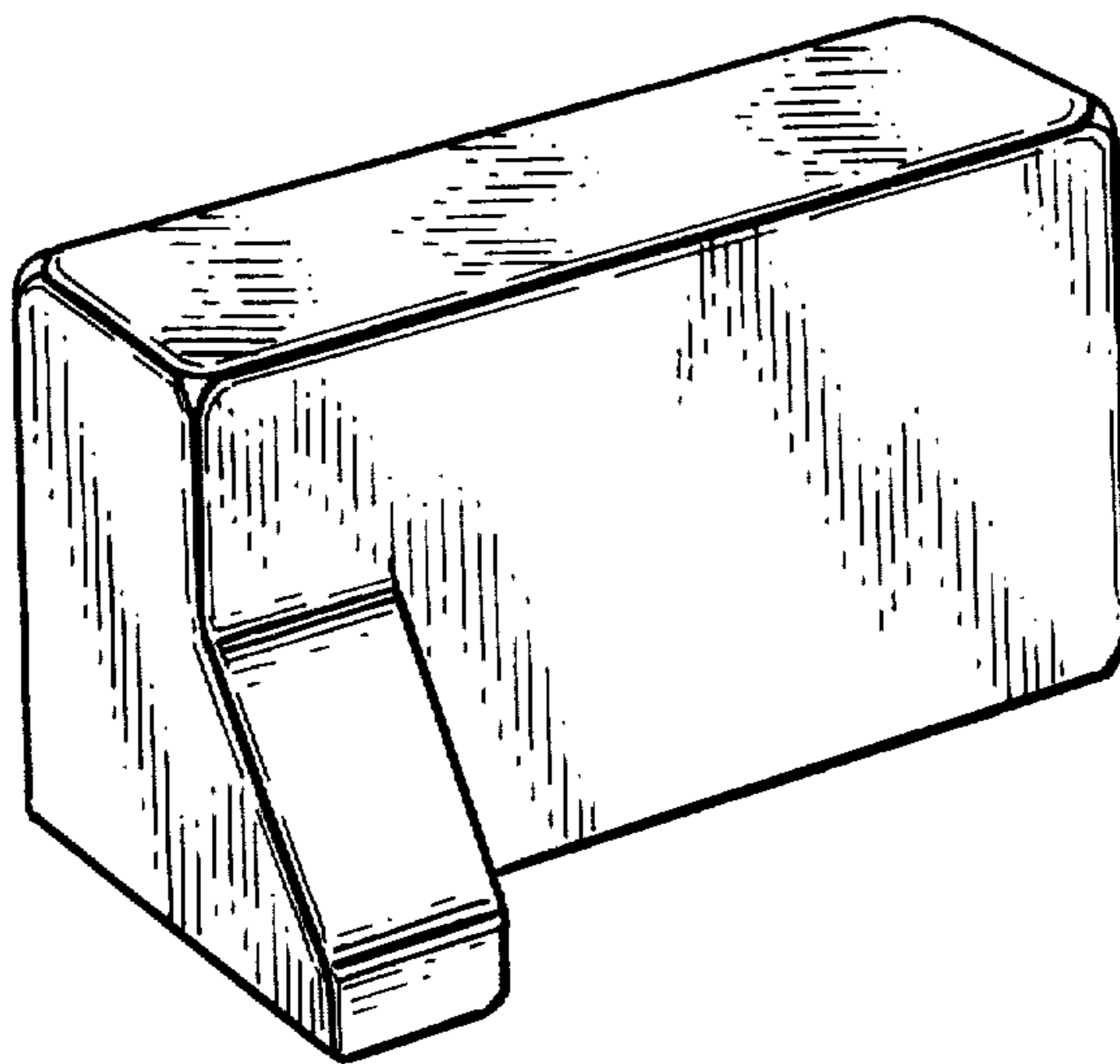

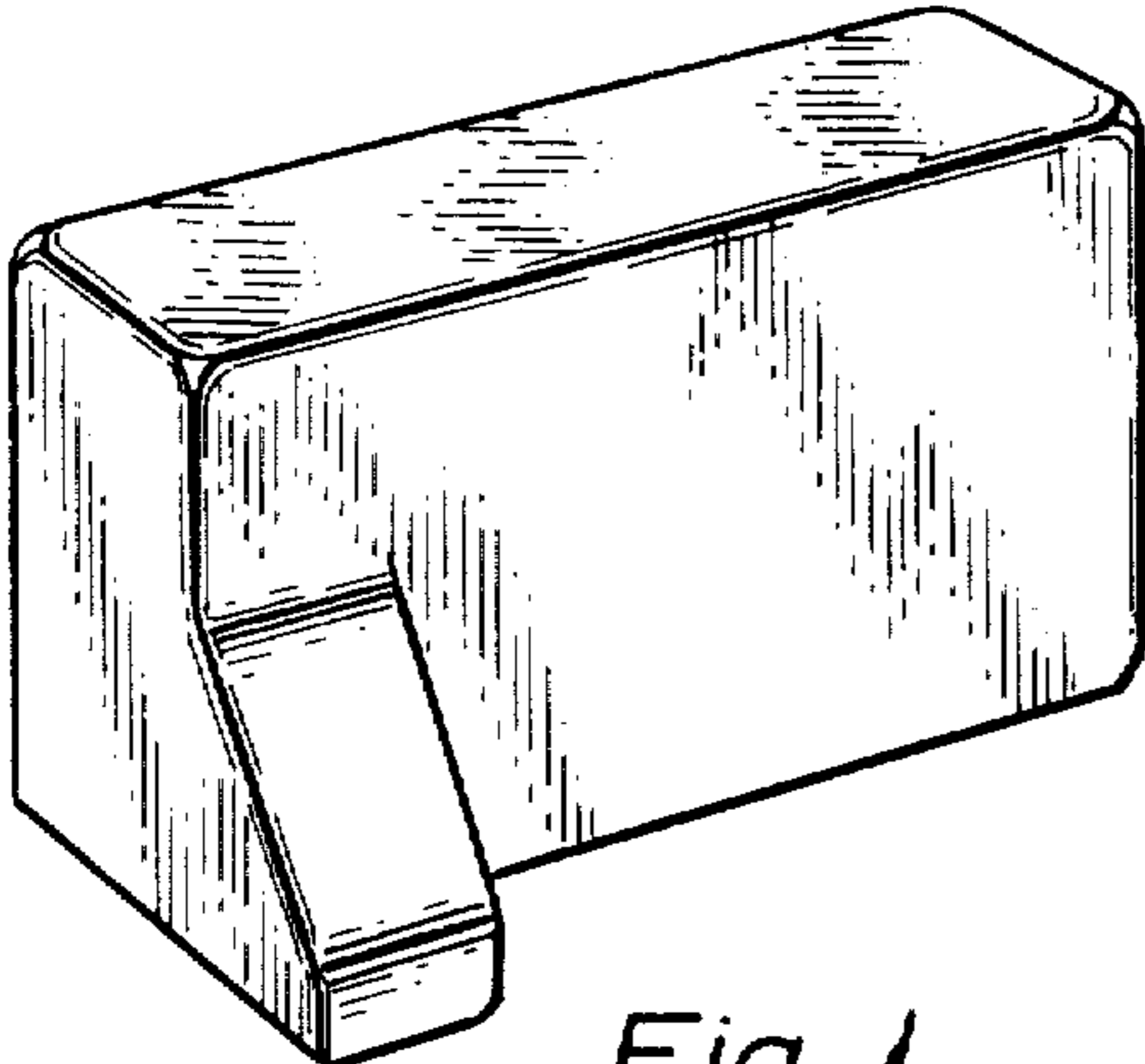
