An ornamental design for eyeglass frame, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an eyeglass frame showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

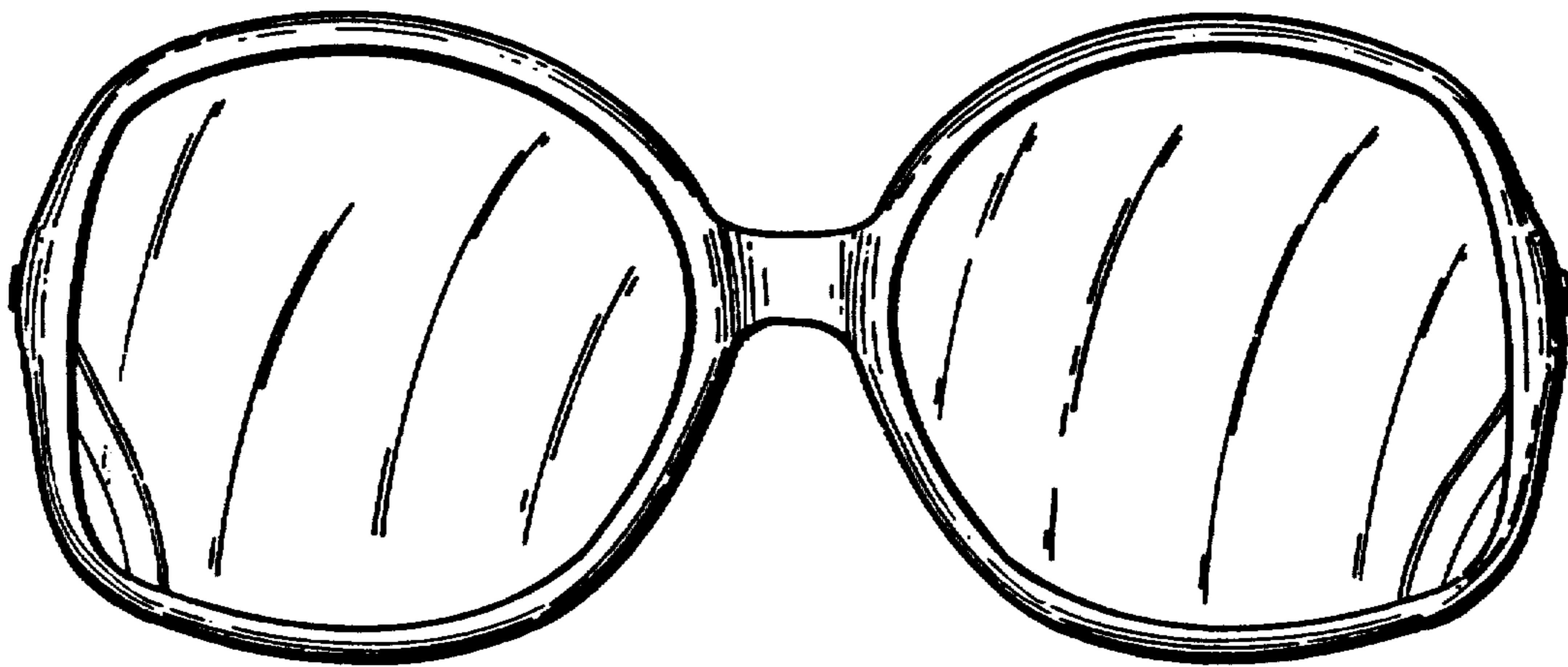

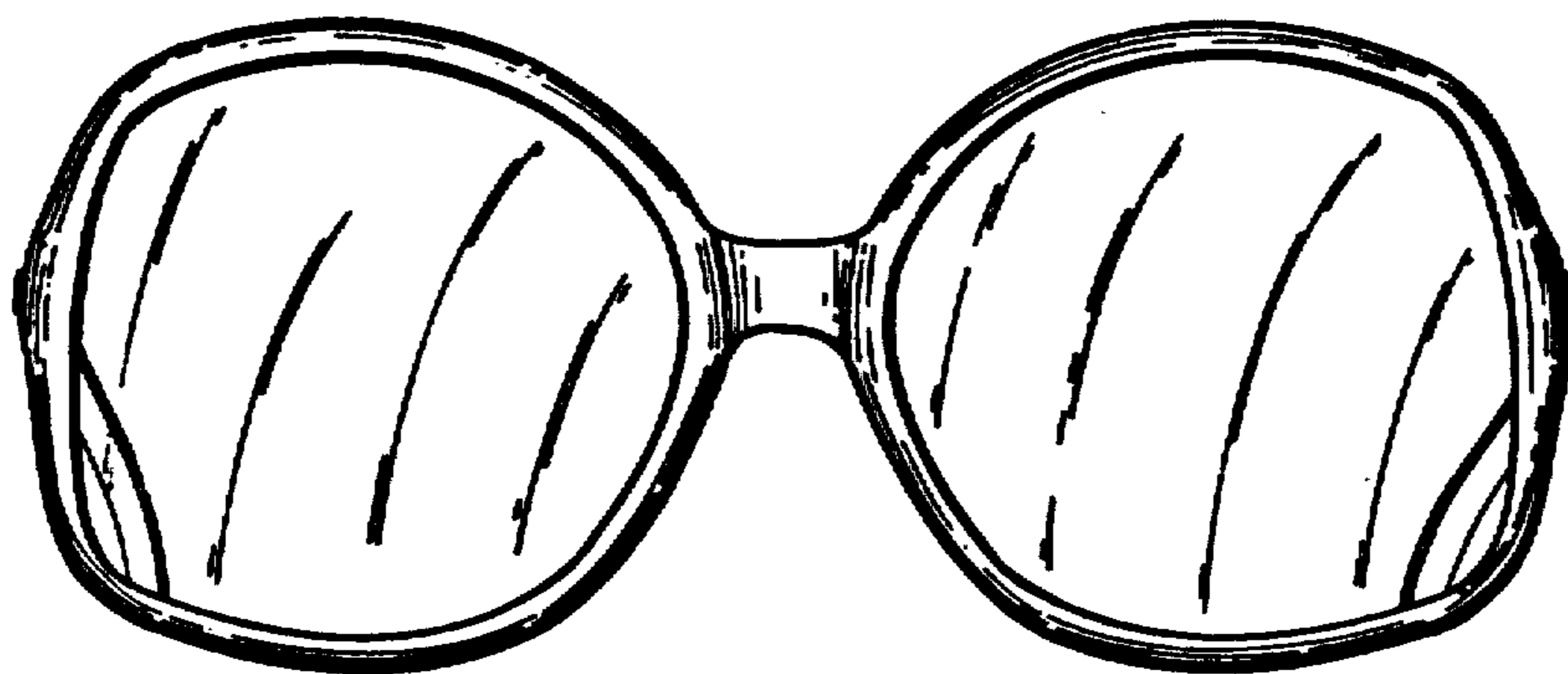

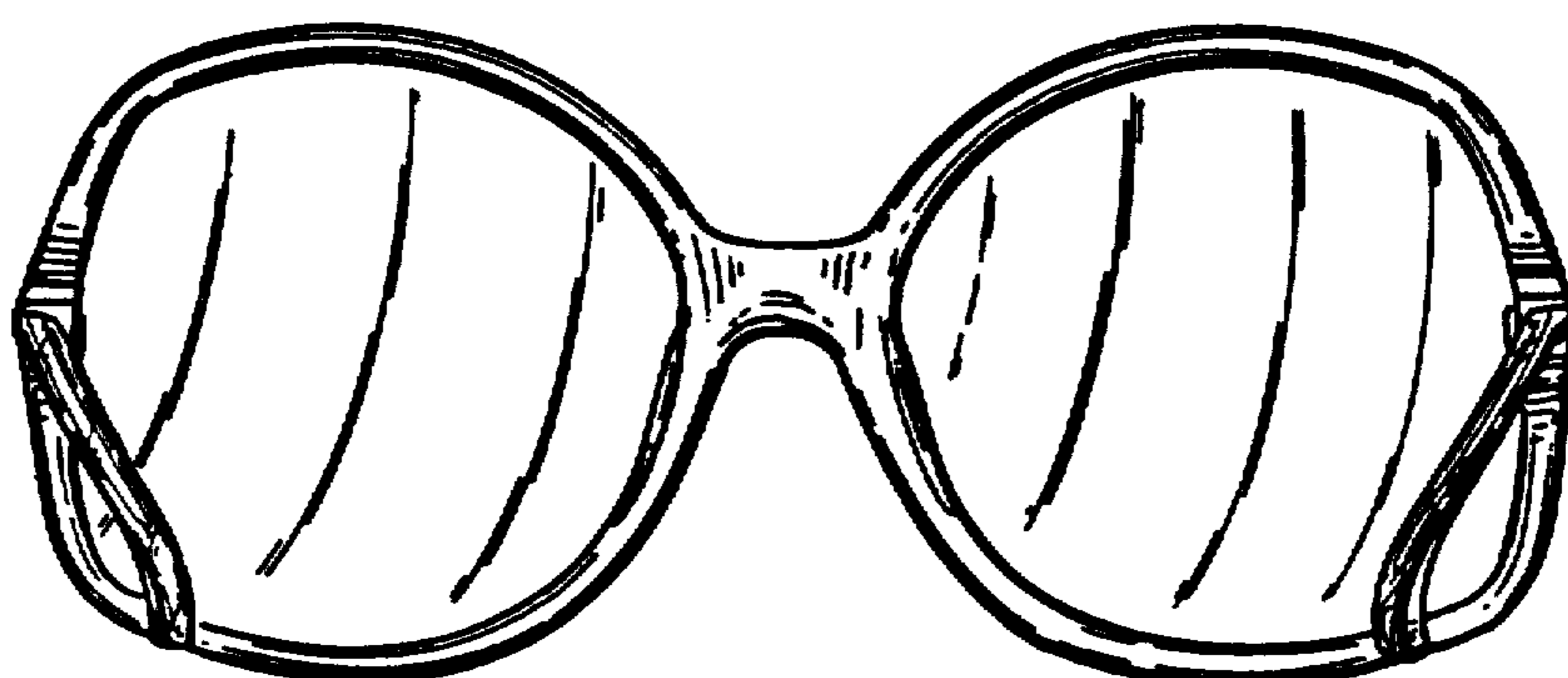

