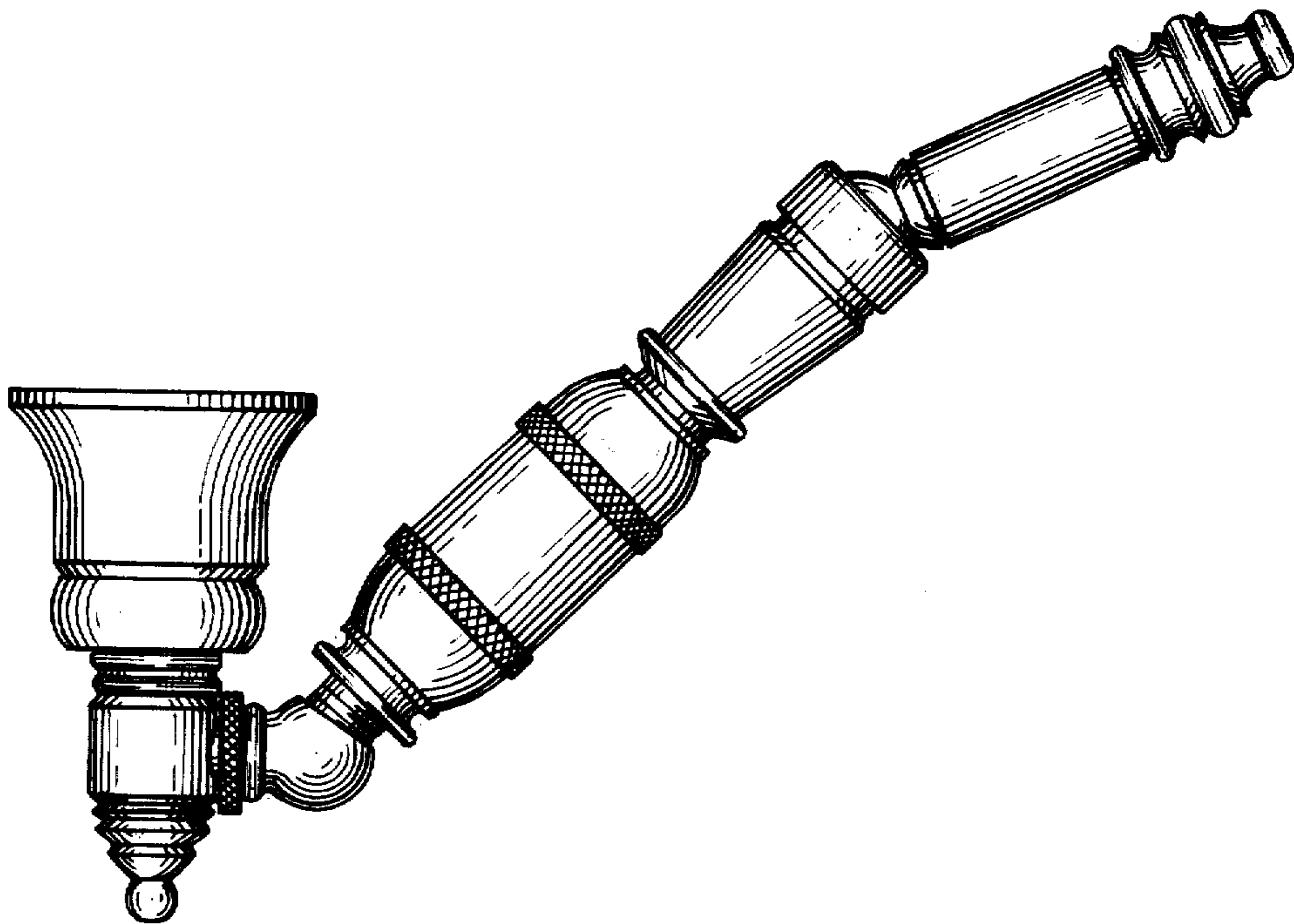

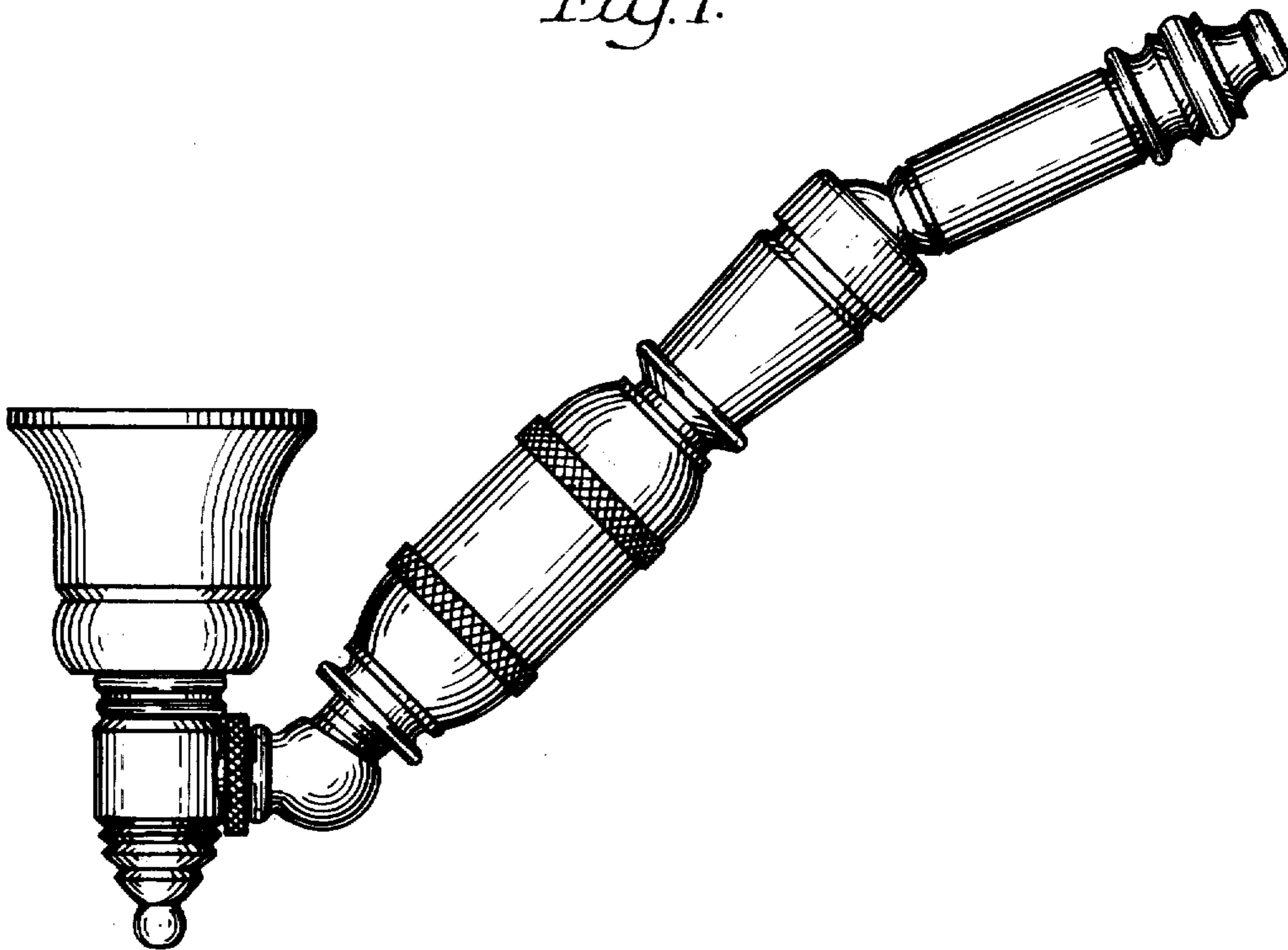
The ornamental design for a