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hand held electronic scanning camera probe, as shown and described.

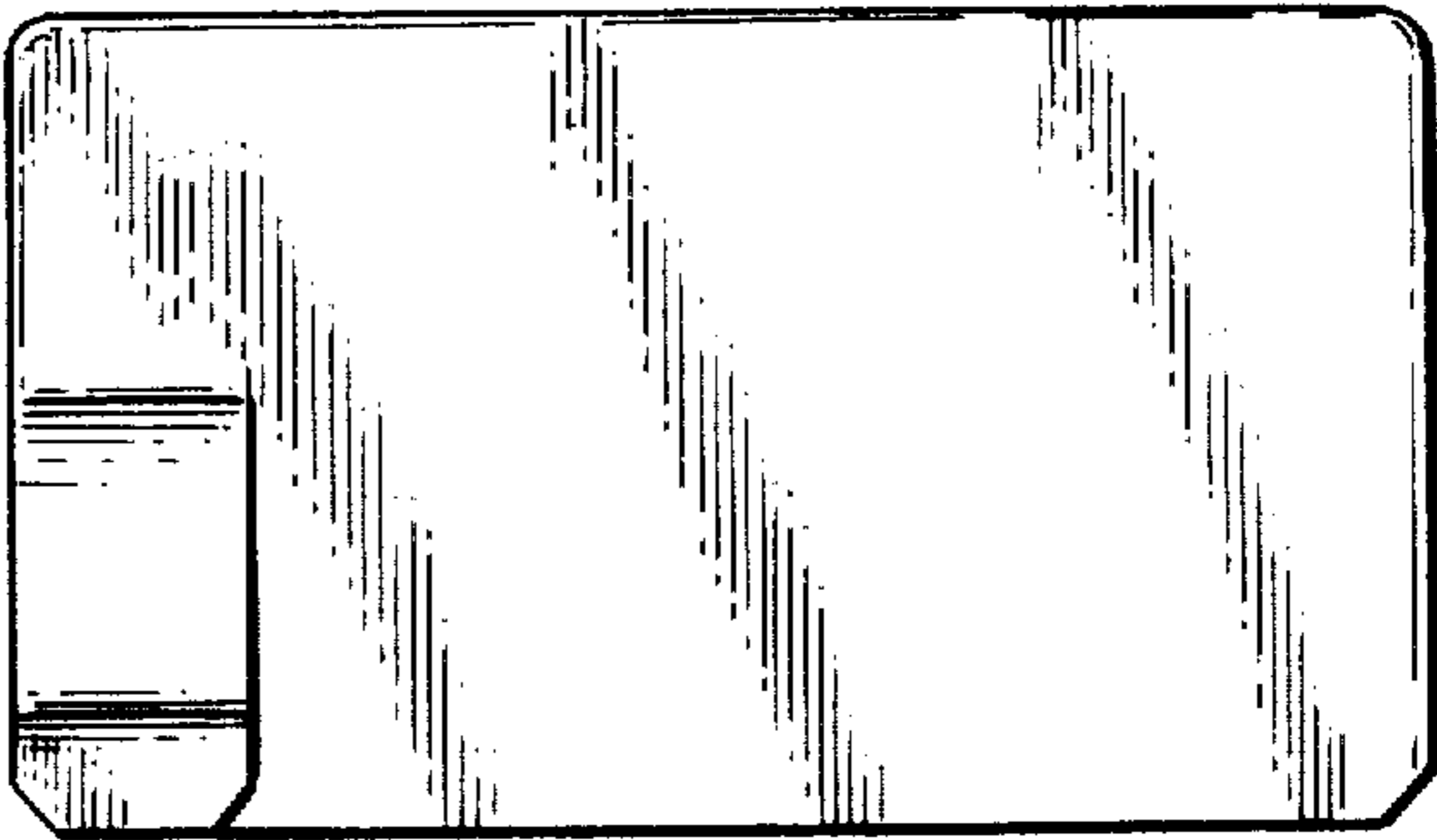
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

