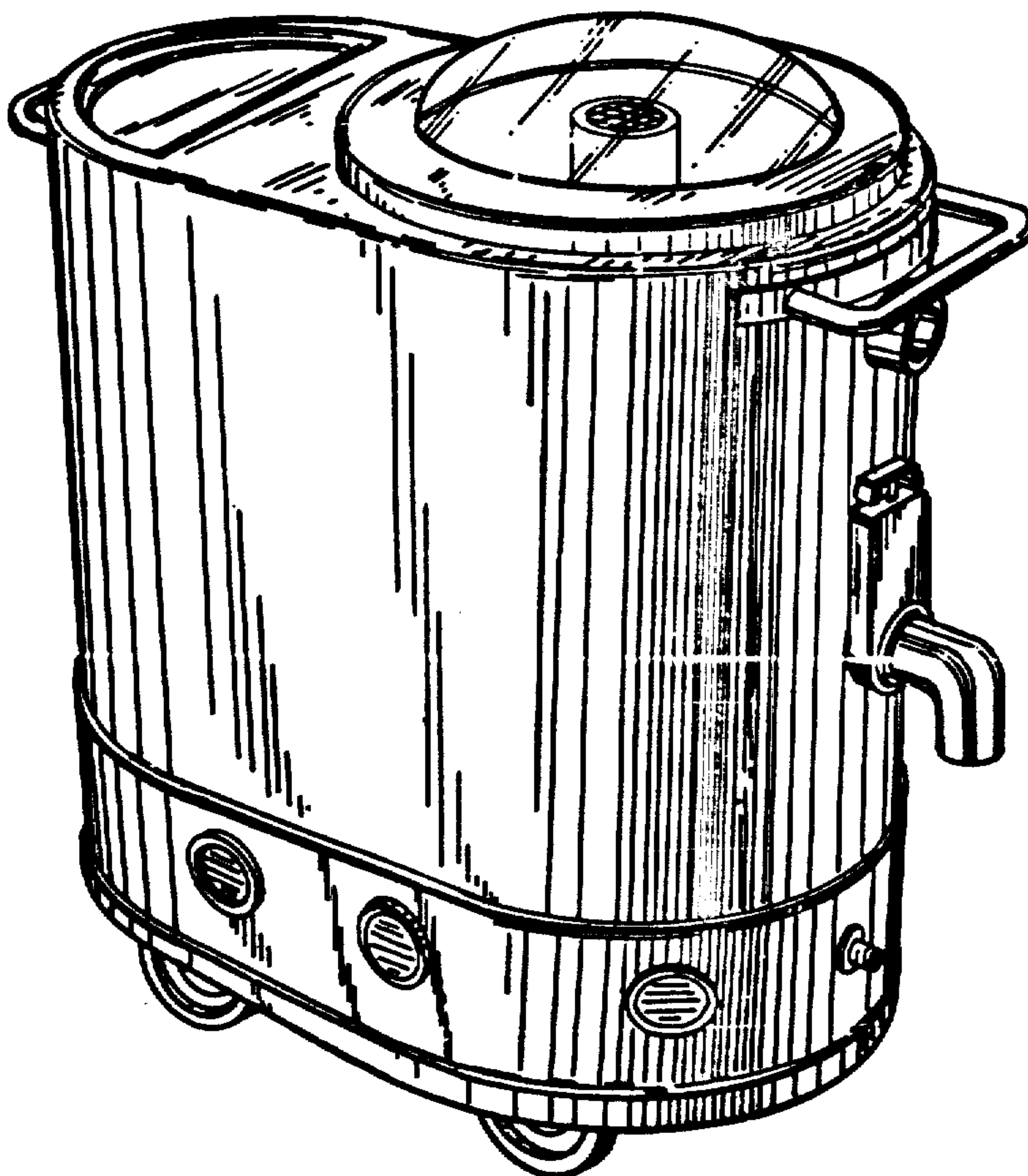

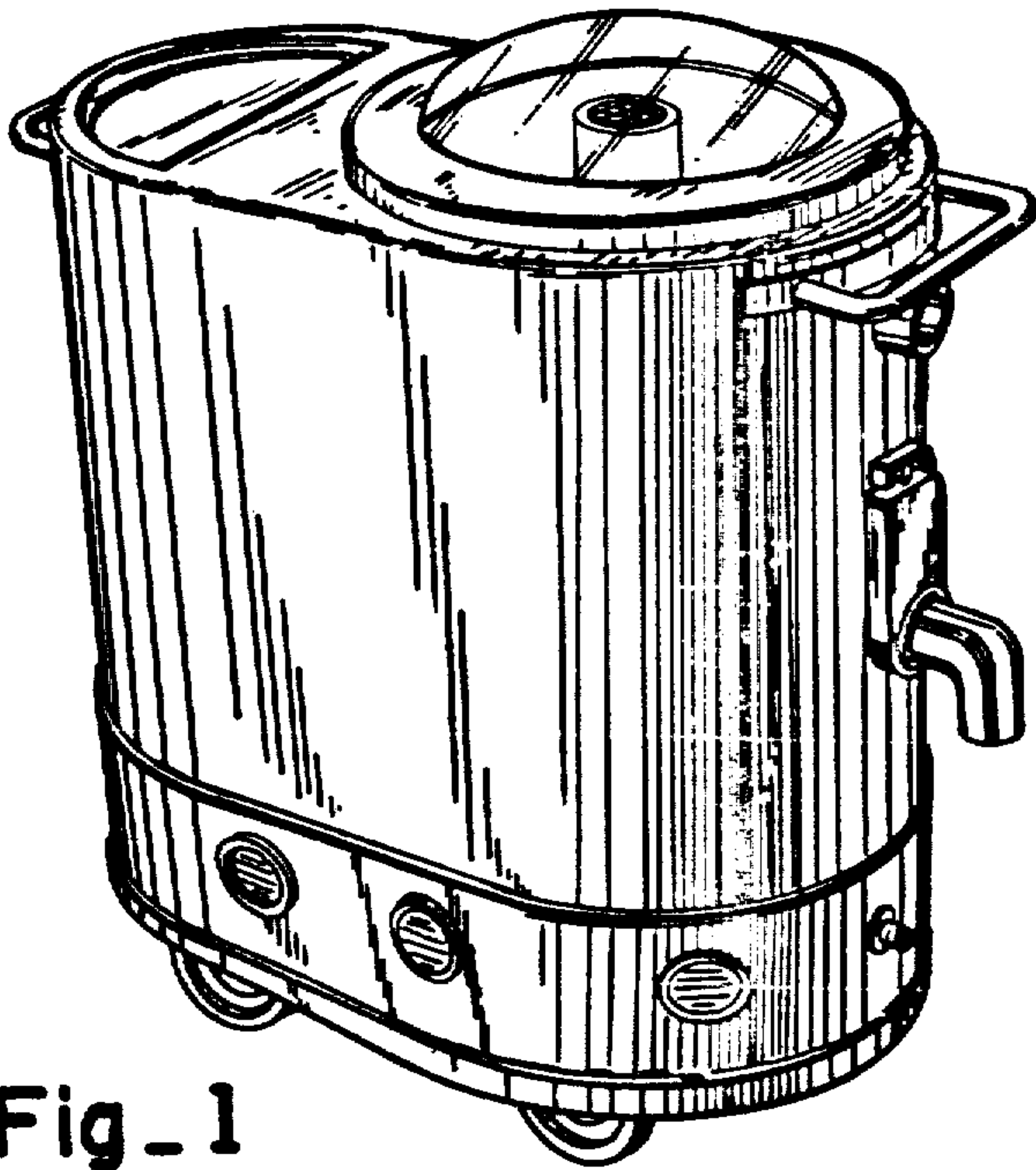

The ornamental design for a hot water extraction-type carpet cleaning machine, as shown.

