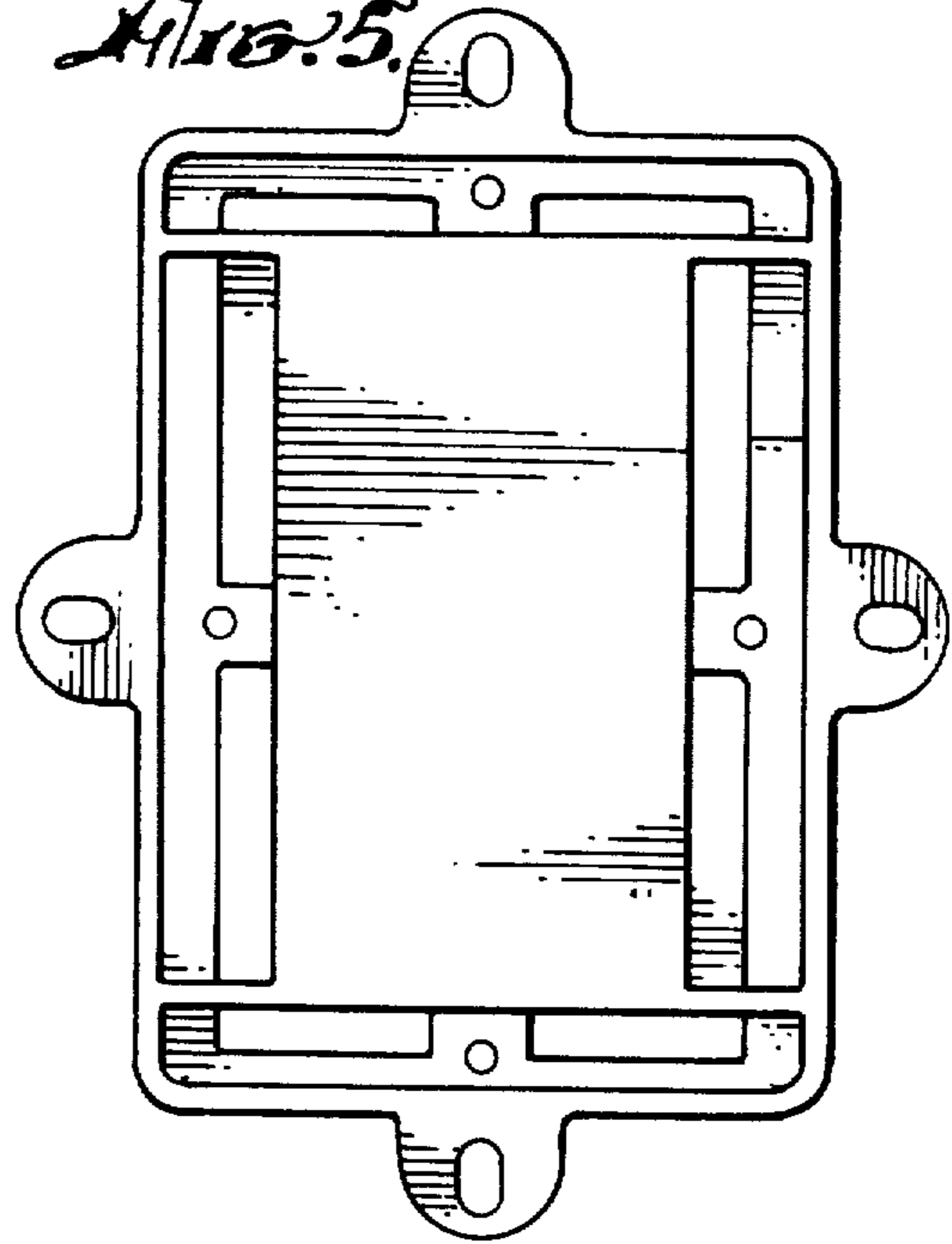
The side not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3.