smoking pipe or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

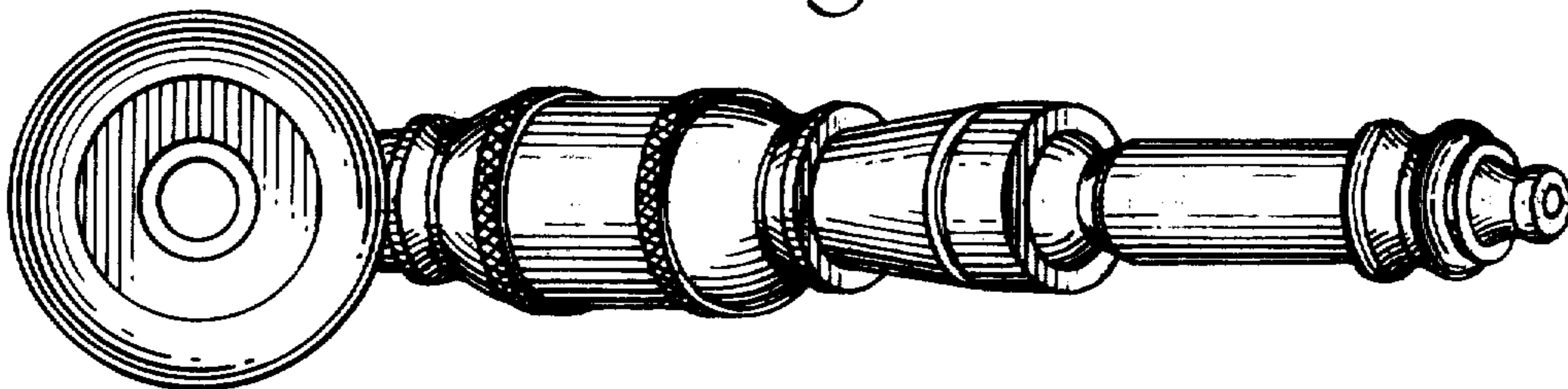