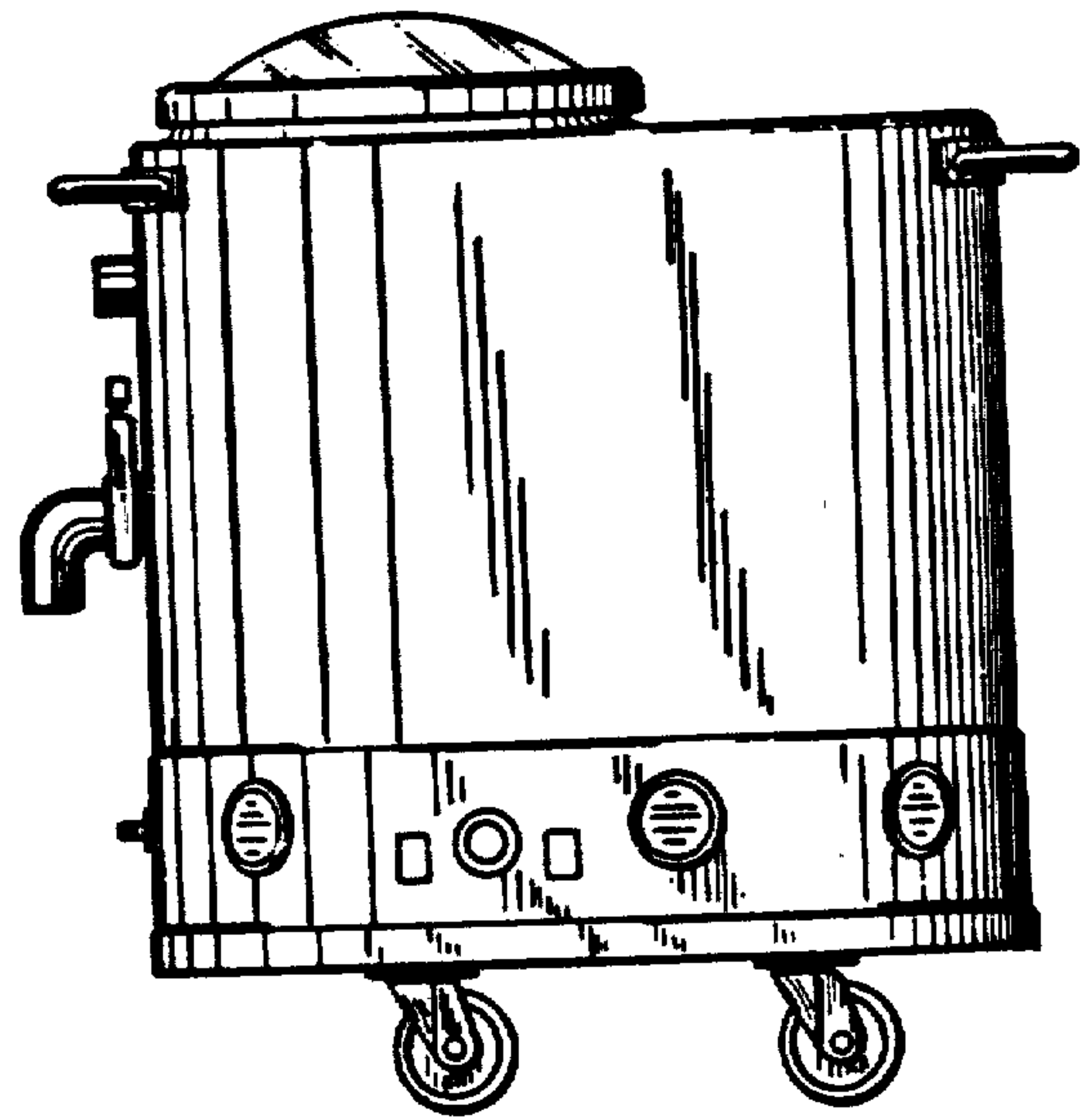