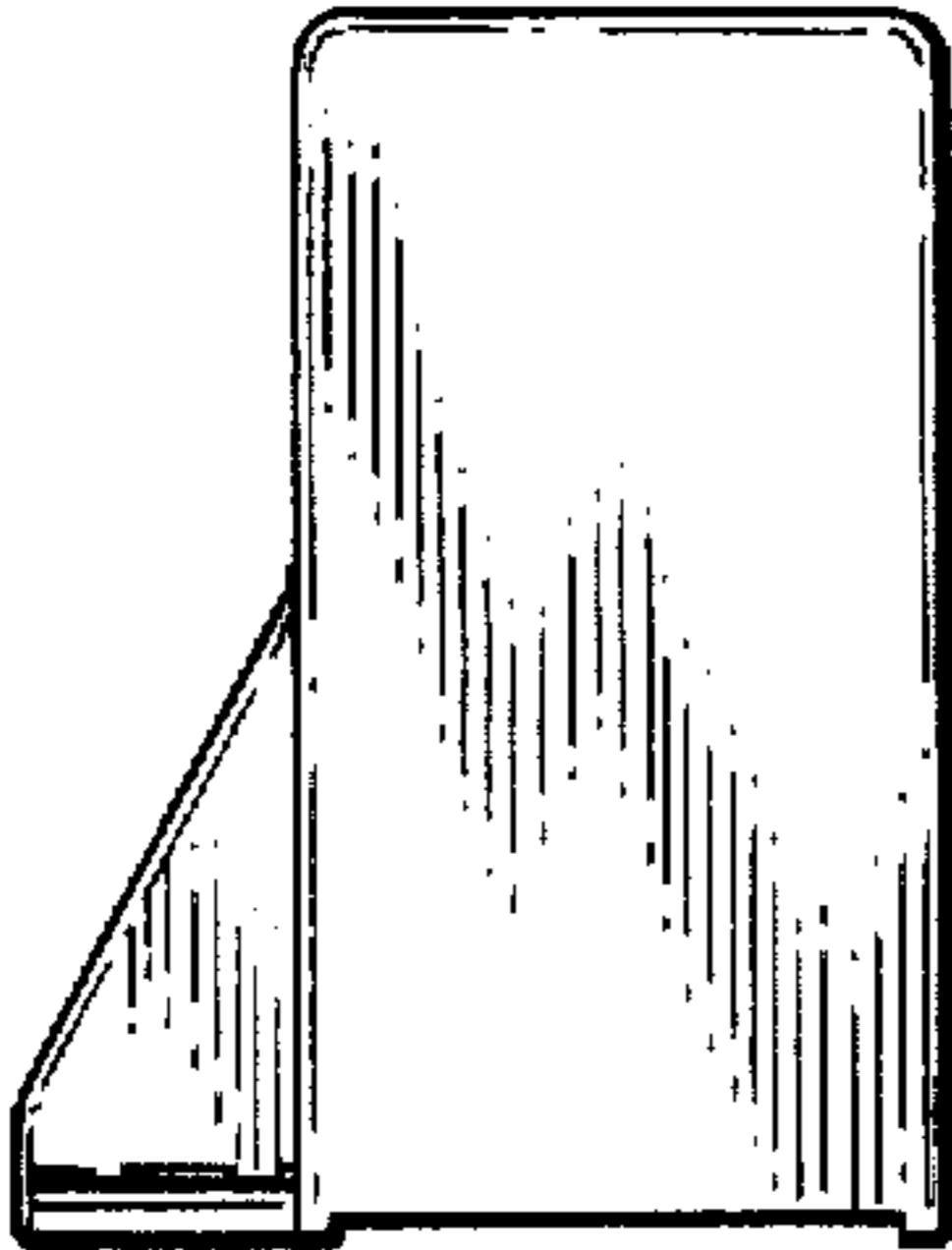




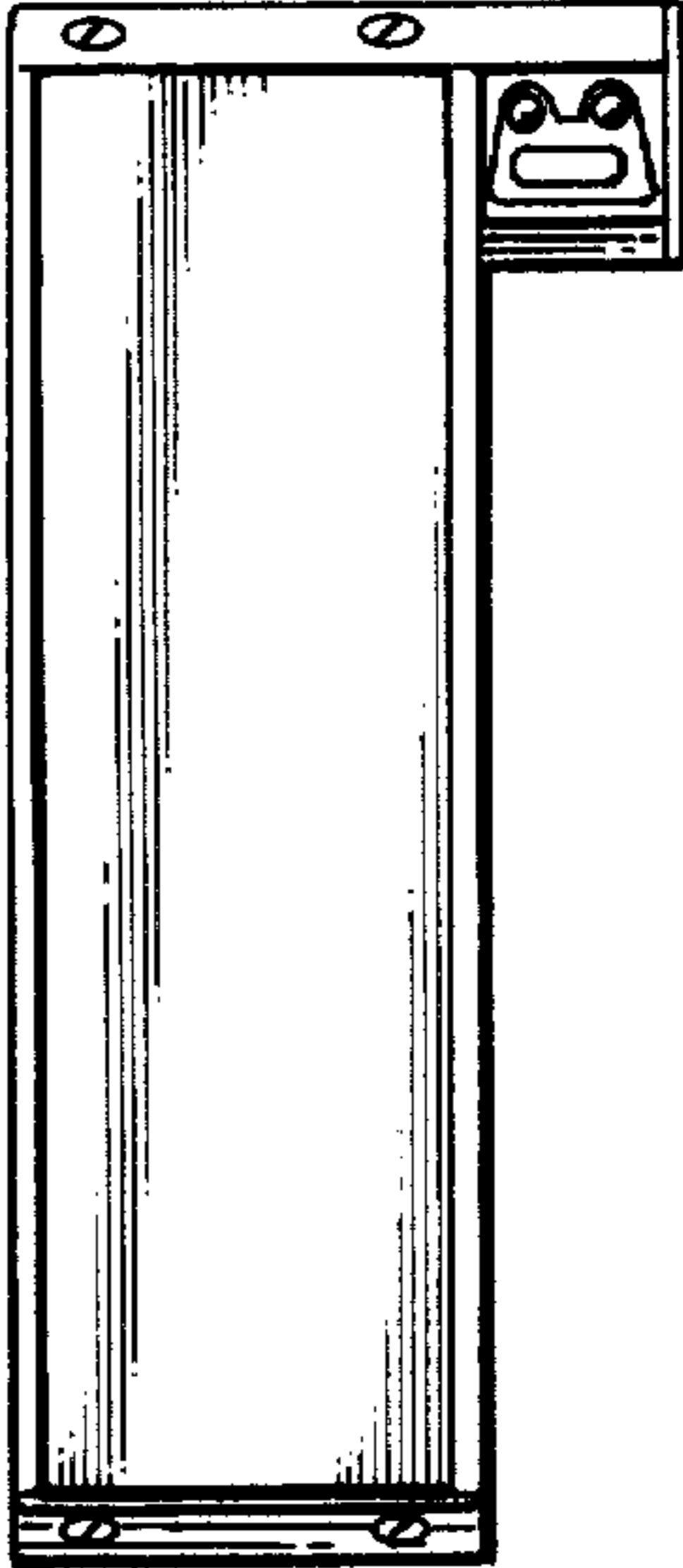
