[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a medical airway tube separator or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a medical airway tube separator or the like, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross section taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

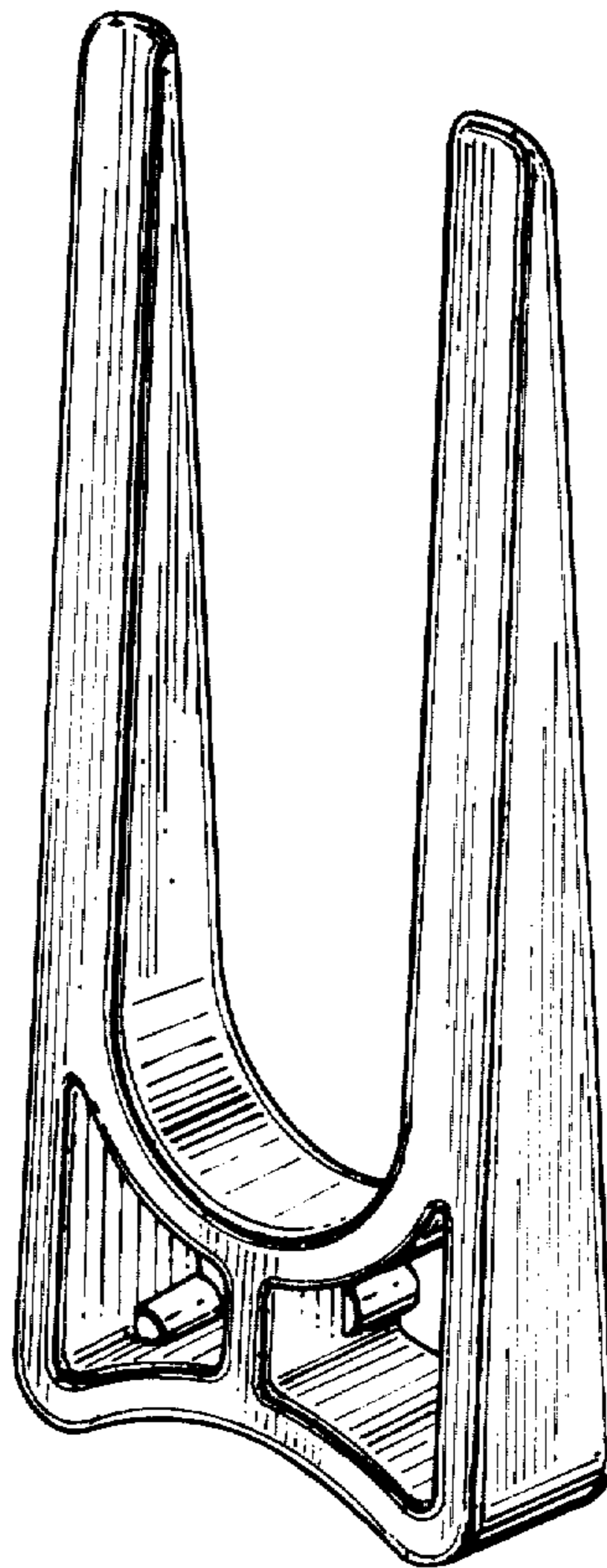