DESCRIPTION

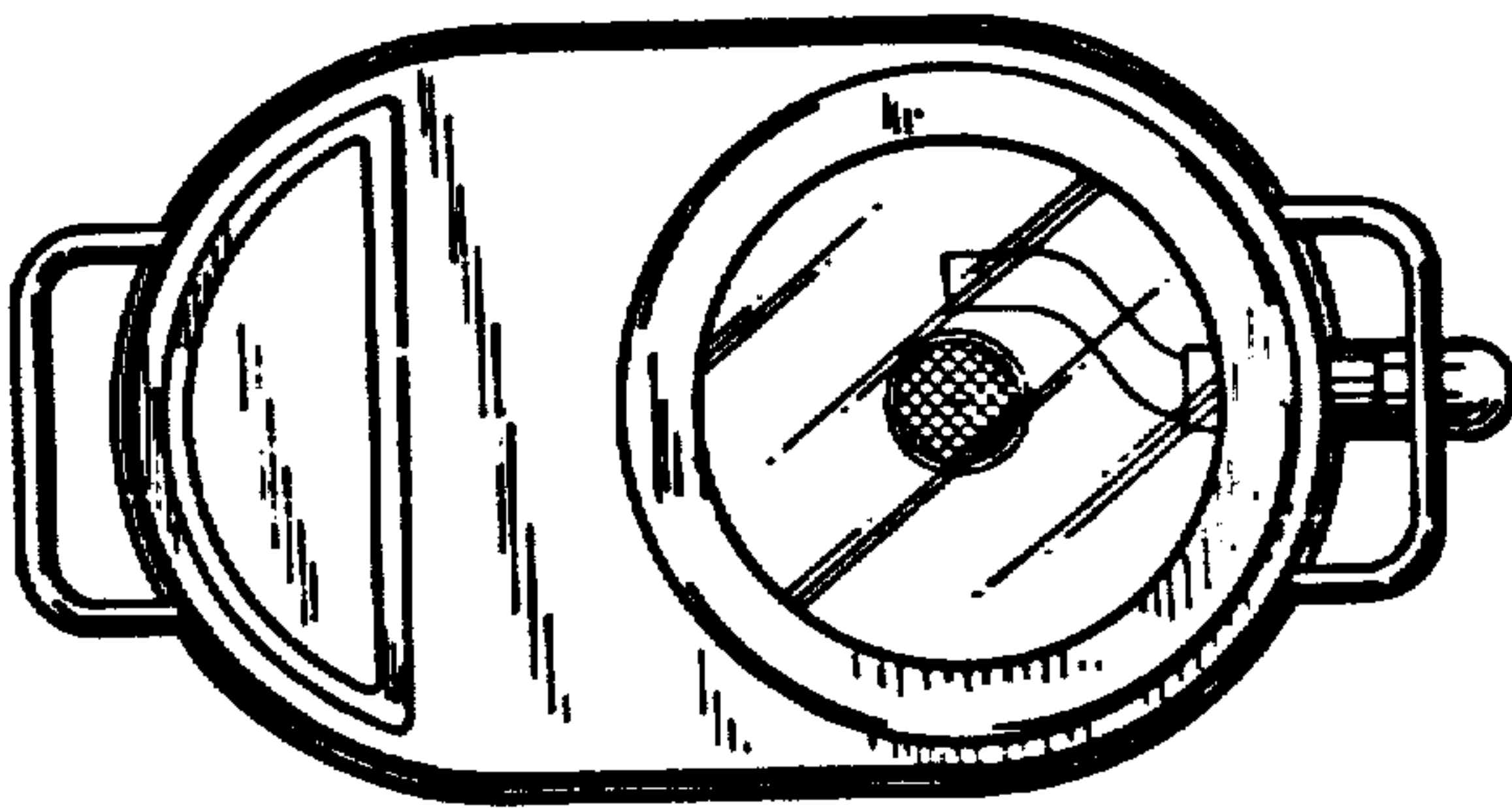