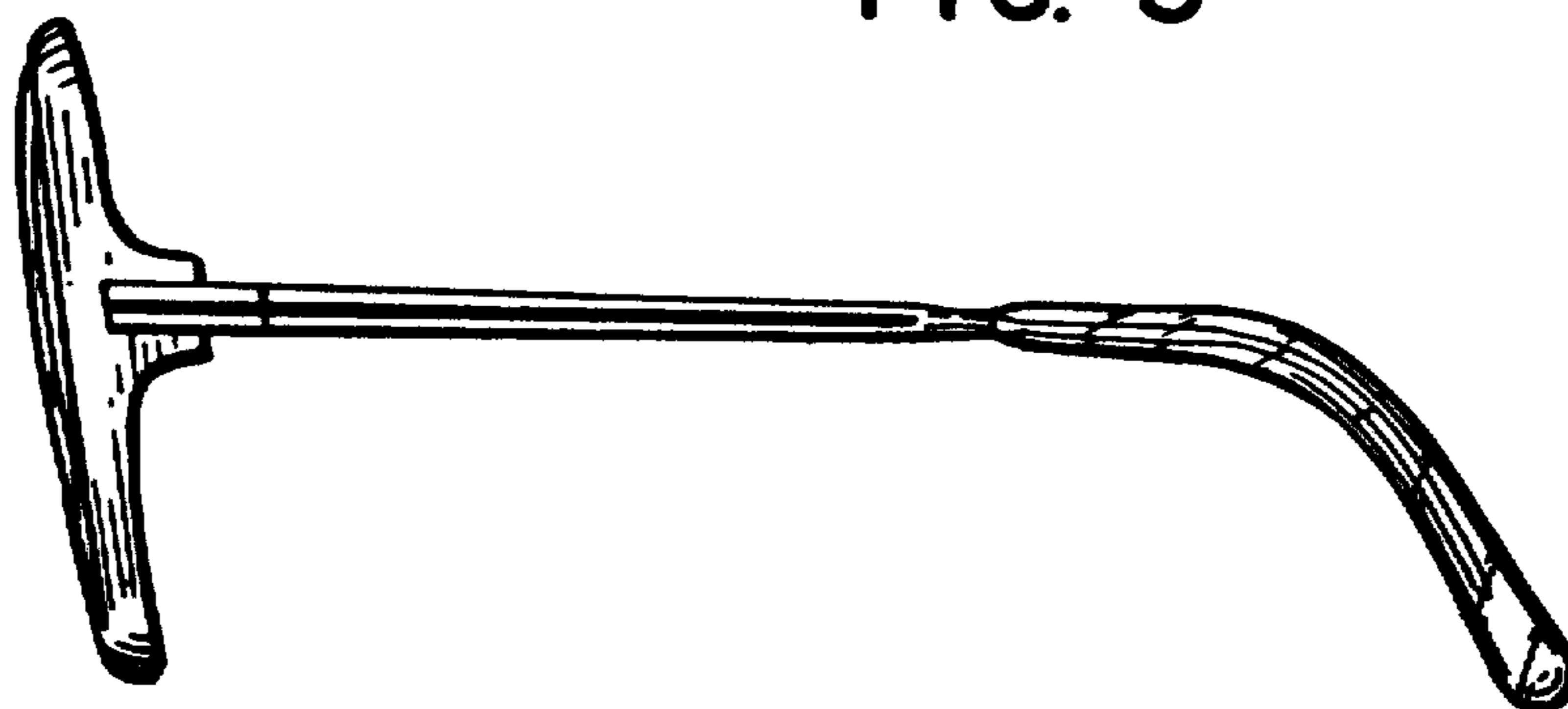

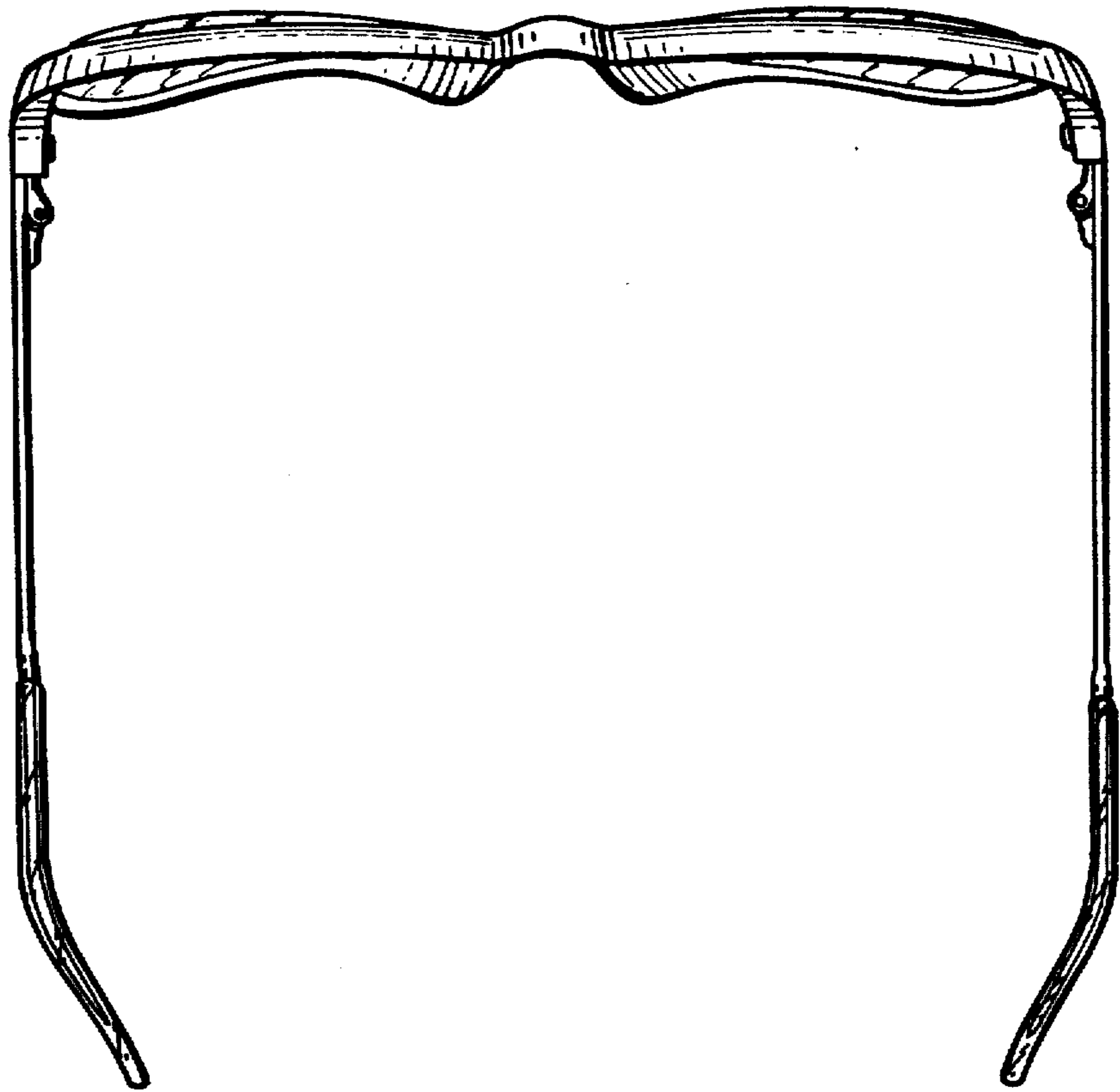