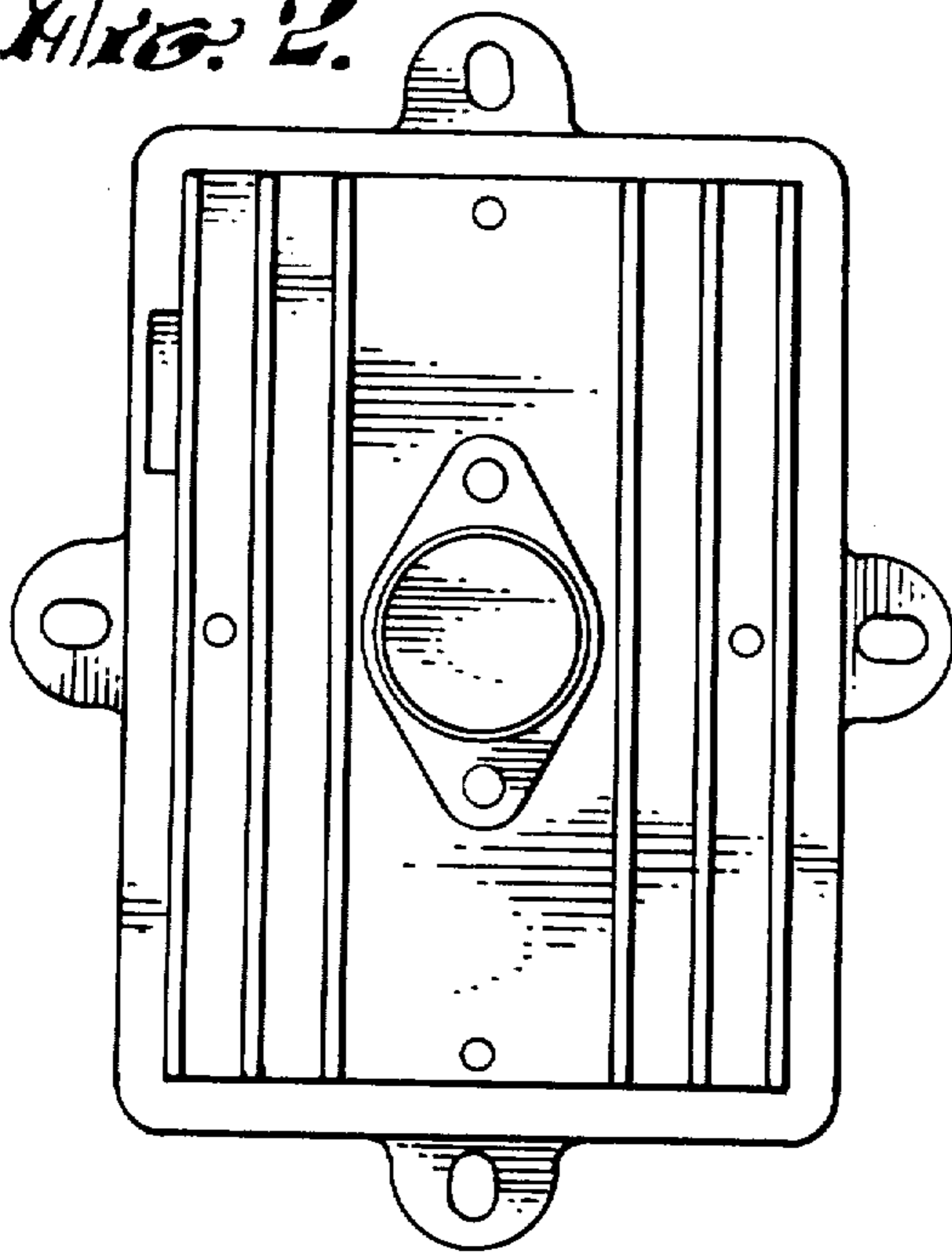

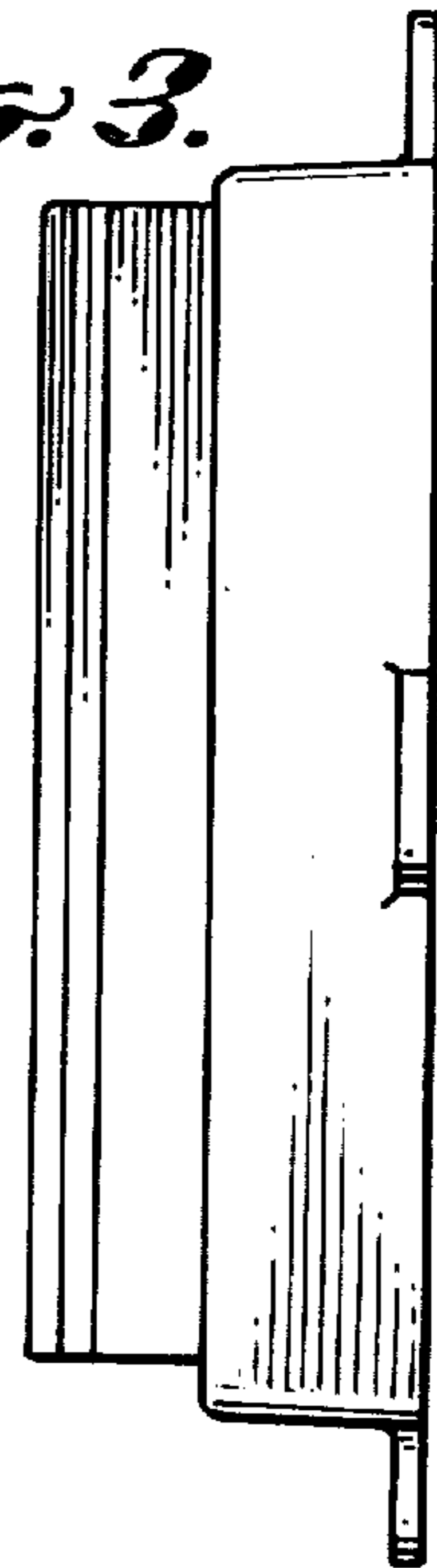