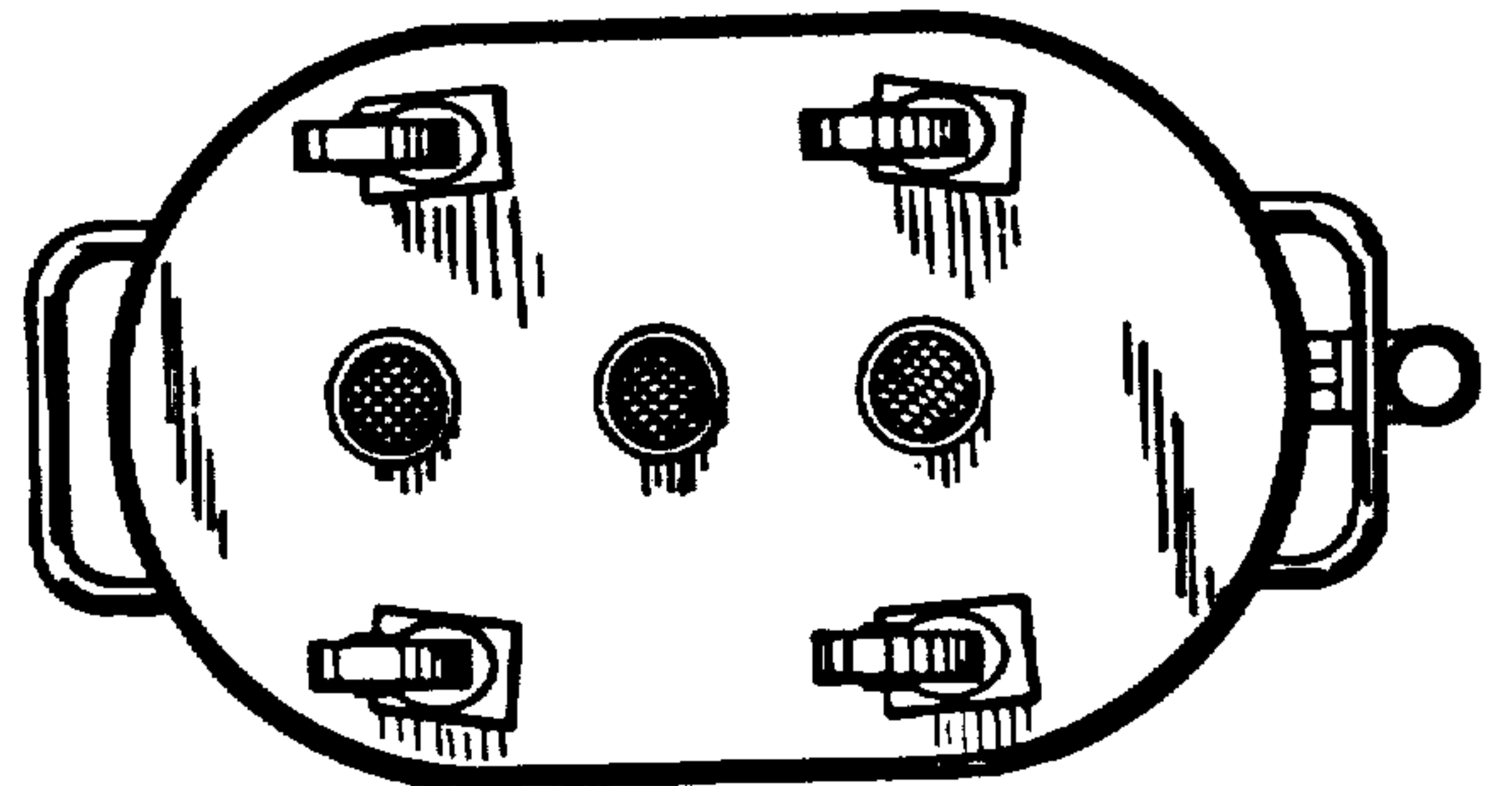