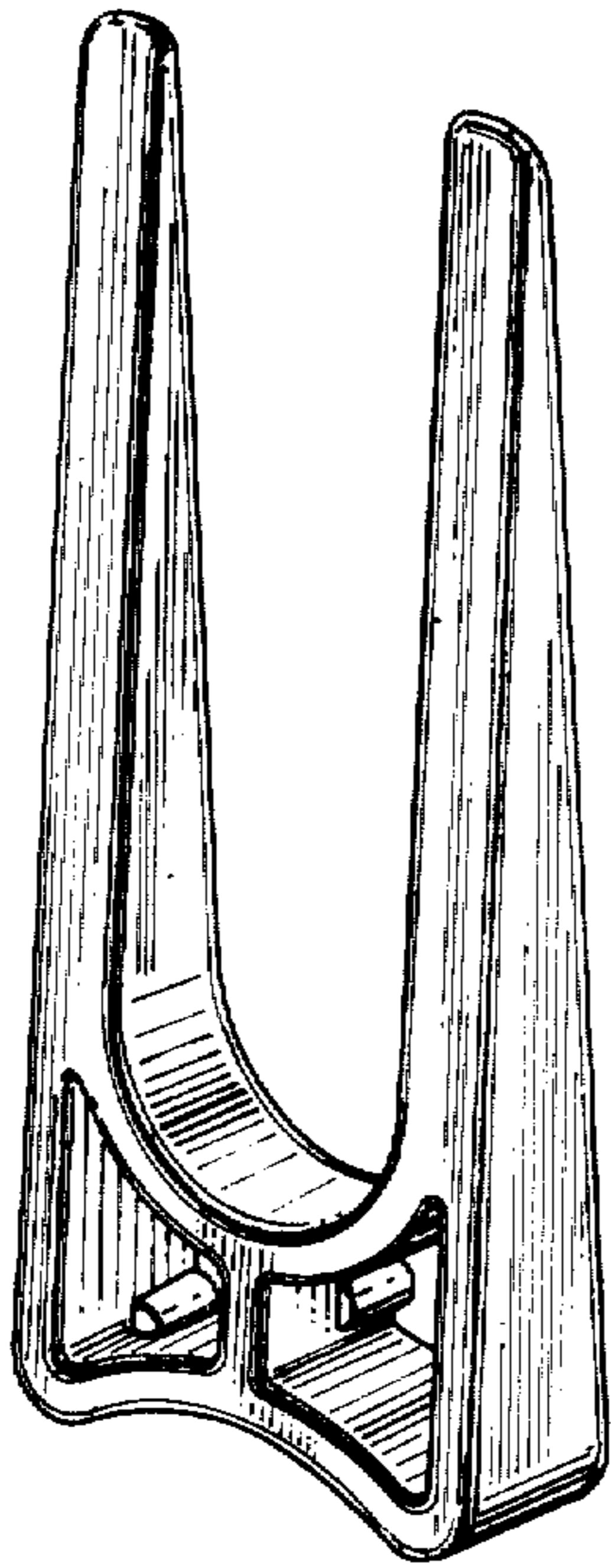

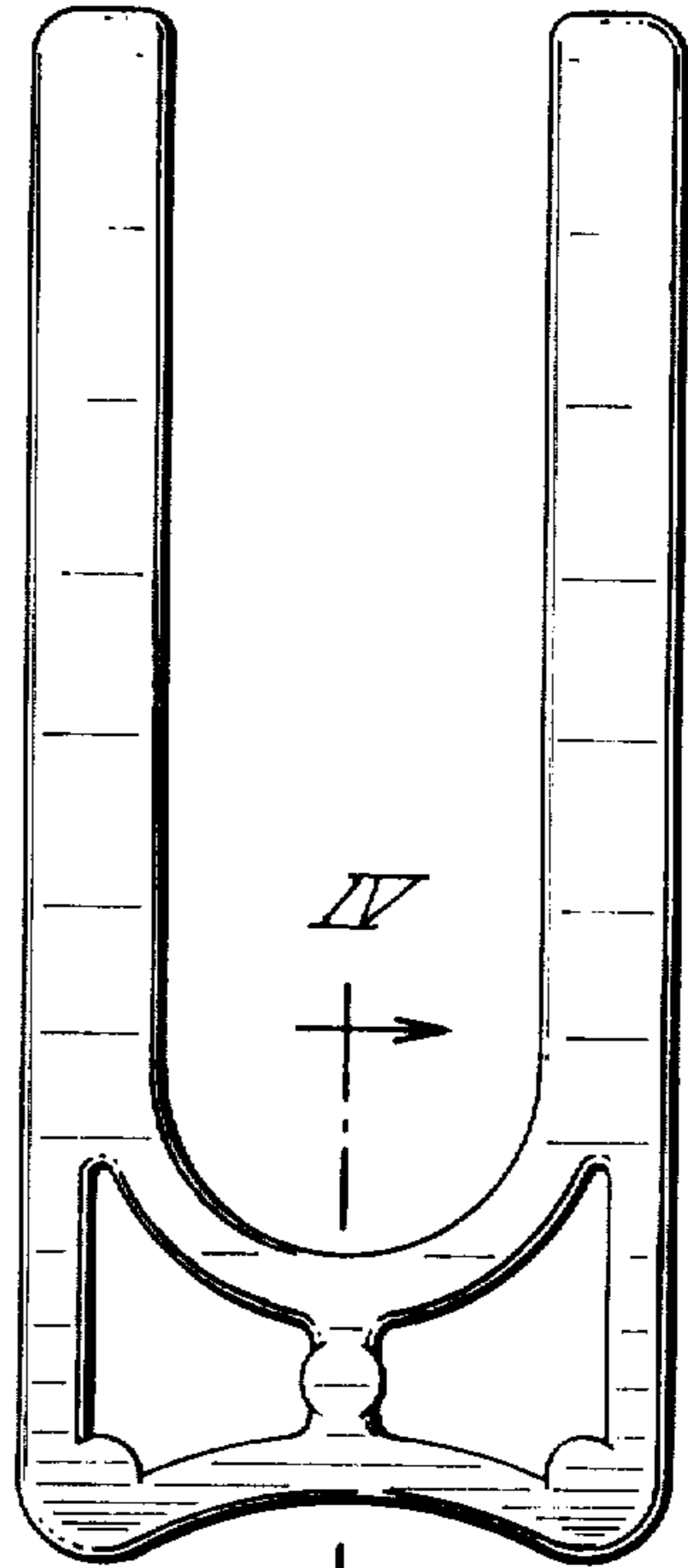

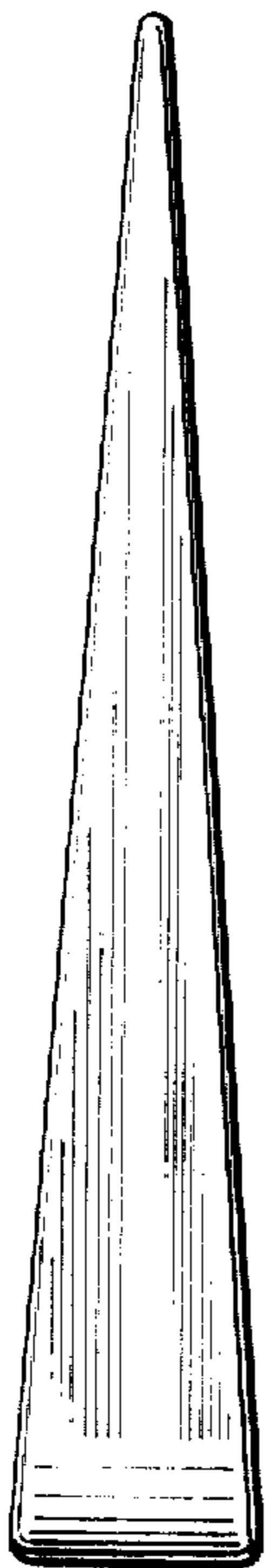

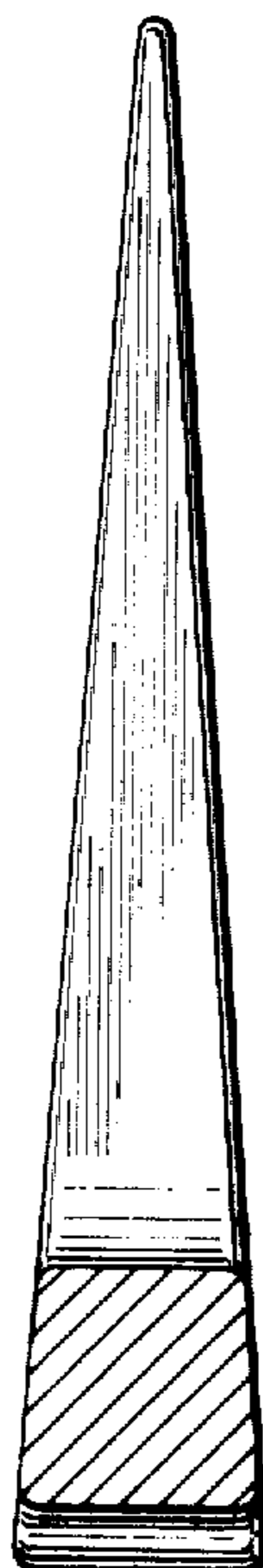