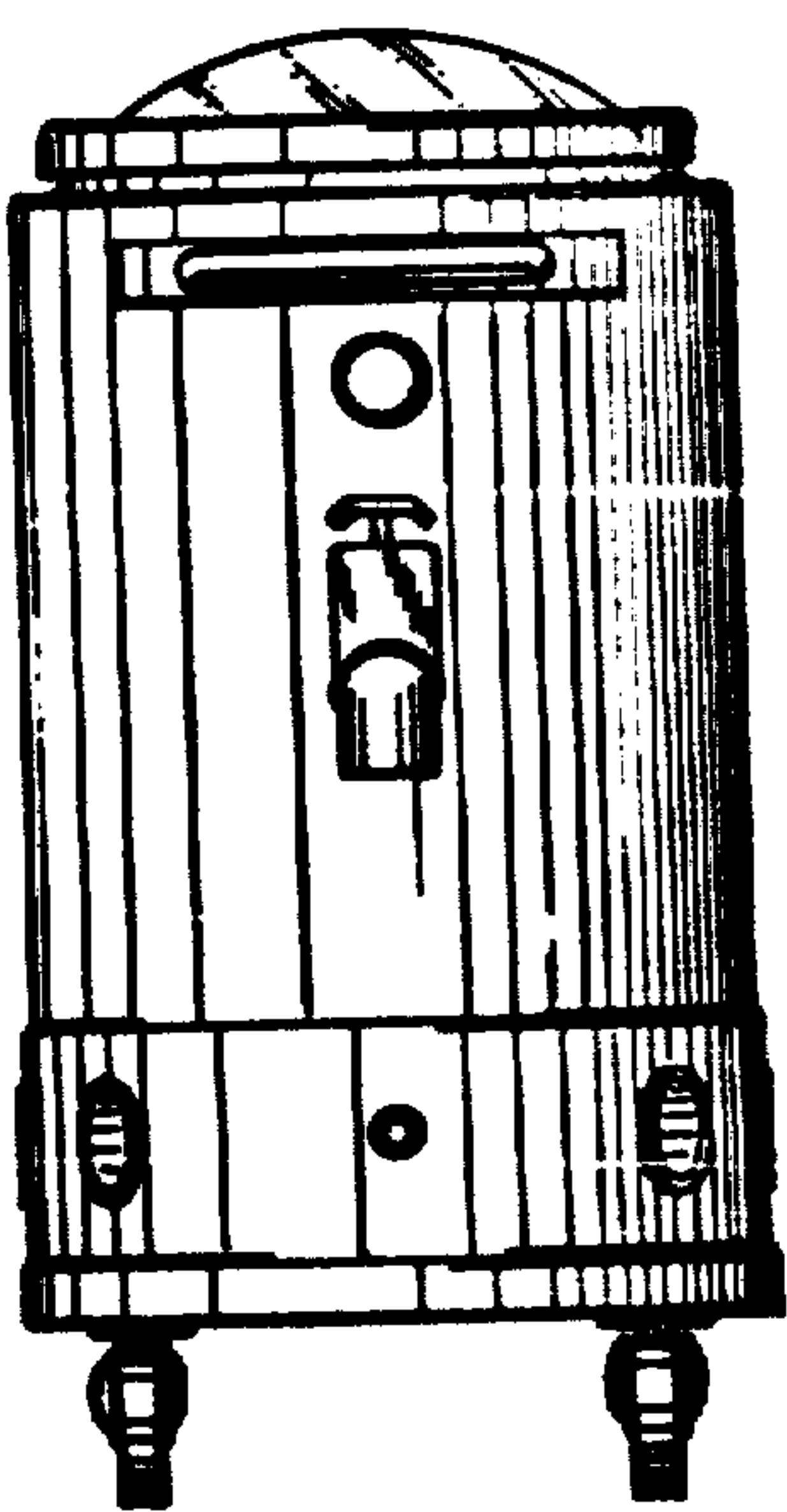

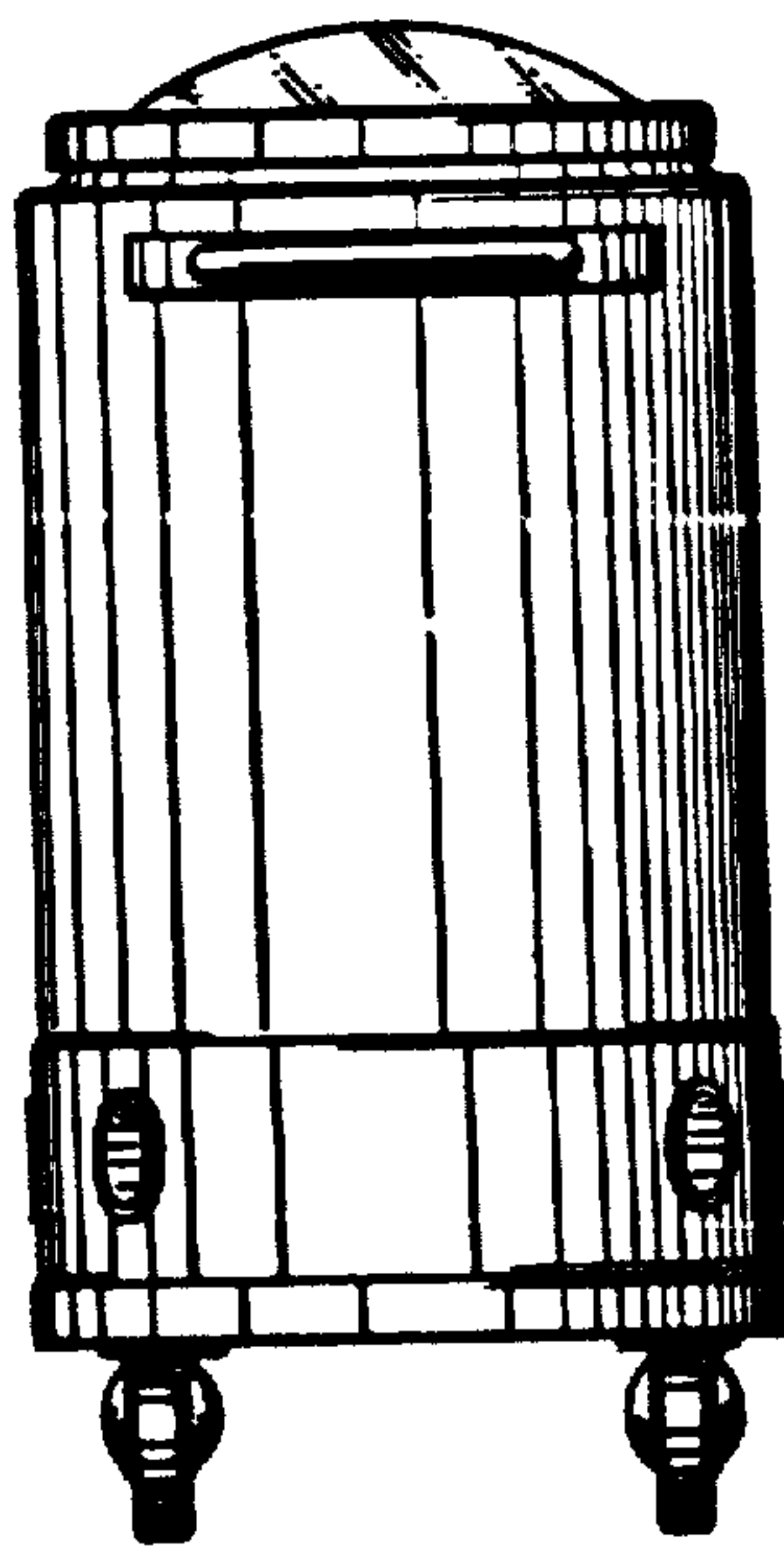

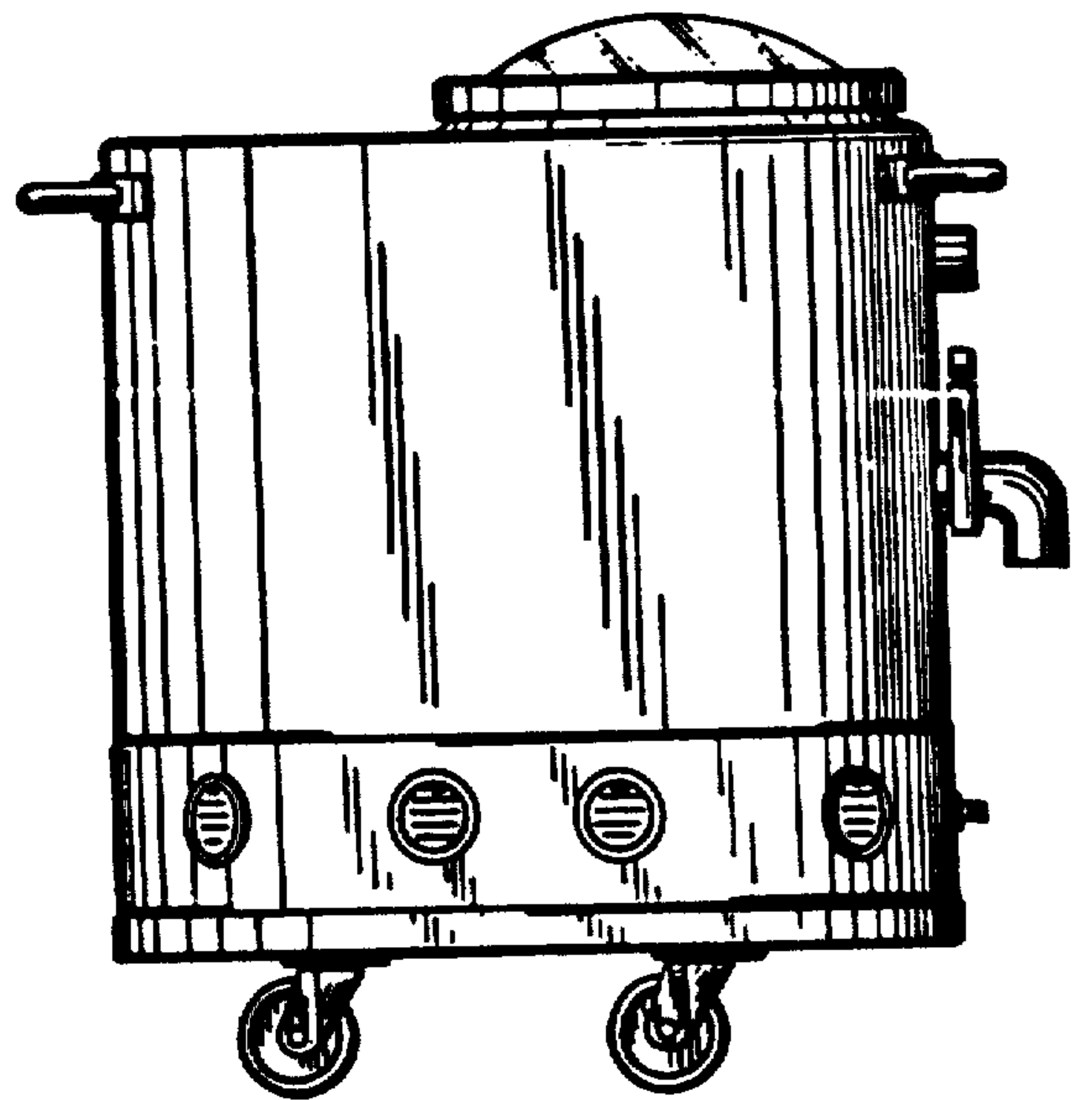
